NEW SCHEME LAUNCHED TO SUPPORT YOUTH GROUPS
IN COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECTS
* * * * *

THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT TODAY LAUNCHED A NEW SCHEME TO PROVIDE SUPPORT FOR GROUPS OF YOUNG PEOPLE WHO WANT TO CARRY OUT PROJECTS OR SERVICES THAT WILL BENEFIT THE COMMUNITY.

KNOWN AS THE +OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUTH SCHEME,+ IT WILL HELP THE GROUPS WITH FINANCING OF THE PROJECTS IN ADDITION TO TECHNICAL ADVICE AND GUIDANCE.

APART FROM PROVIDING SOME PROJECT OR SERVICE THAT MAY BE NEEDED WITHIN THE COMMUNITY, THE SCHEME IS ALSO INTENDED TO HELP YOUNG PEOPLE IN THEIR PERSONAL AND SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT, SAID MR. HENRY AU, SENIOR PRINCIPAL SOCIAL WELFARE OFFICER OF THE DEPARTMENT'S GROUP AND COMMUNITY DIVISION.

HE EXPLAINED THE SCHEME WOULD BE OPERATED AT A DISTRICT LEVEL THROUGH THE DIVISION'S COMMUNITY AND YOUTH OFFICERS OF WHICH THERE ARE TEN IN THE URBAN AREAS AND TWO IN THE NEW TERRITORIES.

+WHAT IT MEANS IS THAT ANY GROUP OF TEN OR MORE YOUNG PEOPLE BETWEEN 15 AND 25 FROM A SCHOOL, YOUTH AGENCY OR INSTITUTION, WHO FEEL THEY HAVE A WORTHWHILE PROJECT THAT IS NEEDED IN THEIR DISTRICT, OR WANT TO PLAN ONE, WILL NOW BE ABLE TO OBTAIN SUPPORT TO CARRY IT THROUGH,+ HE SAID.

+IT WILL BE UP TO THEM TO PLAN THE PROJECT APPLYING WHAT KNOWLEDGE OR SKILLS THEY HAVE TO INVESTIGATE AND IDENTIFY SOCIAL NEEDS WITHIN THEIR COMMUNITIES AND HELP SATISFY THESE NEEDS.

+BY DOING THIS, THEY WILL ALSO LEARN, THROUGH DIRECT EXPERIENCE, HOW TO WORK WITH OTHER PEOPLE, COMMUNITY ORGANISATIONS, LOCAL RESOURCE PEOPLE AND GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS,+ HE SAID.

PLANS, TOGETHER WITH APPLICATION FORMS AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS SHOULD BE SUBMITTED THROUGH THE RESPECTIVE COMMUNITY AND YOUTH OFFICES FOR ASSESSMENT. PROJECTS SHOULD BE OPERATED IN THE DISTRICTS IN WHICH THE APPLICATIONS ARE MADE AND SHOULD BE PLANNED FOR IMPLEMENTATION WITHIN SIX MONTHS.

ASSESSMENT, MR. AU EXPLAINED, WOULD BE MADE ON THE BASIS OF YOUTH INVOLVEMENT AND DEVELOPMENT= COMMUNITY BENEFITS, INCLUDING PRIORITY OF NEEDS= INNOVATION= FEASIBILITY AND OPTIMUM USE OF RESOURCES.

A FIXED AMOUNT OF MONEY, NOT EXCEEDING \$2,000 PER PROJECT, WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE IF THE APPLICATION IS APPROVED. HALF OF THIS SUM WILL BE ADVANCED BEFORE THE START OF THE PROJECT AND THE REST AT THE HALF-WAY STAGE. GROUPS MUST SUBMIT EVALUATION REPORTS AT THE END OF A PROJECT.

FURTHER INFORMATION AND APPLICATION FORMS ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE COMMUNITY AND YOUTH OFFICES.

BUILDING MANagements URGED TO ENSURE GOOD WORKING ORDER
OF INTERNAL PUMPING SYSTEMS
* * * * *

UNLESS INTERNAL PUMPING SYSTEMS ARE OPERATING SATISFACTORILY IN HIGH-RISE BUILDINGS, TENANTS OF UPPER FLOORS MAY GO SHORT WHEN WATER RESTRICTIONS COMMENCE ON SEPTEMBER 25.

STATING THIS TODAY, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE WATER AUTHORITY SAID THAT RESPONSIBILITY FOR INTERNAL PUMPING SYSTEMS LAY ENTIRELY WITH THE BUILDING MANagements.

+SUCH MANagements ARE ADVISED TO ENSURE THAT THEIR SYSTEMS ARE IN GOOD WORKING ORDER,+ HE SAID. +OTHERWISE, WITH THE INTRODUCTION OF WATER RESTRICTIONS, THE OCCUPANTS OF THEIR BUILDINGS MAY SUFFER UNNECESSARY HARDSHIP WHICH IT IS NOT WITHIN THE POWER OF THE WATER AUTHORITY TO ALLEVIATE.+

THE SPOKESMAN ADDED THAT THE WATER AUTHORITY HAD REASON TO BELIEVE SOME BUILDING MANagements MAY HAVE REMOVED INTERNAL PUMPING SYSTEMS.

