AUSTRALIAN MPS VISIT SHA TIN NEW TOWN
* * * * *

THE PARLIAMENTARY DELEGATION TO THE PACIFIC REGION AND ASIA FROM QUEENSLAND TODAY (SATURDAY) SAW THE OLD AND THE NEW SHA TIN.

LED BY MR. NORM LEE, MINISTER FOR INDUSTRY AND ADMINISTRATION, THE NINE-MEMBER AUSTRALIAN DELEGATION TOURED THE OLD SHATIN MARKET WHICH IS TO BE EVENTUALLY CLEARED TO MAKE WAY FOR A NEW TOWN CENTRE.

THEY INSPECTED SHA TIN NEW TOWN'S FIRST PUBLIC HOUSING ESTATE, LEK YUEN ESTATE, AND ITS MANY MODERN FACILITIES. THEY ALSO VISITED A FAMILY AT LEK YUEN AND TOURED THE NEW MARKET AND SUPERMARKET AREAS.

THE VISITORS STARTED THEIR HALF-DAY FACT-FINDING TOUR WITH A BRIEFING AND DISCUSSION WITH THE ACTING SECRETARY FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES, MR. JOHN TODD, AT THE NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION HEADQUARTERS, KOWLOON.

ACCOMPANIED BY THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES (DEVELOPMENT), MR. ROBERT UPTON AND OTHER SENIOR OFFICIALS, THE MPS WENT UP TO A VANTAGE POINT AT SHA TIN WAI TO TAKE A BIRD'S EYE VIEW OF THE NEW TOWN'S DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS.

THEY WERE BRIEFED BY THE SHA TIN DISTRICT OFFICER, MR. GERRY HIGGINSON, AND THE SHA TIN PROJECT MANAGER, MR. KWEI SEE-KAN ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE NEW TOWN INTO A BALANCED, SELF-CONTAINED COMMUNITY OF HALF A MILLION PEOPLE BY MID-1980'S.

ONE MEMBER OF THE DELEGATION, MR. SAM DOUMANY, SAID LATER HE WAS GREATLY IMPRESSED BY THE MAMMOUTH SCALE OF THE NEW TOWN DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME.

+THIS IS REALLY POSITIVE AND CONSTRUCTIVE EFFORT BY THE GOVERNMENT OF HONG KONG TO HOUSE HUNDREDS OF THOUSANDS OF PEOPLE,+ HE SAID.

ANOTHER DELEGATION MEMBER, MR. LES YEWDAL, SUMMED UP HIS IMPRESSIONS OF SHA TIN IN THREE WORDS: +IT'S JUST INCREDIBLE+.

THE QUEENSLAND PARLIAMENTARY DELEGATION IS ON THE SIXTH LEG OF THEIR PACIFIC REGION AND ASIA TOUR, HAVING VISITED TONGA, AMERICAN SAMOA, HAWAII, GUAM AND JAPAN. THE DELEGATION WILL LEAVE FOR SINGAPORE AND MALAYSIA THIS AFTERNOON.

SPECIAL HALF-FARE TRAIN TICKETS FOR STUDENTS

* * * *

STUDENTS TRAVELLING ON ORDINARY CLASS TRAINS WILL BE GIVEN A HALF-FARE CONCESSION ON WEEKDAYS DURING THE SUMMER VACATION FROM JULY 3 TO AUGUST 31 THE KOWLOON-CANTON RAILWAY ANNOUNCED TODAY.

THE FARE CONCESSION WILL PROVIDE AN INCENTIVE FOR YOUNG PEOPLE IN THE URBAN AREAS TO ORGANISE PICNICS AND OUTINGS IN THE NEW TERRITORIES AND ENCOURAGE THOSE IN THE RURAL DISTRICTS TO GO TO THE CITY MORE FREQUENTLY TO PARTICIPATE IN ACTIVITIES ORGANISED BY THE GOVERNMENT AND VOLUNTARY AGENCIES DURING THE SUMMER VACATION.

UNDER THIS CONCESSIONARY ARRANGEMENT, ORDINARY HALF-FARE CHILD TICKETS PRINTED WITH THE WORD 'STUDENT' WILL BE SOLD TO BONA-FIDE, FULL-TIME STUDENTS AT VARIOUS STATIONS AND ONLY RETURN TICKETS VALID FOR THE DATE OF ISSUE WILL BE AVAILABLE.

THESE TICKETS WILL BE SOLD ON WEEKDAYS ONLY, AND WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE ON SATURDAYS, SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

STUDENTS OVER-RIDING THE STATIONS FOR WHICH THEIR CONCESSION TICKETS WERE ISSUED WILL BE REQUIRED TO PAY HALF-FARE PLUS 100 PER CENT FOR THAT PORTION OF THE JOURNEY FOR WHICH THEY DO NOT HOLD TICKETS.

