THE POSTMASTER GENERAL, MR DOMINIC S.W. WONG, ANNOUNCED TODAY (SUNDAY) THAT MRS DORIS HO KO SUET-YIU HAS TAKEN OVER THE POST OF DEPUTY POSTMASTER GENERAL FROM MISS ELLE SHUM MUN-LING.

MRS HO HAS LONG ADMINISTRATIVE EXPERIENCE AND HAS HELD A VARIETY OF POSTS WITHIN THE GOVERNMENT BEFORE JOINING THE POST OFFICE.

SURVEY ON PORT-RELATED INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL ENTERPRISES

\* \* \* \* \*

THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT IS CONDUCTING A SURVEY ON EXISTING PORT-RELATED INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL OPERATIONS AS PART OF ITS STUDY ON SUCH PORT-RELATED ENTERPRISES.

THE SURVEY IS CONDUCTED WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT AND COLLECTS INFORMATION REGARDING THE TYPE OF ACTIVITIES, SIZE, LOCATION AND MODUS OPERANDI OF THE INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL ENTERPRISES WHICH ARE CLOSELY ASSOCIATED WITH THE FUNCTIONING, EITHER OF THE PORT ITSELF OR HAVING OPERATIONAL NEEDS TO BE NEAR TO PORT FACILITIES.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY (SUNDAY) THAT THE SURVEY ALSO ASSESSED THE POTENTIAL DEMAND FOR LAND AND FACILITIES FOR ESTABLISHMENTS ON LANTAU AND TUEN MUN.

THE SURVEY IS ALSO AIMED AT LOOKING AT THE IMPACT OF THE EXPANSION OF MAJOR PORT FACILITIES AT THE WESTERN HARBOUR AND TUEN MUN ON EXISTING PORT-RELATED ESTABLISHMENTS WHICH ARE CURRENTLY LOCATED AT SUCH URBAN AREAS AS CHEUNG SHA WAN, SHAM SHUI PO AND TAI KOK TSUI.

THE RESULTS OF THE SURVEY WOULD BE USED IN FORECASTING TOTAL LAND AND FACILITIES REQUIREMENTS OF PORT-RELATED INDUSTRIES IN LANTAU AND TUEN MUN AREAS, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

IT WOULD ALSO PROVIDE INPUTS FOR THE GOVERNMENT IN FORMULATING THE TERRITORIAL INDUSTRIAL LAND DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY UNDER THE TERRITORIAL DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY REVIEW, HE SAID.

SENIOR DIRECTORATE OR MANAGERIAL PERSONNEL FROM ESTABLISHMENTS DRAWN BY RANDOM SAMPLING HAVE BEEN INVITED TO PROVIDE INFORMATION IN THE SURVEY.

INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE RESPONDENTS WILL BE KEPT STRICTLY CONFIDENTIAL.

THE SURVEY IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED NEXT MONTH.

'GARDEN CELEBRATION' STRESSES COMBINED PITCHING-IN EFFORTS

TENS OF THOUSANDS OF PEOPLE TODAY (SUNDAY) VISITED A LIVING GREEN GARDEN WHICH WAS BUILT OVERNIGHT TO EXEMPLIFY THAT COMBINED PITCHING-IN EFFORTS COULD TURN HONG KONG INTO A CLEANER, BEAUTIFUL PLACE.

CALLED "THE GARDEN CELEBRATION", THE ONE-DAY COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT EVENT AT THE CHATER ROAD PEDESTRIAN PRECINCT IN CENTRAL WAS ORGANISED BY THE JOINT URBAN COUNCIL/REGIONAL COUNCIL KEEP HONG KONG CLEAN STEERING COMMITTEE.

OMELCO MEMBER, MR ALLEN LEE PENG-FEI, SAID AT THE OPENING CEREMONY THAT HONG KONG IS A PLACE FULL OF MIRACLES, ORIGINAL IDEAS AND REMARKABLE ACHIEVEMENTS.

"IF I WERE NOT TOLD BEFOREHAND, I COULD HARDLY IMAGINE THIS UNIQUE, LIVING GREEN GARDEN FEATURING DIFFERENT PLOTS OF LANDSCAPE WOULD SUDDENLY APPEAR HERE IN THE CORE OF CENTRAL AFTER JUST ONE NIGHT'S CONSTRUCTION," HE SAID.

THE PURPOSE, HE NOTED, WAS TO DISSEMINATE THROUGH THIS INNOVATIVE IDEA AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE TO THE PEOPLE OF HONG KONG: "WE NEED A NEAT, TIDY AND ATTRACTIVE LIVING ENVIRONMENT IN WHICH WE CAN LIVE AT EASE AND DEVOTE OURSELVES TO WORK AND THE UPBRINGING OF OUR CHILDREN."

ALSO SPEAKING AT THE CEREMONY, THE CHAIRMAN OF THE STEERING COMMITTEE, MR GILBERT LEUNG KAM-HO, SAID:

"WHAT WE WANT TO GET ACROSS TO EVERYBODY IS THAT IF WE ARE DETERMINED TO MAKE HONG KONG A CLEANER PLACE OR EVEN TURN HONG KONG INTO A GARDEN, IT IS ALWAYS POSSIBLE EVEN WITHIN A VERY SHORT PERIOD OF TIME."

