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OPERATION ROLLING STONE TO WEED OUT ILLEGAL STRUCTURES

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THE BUILDINGS ORDINANCE OFFICE (BOO) OF THE BUILDINGS AND LANDS DEPARTMENT HAS LAUNCHED A NEW OPERATION THIS MONTH AGAINST ILLEGAL STRUCTURES PROJECTING FROM BUILDING WALLS.

THE OPERATION, CODED-NAMED ROLLING STONE, IS BOO'S LATEST ENDEAVOUR IN ITS CAMPAIGN TO WEED OUT DANGEROUS APPENDAGES FOR THE SAFETY OF THE RESIDENTS AND PASSERS-BY.

IT CAME SHORTLY AFTER THE SUCCESSFUL CONCLUSION OF OPERATION CATHERINE WHEEL, A TWO-YEAR EXERCISE DURING WHICH ADVISORY LETTERS WERE SENT TO PROPERTY OWNERS OF THE TARGETTED BUILDINGS, REQUESTING THEM TO REMOVE THEIR ILLEGAL STRUCTURES VOLUNTARILY.

THE EXERCISE HAD RESULTED IN THE DEMOLITION OF 18,444 UNAUTHORISED STRUCTURES FROM 11,079 FLATS IN 52 TARGETTED BUILDINGS.

ONLY 3,011 REMOVAL ORDERS HAD TO BE ISSUED TO THOSE WHO IGNORED THE ADVISORY LETTERS.

THE NEW OPERATION HAS PICKED THE BO FUNG GARDENS, A THREE-TOWER BLOCK GARDEN ESTATE AT 1090-1094 KING'S ROAD, QUARRY BAY, AS ITS FIRST TARGET BECAUSE THE BUILDING HAS SOME 840-PLUS UNAUTHORISED BUILDING WORKS (UBW) PROJECTING FROM THE BUILDINGS' EXTERNAL WALLS.

THE UBW, SUCH AS METAL CAGES, CANOPIES, METAL RACKS, SOLID EXTENSIONS, STRUCTURES ON APPROVED CANOPIES AND SHOP-FRONT EXTENSIONS, ARE ALL POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS AND ENVIRONMENTALLY AND AESTHETICALLY UNDESIRABLE.

A BOO SPOKESMAN SAID THE ADVISORY-LETTER-APPROACH, WHICH HAD ACHIEVED A 55 PER CENT VOLUNTARY COMPLIANCE RATE DURING OPERATION CATHERINE WHEEL, HAD BEEN ADOPTED FOR THE NEW OPERATION.

"ADVISORY LETTERS HAVE ALREADY BEEN SENT TO OWNERS AND OCCUPIERS OF BO FUNG GARDENS REQUESTING THEM TO TAKE STEPS TO REMOVE THE UNAUTHORISED BUILDING WORKS THEMSELVES.

"TALKS AND MEETINGS WILL ALSO BE HELD WITH OWNERS CORPORATIONS AND MUTUAL AID COMMITTEES OF THE BUILDINGS TO SEEK THEIR CO-OPERATION AND INVOLVEMENT IN MOBILISING THE OWNERS AND RESIDENTS TO REMOVE THE PROJECTING UBWS VOLUNTARILY," HE SAID.

FOR THOSE WHO DO NOT RESPOND TO THE ADVISORY LETTERS, THE SPOKESMAN SAID, REMOVAL ORDERS WILL BE ISSUED.

"FOR NON-COMPLIANCE, PROSECUTION ACTION WILL BE TAKEN AND THE UBWS WILL BE REMOVED BY GOVERNMENT CONTRACTORS IF NECESSARY," HE WARNED.

THE OPERATIONS ON BO FUNG GARDENS WILL BE DIVIDED INTO THREE PHASES. ACTION ON BLOCKS A AND B ARE EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED BY THE END OF THIS YEAR AND BLOCK C EARLY NEXT YEAR.

"WITH THE CO-OPERATION OF ALL THE OWNERS AND OCCUPIERS, WE HOPE THE WHOLE OPERATION ON THESE BUILDINGS CAN BE COMPLETED AT AN EARLIER DATE," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

HEP B VACCINATION PROGRAMME TO EXTEND TILL END OF YEAR

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THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TODAY (SUNDAY) CALLED ON PARENTS WITH CHILDREN BORN BETWEEN 1986 AND 1988 AND HAVE NOT BEEN VACCINATED AGAINST HEPATITIS B TO TAKE THEM FOR VACCINATION BEFORE THE END OF THE YEAR.

VACCINATION AGAINST THE DISEASE IS FREE AT THE DEPARTMENT'S MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH CENTRES UNDER A PREVENTIVE PROGRAMME INTRODUCED IN JULY LAST YEAR AND SCHEDULED FOR ONE YEAR, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID.

"THE PROGRAMME HAS NOW BEEN EXTENDED TILL THE END OF THE YEAR TO ALLOW PARENTS WHO HAVE NOT YET RESPONDED TO TAKE ACTION AND NOT TO BE MISSED OUT," HE ADDED.

