PROGRAMME FOR ROAD TUNNEL TO JUNK BAY
* * * * *

TENDERS WILL BE INVITED SOON, AND WORK EXPECTED TO START IN AUGUST, ON A SINGLE-TUBE ROAD TUNNEL CONNECTING JUNK BAY WITH THE KWUN TONG AND LEI YUE MUN ROADS.

THIS WAS REVEALED BY THE MAN IN CHARGE OF THE JUNK BAY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT, MR NORMAN TUCKER, SPEAKING AT THE ROTARY CLUB OF THE NEW TERRITORIES TODAY (MONDAY).

+THE FIRST TUBE OF THE ROAD TUNNEL WILL PROVIDE THE TRAFFIC CAPACITY TO SERVE A POPULATION OF BETWEEN 150 000 AND 175 000,+ HE SAID.

+FOR THE FULL DEVELOPMENT OF JUNK BAY PHASE ONE UP TO A POPULATION OF 223 000, IT WILL BE NECESSARY TO CONSTRUCT A SECOND TUBE OF THE TUNNEL AND UPGRADE THE ROAD TO A DUAL-CARRIAGEWAY TWO-LANE ROAD.

+THIS WOULD THEN HAVE SPARE CAPACITY TO SERVE A POPULATION OF UP TO 300 000.+

MR TUCKER SAID THE SINGLE-TUBE TUNNEL WOULD ALSO INCLUDE LARGE WATER MAINS TO CONVEY WATER FROM A NEW TREATMENT WORKS BEING BUILT AT PAK KONG IN SAI KUNG TO EAST KOWLOON AND HONG KONG ISLAND AS WELL AS TO JUNK BAY.

+FURTHER WORK ON THE ROAD NETWORK OF THE TOWN WILL BEGIN IN AUGUST AND ANOTHER RECLAMATION CONTRACT STARTING IN OCTOBER WILL FILL IN THE SEA CHANNEL BESIDE THE FIRST HOUSING ESTATE, PO LAM ESTATE,+ HE ADDED.

MR TUCKER DESCRIBED JUNK BAY NEW TOWN AS +AN ESSENTIAL ELEMENT IN THE PUBLIC HOUSING DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME+.

+SITES IN PHASE ONE OF JUNK BAY WILL CONTRIBUTE SOME 33 000 FLATS TO THE HOUSING STOCK BETWEEN NOW AND 1994, REPRESENTING ABOUT 10 PER CENT OF THE TOTAL PRODUCTION FOR THAT PERIOD.

+THE FIRST PEOPLE ARE EXPECTED TO MOVE INTO PHASE ONE OF PO LAM ESTATE IN JANUARY 1987, AND INTO PHASE TWO IN MID-1987. THERE WILL BE A CONTINUOUS IN-FLOW THEREAFTER UNTIL 1995.+

HE EXPLAINED THAT WHILE THE TWO FOUNDRIES COULD NOT BE REMOVED BEFORE THE FIRST HOUSING BLOCKS WERE OCCUPIED POLLUTION REDUCTION SYSTEMS WOULD BE INTRODUCED UNTIL THE FACTORIES COULD BE RELOCATED.

THE REMAINING INDUSTRIES AT THE HEAD OF THE BAY AREA WOULD BE CLOSED BEFORE THE END OF THE YEAR.

+THE DECISION TO GO AHEAD WITH THE EASTERN HARBOUR CROSSING AND TO INCLUDE AN MTR LINE WILL SIGNIFICANTLY REDUCE THE COST OF AN MTR LINK TO JUNK BAY.

+THIS OFFERS THE POSSIBILITY OF ADDITIONAL TRANSPORT OPTIONS TO SERVE THE TOWN IN THE FUTURE AND ALSO MAKES PROPOSALS FOR FURTHER DEVELOPMENT MORE ATTRACTIVE AND MORE COST EFFECTIVE,+ HE SAID.

NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH SCHEME TO BE PROMOTED

A MAJOR TASK OF THE KWAI CHUNG AND TSING YI DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME COMMITTEE IN THE CURRENT FINANCIAL YEAR WOULD BE TO ASSIST THE POLICE IN FURTHER PROMOTING THE NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH SCHEME IN THE DISTRICT, THE NEWLY-APPOINTED CHAIRMAN, MR CHOI HING-SHUN, SAID TODAY (MONDAY).

+THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH SCHEME IN HIGH-RISE BUILDINGS WAS WELL RECEIVED BY RESIDENTS AND THE DFCC WOULD BE EXPANDING THE SCHEME TO INCLUDE MORE HOUSEHOLDS TO HELP FIGHT CRIME,+ MR CHOI SAID.

THE PROPOSED BUILDINGS TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE SCHEME INCLUDE YEUNG KING HOUSE IN LAI KING ESTATE, BLOCKS 1-3, KWAI FONG TERRACE, BLOCK 19, KWAI SHING ESTATE, AND CHING YUNG HOUSE IN CHEUNG CHING ESTATE.

AT PRESENT, 173 NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH UNITS, COVERING 2 381 HOUSEHOLDS, HAVE BEEN FORMED IN SIX BUILDINGS IN THE DISTRICT.

THE DFCC ALSO PLANS TO PUBLISH A NEWSLETTER TO INFORM LOCAL ORGANISATIONS AND RESIDENTS OF DFCC ACTIVITIES AND TO PUT ACROSS THE CRIME PREVENTION MESSAGE TO THEM.

THE KWAI CHUNG AND TSING YI DISTRICT DFCC THIS YEAR COMPRISES FIVE OFFICIAL MEMBERS AND 12 UNOFFICIALS, THE LATTER COMING FROM VARIOUS SECTORS IN THE DISTRICT, INCLUDING PROFESSIONALS, SOCIAL WORKERS, TEACHERS, INDUSTRIALISTS AND HOUSEWIVES.

