TSUEN WAN SPORTS FESTIVAL OPENS
* * *

THE FOURTH TSUEN WAN SPORTS FESTIVAL WAS OFFICIALLY OPENED TODAY (SATURDAY) BY THE REGIONAL SECRETARY FOR NEW TERRITORIES, MR IAN MACPHERSON.

THE THREE-WEEK ANNUAL FESTIVAL, AIMED AT PROMOTING LOCAL SPORTS STANDARDS, WILL PROVIDE A WIDE RANGE OF ACTIVITIES INCLUDING VARIOUS KINDS OF BALL GAMES, WATER SPORTS, BOXING, ROLLER-SKATING AND GO-KART RACING.

A HIGHLIGHT OF THE FESTIVAL WILL BE THE INTERNATIONAL TABLE-TENNIS INVITATION COMPETITION AND A TEAM FROM CHINA HAS BEEN INVITED TO PERFORM IN THIS EVENT.

A BASKETBALL-ON-WHEELCHAIR COMPETITION FOR THE DISABLED HAS ALSO BEEN INCLUDED IN THE PROGRAMME SO THAT THE HANDICAPPED WILL ALSO BE ABLE TO ENJOY THE FESTIVAL.

ALTOGETHER 60 EVENTS WILL BE HELD AT 15 VENUES IN THE DISTRICT. ADMISSION TO ALL THE EVENTS WILL BE FREE.

TICKETS AND PROGRAMME BROCHURES ARE AVAILABLE FROM TSUEN WAN DISTRICT OFFICE, PUBLIC ENQUIRY CENTRES, RECREATION AND CULTURE DEPARTMENT OFFICES AND THE FEDERATION OF TSUEN WAN DISTRICT SPORTS AND RECREATION ASSOCIATION.

THE EXPENSES OF THE FESTIVAL WILL BE OVER \$420 000, OF WHICH \$300 000 WILL BE FINANCED BY TSUEN WAN DISTRICT BOARD AND THE BALANCE FROM LOCAL DONATIONS.

ALSO PRESENT AT TODAY'S CEREMONY WERE TSUEN WAN DISTRICT COMMISSIONER, MR HAMISH MACLEOD, AND THE FESTIVAL CHAIRMAN, MR CHAU HOW-CHEN.

THE FESTIVAL HAS BEEN ORGANISED BY TSUEN WAN DISTRICT BOARD, THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT, THE RECREATION AND CULTURE DEPARTMENT AND THE FEDERATION OF TSUEN WAN DISTRICT SPORTS AND RECREATION ASSOCIATION.

SHAM SHUI PO DB MEMBERS TOUR DISTRICT

ELECTED AND APPOINTED UNOFFICIAL MEMBERS OF THE SHAM SHUI PO DISTRICT BOARD TODAY (SATURDAY) TOURED THE VARIOUS DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN THE DISTRICT.

THE GROUP WAS ACCOMPANIED BY THE DISTRICT OFFICER, MR STEPHEN IP, AND OTHER OFFICIAL BOARD MEMBERS.

THEY FIRST ARRIVED AT THE SHAM SHUI PO FERRY CONCOURSE WHERE THEY WERE BRIEFED ON THE WEST KOWLOON CORRIDOR PROJECT NOW UNDER CONSTRUCTION AND PLANNED DEVELOPMENTS ON THE WATERFRONT RECLAMATION INCLUDING A CULTURAL COMPLEX, A POLYCLINIC, A MULTI-STOREY CAR PARK, A COMMUNITY CENTRE AND SCHOOLS.

THE MEMBERS THEN PROCEEDED TO HAWKER AREAS IN PEI HO AND APLIU STREETS WHERE THEY WERE TOLD THAT THE SHAM SHUI PO MARKET WOULD BE REDEVELOPED NEXT YEAR AND OPERATORS THERE WOULD BE RESITED TEMPORARILY TO TUNG CHAU STREET, UNDER THE WEST KOWLOON CORRIDOR.

THE PARTY ALSO VISITED THE TAI HANG TUNG RESETTLEMENT ESTATE WHERE THEY SAW THE TYPICAL WORK OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY'S REDEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME TO IMPROVE THE LIVING CONDITIONS AT OLDER ESTATES THROUGH IN-SITU CONVERSION OF FLATS AND BUILDING NEW BLOCKS ON THE SITES OF OLD ONES.

AT THE ADJACENT NAM SHAN ESTATE, THEY LEARNED THAT THE LARGE MURAL PROVIDED BY THEIR DISTRICT BOARD HAD PROVED A POPULAR SPOT FOR CHILDREN.

THE MURAL, DEPICTING A COLOURFUL CARP AND AN UNDERWATER SCENE, HAS ITS CENTRE PART LEFT BLANK TO LET CHILDREN EXPRESS THEIR ARTISTIC TALENTS.

THE MORNING TOUR ALSO TOOK THE DISTRICT BOARD MEMBERS TO THE CHU KOO CHAI SQUATTER AREA WHERE THE CO-OPERATION OF THE MUTUAL AID COMMITTEE AND THE DISTRICT BOARD HAD BROUGHT ABOUT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENTS.

