INDUSTRIALISTS URGED TO SPONSOR STAFF
FOR PART-TIME DAY RELEASE COURSES
* * * * *

THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION (TECHNICAL), MR. DANIEL WATERS THIS EVENING CALLED ON MORE CONTRACTORS IN THE PRIVATE AND PUBLIC SECTORS TO CONSIDER SPONSORING STUDENTS ON THE CONSTRUCTION TECHNICIANS' PART-TIME DAY-RELEASE COURSE AT THE MORRISON HILL TECHNICAL INSTITUTE.

HE WAS SPEAKING AT THE GRADUATION DINNER MARKING THE FOURTH GRADUATION CEREMONY OF THIS COURSE WHICH FIRST STARTED AT THE INSTITUTE IN 1970.

+THE COURSE HAS BEEN WELL SPOKEN OF BY THE HONG KONG TRAINING COUNCIL,+ MR. WATERS SAID. +THIS IS PRAISE INDEED.+

DESCRIBING THE COURSE AS +A SUCCESS,+ THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR SAID HE UNDERSTOOD THAT BOTH THE CONTRACTORS AND THE STUDENTS FELT THAT THE COURSE SERVED A USEFUL PURPOSE.

BUT MR. WATERS WAS DISAPPOINTED THAT SO FAR THERE HAD BEEN ONLY ONE CLASS. HE HOPED THAT MORE EMPLOYERS WOULD SEND THEIR STAFF TO ATTEND THE COURSE.

+STUDENTS ARE SPONSORED BY THEIR EMPLOYERS AND THEY ATTEND THE COURSE FOR ONE FULL DAY AND FOR TWO EVENINGS A WEEK.

+WHILE ATTENDING THE COURSE DURING THE DAY, THEY ARE ON FULL PAY. ON THE OTHER HAND, WHAT THE STUDENT LEARNS ON THE COURSE WILL FAR OUTWEIGH THE ACTUAL COURSE FEES OR THE VALUE OF THE TIME SPENT,+ MR. WATERS POINTED OUT.

THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR SAID HE WAS NOT JUST TALKING ONLY TO CONTRACTORS AND THE BUILDING INDUSTRY.

HE SAID: +I AM TALKING TO ALL EMPLOYERS IN ALL OTHER INDUSTRIES. I WOULD URGE THEM TO SPONSOR STUDENTS, AT BOTH CRAFT AND TECHNICIAN LEVELS.

+WE NOW HAVE AN EXTENSIVE RANGE OF PART-TIME DAY-RELEASE CLASSES IN TECHNICAL INSTITUTES. THEIR BIG ADVANTAGE IS THAT THEY LINK THE RELATED TECHNICAL EDUCATION IN A TECHNICAL INSTITUTE WITH ON-THE-JOB TRAINING EXPERIENCE. ONE CANNOT BE DIVORCED FROM THE OTHER. THIS IS MOST IMPORTANT.+

HE CONGRATULATED THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY IN HONG KONG FOR SHOWING CONSIDERABLE INITIATIVE AND FORESIGHT.

THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY TRAINING CENTRE TO BE OPENED LATER THIS MONTH WAS A VERY COMMENDABLE ACHIEVEMENT AND ONE WHICH OTHER INDUSTRIES COULD DO WELL TO CONSIDER, MR. WATERS SAID.

MORE ENROLLED AS VOLUNTEERS TO HELP PROBATIONERS

* * * * *

ANOTHER 40 VOLUNTEERS WHO HAVE ENROLLED TO HELP PROBATIONERS ARE NOW ATTENDING AN ORIENTATION COURSE ORGANISED FOR THEM BY THE PROBATION AND CORRECTIONS DIVISION OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT.

THIS COURSE FOLLOWS TWO SUCCESSFUL ONES HELD LAST DECEMBER AND APRIL WHEN 25 AND 30 VOLUNTEERS ENROLLED RESPECTIVELY.

THE 'VOLUNTEERS SCHEME FOR PROBATIONERS', ONE OF THE REHABILITATION PROGRAMMES ORGANISED FOR YOUNG OFFENDERS, IS A SERVICE RENDERED BY SELECTED VOLUNTEERS TO PROVIDE PERSONAL AND MORAL SUPPORT THROUGH FRIENDSHIP TO PROBATIONERS.

THE 40 VOLUNTEERS, ALL AGED BETWEEN 17 AND 26, COME FROM A CROSS SECTION OF THE COMMUNITY AND COMPRISE TEACHERS, STUDENTS, OFFICE CLERKS AND FACTORY WORKERS.

A BRIEF OPENING CEREMONY FOR THE ORIENTATION COURSE WAS HELD THIS (SATURDAY) AFTERNOON AT THE LADY TRENCH TRAINING CENTRE TO INTRODUCE THE SCHEME TO THE VOLUNTEERS IN MORE DETAIL AND TO LET THEM HAVE A CHANCE TO MEET EACH OTHER.

