MULTI-VISUAL PRESENTATION OF THE FUTURE

A MULTI-VISUAL SLIDE SHOW, +VISION OF THE FUTURE+, TODAY (SATURDAY) LAUNCHED A SPECIAL PROGRAMME TO COINCIDE WITH THE 1985 INTERNATIONAL YOUTH YEAR IN YAU MA TEI.

PART OF THE AUDIO-VISUAL QUARTET, THE SHOW WAS ORGANISED BY THE YAU MA TEI AND TSIM SHA TSUI CULTURE AND ARTS ASSOCIATION, AND SPONSORED BY THE DISTRICT BOARD.

SPEAKING AT THE OPENING CEREMONY, DISTRICT OFFICER, MR AUGUSTINE CHENG, PRAISED THE ASSOCIATION FOR ITS CONTRIBUTION TO THE COMMUNITY.

+PROMOTION AND PATRONAGE OF CULTURAL AND ARTISTIC ACTIVITIES ARE ALSO THE CONCERN OF THE YAU MA TEI DISTRICT BOARD,+ HE SAID.

+MUCH OF ITS SUPPORT TAKES THE FORM OF FINANCIAL AID TO LOCAL ORGANISATIONS, AND THE BOARD HAS JUST AGREED TO INCREASE ITS GRANT TO THE ASSOCIATION FROM \$50 000 TO \$85 000, WHICH IS 16 PER CENT OF ITS BUDGET FOR COMMUNITY BUILDING ACTIVITIES AND IS THE LARGEST GRANT TO ONE SINGLE DISTRICT ORGANISATION,+ HE ADDED.

THE SHOW, HELD IN THE HENRY G. LEONG COMMUNITY CENTRE, WAS A UNIQUE PRESENTATION OF THE VARIOUS ASPECTS OF DEVELOPMENT AND CHANGES OF THE COMMUNITY WITH THE USE OF THE LATEST AUDIO-VISUAL TECHNOLOGY WHICH INVOLVED THE OPERATION OF 15 SLIDE PROJECTORS THAT CAST IMAGES ONTO A HUGE SCREEN.

A SEMINAR ON THE REPORT OF THE BROADCASTING REVIEW BOARD WAS ALSO HELD. LEADERSHIP TRAINING FOR EASTERN DISTRICT YOUTHS

A YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING SCHEME WILL BE LAUNCHED IN EASTERN DISTRICT TO PROVIDE TRAINING FOR YOUNG PEOPLE INTERESTED IN COMMUNITY SERVICES.

YOUTHS WANTING TO IMPROVE THEIR SERVICE SKILLS AND LEARN ABOUT THEIR COMMUNITY ARE URGED TO TAKE PART IN THE SCHEME.

THOSE AGED BETWEEN 17 AND 25 AND WHO LIVE, WORK OR STUDY IN THE DISTRICT, ARE WELCOME TO JOIN THE SCHEME, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE EASTERN DISTRICT OFFICE SAID TODAY (SATURDAY).

+ALL TRAINED LEADERS ARE EXPECTED TO ORGANISE AT LEAST ONE COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECT WHEN THEY COMPLETE THEIR TRAINING COURSE,+ HE ADDED.

THE SCHEME IS ORGANISED BY THE EASTERN DISTRICT YOUTH RECREATION CO-ORDINATING COMMITTEE, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT AND LOCAL VOLUNTARY AGENCIES, AND IS SPONSORED BY THE DISTRICT BOARD.

THE FIRST PART OF THE TRAINING SCHEME WILL INVOLVE A SERIES OF SEMINARS BETWEEN NOVEMBER 20 AND JANUARY 4. THE SEMINARS WILL BE HELD EVERY WEDNESDAY EVENING FROM 7.30 PM TO 9.30 PM AT THE HONG KONG FEDERATION OF YOUTH GROUPS MANSION STREET YOUTH CENTRE, 55 MODEL LANE IN NORTH POINT.

THEY WILL FOCUS ON TRAINING YOUTHS IN LEADERSHIP SKILLS, DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION, WORKS AND FUNCTIONS OF COMMITTEES, HUMAN RELATIONSHIP, AND SKILL IN ORGANISING RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES.

THE SECOND PART OF THE SCHEME IS A WORK CAMP ON DECEMBER 14 AND 15.

SEMINAR ON SAFETY IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION

THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT WILL ORGANISE A SEMINAR NEXT MONTH TO REFRESH THE AWARENESS OF PRIMARY SCHOOL TEACHERS ON THE IMPORTANCE OF SAFETY ASPECTS IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION.

THE SEMINAR ON SAFETY PRECAUTIONS IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION FOR PRIMARY SCHOOLS, ORGANISED BY THE PHYSICAL EDUCATION SECTION OF THE DEPARTMENT, WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE LECTURE THEATER OF THE GRANTHAM COLLEGE OF EDUCATION IN GASCOIGNE ROAD ON DECEMBER 7. ABOUT 300 PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHERS WILL ATTEND.

SCHOOL HEADS ARE NOW INVITED TO NOMINATE THEIR PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHERS TO ATTEND THE SEMINAR, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT SAID.

NOMINATIONS SHOULD BE FORWARDED TO THE PRINCIPAL INSPECTOR (PHYSICAL EDUCATION), PHYSICAL EDUCATION SECTION, KOWLOON GOVERNMENT OFFICES, SEVENTH FLOOR, 405 NATHAN ROAD BEFORE NOVEMBER 22.

THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT WILL ALSO HOLD EIGHT +IMPROVE PERSONAL SKILLS ON TABLE TENNIS+ TRAINING COURSES FOR PRIMARY SCHOOL PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHERS.