LATER AT THE LAI KOK ESTATE AND THE HOME OWNERSHIP CHING LAI COURT, THEY HAD DISCUSSIONS FROM VANTAGE POINTS ON DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS FOR SHAM SHUI PO AND ON THE LAI CHI KOK RECLAMATION.

LIFE-SAVING SERVICE VITAL TO BATHERS

THERE ARE MANY KEEN AND CAPABLE VOLUNTEERS WHO ARE ALWAYS READY TO MAKE THEMSELVES AVAILABLE TO UNDERTAKE LIFE-SAVING DUTIES TO SUPPLEMENT GOVERNMENT'S OWN STAFF RESOURCE SO THAT THE PUBLIC CAN ENJOY BATHING IN SAFETY, THE DIRECTOR OF NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES, MR JOHN HEYWOOD STATED TODAY AT THE PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY OF THE NEW TERRITORIES LIFE-SAVING OPEN COMPETITION AT KWAI SHING PUBLIC SWIMMING POOL.

HE SAID THAT ALTHOUGH BATHING MAY BE ENJOYABLE, THERE WAS HOWEVER ALWAYS THE DANGER OF ACCIDENT, SOMETIMES FATAL, WHEN INEXPERIENCED SWIMMERS KNOWINGLY OR UNKNOWINGLY CHALLENGE THE FORCES OF NATURE.

AND TO MEET THIS THREAT TO LIFE, THE SKILL OF LIFE-SAVING HAS BEEN FOSTERED AND DEVELOPED, PARTICULARLY BY A NUMBER OF VOLUNTARY ORGANISATIONS WHO TRAIN THEIR MEMBERS IN LIFE-SAVING, HE ADDED.

AMONG THE VOLUNTARY ORGANISATIONS ARE THE HONG KONG LIFE GUARD CLUB, THE CIVIL AID SERVICES, THE AUXILIARY MEDICAL SERVICE AND ST. JOHN AMBULANCE BRIGADE.

MR HEYWOOD SAID THE GOVERNMENT ALSO EMPLOYED AND TRAINED LIFEGUARDS AND DEPLOYED THEM AT BEACHES IT MANAGED.

HE PAID TRIBUTE TO ALL THOSE LIFE SAVERS, VOLUNTEERS AND GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ALIKE, WHO WORK ON THE PUBLIC BEACHES MANAGED BY THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT.

+THE BATHING PUBLIC IS GREATLY IN YOUR DEBT FOR, AS I HAVE SAID, IT IS YOUR PRESENCE AT PUBLIC BATHING FACILITIES DURING THE LONG HOT SUMMER DAYS WHICH ENABLES THE MAXIMUM BENEFIT TO BE DERIVED FROM OUR BEACHES AND POOLS FOR RECREATIONAL AND LEISURE PURPOSES,+ HE SAID.

ALTHOUGH THE EVER-INCREASING NUMBER OF SWIMMERS AT THE NTSD BEACHES EACH YEAR MADE THE TASK OF LIFE SAVERS EVEN MORE DIFFICULT, MR HEYWOOD SAID THERE WAS ALWAYS A NEED TO IMPROVE THE LIFE-SAVING SKILLS AND TO DO BETTER.

IT WAS FOR THIS REASON THAT THE NTSD HAD ORGANISED LIFEGUARD TRAINING COURSES THIS YEAR AND TODAY'S OPEN COMPETITION, MR HEYWOOD POINTED OUT.

MR HEYWOOD SAID THE COMPETITION COULD FOSTER THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPROVEMENT OF THESE IMPORTANT LIFE-SAVING SKILLS, AND SUCH IMPROVEMENTS MIGHT WELL MEAN THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A LIFE SAVED AND A LIFE LOST.

TODAY'S COMPETITION, WITH 140 EXPERIENCED LIFEGUARDS TAKING PART, WAS AIMED AT TESTING THE PARTICIPANTS' ENDURANCE AND SWIMMING ABILITY AS WELL AS THEIR LIFE-SAVING TECHNIQUES.

FOR MOST OF THE DAY, NON-STOP RESCUE OPERATIONS WENT ON AT KWAI SHING SWIMMING POOL. THE COMPETITION CAME TO A HAPPY END IN THE AFTERNOON WITH TROPHIES PRESENTED TO THE WINNING TEAMS BY THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR (NORTH REGION) OF NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES, MR BOWEN LEUNG.

ALSO TAKING PART IN THE FUNCTION WERE THE DIRECTOR OF HONG KONG LIFEGUARD CLUB, MR KWOK HON-MING, AND THE CHAIRMAN OF NEW TERRITORIES BRANCH OF HONG KONG LIFEGUARD CLUB, MR LAU HON-WAH.

THE AIRPORT TUNNEL'S EASTBOUND TUBE AND THE NORTHBOUND SECTION OF EAST KOWLOON WAY FROM WUHU INTERCHANGE TO SAN SHAN INTERCHANGE WILL BE TEMPORARILY CLOSED TO TRAFFIC BETWEEN 11 PM AND 5 AM THE FOLLOWING MORNING STARTING FROM MONDAY (NOVEMBER 8) FOR ABOUT 12 CONSECUTIVE NIGHTS.
