SIR PHILIP VISITS LAND TRANSPORT AGENCY

\* \* \* \* \*

SIR PHILIP HADDON-CAVE, DEPUTY TO THE GOVERNOR, TODAY VISITED THE GOVERNMENT LAND TRANSPORT AGENCY. HE WAS BRIEFED BY MR JOHN GRAY, CONTROLLER, GOVERNMENT LAND TRANSPORT AND HIS SENIOR STAFF ON THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE AGENCY.

SIR PHILIP THEN VISITED THE KAI TAK AND HONG KONG TRANSPORT POOLS. HE MET THE TRANSPORT SUPERVISORS AND THEIR STAFF, AND SAW TRANSPORT OPERATIONS AND TRAINING ACTIVITIES.

THE GOVERNMENT LAND TRANSPORT AGENCY WAS FORMED IN MAY 1978 UNDER SIR PHILIP HADDON-CAVE WHEN HE WAS THE FINANCIAL SECRETARY. THE AIM WAS TO ENSURE THAT ALL THE RESOURCES OF THE GOVERNMENT VEHICLE FLEET, CONSISTING OF SOME 5 000 VEHICLES AT THE TIME, WERE MANAGED EFFICIENTLY, AND TO CO-ORDINATE TRANSPORT RESOURCES IN THE MOST ECONOMICAL WAY.

IN 1979, THE GOVERNMENT LAND TRANSPORT AGENCY BECAME INDEPENDENT AND TOOK OVER THE MANAGEMENT OF THE GOVERNMENT TRANSPORT POOLS FROM THE THEN ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL OFFICE. THE CONTROLLER, GOVERNMENT LAND TRANSPORT NOW ADMINISTERS ALL THE TRANSPORT MANAGEMENT AND DRIVER GRADES OF OVER 3 000 PERSONNEL.

THE GOVERNMENT LAND TRANSPORT AGENCY HAS INTRODUCED MODERN TECHNIQUES INTO THE MANAGEMENT OF THE GOVERNMENT VEHICLE FLEET WHICH NOW HAS A TOTAL OF 6 000 VEHICLES WITH A CAPITAL COST OF \$650 MILLION. THE GROWTH OF THE GOVERNMENT VEHICLE FLEET HAS BEEN REDUCED FROM 9.8 PER CENT IN 1978/79 TO 4.5 PER CENT IN 1983/84, ESSENTIALLY BY ADVISING DEPARTMENTS HOW TO MAKE MORE EFFECTIVE USE OF EXISTING RESOURCES. IN 1984 IT IS INTENDED TO INTRODUCE COMPUTER SYSTEMS WHICH WILL IMPROVE THE CURRENT TRANSPORT MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM.

THIS IN TURN WILL ENHANCE THE ABILITY OF THE AGENCY TO MAXIMISE THE UTILISATION OF GOVERNMENT VEHICLES.

U.S. WITHDRAWS RESTRAINT REQUEST  
\* \* \* \*

FOLLOWING RECENT INCONCLUSIVE CONSULTATIONS IN WASHINGTON, THE TRADE DEPARTMENT HAS BEEN NOTIFIED THAT THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT HAS DECIDED TO WITHDRAW THE REQUEST FOR RESTRAINT ON HONG KONG'S EXPORTS OF COTTON SHEETS (CATEGORY 361).

ANNOUNCING THIS TODAY, THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF TRADE, MR MICHAEL CARTLAND, SAID THAT HONG KONG HAD BEEN PREPARING TO MAKE A COMPLAINT ABOUT THE CASE AT THE NEXT MEETING OF THE TEXTILES SURVEILLANCE BODY IN GENEVA, BUT IN VIEW OF THE UNITED STATES' WITHDRAWAL, THIS WOULD NO LONGER BE NECESSARY.

+NEVERTHELESS THIS CASE DEMONSTRATES THE NEED TO MAINTAIN CONSTANT VIGILANCE TO ENSURE THAT HONG KONG'S RIGHTS UNDER THE MFA ARE UPHELD AND ARE NOT OVERLOOKED BY THE UNITED STATES OR OTHER IMPORTING COUNTRIES IN AN ATTEMPT TO APPEASE THEIR DOMESTIC TEXTILE LOBBIES,+ HE SAID.

THE TRADE DEPARTMENT HAS RESUMED THE ISSUE OF EXPORT AUTHORISATIONS FOR CATEGORY 361 WITH EFFECT FROM TODAY.

AND HONG KONG FOOTBALL CLUB. ON NOVEMBER 19 AND 20 (SATURDAY AND SUNDAY), GAMES WILL START AT 9.30 AM, OFFERING THE PROMISE OF TWO GREAT DAYS OF BOWLING.

SCHOOLS GET FIRE PREVENTION TEACHING KITS

FIRE PREVENTION TEACHING KITS WERE TODAY DISTRIBUTED TO MORE THAN 500 SCHOOL REPRESENTATIVES AT A CEREMONY HELD IN THE WONG TAI SIN FIRE STATION.

THE 67-PAGE BI-LINGUAL TEACHING KIT, JOINTLY PRODUCED BY THE FIRE SERVICES DEPARTMENT, THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT AND THE GOVERNMENT INFORMATION SERVICES, PROVIDES INFORMATION ABOUT FIRE PREVENTION, AND CONTAINS ILLUSTRATIONS, PHOTOGRAPHS, SLIDES AND CASSETTE TAPES.

ONE THOUSAND SETS OF THE KIT WERE RECENTLY PREPARED, WITH THE SUPPORT OF \$200 000 FROM MCDONALD'S RESTAURANTS (HK) LTD. THESE WERE IN ADDITION TO THE FIRST LOT OF 120 SETS DISTRIBUTED TO THE COLLEGES OF EDUCATION AND KEPT IN THE VISUAL EDUCATION SECTION OF ED.

ALTHOUGH THE FIRE RECORD IN HONG KONG WAS GOOD IN COMPARISON WITH OTHER BIG CITIES WITH SIMILAR FIRE RISKS, MR LAM SAID, THERE SHOULD BE NO ROOM FOR COMPLACENCY.

+ONLY BY APPROPRIATE PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES CAN WE KEEP FIRE RECORDS LOW AND LESSEN THE DANGER IN SOME CASES,+ HE ADDED.