THE EIGHT HALF-DAY TRAINING COURSES, JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE JUBILEE SPORTS CENTRE AND THE PHYSICAL EDUCATION SECTION OF THE DEPARTMENT, WILL BE HELD AT THE JUBILEE SPORTS CENTRE IN SHA TIN BETWEEN DECEMBER 28 AND 31.

THE HEAD TABLE TENNIS COACH OF JUBILEE SPORTS CENTRE, MR CHENG CHUNG-YIN, WILL BE THE INSTRUCTOR OF THE COURSES. A TOTAL OF 128 TEACHERS WILL BE ACCOMMODATED.

THE FREE COURSES ARE AIMED AT IMPROVING THE PRACTICAL SKILLS OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHERS AND THEIR TECHNIQUES ON TEACHING TABLE TENNIS. THERE WILL BE SESSIONS FOR BOTH THEORY AND PRACTICE DURING THE COURSES.

TEACHERS WISHING TO ATTEND THE COURSES SHOULD SUBMIT THEIR APPLICATIONS TO THE PRINCIPAL INSPECTOR (PHYSICAL EDUCATION) OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT BEFORE DECEMBER 10.

HO MAN TIN, HUNG HOM FLYOVER PROPOSED

* * * *

THE ENGINEERING DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT PROPOSES TO CONSTRUCT A FLYOVER ALONG FAT KWONG STREET AND MAN YUE STREET TO IMPROVE VEHICULAR TRAFFIC BETWEEN HO MAN TIN AND HUNG HOM.

THE TWO-WAY FLYOVER WILL BE 600-METRE LONG AND 7.3-METRE WIDE.

IT WILL RUN FROM FAT KWONG STREET IN HO MAN TIN NEAR CHATHAM ROAD NORTH, CROSS MA TAU WAI ROAD, AND CONTINUE ALONG MAN YUE STREET TO JOIN THE JUNCTION OF MAN LOK STREET IN HUNG HOM.

IT WILL ALSO LINK THE HUNG HOM PORTION OF THE FUTURE NORTH-SOUTH DUAL CARRIAGEWAY WITH THE TO KWA WAN RECLAMATION.

THE PROJECT WILL ALSO INVOLVE WIDENING AND MODIFICATION TO GROUND LEVEL ROADS AT FAT KWONG STREET, MAN YUE STREET AND ASSOCIATED BRANCH ROADS.

A PLAN SHOWING THE PROPOSED WORKS CAN BE SEEN AT:

FOOD ESTABLISHMENT OPERATORS IN THE NON-URBAN AREAS WERE URGED TO FOLLOW HYGIENE RULES WHEN HANDLING FOOD, OR THEY WOULD BE PROSECUTED.

THE REGIONAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT ISSUED THIS WARNING FOLLOWING A RECENT CASE IN WHICH 11 PEOPLE WERE FINED A TOTAL OF \$7 450 AT THE TSUEN WAN MAGISTRACY FOR RELATED OFFENCES.

TWO OF THE OFFENDERS, WHO HAD PREVIOUS CONVICTIONS, WERE EACH FINED \$1 000, AN RSD SPOKESMAN SAID.

THE PROSECUTIONS WERE THE RESULT OF A TWO-WEEK OPERATION LAUNCHED BY THE RSD IN SEPTEMBER IN TSUEN WAN AND KWAI CHUNG DISTRICTS.

THE SPOKESMAN STRESSED THAT THE DEPARTMENT WOULD CONTINUE ITS EFFORTS TO INSPECT FOOD PREMISES TO DISCOURAGE THE MALPRACTICE.

UNDER THE PROVISION OF THE FOOD BUSINESS (NEW TERRITORIES) REGULATIONS, OFFENDERS ARE LIABLE TO A MAXIMUM FINE OF \$2 000 AND AN IMPRISONMENT OF THREE MONTHS, HE ADDED.

TEMPORARY HAUL ROAD PLANNED FOR LAM TIN

* * * * *

A TEMPORARY HAUL ROAD HAS BEEN PLANNED TO LINK THE PROPOSED LAM TIN ESTATE (SOUTH) EXTENSION TO A TEMPORARY RECLAMATION AREA IN JUNK BAY NEAR RENNIE'S MILL.

THE PROPOSED ROAD WILL ENABLE EXCAVATED MATERIAL TO BE TRANSPORTED FROM THE SITE FORMATION WORK OF THE LAM TIN PROJECT TO THE RECLAMATION AREA.

ON COMPLETION OF THE SITE FORMATION, THE TEMPORARY ROAD WILL BE REINSTATED TO CONFORM WITH NATURAL ENVIRONMENT.

DURING CONSTRUCTION, A SECTION OF THE EXISTING FOOTPATH FROM KO CHIU ROAD ESTATE TO RENNIE'S MILL WILL BE PERMANENTLY CLOSED, BUT A DIVERSION WILL BE PROVIDED.

THE WORK ALSO INCLUDES THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FOOTBRIDGE ACROSS THE HAUL ROAD NEAR RENNIE'S MILL.

THE PLAN AND SCHEME MAY BE INSPECTED AT THE CENTRAL AND WESTERN DISTRICT OFFICE, CENTRAL ENQUIRY SUB-OFFICE, CENTRAL GOVERNMENT OFFICES, WEST WING, MAIN ENTRANCE LOBBY, HONG KONG; AND THE SAI KUNG DISTRICT OFFICE AND DISTRICT LANDS OFFICE, SAI KUNG GOVERNMENT OFFICES BUILDING, MAN NIN STREET, SAI KUNG TOWN.