AT THE CEREMONY, MR. MAK WING-HONG, HEAD OF THE PROBATION AND CORRECTIONS DIVISION SAID: +AFTER THE INITIAL INTRODUCTION, TRAINING SESSIONS WILL BE ARRANGED FOR THE VOLUNTEERS. TALKS, GROUP DISCUSSIONS AND OBSERVATION VISITS ARE THE MAJOR SUBJECTS IN THE TRAINING PROGRAMME.

+VOLUNTEERS WILL BE ABLE TO ACQUIRE BASIC KNOWLEDGE OF THE WORK OF THE PROBATION SERVICE, THE SPECIAL PROBLEMS OF DRUG-ADDICTS, TRIAD OFFENDERS ON PROBATION AND PROBLEM GIRLS ON PROBATION, AND THEIR ROLE AND FUNCTION AS VOLUNTEERS IN THE SCHEME.+

WHEN THEY HAD BEEN EQUIPPED BY THE TRAINING, THEY WOULD BE 'MATCHED' WITH THE PROBATIONERS AND START HELPING TO REFORM THEM, HE ADDED.

COMMENTING ON THE MAJOR ADVANTAGE OF THE 'VOLUNTEERS SCHEME FOR PROBATIONERS', MR. MAK SAID, +A YOUNG OFFENDER MAY FEEL MORE AT EASE WITH A VOLUNTEER WHO IS NOT ASSIGNED BY THE AUTHORITY TO KEEP AN EYE ON HIM. HE OFTEN REGARDS THE VOLUNTEER AS A FRIEND AND CONFIDES HIS DEEPEST SECRETS TO HIM.+

HE FURTHER POINTED OUT THAT THE SCHEME WOULD BE IMPORTANT TOWARDS REHABILITATING THE YOUNG OFFENDERS, AS A VOLUNTEER COULD ALWAYS INTRODUCE A PROBATIONER TO A NEW CIRCLE OF FRIENDS AND HELP HIM BREAK AWAY FROM HIS FORMER BAD ASSOCIATES.

TSUEN WAN NEW TOWN EXHIBITION

AN EXHIBITION SHOWING THE DEVELOPMENTS WHICH ARE CHANGING THE FACE OF TSUEN WAN NEW TOWN WILL BE OPENED ON MONDAY (AUGUST 8).

THE EXHIBITION, ORGANISED BY THE TSUEN WAN DISTRICT OFFICE, WILL MARK THE OPENING OF A PUBLIC EXHIBITION AREA IN THE LAI CHI KOK AMUSEMENT PARK.

ENTITLED +TODAY AND YESTERDAY IN TSUEN WAN+, THE EXHIBITION WILL HIGHLIGHT THE GOVERNMENT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMMES AND THE PROVISION OF COMMUNITY AND RECREATION FACILITIES IN THE NEW TOWN.

IT WILL HAVE MODELS, PLANS, DRAWINGS AND PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE MANY SCHEMES BEING UNDERTAKEN IN THE TOWN.

THE EXHIBITION WILL BE OFFICIALLY OPENED BY THE TSUEN WAN TOWN MANAGER, MR. JAMES HAYES, AND MRS. JANE AKERS-JONES, WIFE OF THE SECRETARY FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES.

MR. HAYES SAID TODAY THE EXHIBITION WOULD BE AN EXTENSION OF THE TOWN SQUARES EXHIBITION STAGED BY HIS OFFICE IN JUNE.

+WE HAD ABOUT 7,000 LOCAL PEOPLE COME TO THE LAST EXHIBITION AND WE HOPE THAT A LARGER NUMBER OF PEOPLE WILL BE INTERESTED IN THIS NEW EXHIBITION,+ HE SAID.

+WE WERE ASKED BY MR. DEACON CHIU, PROPRIETOR OF THE LAI CHI KOK AMUSEMENT PARK, TO PUT ON THIS EXHIBITION IN A HALL HE IS SETTING ASIDE FOR DESERVING BODIES WHO WISH TO DISPLAY MATTERS OF PUBLIC INTEREST.

+WE WERE DELIGHTED TO ACCEPT THE INVITATION.+

CENTREPIECE OF THE EXHIBITION WILL BE THE PLANS DRAWN UP BY ARCHITECTURAL STUDENTS FROM THE HONG KONG UNIVERSITY FOR FIVE OF TSUEN WAN'S TOWN SQUARES -- TAI PEI SQUARE, YI PEI SQUARE, SAM PEI SQUARE, HAU TEI SQUARE AND LO TAK COURT.

ALSO ON DISPLAY WILL BE DESIGN SKETCHES FOR TSUEN WAN'S PLANNED TOWN HALL, ITS INDOOR GAMES HALL AND THE KWAI CHUNG SPORTS GROUND.

THE EXHIBITION WILL RUN FOR TWO WEEKS AND WILL BE OPEN BETWEEN 9 A.M. AND 11 P.M. DAILY.