THE SPOKESMAN POINTED OUT THAT PRE-SCHOOL CHILDREN WERE PARTICULARLY PRONE TO HEPATITIS B VIRUS INFECTION BECAUSE THEY WERE VERY ACTIVE AND MIGHT INJURE THEMSELVES EASILY THROUGH ACTIVITIES AND ACCIDENTS.

"HEPATITIS B VIRUS CAN GAIN ACCESS TO THEIR BODIES THROUGH EVEN MINOR WOUNDS.

"INFECTION BY HEPATITIS B VIRUS MAY RESULT IN DEVELOPING CHRONIC LIVER DISEASES SUCH AS CIRRHOSIS AND LIVER CANCER," HE SAID.

TO ACHIEVE MAXIMUM PROTECTION, EACH CHILD SHOULD RECEIVE A FULL COURSE OF THREE DOSES -- THE FIRST TWO DOSES AT AN INTERVAL OF ONE MONTH WHILE THE SECOND AND THE THRID DOSE AT AN INTERVAL OF TWO TO FOUR MONTHS.

PARENTS ARE ADVISED TO BRING THEIR CHILDREN, TOGETHER WITH IMMUNISATION CARDS, BACK TO THEIR RESPECTIVE MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH CENTRES AS SOON AS POSSIBLE FOR VACCINATION.

THE GOVERNMENT INTRODUCED A VACCINATION PROGRAMME AGAINST THE DISEASE IN 1984 FOR BABIES BORN TO CARRIER MOTHERS AND HEALTH CARE WORKERS.

IT WAS EXPANDED IN NOVEMBER 1988 TO COVER ALL NEWBORNS.

IN JULY LAST YEAR, THE PROGRAMME WAS FURTHER EXPANDED TO COVER PRE-SCHOOL CHILDREN BORN BETWEEN 1986 AND 1988 WITHIN A SCHEDULED PERIOD OF ONE YEAR.

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STAMPS MARK 40TH ANNIVERSARY OF QUEEN'S CORONATION

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THE POSTMASTER GENERAL, MR M PAGLIARI, ANNOUNCED TODAY (SUNDAY) THAT A SET OF SPECIAL STAMPS WILL BE ISSUED ON JUNE 2 TO COMMEMORATE THE 40TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE CORONATION OF THE QUEEN.

THERE WILL BE FOUR DENOMINATIONS: 80-CENT, \$1.80, \$2.30 AND \$5.

THE STAMPS WERE DESIGNED BY MR COLIN TILLYER AND PRINTED BY LEIGH-MARDON PTY LIMITED OF AUSTRALIA.

THEY WILL BE PUT UP FOR ADVANCE INFORMATION OF THE PUBLIC AT THE GENERAL POST OFFICE, TSIM SHA TSUI POST OFFICE AND SHA TIN CENTRAL POST OFFICE FROM MAY 20.

A SET OF POSTCARDS SHOWING CHANGES TO THE VICTORIA HARBOUR WATERFRONT SINCE THE QUEEN'S CORONATION IN 1953 WILL BE ISSUED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE STAMPS.

THEY ARE AVAILABLE AT \$5 A SET FROM MAY 20 AT ALL POST OFFICES EXCEPT THE AIRPORT POST OFFICE.

OFFICIAL FIRST DAY COVERS WILL BE ON SALE AT ALL POST OFFICES, EXCEPT THE AIRPORT POST OFFICE, FROM MAY 20 AT \$1 EACH.

ADVANCE ORDERS FOR SERVICED FIRST DAY COVERS WILL BE ACCEPTED FROM MAY 20 TO 25. THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF COVERS PER ORDER IS FIVE.

ON THE FIRST DAY OF ISSUE, EACH CUSTOMER ON THE QUEUE IS ENTITLED TO TWO SHEETS OF STAMPS (100 PIECES) OF EACH DENOMINATION.

NO RESTRICTION HOWEVER WILL BE IMPOSED ON THE SALE OF POSTCARDS.

FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF CUSTOMERS, FIRST DAY COVERS PRE-AFFIXED WITH A SET OF STAMPS AND CANCELLED WITH THE FIRST DAY OF ISSUE POSTMARK WILL BE AVAILABLE AT \$12.90 EACH AT THE SIX PHILATELIC OFFICES:

PEAK POST OFFICE

A HAND-BACK SERVICE WILL BE GIVEN TO ALL OFFICIAL AND PRIVATELY MADE COVERS BEARING THE "FIRST DAY" INDICATION ON JUNE 2 AT ALL POST OFFICES EXCEPT THE AIRPORT POST OFFICE.

A SPECIAL DATESTAMP WILL BE INTRODUCED FOR THE PURPOSE.

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SAMPLE STATUTORY DECLARATION FORM FOR NT VILLAGERS

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THE BUILDINGS AND LANDS DEPARTMENT HAS DESIGNED A SAMPLE STATUTORY DECLARATION FORM FOR NEW TERRITORIES VILLAGERS WHO NEED TO MAKE STATUTORY DECLARATIONS TO SUPPORT THEIR CLAIM TO LAND TITLE IN LEASED LAND AFFECTED BY LAND RESUMPTIONS.

