GOVT TO STUDY SOCIAL WELFARE MANPOWER SURVEY REPORT

THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE, MRS. ANSON CHAN, SAID TODAY (FRIDAY) THE GOVERNMENT WOULD CONSIDER CAREFULLY THE REPORT ON THE RECENTLY-COMPLETED SOCIAL WELFARE MANPOWER SURVEY.

SHE SAID THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON SOCIAL WORK TRAINING WOULD FIND THE INFORMATION INVALUABLE IN ASSESSING AND ADVISING THE GOVERNMENT ON TRAINING NEEDS.

MRS. CHAN WAS GIVING A TALK AT A WORKSHOP OF THE HONG KONG COUNCIL OF SOCIAL SERVICE IN WHICH SHE DISCUSSED THE 1979 WHITE PAPER ON SOCIAL WELFARE AND EXAMINED ITS IMPLICATIONS ON FUTURE DEVELOPMENT.

SHE SAID THE SURVEY INDICATES AN EXISTING SHORTFALL OF ABOUT 475 TRAINED SOCIAL WORKERS, BUT THIS ALREADY TAKES INTO ACCOUNT THE REQUIREMENTS ARISING OUT OF THE VARIOUS GREEN PAPERS FROM WHICH THE WHITE PAPER IS DERIVED.

IN THE CONTEXT OF THE RECENT REVIEW OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE FIVE-YEAR DEVELOPMENT PLAN, SHE SAID, VARIOUS REMEDIES WERE CONSIDERED, AND THESE INCLUDED INCREASING FROM ABOUT 10 TO 40 PER CENT THE NUMBER OF SOCIAL WORK STUDENTS IN TRAINING INSTITUTIONS AS FROM THE 1979-80 ACADEMIC YEAR.

OTHER MAJOR MEASURES, SHE ADDED, ARE TO MAKE MORE ECONOMIC USE OF TRAINED MANPOWER AND TO IMPROVE THE CONDITIONS OF SERVICE THROUGH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE WELFARE CLASS REVIEW, TO MAKE GREATER USE OF PART-TIME TRAINED WORKERS AND TO PROVIDE IN-SERVICE TRAINING TO PRODUCE MORE PROFESSIONAL WORKERS.

ON FEE CHARGING FOR WELFARE SERVICES, MRS. CHAN SAID THE GOVERNMENT WAS FORMULATING GUIDELINES AND EXAMINING THE LEVEL OF FEES IN SPECIFIC SERVICE AREAS WHICH WOULD BE DISCUSSED WITH THE VOLUNTARY SECTOR SHORTLY.

+WITH IMPROVED LIVING CONDITIONS, GREATER AFFLUENCE AMONGST THE COMMUNITY AS A WHOLE AND IMPROVED SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS, IT SEEMS OPPORTUNE TO CONSIDER LEVYING SOME CHARGES FOR SERVICES PROVIDED, TO BE PAID FOR BY THOSE WHO CAN AFFORD IT,+ SHE SAID.

FOR THE TIME BEING, SHE SAID, WHILE THE MAJORITY OF WELFARE SERVICES ARE STILL INADEQUATE TO MEET FULL DEMAND, PRIORITY SHOULD BE GIVEN TO THOSE IN THE LOW INCOME GROUP.

HOWEVER, SHE POINTED OUT THAT AS VOLUNTARY AGENCIES MOVED AWAY FROM THE CONCEPT OF CHARITABLE HANDOUTS, THEY SHOULD ALSO RE-APPRAISE THEIR ROLE IN PROVIDING DIRECT SERVICES.

+AS THE GAP BETWEEN SUPPLY AND DEMAND NARROWS, I BELIEVE THAT VOLUNTARY AGENCIES SHOULD NO LONGER RESTRICT THEMSELVES TO CATERING ONLY FOR THE LOW INCOME GROUP, BUT SHOULD ALSO EMBRACE MORE AFFLUENT CLIENTS WHO NEED A PARTICULAR SERVICE BUT WHO ARE GENERALLY ABLE TO MEET A REASONABLE FEE,+ SHE SAID.

/IN THIS WAY, .....

IN THIS WAY, SHE SAID, DIRECT SOCIAL WELFARE SERVICES WILL TRULY COME OF AGE.

REFERRING TO CRITICISM THAT A NEGATIVE APPROACH WAS ADOPTED IN THE PERSONAL SOCIAL WORK AMONG YOUTH (PSWAY) PROGRAMME, MRS. CHAN CHALLENGED THE VALIDITY OF THIS STATEMENT.

