NEW TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS IN MID-LEVELS

* * * *

NEW TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE INTRODUCED IN THE MID-LEVELS AREA FROM 10 AM ON MONDAY (FEBRUARY 15) TO IMPROVE TRAFFIC CIRCULATION.

THEY ARE:

- * THE SECTION OF BUS-ONLY LANE ON PARK ROAD AND ROBINSON ROAD BETWEEN BREEZY PATH AND CASTLE ROAD WILL BE RE-OPENED TO ALL TRAFFIC.
- * THE EXISTING PRIVATE LIGHT BUSES CLEARWAY RESTRICTION ON THE SECTION OF PARK ROAD AND ROBINSON ROAD BETWEEN BREEZY PATH AND CASTLE ROAD WILL BE REPLACED BY PEAK HOUR URBAN CLEARWAY RESTRICTION.
- * THE BUS-ONLY LANES IN MID-LEVELS AREA WILL BE IN OPERATION FROM 7 AM TO 8 PM DAILY.
- * URBAN CLEARWAY RESTRICTION WILL BE IMPOSED ON THE SECTION OF OLD BAILEY STREET BETWEEN CAINE ROAD AND CHANCERY LANE FROM 7 AM TO 10 AM AND FROM 4 PM TO 7 PM DAILY.

TRAFFIC SIGNS AND CARRIAGEWAY MARKINGS WILL BE PUT UP TO GUIDE MOTORISTS.

TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PEAK TRAM SERVICE

PEAK TRAM SERVICE WILL BE TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED FROM 12.15 AM ON MONDAY (FEBRUARY 15) TO 7 AM ON WEDNESDAY (FEBRUARY 24) FOR OVERHAULING WORK.

A TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID THAT OTHER PUBLIC TRANSPORT WILL RUN ADDITIONAL SERVICES DURING THIS PERIOD.

CMB ROUTE 15, FROM THE PEAK TO CENTRAL, WILL OPERATE AT 10-MINUTE FREQUENCIES DURING PEAK PERIODS AND EVERY 15 TO 20 MINUTES DURING OFF-PEAK HOURS.

HK/US TEXTILE TALKS RECESS

+THE TALKS IN WASHINGTON BETWEEN HONG KONG AND THE UNITED STATES ON A NEW TEXTILE ARRANGEMENT RECESSED ON FRIDAY (FEBRUARY 12), + MR BILL DORWARD, DIRECTOR OF TRADE INDUSTRY AND CUSTOMS, SAID TODAY (SATURDAY).

MR DORWARD SAID THAT HE HAD RECEIVED A REPORT FROM THE HONG KONG DELEGATION THAT THE TWO SIDES HAD DECIDED THAT A TEMPORARY RECESS WAS NECESSARY TO ALLOW THEM TO TAKE STOCK OF THE POSITION REACHED SO FAR.

ACCORDING TO MR DORWARD WHILE THERE HAD BEEN A MEASURE OF PROGRESS, MR LAWRENCE MILLS, COMMISSIONER OF TRADE, HAD REPORTED FROM WASHINGTON THAT THE SCOPE AND NATURE OF THE US PROPOSALS WERE SUCH AS TO MAKE IT NECESSARY TO CONSULT THE TEXTILES ADVISORY BOARD FURTHER.

THE TALKS ARE PROVISIONALLY SCHEDULED TO RESUME ON MARCH 11.

FURTHER FINANCIAL HELP HAS BEEN GIVEN TO THE FAMILY OF THREE ABERDEEN FISHERMEN WHO DIED RECENTLY IN A SHOOTING INCIDENT ABOUT 500 NAUTICAL MILES SOUTH OF HONG KONG.

A SUM OF \$10 000 HAS BEEN ALLOCATED TO THE FAMILY FROM THE TANG SHIU-KIN/HO TIM CHARITABLE FUND, WHICH IS ADMINISTERED BY THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT.

THE CASH IS ON TOP OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AMOUNTING TO \$10 180 PAID OUT BY THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT TO THE FAMILY ON THURSDAY.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE SWD SAID TODAY THAT THE CASE IS AN EXAMPLE OF THE DEPARTMENT'S EFFORTS TO REACH OUT TO THOSE IN NEED OF HELP.

+AS SOON AS WE HEARD ABOUT THE CASE, OUR FIELD STAFF TOOK THE INITIATIVE TO CONTACT THE FAMILY AND OFFER WHATEVER ASSISTANCE WE COULD,+ HE SAID.

TUEN MUN INDUSTRIAL BOOKLET PUBLISHED

* * *

A 24-PAGE BOOKLET ON INDUSTRIAL INVESTMENT IN TUEN MUN HAS BEEN PUBLISHED BY THE DISTRICT BOARD'S COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY SUB-COMMITTEE.

IT IS A BI-LINGUAL PUBLICATION AND CONTAINS INFORMATION ON THE NEW TOWN'S EXISTING INDUSTRIES, COMMUNICATIONS, AVAILABILITY OF LAND, LABOUR SUPPLY, PROVISION OF SUPPORTING SERVICES, AND ACCOMMODATION AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES.