+THESE SYSTEMS ARE ESSENTIAL TO THE SUPPLY OF WATER -- IN PARTICULAR TO UPPER FLOORS -- WHEN MAINS PRESSURES ARE LOW= FOR EXAMPLE DURING TIMES OF WATER RESTRICTIONS,+ HE SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN ALSO POINTED OUT THAT THE CONTENTS OF STORAGE TANKS ON ROOFS OF DOMESTIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS SHOULD NOT BE USED BY OCCUPANTS, INCLUDING THOSE IN HOTEL ROOMS, OUTSIDE THE NOTIFIED HOURS OF SUPPLY.

MANagements SHOULD THEREFORE ENSURE THAT RESPONSIBLE MEMBERS OF THEIR STAFFS SHUT OFF SUPPLIES FROM THESE TANKS DURING THE HOURS OF RESTRICTION.

WATER SITUATION REPORT
* * * * *

THE TOTAL WATER STORAGE IN ALL RESERVOIRS AS AT 9 A.M. TODAY (THURSDAY) STOOD AT 36,501 MILLION GALLONS, REPRESENTING 54.2 PER CENT OF THE FULL CAPACITY OF 67,300 MILLION GALLONS. AT THIS TIME LAST YEAR THERE WERE 66,319 MILLION GALLONS IN STORE.

THIS MORNING'S STORAGE AT PLOVER COVE WAS 27,891 MILLION GALLONS, COMPARED WITH 50,533 MILLION GALLONS ON THE SAME DAY LAST YEAR. PLOVER COVE'S PRESENT STORAGE REPRESENTS 55.2 PER CENT OF ITS FULL CAPACITY OF 50,500 MILLION GALLONS.

A TRACE (0.1 M.M.) OF RAINFALL WAS RECORDED AT THE ROYAL OBSERVATORY DURING THE PAST 24 HOURS ENDING AT 9 A.M. TODAY. TOTAL RAINFALL RECORDED SO FAR THIS YEAR IS 1,362.2 M.M. (53.63 IN).

THE MEAN AVERAGE RAINFALL SINCE JANUARY 1 STANDS AT 1,893.0 MM (74.53 IN), REPRESENTING A SHORTFALL OF 28.0 PER CENT.

BRITISH FOOTWEAR CONSULTANT COMPLETES STUDY TOUR

* * * * *

MR. FRED PILLING, A FOOTWEAR CONSULTANT FROM THE UNITED KINGDOM, WILL LEAVE HONG KONG ON SATURDAY (SEPTEMBER 21) AFTER A THREE-WEEK VISIT TO STUDY THE TECHNICAL MANPOWER NEEDS FOR THE LOCAL FOOTWEAR INDUSTRY AND TO ADVISE THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT ON THE SETTING UP OF A DEPARTMENT OF FOOTWEAR TECHNOLOGY IN ONE OF THE NEW TECHNICAL INSTITUTES.

MR. PILLING, PRINCIPAL OF THE CORDWAINERS TECHNICAL COLLEGE IN LONDON, HAS VISITED A NUMBER OF FOOTWEAR MANUFACTURING ESTABLISHMENTS, THE POLYTECHNIC, THE MORRISON HILL TECHNICAL INSTITUTE, SECONDARY TECHNICAL SCHOOLS, PRE-VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS AND GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS.

HE ALSO MET INDUSTRIALISTS WHILE ON A TOUR OF THE FEDERATION OF HONG KONG INDUSTRIES AND FOOTWEAR TESTING CENTRE, AND HAD DISCUSSIONS WITH SOME MEMBERS OF THE CHINESE MANUFACTURERS ASSOCIATION.

THE CONSULTANT WILL ADVISE THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT ON WHETHER OR NOT A NEW DEPARTMENT OF FOOTWEAR TECHNOLOGY SHOULD BE SET UP IN THE SAN PO KONG TECHNICAL INSTITUTE WHICH IS SCHEDULED TO BE OPENED IN SEPTEMBER 1977.

MR. PILLING IS AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBER OF THE CITY AND GUILDS OF LONDON INSTITUTE. HIS COLLEGE, INCORPORATED IN 1914, HAS MODERNISED WORKSHOPS, A WORKSTUDY LABORATORY AND LECTURE FACILITIES.

THE CORDWAINERS TECHNICAL COLLEGE NOW SPECIALISES IN TECHNICIAN COURSES FOR BOOT AND SHOE MANUFACTURE AND LEATHER GOODS PRODUCTION, WITH THE RELATED DESIGN AND MANAGEMENT SUBJECTS HEAVILY STRESSED.

THREE LOTS OF CROWN LAND WITH A COMBINED AREA OF SOME 76,000 SQUARE FEET WILL BE OFFERED FOR SALE BY AUCTION NEXT MONTH.

TWO OF THE LOTS ARE FOR PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT. ONE IS LOCATED OFF TIN HAU TEMPLE ROAD ON HONG KONG ISLAND AND MEASURES 48,000 SQUARE FEET. THE OTHER COVERS ABOUT 16,500 SQUARE FEET OFF CHAI WAN ROAD.