SHE POINTED OUT THAT EVIDENCE OF GOVERNMENT'S POSITIVE ENCOURAGEMENT TOWARDS DEVELOPING THE POTENTIALS OF YOUTH WAS EVERYWHERE TO BE SEEN IN THE MANY PROGRAMMES IT PROVIDED FOR THE COMMUNITY AS A WHOLE, OF WHOM YOUNG PEOPLE WERE A VERY SIGNIFICANT GROUP.

+TO MENTION JUST A FEW, OUR PROGRAMMES ON EDUCATION, HEALTH, HOUSING, EMPLOYMENT, LEISURE AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES ARE ALL DESIGNED TO EQUIP OUR YOUNG PEOPLE WITH THE NECESSARY HEALTH, SKILLS AND ATTITUDE TO BECOME ACTIVE AND RESPONSIBLE MEMBERS OF SOCIETY,+ SHE SAID.

SHE RECALLED THE PSWAY PROGRAMME WAS CONCEIVED AT A TIME OF PUBLIC CONCERN ABOUT SCHOOL DROPOUTS AND JUVENILE DELINQUENCY, AND SAID THAT WHILE THE PROGRAMME MIGHT BE PREVENTIVE OR REMEDIAL IN NATURE, IT WAS, IN ITS OWN WAY, A POSITIVE EFFORT TO GRAPPLE WITH A PARTICULAR SOCIAL PROBLEM.

+THIS PROGRAMME MAY HAVE PALED IN SIGNIFICANCE WITH THE PASSAGE OF TIME, AND PERHAPS AT A SUITABLE TIME WE SHOULD CONSIDER DROPPING THE DISTINCTIVE LABEL AND REAMALGAMATING THE SERVICES WITHIN THE FAMILY SERVICE UMBRELLA,+ SHE ADDED.

ON SOCIAL SECURITY, MRS. CHAN SAID HONG KONG HAD BEEN WELL SERVED BY THE TRADITIONAL VIRTUES OF SELF-RELIANCE, HARD WORK AND REALISM OF ITS PEOPLE, AND THESE QUALITIES WOULD BE PRESERVED BY A SOCIAL SECURITY SYSTEM THAT CONCENTRATED HELP ON THE MOST DESERVING SECTORS OF THE COMMUNITY -- THE POOR, THE ELDERLY AND THE DISABLED.

SO FAR, SHE SAID, HONG KONG'S SOCIAL SECURITY SCHEMES HAVE BEEN FUNDED ENTIRELY FROM GENERAL REVENUE ON A NON-CONTRIBUTORY BASIS.

SHE SAID THAT WHILE THE INTRODUCTION OF THE TRAFFIC ACCIDENT VICTIMS ASSISTANCE SCHEME LAST MONTH HAD MEANT THAT, FOR THE FIRST TIME, A SOCIAL SECURITY SCHEME WAS BEING FUNDED IN PART BY A SPECIFIC SECTOR OF THE COMMUNITY, THE SCOPE FOR DOING THIS IN OTHER AREAS WAS HOWEVER LIMITED.

+FOR THE FORESEEABLE FUTURE, THE GOVERNMENT DOES NOT SEE ANY FORM OF CONTRIBUTORY SCHEME, WHETHER ON A COMPULSORY OR VOLUNTARY BASIS, PLAYING A MAJOR ROLE IN THE OVERALL SOCIAL SECURITY SYSTEM,+ SHE ADDED.

ON PRESSURE OF SOCIAL WELFARE SERVICES GENERATED BY THE RECENT INFLUX OF REFUGEES, MRS. CHAN SAID THERE WOULD BE NO IMMEDIATE IMPLICATIONS FOR SOCIAL SECURITY BECAUSE OF THE RESIDENCE QUALIFICATION.

+THE EFFECT ON DIRECT SERVICES, PARTICULARLY IN THE LONGER TERM, ARE A LITTLE DIFFICULT TO GAUGE AT THIS POINT IN TIME, THOUGH WE WILL BE LOOKING INTO THIS,+ SHE SAID.

SHE SAID THE GOVERNMENT HAD THIS IN HAND AND WOULD TAKE THESE EXTRA NUMBERS INTO ACCOUNT FOR PLANNING PURPOSES.

ON THE WHITE PAPER AS A WHOLE, MRS. CHAN SAID, +WE HAVE GOT OUR PRIORITIES RIGHT AND THE PROGRAMMES ARE REALISTIC IN TERMS OF MEETING NEEDS AND RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS.+

+OUR PROGRAMMES ARE SUFFICIENTLY FLEXIBLE TO BE ABLE TO RESPOND QUICKLY TO THE RAPID CHANGES IN OUR SOCIETY, AND IN THE FIVE-YEAR PLAN AND OTHER PROGRAMME PLANS ON SPECIFIC SERVICES, WE HAVE A READY MECHANISM TO REVIEW AND ADJUST,+ SHE ADDED.