THE DISTRICT OFFICER, MR BILLY LAM, WHO IS ALSO CHAIRMAN OF THE DISTRICT BOARD, SAYS IN AN INTRODUCTION THAT THE BOOKLET HELPS TO OUTLINE THE TOWN'S ATTRACTIONS TO INVESTORS.

TUEN MUN IS ONE OF THE FASTEST DEVELOPING OF THE NEW TOWNS. IT NOW HAS 130 000 PEOPLE, BUT IS EXPECTED TO HAVE MORE THAN HALF A MILLION PEOPLE BEFORE THE END OF THIS DECADE.

TUEN MUN COULD PROVIDE 1 772.6 HECTARES OF DEVELOPMENT AREA, OF WHICH MORE THAN 11 PER CENT IS DESIGNATED FOR INDUSTRIAL USE, HE SAYS.

THERE IS PLENTY OF ROOM FOR EXPANSION IN EVERY DIRECTION AND THE POTENTIAL OF TUEN MUN BECOMING THE INDUSTRIAL HUB OF THE NORTH WESTERN NEW TERRITORIES IS UNQUESTIONABLE.

THE SUPPLY OF INDUSTRIAL LAND IS PLENTIFUL AND THE MARKET PRICE IS SIGNIFICANTLY LOWER THAN IN THE URBAN AREA AND OTHER NEW TERRITORIES NEW TOWNS.

THE BOOKLET QUOTES THE PRICE OF INDUSTRIAL LAND IN TUEN MUN IN NOVEMBER, 1981, AT \$6 000 PER SQUARE METRE, COMPARED TO \$8 000 TO \$14 000 IN URBAN KOWLOON AND HONG KONG- THE FLATTED FACTORY PRICE AT \$2 000 PER SQUARE METRE COMPARED TO \$3 200 TO \$5 300; AND RENTS FOR FLATTED FACTORY SPACE AT \$17 PER SQUARE METRE PER MONTH COMPARED TO \$25 TO \$50.

IT SAYS AS MOST OF THE RESIDENTS IN THE MAJOR HOUSING ESTATES IN TUEN MUN CAME FROM THE URBAN AREAS THEY INEVITABLY BROUGHT WITH THEM THE SKILL AND RESOURCEFULNESS WHICH HAD PROVED TO BE SO ESSENTIAL AND USEFUL IN INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT IN THE URBAN AREAS.

+THERE IS, THEREFORE, NO LACK OF SKILLED MANPOWER SUPPLY IN TUEN MUN,+ THE BOOKLET STATES.

THE NEW TOWN IS WELL LINKED WITH OTHER PARTS OF THE TERRITORY BOTH BY LAND AND SEA TRANSPORT.

FOR EXAMPLE, IT ONLY TAKES 30 MINUTES TO REACH THE KWAI CHUNG CONTAINER PORT VIA THE SIX-LANE MODERN HIGHWAY, AND THE SAME JOURNEY TIME TO REACH CENTRAL HONG KONG BY THE HOVERFERRY SERVICE. WHEN THE TSUEN WAN MASS TRANSIT RAILWAY STATION OPENS IN MAY, IT WILL TAKE ONLY 20 MINUTES TO GET TO TUEN MUN.

THE BOOKLET ALSO NOTES THAT A 27-KILOMETRE LONG INTERNAL LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT SYSTEM, WHICH HAS A CAPACITY OF 30 000 PASSENGERS PER HOUR AND LINKS WITH YUEN LONG, IS EXPECTED TO BECOME FULLY OPERATIONAL BY 1986.

OTHER ATTRACTIONS WILL INCLUDE THE PROVISION OF SUPPORT FACILITIES AND LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL AREAS FOR MANAGERIAL AND SUPERVISORY STAFF.

RECREATIONAL FACILITIES ARE ADEQUATE AND MANY OTHERS ARE EITHER BEING BUILT OR UNDER ACTIVE PLANNING TO KEEP PACE WITH THE POPULATION GROWTH.

THE BOOKLET WILL BE DISTRIBUTED TO MANUFACTURERS, DEVELOPERS AND TRADE ASSOCIATIONS, AS WELL AS DURING TRADE FAIRS AND SEMINARS.

THE COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY SUB-COMMITTEE, FORMED LAST JUNE, HAS 14 UNOFFICIAL AND 10 OFFICIAL MEMBERS.

THE SPORTSGROUND WILL BE OPEN TO ALL PEOPLE SIX DAYS A WEEK, EXCEPT FRIDAY FOR MAINTENANCE WORK AND WHEN THERE IS A BOOKING FOR EXCLUSIVE USE.

HOWEVER, NO BALL GAMES ARE ALLOWED DURING THE TWO SPECIAL SESSIONS, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

PEOPLE WHO ENTER THE SPORTSGROUND ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR PROPER SPORTS SHOES, SO AS TO MINIMISE DAMAGE TO THE ALL-WEATHER SYNTHETIC TRACK AND TURF.

JOGGERS OR ANY PEOPLE ENTERING THE SPORTSGROUND MAY BE ASKED BY ATTENDANTS TO WRITE DOWN THEIR NAMES AND IDENTITY CARD NUMBERS AT THE ENTRANCE, THE SPOKESMAN ADDED.
