SECURITIES COMMISSION APPOINTMENT

A PROMINENT HONG KONG INDUSTRIALIST, MR. CHOW CHUNG-KAI, HAS BEEN APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR AS A MEMBER OF THE SECURITIES COMMISSION.

HE SUCCEEDS MR. Y.K. PAO WHO HAS RESIGNED FROM THE SECURITIES COMMISSION BECAUSE OF PRESSURE OF OTHER COMMITMENTS. THE APPOINTMENT OF MR. CHOW IS FROM OCTOBER 1 UNTIL NEXT FEBRUARY WHEN THE APPOINTMENTS OF OTHER MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION EXPIRE.

MR. CHOW IS MANAGING DIRECTOR OF WINNER COMPANY (HONG KONG) LTD. AND DEPUTY MANAGING DIRECTOR OF WINSOR INDUSTRIAL CORPORATION LTD. HE IS CURRENTLY VICE PRESIDENT OF THE CHINESE MANUFACTURERS ASSOCIATION AND IS PERMANENT HONORARY CHAIRMAN OF THE FEDERATION OF HONG KONG COTTON WEAVERS. HE ALSO SERVED ON THE TEXTILES ADVISORY BOARD FROM 1961 UNTIL EARLIER THIS YEAR.

THE SECURITIES COMMISSION COMPRISES FIVE UNOFFICIAL MEMBERS AND TWO GOVERNMENT MEMBERS - THE COMMISSIONER FOR SECURITIES AND THE REGISTRAR GENERAL.

LUCKY CLUB GRANTS FOR PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOL PUPILS

PREVOCATIONAL AND SECONDARY MODERN SCHOOLS PUPILS WHOSE FAMILY MONTHLY INCOME IS LESS THAN \$1,200 WILL NOW HAVE A GOOD CHANCE TO OBTAIN A GRANT OF \$300 IF THEIR CONDUCT, SCHOLASTIC ACHIEVEMENT AND ABILITY IN TECHNICAL SUBJECTS ARE GOOD.

THE GRANTS ARE DONATED BY THE LUCKY CLUB, LTD., AN ORGANISATION FOR THE PROMOTION OF SOCIAL WELFARE, WHICH CONSISTS OF MEMBERS OF THE HONG KONG PLASTIC MANUFACTURERS' ASSOCIATION, THE CHIU CHOU PLASTIC MANUFACTURERS' ASSOCIATION AND THE HONG KONG AND KOWLOON PLASTIC PRODUCTS AND MERCHANT UNITED ASSOCIATION. IT HAS DONATED A TOTAL OF MORE THAN \$500,000 FOR WHICH CHILDREN OF WORKERS FROM ALL INDUSTRIES MAY APPLY.

THIS YEAR, THE TECHNICAL BRANCH OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT HAS PROCESSED THE APPLICATIONS AND RECOMMENDED THAT GRANTS BE AWARDED TO 124 PUPILS FROM CARITAS ST. GODFREY PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOL IN ABERDEEN, CARITAS ST. FRANCIS PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOL IN CAINE ROAD, CARITAS ST. JOSEPH PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOL IN TSUEN WAN, CARITAS ST. PAUL PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOL IN CHEUNG CHAU, CHURCH OF CHRIST IN CHINA ROTARY PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOL IN WANG TAU HOM, HOLY CARPENTER PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOL IN HUNG HOM, KEI HEEP SECONDARY MODERN SCHOOL IN WONG TAI SIN, ST. BASIL'S SECONDARY MODERN SCHOOL IN CHAI WAN AND FISH MARKETING ORGANISATION SECONDARY MODERN SCHOOL IN KENNEDY TOWN.

IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT 150 GRANTS WILL BE GIVEN TO PREVOCATIONAL PUPILS NEXT YEAR.

TRAINING COURSE FOR YOUTH LEADERS

A YAU MA TEI YOUTH SERVICE GROUP, THE ALPENGLOW, IS ORGANISING A COURSE TO TRAIN LEADERS FOR A YOUTH GUIDANCE SCHEME WHICH IT PLANS TO START NEXT YEAR.

THE TRAINING COURSE, WHICH WILL BE FOR YOUTHS BETWEEN 17 AND 22 OF FORM FOUR LEVEL OR ABOVE, WILL BE HELD EVERY SATURDAY FROM 2.30 TO 5 P.M. IN MID-OCTOBER AND WILL LAST UNTIL THE END OF DECEMBER.

IT WILL BE HELD AT THE OFFICE OF THE COMMUNITY AND YOUTH OFFICE (YAU MA TEI) WHICH IS SPONSORING THE PROJECT.

THE CONTENTS WILL COVER SUCH SUBJECTS AS THE THEORY OF GUIDANCE WORK, METHODS AND SKILLS IN DEALING WITH YOUTH PROBLEMS AND YOUTH PSYCHOLOGY. LECTURES WILL BE BY PROFESSIONALS IN THE FIELDS RELATED TO THE TOPICS. ALSO INCLUDED WILL BE DISCUSSIONS AND FILMS.

WITH THE START OF A NEW SCHOOL YEAR, STUDENTS WILL AGAIN BE NEEDING QUIET PLACES TO STUDY AND DO THEIR HOMEWORK, THE LAM TIN ESTATE COMMUNITY WORK OFFICE HAS ORGANISED A STUDY ROOM PROJECT FOR PUPILS LIVING IN THE ESTATE.

THE HALL OF THE ESTATE WELFARE BUILDING IN WEST LAM TIN HAS BEEN SET ASIDE TO SERVE THE NEEDS OF THE STUDENTS. IT WILL BE AVAILABLE TO THEM BETWEEN 4.15 P.M. AND 9.45 P.M. FROM MONDAY TO SATURDAY= WHILE ON SUNDAYS, THEY CAN GO THERE ANYTIME BETWEEN 2 AND 7 P.M. IT IS ALSO PLANNED TO OPEN IT OVER PUBLIC HOLIDAYS AS WELL.

THE HALL CAN ACCOMMODATE SIXTY STUDENTS AT ONE TIME.

THE COMMUNITY WORK OFFICE HAS MOBILISED A GROUP OF VOLUNTEERS TO KEEP THE STUDY ROOM CLEAN AND TIDY AND TO HELP THOSE USING IT WITH THEIR PROBLEMS.