FIVE MORE TRADES DESIGNATED  
UNDER APPRENTICESHIP ORDINANCE

THE PROMOTION OF APPRENTICE TRAINING IN HONG KONG TOOK ANOTHER STEP FORWARD TODAY (FRIDAY) WITH THE ANNOUNCEMENT THAT FIVE MORE TRADES WILL SHORTLY BE INCLUDED IN THE COMPULSORY APPRENTICESHIP SCHEME.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY'S GOVERNMENT GAZETTE NOTIFIED THAT FIVE CONSTRUCTION CRAFT TRADES HAVE BEEN SPECIFIED BY THE GOVERNOR ON THE ADVICE OF THE HONG KONG TRAINING COUNCIL AS +DESIGNATED TRADES+ UNDER THE APPRENTICESHIP ORDINANCE, EFFECTIVE ON JULY 16.

THE TRADES ARE THOSE OF CARPENTER/JOINER, PAINTER/DECORATOR/SIGN WRITER, WOOD FURNITURE MAKER, METAL FURNITURE MAKER AND PAINTER/DECORATOR (FURNITURE).

THE GAZETTE HAS ALSO NOTIFIED THAT THE APPRENTICESHIP PERIOD FOR THE TRADES WILL BE THREE YEARS.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID IT WAS GOVERNMENT POLICY TO PROMOTE APPRENTICE TRAINING IN TRADES WHICH ARE VITAL TO HONG KONG'S INDUSTRIES AND TO ENSURE AN ADEQUATE SUPPLY OF SKILLED MANPOWER.

THE LATEST INCLUSION HAS BROUGHT THE NUMBER OF TRADES DESIGNATED UNDER THE PROVISION OF THE ORDINANCE TO 36.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THE ORDINANCE AFFECTS THE EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING OF YOUNG PEOPLE BETWEEN THE AGES OF 14 AND 18.

IT STIPULATES THAT AN EMPLOYER CAN ONLY ENGAGE A YOUNG PERSON IN A DESIGNATED TRADE IF THE YOUNG PERSON HAS ENTERED INTO A CONTRACT OF APPRENTICESHIP REGISTERED WITH THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT OR HAS COMPLETED AN APPRENTICESHIP IN THAT TRADE AND HOLDS A CERTIFICATE. BUT THE COMMISSIONER FOR LABOUR HAS POWER TO GRANT EXEMPTION IN CERTAIN CASES.

THE SPOKESMAN ADVISED EMPLOYERS OF YOUNG PEOPLE ENGAGED IN THE NEWLY DESIGNATED TRADES TO PREPARE THEMSELVES TO COMPLY WITH THE ORDINANCE AND TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS OF APPRENTICESHIP WITH THEIR YOUNG WORKERS.

A CONTRACT OF APPRENTICESHIP REGISTERED WITH THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT WILL ENSURE THAT THE APPRENTICE WILL BE GIVEN ADEQUATE TRAINING, INCLUDING ATTENDANCE AT HIS EMPLOYER'S EXPENSE IN A TECHNICAL COURSE RELATED TO HIS TRADE IN A GOVERNMENT TECHNICAL INSTITUTE.

THE CONTRACT WILL ALSO HELP PROTECT THE EMPLOYER FROM LOSING HIS APPRENTICE TO ANOTHER EMPLOYER.

HONG KONG DELEGATION TO STUDY EUROPEAN  
LIGHT RAIL SYSTEMS  
\*\*\*\*\*

A HONG KONG DELEGATION WILL VISIT SIX EUROPEAN CITIES LATER THIS MONTH TO STUDY THE OPERATION OF LIGHT RAIL SYSTEMS.

THE ITINERARY OF THE ONE-WEEK VISIT, BEGINNING ON JUNE 17 INCLUDES HANOVER AND FRANKFURT IN WEST GERMANY, BASEL AND ZURICH IN SWITZERLAND AND BRUSSELS IN BELGIUM.

LEADING MEMBERS OF THE DELEGATION WILL ALSO ATTEND THE ANNUAL CONGRESS OF THE INTERNATIONAL UNION OF PUBLIC TRANSPORT OPERATORS TO BE HELD A WEEK EARLIER IN HELSINKI, FINLAND.

THE CONGRESS WILL INCLUDE SESSIONS ON LIGHT RAIL SYSTEMS, MASS TRANSIT SYSTEMS, BUS SYSTEMS AND LONG TERM PROBLEMS OF THE PUBLIC TRANSPORT INDUSTRY.

THE RECENT GOVERNMENT WHITE PAPER ON INTERNAL TRANSPORT POLICY DISCLOSED THAT DETAILED STUDIES OF THE POSSIBLE IMPLEMENTATION OF A LIGHT RAIL SYSTEM ALONG THE NORTH SHORE OF HONG KONG ISLAND — THE ISLAND CORRIDOR — ARE WELL ADVANCED.