REFUSE TRANSFER STATION UNDER STUDY

* * * * *

CONSULTANT ENGINEERS WERE TODAY (MONDAY) APPOINTED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION DEPARTMENT TO PREPARE PROPOSALS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A REFUSE TRANSFER STATION AT KOWLOON BAY. THIS IS PART OF THE DEPARTMENT'S CONTINUING EFFORTS TO PLAN FOR PROPER DISPOSAL OF WASTES.

ACTING PRINCIPAL ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION OFFICER, MR JOHN BOXALL, SAID THE CONSULTANT FIRM, MOTT HAY AND ANDERSON HONG KONG LTD, WILL DEVELOP TECHNICAL PROPOSALS OVER THE NEXT THREE MONTHS, AND THESE WILL BE FORMULATED INTO A CONTRACT AND FINANCIAL PACKAGE FOR TENDER PURPOSES BY THE END OF THE YEAR.

LEADING INTERNATIONAL WASTE MANAGEMENT CONTRACTORS WILL BE INVITED TO SUBMIT TENDERS FOR THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, FINANCING AND OPERATION OF THE STATION, WHICH WILL BE THE FIRST OF ITS KIND IN HONG KONG.

AT PRESENT, MUNICIPAL WASTE COLLECTED BY URBAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT IN THE URBAN AREA IS DISPOSED OF AT THREE INCINERATION PLANTS (KENNEDY TOWN, LAI CHI KOK AND KWAI CHUNG), CHAI WAN COMPOSTING PLANT OR JORDAN VALLEY CONTROLLED TIP.

BY 1989, WHEN THE JORDAN VALLEY CONTROLLED TIP IS FULL, IT IS PROPOSED THAT A REFUSE TRANSFER STATION BE BUILT AT KOWLOON BAY TO REPLACE THE URBAN TIP.

AT THIS FACILITY, WASTE FROM REFUSE COLLECTION VEHICLES WILL BE TRANSFERRED ON TO BULK VEHICLES FOR TRANSPORT TO LARGE-SCALE CONTROLLED TIPS IN THE NEW TERRITORIES.

A SECTION OF MAN KAM TO ROAD BETWEEN JOCKEY CLUB ROAD AND ITS JUNCTION WITH LIN MA HANG ROAD IS TO BE WIDENED TO IMPROVE THE TRAFFIC FLOW FROM HONG KONG TO THE SHENZHEN SPECIAL ECONOMIC ZONE.

THE WORK INVOLVES ABOUT 2.5 KILOMETRES OF MAN KAM TO ROAD WHICH WILL BE BROADENED FROM ITS PRESENT SIX METRES TO 10.3 METRES TO ENABLE IT TO TAKE THREE LANES OF TRAFFIC.

NEW TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS AT TAI WAI

THE PERMANENT KCR TAI WAI STATION, WHICH REPLACES THE TEMPORARY RAILWAY STATION IN TAI WAI INDUSTRIAL AREA AND IS DESIGNED TO CATER FOR A LARGER PASSENGER VOLUME, WILL BECOME OPERATIONAL FROM 5 AM ON WEDNESDAY (APRIL 23).

SPECIAL TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE INTRODUCED IN TAI WAI TO COINCIDE WITH THE OPENING OF THE STATION, UNDER STAGE II OF A TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT MANAGEMENT SCHEME. STAGE 1 CAME INTO FORCE ON APRIL 16. THE FURTHER MEASURES ARE:

TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS

THE TAI WAI BUS TERMINUS WILL BE CONVERTED INTO A TEMPORARY TRANSPORT INTERCHANGE FOR FRANCHISED BUSES, GREEN MINIBUSES, TAXIS AND PRIVATE VEHICLES. THE SECTION OF TSUEN NAM ROAD BETWEEN TAI WAI ROAD AND MEI TIN ROAD WILL BE RE-ROUTED FROM TWO-WAY TO ONE-WAY WESTBOUND. NO VEHICLES OTHER THAN FRANCHISED BUSES WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE TRANSPORT INTERCHANGE FROM MEI TIN ROAD AND CHIK WAN ROAD, OR TO ENTER MEI TIN ROAD FROM TSUEN NAM ROAD.

BUS SERVICES

KMB ROUTE NO 80K (SUN CHUI TO SIU LEK YUEN) AND ROUTE NO 82K (MEI LAM TO KCR FO TAN STATION) WILL BE REVISED. ON JOURNEYS TO SIU LEK YUEN, BUSES ON ROUTE NO 80K WILL BE DIVERTED VIA CHE KUNG MUI ROAD, MEI TIN ROAD, TSUEN NAM ROAD, TAI WAI BUS TERMINUS, TAI WAI ROAD AND TAI PO ROAD. ON SUN CHUI-BOUND JOURNEYS BUSES WILL BE DIVERTED VIA TAI PO ROAD, SHING HO ROAD, CHIK FUK STREET, CHIK LUK LANE, TSUEN NAM ROAD, MEI TIN ROAD AND CHE KUNG MUI ROAD.

ON JOURNEYS TO FO TAN, BUSES ON ROUTE NO 82K WILL BE DIVERTED VIA MEI TIN ROAD, TSUEN NAM ROAD, TAI WAI BUS TERMINUS, TAI WAI ROAD, CHIK FAI STREET, MEI TIN ROAD AND CHE KUNG MUI ROAD. ON MEI LAM-BOUND JOURNEYS, BUSES WILL OPERATE VIA CHE KUNG MUI ROAD, MEI TIN ROAD, TSUEN NAM ROAD, TAI WAI BUS TERMINUS, TAI WAI ROAD, CHIK FAI STREET AND MEI TIN ROAD.