AND THOSE FOUND TRAVELLING IN FIRST CLASS COACHES WITH ORDINARY CLASS HALF-FARE TICKETS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PAY THE FULL FARE OF THE FIRST CLASS PLUS 100 PER CENT, LESS ORDINARY CLASS HALF-FARE.

WHEN PURCHASING THE HALF-FARE TICKETS, STUDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PRODUCE DOCUMENTS CERTIFYING THEIR IDENTITY. IF SUCH DOCUMENTS CONTAIN NO PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE HOLDERS, HONG KONG IDENTITY CARDS MUST ALSO BE PRODUCED FOR INSPECTION.

ON REQUEST, SUCH DOCUMENTS MUST ALSO BE SHOWN TO TICKET INSPECTORS ON THE TRAINS.

THE CONCESSION MAY BE WITHDRAWN AT ANY TIME AND NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE IN RESPECT OF UNUSED PORTIONS OF THE RETURN TICKETS.

GENERAL MANAGER OF PRISONS INDUSTRIES APPOINTED
* * * * *

A SCOTTISH PRISON INDUSTRIES EXPERT HAS JOINED THE PRISONS DEPARTMENT AS GENERAL MANAGER (PRISON INDUSTRIES).

HE IS MR. TERRY COLLINSON, 49, WHO IS ON SECONDMENT FROM THE SCOTTISH HOME AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT CONTROLLERATE (INDUSTRIES AND SUPPLIES).

MR. COLLINSON VISITED HONG KONG LAST YEAR BETWEEN JANUARY AND APRIL, UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE COMMONWEALTH FUND FOR TECHNICAL CO-OPERATION, AS ADVISOR TO THE PRISONS DEPARTMENT ON PRISON INDUSTRIES MANAGEMENT AND TO CONDUCT A DETAILED REVIEW OF INDUSTRIAL ACTIVITIES IN THE PRISONS DEPARTMENT.

THE REVIEW WAS MADE AT THE REQUEST OF THE COMMISSIONER OF PRISONS, MR. T.G. GARNER, WHO WISHES TO MODERNISE AND IMPROVE BOTH PRISON INDUSTRIES FACILITIES AND PRODUCTION RATES.

DURING HIS SECONDMENT, MR. COLLINSON WILL ADVISE ON AND SUPERVISE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF RECOMMENDATIONS MADE IN HIS REPORT FOLLOWING THE EARLIER VISIT. IT IS HOPED THAT THIS WILL RESULT IN A SUBSTANTIAL SAVING TO GOVERNMENT.

MR. COLLINSON, WHO IS ACCOMPANIED BY HIS WIFE, HAS WORKED FOR THE SCOTTISH CIVIL SERVICE IN VARIOUS APPOINTMENTS FOR OVER 18 YEARS. HIS LAST APPOINTMENT WAS THAT OF SENIOR PRINCIPAL CONTROLLER OF PRISON INDUSTRIES AND SUPPLIES.

MR. AND MRS. COLLINSON, WHOSE HOME IS IN EDINBURGH, HAVE TWO SONS.

EQUIPMENT FOR SHA TIN SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT

* * * * *

THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT IS INVITING TENDERS FOR THE SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT FOR STAGE ONE OF THE SHA TIN NEW TOWN PERMANENT SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS.

THE EQUIPMENT, INCLUDING MULTI-MOTOR STARTERS, SWITCH AND CONTROL PANELS, WILL BE USED TO CONTROL THE TREATMENT OF THE SEWAGE BY BIOLOGICAL AND MECHANICAL PROCESSES.

THE CONTRACT TO BE TENDERED IS THE FIRST OF FOUR OF ITS TYPE TO BE INVITED. TENDERS FOR THE OTHER THREE CONTRACTS WILL BE CALLED AT A LATER STAGE.

MR. WONG KWOK-CHOY, CHIEF ENGINEER OF P.W.D.'S CIVIL ENGINEERING OFFICE, SAID TODAY THAT BY THE TIME THE \$225 MILLION TREATMENT PLANT IS COMMISSIONED IN 1980 THE POPULATION AT SHA TIN NEW TOWN SHOULD BE ABOUT 150,000 WHILE STAGE 1 OF THE SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT WILL BE CAPABLE OF SERVING 230,000 PEOPLE.

+PART OF THE PLANT WILL BECOME OPERATIONAL BY THE MIDDLE OF 1980, SOME SIX MONTHS BEFORE COMPLETION,+ MR. WONG SAID.