THE LIGHT RAIL SYSTEM IS BEING DESIGNED TO BE IMPLEMENTED IN STAGES FROM THE EXISTING TRAMWAY.

THIS WILL RESULT IN AN INTERCHANGE WITH THE MASS TRANSIT RAILWAY AT ADMIRALTY AND CHATER-PEDDER STATIONS SO THAT, ULTIMATELY, A TOTALLY UNDERGROUND SYSTEM CAN BE ACHIEVED.

THE PHASED IMPLEMENTATION OF SUCH A SYSTEM FORMS THE CENTRAL FEATURE OF THE TRANSPORT STRATEGY ADOPTED BY TRANSPORT AUTHORITIES IN A NUMBER OF EUROPEAN CITIES AND THE IMPLEMENTATION STUDIES OF THE HONG KONG LIGHT RAIL SYSTEM HAVE BENEFITTED FROM THEIR ADVICE AND EXPERIENCE.

THE HONG KONG DELEGATION'S VISIT TO WEST GERMANY, SWITZERLAND AND BELGIUM WILL FAMILIARISE SENIOR GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS WITH LIGHT RAIL SYSTEMS AND WILL INCLUDE AN ASSESSMENT OF THE EXTENT TO WHICH PRACTICES ADOPTED IN EUROPE CAN BE SUCCESSFULLY IMPLEMENTED IN HONG KONG.

THE SECRETARY FOR THE ENVIRONMENT, MR. DEREK JONES WILL LEAD THE SEVEN-MAN DELEGATION WHICH WILL INCLUDE THE COMMISSIONER FOR TRANSPORT, MR. A.T. ARMSTRONG-WRIGHT AND THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT'S MASS TRANSIT ADVISER, MR. A.H. WILKINS.

THE GROUP WILL ALSO BE ACCOMPANIED BY A REPRESENTATIVE OF MARTIN AND VOORHEES ASSOCIATES, THE BRITISH FIRM OF CONSULTANTS WHO ARE CONDUCTING IMPLEMENTATION STUDIES INTO A POSSIBLE LIGHT RAIL SYSTEM FOR HONG KONG AND WHO ARE ORGANISING THE DELEGATION'S VISIT TO EUROPE.

THE GOVERNOR-IN-COUNCIL ON JUNE 5 SPECIFIED EIGHT FURTHER RATING AREAS IN THE NEW TERRITORIES WHICH INCLUDE THE MORE DEVELOPED AND DEVELOPING ISLANDS AS WELL AS CERTAIN OTHER AREAS WHERE DEVELOPMENT HAS TAKEN PLACE.

AT THE SAME TIME, THE EXISTING RATING AREA FOR TSING YI HAS BEEN RESPECIFIED TO RATIONALISE THE BOUNDARY AND ENSURE THAT PROPOSED RECLAMATIONS THERE WILL ALL BE WITHIN THE RATING AREA.

THE ORDER COVERING THIS IS PUBLISHED IN TODAY'S (FRIDAY) GOVERNMENT GAZETTE.

COMMENTING ON THE ORDER, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE RATING AND VALUATION DEPARTMENT SAID IT IS PROPOSED TO CHARGE RATES IN THE ADDITIONAL AREAS FROM APRIL 1, 1980.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THESE ADDITIONAL AREAS FORM THE SIXTH AND FINAL PHASE OF THE CURRENT PROGRAMME OF EXTENSION OF RATING TO THE NEW TERRITORIES.

HE POINTED OUT, HOWEVER, THAT FURTHER EXTENSIONS OF THE RATING AREAS ARE LIKELY WHEN DEVELOPMENT TAKES PLACE OUTSIDE THE EXISTING RATING AREAS.

HE ADDED THAT EXEMPTION FROM RATES FOR TRADITIONAL VILLAGE HOUSES IN THE NEW TERRITORIES, WHICH HAS APPLIED TO THE PREVIOUS PHASES, WILL ALSO APPLY ON THIS OCCASION.

THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT HAS OPENED A PUBLIC DUMP AT THE ALDRICH BAY RECLAMATION.

DUMPING LICENCES MAY BE OBTAINED FREE OF CHARGE ON APPLICATION TO THE CHIEF ENGINEER, PORT WORKS DIVISION, PWD AT MURRAY BUILDING, FIRST FLOOR, GARDEN ROAD, HONG KONG.

HOLDERS OF VALID DUMPING LICENCES FOR PUBLIC DUMPS IN HONG KONG WILL BE PERMITTED TO DUMP MATERIALS SUCH AS APPROVED SOFT EARTH, BUILDING DEBRIS AND CERTAIN SIZE OF STONES PROVIDING THEY ARE WELL MIXED WITH EARTH.