ANNOUNCING THIS TODAY (SUNDAY), A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT THANKED THE HEUNG YEE KUK FOR ITS CONTRIBUTION TO THE DRAFTING OF THE SAMPLE FORM.

THE SAMPLE FORM IS NOW AVAILABLE FOR REFERENCE AT ALL DISTRICT LANDS OFFICES IN THE NEW TERRITORIES AND AT THE NEW AIRPORT (NEW TERRITORIES) OFFICE IN THE TSUEN WAN GOVERNMENT OFFICES.

SAMPLE FORMS FOR OTHER SIMILAR STATUTORY DECLARATIONS MADE BY VILLAGERS IN THE PAST ARE ALSO AVAILABLE AT THESE OFFICES.

THEY ARE ALSO AVAILABLE FOR REFERENCE AT ALL RURAL COMMITTEES IN THE NEW TERRITORIES.

THE SPOKESMAN POINTED OUT THAT VILLAGERS MAKING STATUTORY DECLARATIONS RELATING TO LAND RESUMPTION MATTERS IN THE NEW TERRITORIES MIGHT REFER TO THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THESE SAMPLE FORMS BEFORE FILLING IN THE STANDARD DECLARATION FORM.

THE INFORMATION COULD BE AMENDED BY VILLAGERS TO SUIT THEIR PARTICULAR CASES.

VILLAGERS WISHING TO MAKE STATUTORY DECLARATIONS MIGHT APPROACH THE DISTRICT LANDS OFFICE OF THEIR DISTRICT OR THE NEW AIRPORT (NEW TERRITORIES) OFFICE TO MAKE THE NECESSARY ARRANGEMENTS, THE SPOKESMAN ADDED.

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FUNG HON CHU TRUST FUND TO HELP PROMOTE GIFTED EDUCATION

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AN \$8 MILLION DONATION TO SET UP A FUNG HON-CHU EDUCATION TRUST FUND WILL BE USED MAINLY TO SET UP A RESOURCE CENTRE FOR THE EDUCATION OF ACADEMICALLY GIFTED CHILDREN.

THE DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION, MR DOMINIC S W WONG, AND HIS PREDECESSOR, MR LI YUET-TING, ACCEPTED THE DONATION FROM ENTREPRENEUR AND FORMER LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AND URBAN COUNCIL MEMBER, MR FUNG HON-CHU, AT THE LATTER'S RESIDENCE.

MR FUNG IS THE CHAIRMAN EMERITUS OF THE LI & FUNG GROUP OF COMPANIES, ONE OF THE OLDEST CHINESE FIRMS IN HONG KONG.

MR LI IS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TRUST FUND. OTHER TRUSTEES ARE MRS JULIA SHEN FUNG; MR WAN HING-YUEN, PRINCIPAL OF THE COTTON SPINNERS ASSOCIATION PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOL, AND MRS GRACE YUNG, ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION (SERVICES).

MR WONG THANKED MR FUNG FOR HIS GENEROUS DONATION WHICH WOULD GREATLY HELP THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT IN FULLY IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS IN THE EDUCATION COMMISSION'S REPORT NO. 4 ON THE EDUCATION OF GIFTED CHILDREN.

THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT WOULD ESTABLISH A RESOURCE CENTRE AS A BASE FOR A TEAM OF PROFESSIONAL OFFICERS TO DEVELOP AND DISSEMINATE CURRICULUM MATERIALS AND TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL HELP TO TEACHERS TEACHING GIFTED CHILDREN IN THEIR SCHOOLS.

TEACHERS AT THE CENTRE WOULD BE ABLE TO SELECT OR PRODUCE THEIR OWN TEACHING MATERIALS, MEET OTHER TEACHERS OF GIFTED CHILDREN AND SHARE PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE. PARENTS OF GIFTED CHILDREN WOULD ALSO BE GIVEN ADVICE ON HOW BEST TO SUPPORT THEM AT HOME.

THE CENTRE WOULD ALSO PROVIDE A VENUE FOR SEMINARS AND WORKSHOPS FOR THE GIFTED CHILDREN THEMSELVES, AT WHICH THEY COULD MEET THEIR PEERS AS WELL AS SPECIALISTS FROM VARIOUS FIELDS.

IN ADDITION, DURING LONG SCHOOL HOLIDAYS, THE CENTRE WOULD BE ARRANGING ENRICHMENT PROGRAMMES FOR THE CHILDREN TO FURTHER DEVELOP THEIR POTENTIAL. THEY COULD ALSO PURSUE EXTENDED STUDIES WHICH COULD NOT BE FITTED INTO THEIR OWN SCHOOL-BASED PROGRAMMES.

THE PROPOSED CENTRE WOULD BE NAMED THE FUNG HON CHU GIFTED CHILDREN EDUCATION RESOURCE CENTRE.

"PRIZE-WINNING WORKS WILL BE EXHIBITED IN OSLO, PARIS, NEW YORK, VIENNA AND OTHER CITIES AROUND THE WORLD, SPECIAL DIPLOMAS AND PRIZES WILL ALSO BE AWARDED," HE SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN URGED STUDENTS TO PARTICIPATE ACTIVELY IN THIS INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION.