+IN THE INTERIM PERIOD, THE SEWAGE FROM SHA TIN IS BEING TREATED AT THE TEMPORARY AND INTERIM SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS.+

HE ALSO POINTED OUT THAT THE TREATMENT PLANT, WHEN FULLY DEVELOPED ON 17 HECTARES OF RECLAIMED LAND JUST NORTH OF THE NEW RACECOURSE, WOULD SERVE THE NEW TOWN'S ENTIRE POPULATION OF MORE THAN HALF A MILLION.

MR. WONG SAID THAT THE FIRST STAGE OF THE PLANT, THE BIGGEST OF ITS TYPE EVER UNDERTAKEN IN HONG KONG, WAS PARTLY FINANCED BY A \$95 MILLION LOAN FROM THE ASIAN DEVELOPMENT BANK.

+TENDERS FOR THE SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF EQUIPMENT ARE ALSO BEING INVITED ON AN INTERNATIONAL BASIS FROM MANUFACTURERS IN MEMBER COUNTRIES OF THE ASIAN DEVELOPMENT BANK AND LUXEMBOURG,+ HE ADDED.

MEANWHILE, WORK ON THE MAIN CONTRACT FOR THE PLANT IS MAKING GOOD PROGRESS.

THE CONTRACT, COVERING CIVIL ENGINEERING AND BUILDING WORKS OF STAGE ONE OF THE PROJECT, INVOLVES, AMONG OTHER THINGS, THE CONSTRUCTION OF PRIMARY SEDIMENTATION TANKS, AERATION TANKS, FINAL SETTLING TANKS, A LABORATORY AND AN ADMINISTRATION BUILDING.

THE SHA TIN SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT FORMS A MAJOR PART OF A COMPREHENSIVE SEWERAGE AND SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITIES DESIGNED TO DEAL WITH INDUSTRIAL AND DOMESTIC WASTES FROM SHA TIN NEW TOWN.

ON COMPLETION IT WILL BE ABLE TO TREAT MORE THAN 102,000 CUBIC METRES OF RAW SEWAGE A DAY.

REMOVAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR JUDICIARY

THE REGISTRAR OF SUPREME COURT, MR. SIMON MAYO, TODAY DREW THE ATTENTION OF THE PUBLIC TO CERTAIN REMOVAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE JUDICIARY.

THE ARRANGEMENTS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- * THE VICTORIA DISTRICT COURT WILL REMOVE TO WESTERN MAGISTRACY AT 2 POKFULAM ROAD. THE MOVE IS BEING EFFECTED TODAY AND TOMORROW AND THE COURTS WILL OPERATE AT WESTERN MAGISTRACY ON JUNE 26. FROM THAT DATE WESTERN MAGISTRACY WILL BE KNOWN AS VICTORIA DISTRICT COURT AT WESTERN. SIMILAR ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE MADE FOR NOTIFYING INTERESTED PARTIES OF THE CHANGE.

- * THE SUPREME COURT WILL REMOVE TO THE VICTORIA DISTRICT COURT AT BATTERY PATH OVER THE WEEKEND OF THE 8TH AND 9TH JULY. THE COURTS WILL OPERATE AT BATTERY PATH ON THE 10TH JULY. FROM THAT DATE THE PRESENT VICTORIA DISTRICT COURT WILL BE KNOWN AS THE SUPREME COURT AT BATTERY PATH. ALSO ON THE SAME DATES THE REGISTRARS OF THE SUPREME COURT EXCLUDING MYSELF, THE SUPREME COURT REGISTRY, THE PROBATE REGISTRY, THE ACCOUNTS OFFICE AND THE LIBRARY WILL REMOVE TO FIRE BRIGADE BUILDING. SIMILAR ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE MADE FOR NOTIFYING PARTIES CONCERNED OF THE CHANGE. IN ADDITION ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE MADE TO ENSURE THAT PROMINENT NOTICES ARE DISPLAYED AT THE PRESENT SUPREME COURT BUILDING TO ENSURE THAT SUFFICIENT INSTRUCTIONS AND DIRECTIONS ARE PROVIDED TO PERSONS HAVING RECOURSE TO THE COURTS TO ENSURE THAT THEY KNOW WHERE TO ATTEND.

THE FIRE SERVICES DEPARTMENT WILL LAUNCH A RECRUITMENT EXERCISE ON MONDAY (JUNE 26) FOR YOUNG MEN TO FILL ABOUT 320 VACANT POSTS OF FIREMEN.

THE RECRUITMENT EXERCISE WILL BE CONDUCTED AT TSIM SHA TSUI FIRE STATION, CANTON ROAD, KOWLOON BETWEEN 9 A.M. AND 6 P.M. DAILY, EXCLUDING SATURDAYS AND SUNDAYS, UNTIL JULY 4.