OTHER OFFICIATING GUESTS WERE THE REGIONAL COUNCIL CHAIRMAN, MR CHEUNG YAN-LUNG; THE URBAN COUNCIL CHAIRMAN, DR RONALD LEUNG DING-BONG; VICE-CHAIRMAN OF THE STEERING COMMITTEE, MISS CHRISTINA TING YUK-CHEE; THE DIRECTOR OF URBAN SERVICES, MR HAIDER BARMA; AND THE DIRECTOR OF REGIONAL SERVICES, MR ADOLF HSU.

AMONG THE GUESTS WERE LEGISLATORS, URBAN AND REGIONAL COUNCILLORS; DISTRICT BOARD CHAIRMEN AND MEMBERS; SENIOR GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS; CELEBRITIES AND THE CAMPAIGN MASCOTS, THE DRAGON OF CLEANLINESS FAMILY.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE GARDEN INCLUDED THE CENTRE-PIECE, A VICTORIAN-STYLED FOUNTAIN; LANDSCAPE FEATURING CHINESE AND JAPANESE DESIGNS; DIFFERENT SPECIES OF BLOOMING LILIES, CARNATION AND CHRYSANTHEMUM; TROPICAL PLANTS; AND TWO ARCHWAYS ADORNED WITH FLOWERS.

THERE WAS ALSO A SPECIAL EXHIBITION OF THE 19 DISTRICT BOARDS' YEAR-ROUND KEEP HONG KONG CLEAN ACTIVITIES IN AN OPEN-AIR GALLERY.

DESIGNED BY LANDSCAPING EXPERTS FROM THE URBAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT, THE GARDEN WAS BUILT DURING LAST (SATURDAY) NIGHT THROUGH TEAMWORK AND SUPPORT FROM BOTH THE PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SECTORS.

MR LEUNG THANKED THE MUNICIPAL COUNCILS, DISTRICT BOARDS, RELEVANT GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS, AND VARIOUS COMMERCIAL SPONSORS FOR THEIR ENTHUSIASTIC SUPPORT AND PARTICIPATION.

FACTORY FINED FOR NOT KEEPING EMPLOYEES' RECORD

EMPLOYERS MAY FACE HEAVY FINES FOR NOT KEEPING RECORDS OF THEIR EMPLOYEES AT THEIR PLACES OF EMPLOYMENT.

THE REMINDER WAS MADE BY THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT FOLLOWING THE RECENT CONVICTION OF AN EMPLOYER BY THE COURT OF FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENT UNDER THE IMMIGRATION ORDINANCE.

THE MAYSAN GARMENT MANUFACTURERS LIMITED, WHICH FAILED TO PRODUCE FOR INSPECTION RECORDS OF TWO EMPLOYEES, WAS FINED \$2,000 BY A KWUN TONG MAGISTRATE EARLIER THIS MONTH.

"THE ORDINANCE REQUIRES AN EMPLOYER TO KEEP AT THE PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT A RECORD OF THE FULL NAME AND THE IDENTITY CARD NUMBER OF EACH OF HIS EMPLOYEES FOR INSPECTION BY LABOUR INSPECTORS," A SENIOR LABOUR OFFICER (LABOUR INSPECTION), MR CHAN KWOK-KUEN, SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

"IF AN EMPLOYER HAS MORE THAN 10 EMPLOYEES AT A WORKPLACE, THE RECORD SHOULD BE KEPT IN THE FORM OF A LIST," MR CHAN ADDED.

ANY EMPLOYER FAILING TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENT IS LIABLE TO A MAXIMUM FINE OF \$10,000.

THE COLOURING-IN CONTEST IS FOR SCHOOL CHILDREN AT PRIMARY ONE AND TWO WHILE THE BOOKMARK DESIGN COMPETITION IS OPEN TO PUPILS AT PRIMARY THREE TO SIX.

IN ADDITION TO TROPHIES, THE TOP WINNERS OF THE THREE CONTESTS WILL EACH RECEIVE BOOK COUPONS WORTH BETWEEN \$400 AND \$1,600.

THERE WILL ALSO BE CONSOLATION PRIZES FOR OUTSTANDING ENTRANTS IN EACH CONTEST.

THE WINNING ENTRIES WILL BE PUT ON DISPLAY AT AN EXHIBITION ON ORAL HEALTH IN MARCH NEXT YEAR.

FREE LEGAL ADVICE SCHEME FOR ISLANDERS EXTENDED

THE FREE LEGAL ADVICE SCHEME AVAILABLE AT THE ISLANDS DISTRICT OFFICE'S SUB-OFFICES AT MUI WO AND CHEUNG CHAU HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO ITS HEAD OFFICE IN CENTRAL, A DISTRICT OFFICE SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

"THIS MEANS THAT ISLANDERS CAN NOW APPROACH ANY OF THE THREE OFFICES DURING OFFICE HOURS TO MAKE APPOINTMENTS WITH LAWYERS AT THESE ADVICE CENTRES," HE SAID.

THE ISLANDS DISTRICT OFFICE IS LOCATED ON THE 20TH FLOOR OF HARBOUR BUILDING AT 38 PIER ROAD IN CENTRAL (NEXT TO THE OUTLYING ISLANDS FERRY PIER), TO SERVE RESIDENTS OF LAMMA, PENG CHAU AND DISCOVERY BAY.

THE SCHEME IS PROVIDED BY THE LAW SOCIETY IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE 19 DISTRICT OFFICES TO PEOPLE WHO CANNOT AFFORD TO CONSULT PRIVATE LAWYERS.