THE THIRD LOT IS FOR INDUSTRIAL OR GODOWN PURPOSES. IT IS LOCATED IN WONG CHUK HANG ROAD IN ABERDEEN AND MEASURES ABOUT 11,400 SQUARE FEET.

AUGUST G.C.P.I. DROPS BY SIX POINTS

AS FOOD PRICES SLUMP

* * * * *

THE GENERAL CONSUMER PRICE INDEX FOR AUGUST DROPPED BY SIX POINTS TO 187. THIS WAS 3.1 PER CENT LOWER THAN THAT FOR THE PREVIOUS MONTH.

THE DROP WAS DUE MAINLY TO A DECLINE OF 13 POINTS IN THE INDEX FOR FOODSTUFFS. COMPARED WITH JULY, THE AVERAGE RETAIL PRICE OF FRESH VEGETABLES DROPPED SIGNIFICANTLY BY 37 PER CENT. THIS WAS MAINLY ATTRIBUTABLE TO A SEASONAL INCREASE IN SUPPLY FROM LOCAL FARMS.

THE AVERAGE RETAIL PRICES OF RICE, POULTRY AND FRESH FRUITS ALSO DECLINED, BUT, THE AVERAGE RETAIL PRICES OF PORK AND MEALS BOUGHT AWAY FROM HOME ADVANCED.

THE INDEX FOR CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR WENT DOWN BY TWO POINTS, WHILE THE INDEX FOR TRANSPORT AND VEHICLES ADVANCED BY FOUR POINTS. THIS WAS LARGELY BROUGHT ABOUT BY THE RECENT UPWARD REVISION IN THE FARES CHARGED BY THE HONG KONG AND YAUMATI FERRY COMPANY.

INCREASES OF ONE POINT EACH WERE ALSO RECORDED IN THE INDEX FOR FUEL AND LIGHT, THE INDEX FOR DURABLE GOODS AND THE INDEX FOR SERVICES.

MOVEMENTS IN THE INDEXES FOR OTHER SECTIONS OF COMMODITY WERE INSIGNIFICANT.

CHAI WAN CLEAN-UP COMPLETED

* * * * *

HOUSING DEPARTMENT STAFF TODAY COMPLETED THE FINAL PHASE OF A MAJOR CLEAN-UP PROGRAMME IN CHAI WAN ESTATE TO IMPROVE THE ENVIRONMENT OF THE 53,000 TENANTS.

THE TIDINESS OPERATION WAS CARRIED OUT IN SIX PHASES DURING THE PAST TWELVE MONTHS, AND WAS WELCOMED BY THE RESIDENTS.

+THE RESIDENTS REALISE THAT THE OPERATION IS CARRIED OUT FOR THEIR GOOD,+ SAID MR. CHAN YUI-LUN, HOUSING MANAGER. +THE ESTATE, WHICH HAS BEEN A HAWKER BLACK-SPOT, IS NOW CLEAN AND TIDY WITH HAWKERS PLYING THEIR TRADES ORDERLY IN THE BAZAARS.+

IN TODAY'S OPERATION, TIDINESS TEAMS DEMOLISHED MORE THAN 110 ILLEGAL STRUCTURES AND REMOVED 120 ILLEGAL EXTENSIONS, OVER-SIZED SUNSHADES AND UNAUTHORISED SIGN BOARDS.

THE ACTION, WITH THE HAWKERS' FULL CO-OPERATION, WAS CARRIED OUT SMOOTHLY AND COMPLETED IN ABOUT TWO HOURS.

MORE THAN 40 HAWKERS AFFECTED HAVE BEEN TEMPORARILY RESITED AT A NEARBY OPEN SPACE. THEY WILL BE ALLOCATED SITES IN A HAWKER RESITE AREA BETWEEN BLOCKS 7 AND 9 WHEN IT IS READY IN THREE TO FOUR WEEKS.

THE KWAI CHUNG ROAD FLYOVER AND THE LAI CHI KOK ROAD INTERCHANGE IN KOWLOON WILL BE PARTIALLY CLOSED BETWEEN MID-NIGHT AND 3 A.M. FROM SEPTEMBER 24 TO 27.

DURING THIS PERIOD ONLY ONE LANE WILL BE OPEN TO TRAFFIC. THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE IS TO FACILITATE CLEARANCE OPERATIONS ON A NUMBER OF CHOKED GULLY GRATINGS ON THE FLYOVERS.

MEANWHILE, ON HONG KONG ISLAND, THE SECTION OF WONG CHUK HANG ROAD BETWEEN ABERDEEN POLICE STATION AND NAM LONG SHAN ROAD WILL BE CLOSED FROM SEPTEMBER 24 TO 28 BETWEEN 12.45 A.M. AND 6 A.M. DURING THESE HOURS TRAFFIC WILL BE DIVERTED THROUGH HEUNG YIP STREET.

THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THIS SECTION IS TO FACILITATE THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FOOTBRIDGE ACROSS WONG CHUK HANG ROAD NEAR ITS JUNCTION WITH NAM LONG SHAN ROAD.