APPLICANTS SHOULD BE AGED BETWEEN 18 AND 30, HAVE GOOD PHYSIQUE AND NORMAL EYE SIGHT, BE ABLE TO SPEAK FLUENT CANTONESE AND READ AND WRITE CHINESE.

THEY SHOULD HAVE LIVED IN HONG KONG FOR A CONTINUOUS PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS OR MORE AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION.

THE STARTING SALARY FOR A FIREMAN IS \$1,210 A MONTH AND THE MAXIMUM IS \$1,770.

SCOUTING HELPS BUILD GOOD, STRONG COMMUNITY

THE PROMOTION OF SCOUTING WILL HELP TO BUILD GOOD AND STRONG COMMUNITY WHICH IS ESSENTIAL IN AN AREA SUCH AS TUEN MUN WHERE RAPID POPULATION AND ECONOMIC EXPANSION IS TAKING PLACE, THE ACTING SECRETARY FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES, MR. JOHN TODD, SAID TODAY.

ADDRESSING THE GATHERING AT THE INAUGURATION CEREMONY FOR OFFICE-BEARERS OF THE TUEN MUN DISTRICT SCOUT COUNCIL, MR. TODD SAID THE HONG KONG SCOUT ASSOCIATION HAD, SINCE LAST YEAR, IMPLEMENTED ITS +PLAN E+ WITH THE AIM OF INCREASING THE NUMBER OF SCOUTS TO 50,000 IN SEVEN YEARS AND OF PROMOTING EFFICIENCY SO THAT A GREATER NUMBER OF YOUTHS WILL BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN SCOUT ACTIVITIES.

+I NOTE WITH PLEASURE THAT THE TUEN MUN SCOUT ASSOCIATION PLANS TO RESPOND TO SUCH EFFORTS.

SHA TIN POLICE STATION TO BE COMPLETED IN AUGUST

THE NEW DIVISIONAL POLICE STATION AT SHA TIN IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED IN EARLY AUGUST.

THE STATION, WHICH IS PART OF SHA TIN NEW TOWN DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME, OCCUPIES A SITE OF ABOUT 5,000 SQUARE METRES AT THE JUNCTION OF TAI PO ROAD AND LION ROCK TUNNEL ROAD.

MR. M.H. HUI, P.W.D.'S SENIOR ARCHITECT IN CHARGE OF THE PROJECT, SAID TODAY THAT THE NEW STATION IS BEING BUILT ALONG THE SAME LINES AS THE NORTH POINT DIVISIONAL HEADQUARTERS AND POLICE STATION.

+BASICALLY, IT CONSISTS OF AN 18-STOREY BLOCK, A SINGLE-STOREY BLOCK AND A COMPOUND+ HE SAID.

+THE NORMAL POLICE OPERATIONAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES, BARRACKS, RECREATION ROOMS, AND MARRIED QUARTERS FOR INSPECTORS WILL BE HOUSED IN THE HIGH-RISE BLOCK. THE LOW BLOCK WILL ACCOMMODATE DOG KENNELS, STORES, CAR PARKS AND SERVICE FACILITIES,+ HE ADDED.

TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENT IN SHA TIN

* * * * *

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT TODAY ANNOUNCED THAT FROM 10 A.M. ON MONDAY (JUNE 26) URBAN CLEARWAY RESTRICTIONS WILL BE IMPOSED ON TWO SECTIONS OF ROAD IN SHA TIN FROM 7 A.M. TO MIDNIGHT DAILY.

THEY ARE THE SECTION OF THE NEW ROAD BETWEEN LION ROCK TUNNEL ROAD AND 345 FEET EAST OF THE SHING MUN RIVER BRIDGE IN TAI WAI, AND THE ACCESS ROAD LINKING THIS NEW ROAD TO TAI PO ROAD.

ALL MOTOR VEHICLES EXCEPT FRANCHISED BUSES WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM PICKING UP OR SETTING DOWN PASSENGERS AND LOADING OR UNLOADING GOODS DURING THE RESTRICTED PERIOD.

WITH EFFECT FROM THE SAME TIME, THE SECTION OF THE EXISTING TAI PO ROAD BETWEEN THE JUNCTION OF LION ROCK TUNNEL ROAD/SHA TIN BYPASS ROAD AND 88 FEET WEST OF THE LEVEL CROSSING AT TO FUNG SHAN WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL MOTOR VEHICLES EXCEPT THOSE AUTHORISED IN WRITING BY THE COMMISSIONER OF TRANSPORT.