GOOD RESPONSE TO POSTER DESIGN COMPETITION
* * * * *

NINETY-FIVE ENTRIES HAVE BEEN RECEIVED SO FAR IN THE COUNTRY PARKS POSTER DESIGN COMPETITION JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE COUNTRY PARKS AUTHORITY AND THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE COUNTRY PARKS AUTHORITY SAID: +OF THE ENTRIES, 87 ARE FOR THE JUNIOR SECTION FOR ALL STUDENTS UNDER THE AGE OF 15= AND EIGHT FOR THE OPEN SECTION FOR EVERYONE UNDER THE AGE OF 25.+

THE COMPETITION AIMS TO PROMOTE AWARENESS OF THE COUNTRY CODE AND THE NEED FOR CONSERVATION AND PROPER USE OF THE COUNTRYSIDE, HE ADDED.

THERE WILL BE FIVE PRIZES IN EACH SECTION -- A FIRST PRIZE OF \$500, A SECOND PRIZE OF \$200 AND THREE THIRD PRIZES OF \$100 EACH.

THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING ENTRIES IS AUGUST 15, 1977. CONDITIONS FOR THE COMPETITION ARE OBTAINABLE FROM ALL CITY DISTRICT OFFICES, ALL NEW TERRITORIES DISTRICT OFFICES OR DIRECT FROM THE COUNTRY PARKS AUTHORITY, CARE OF THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT.

POSTERS FOR ENTRY SHOULD EMPHASISE ONE OR MORE OF THE SIX POINTS IN THE COUNTRY CODE AND SHOULD INCORPORATE THE WORDING OF THE CODE IN ENGLISH OR CHINESE:

- * DO NOT DESTROY BY FIRE OR VANDALISM,
- * DO NOT SPOIL WITH LITTER AND DIRT,
- * DO NOT POLLUTE WATER CATCHMENT AREAS, WATER COURSES AND RESERVOIRS,
- * DO NOT DESTROY VEGETATION AND WILDLIFE,
- * DO NOT DAMAGE CROPS= RESPECT FARMERS' PROPERTY, AND
- * RESPECT THE COUNTRYSIDE.

SUMMER EXPERIENCE CAN BE A LIFE TIME CAREER

* * * * *

EDWIN TAM, A FORM V STUDENT OF THE KOWLOON TECHNICAL SCHOOL KNOWS WHAT HE WILL DO FOR A CAREER WHEN HE LEAVES SCHOOL NEXT YEAR.

FOR EDWIN, WHO IS ONE OF MORE THAN 100 SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN THIS YEAR'S SUMMER WORK EXPERIENCE SCHEME ORGANISED BY THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT AND THE HONG KONG ASSOCIATION OF CAREERS MASTERS, IS NOW A LABORATORY ASSISTANT AT THE UNITED CHRISTIAN HOSPITAL.

+I AM THINKING OF TAKING UP PATHOLOGY AS MY CAREER,+ 18-YEAR-OLD EDWIN SAID BEAMING WITH CONFIDENCE.

+HOSPITAL WORK IS INTERESTING AS WELL AS CHALLENGING AND THERE ARE SO MANY THINGS TO LEARN,+ HE ADDED.

+UNDER THE GUIDANCE AND ENCOURAGEMENT OF THE REGULAR STAFF, I HAVE BEEN ABLE TO PICK UP NEW KNOWLEDGE AND PRACTISE ON THE THEORIES I HAVE LEARNED IN SCHOOL.

+I HAD WANTED TO DEVOTE ONE MONTH OF MY VACATION TO THE SUMMER JOB. I HAVE NOW ASKED TO STAY ONE MORE MONTH TO KNOW MORE ABOUT THE JOB,+ HE SAID.

HE HOPED THAT MORE STUDENTS COULD JOIN THE SUMMER WORK SCHEME AND URGED THAT MORE EMPLOYERS SHOULD GIVE STUDENTS THE OPPORTUNITY TO TRY OUT THEIR ABILITIES AND INTERESTS AT A JOB DURING THE LONG SCHOOL RECESS.

MISS ROSE LAU, SECRETARY OF THE ASSOCIATION, EXPLAINED THAT THE SCHEME NOW IN ITS FOURTH YEAR PROVIDES FORM V AND FORM THREE STUDENTS OF PRE-VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS AN OPPORTUNITY TO +GET THE FEEL OF WORK+ SO AS TO ADJUST BETTER IN THEIR EVENTUAL TRANSITION FROM SCHOOL TO WORK IN SOCIETY.

+IT ALSO HELPS THE STUDENTS TO UNDERSTAND THEIR OWN POTENTIALS AND INTERESTS AND THUS GAIN MORE SELF-CONFIDENCE WHEN CHOOSING A LIFE CAREER,+ SHE ADDED.

MISS LAU, WHO IS ALSO THE CAREERS OFFICER OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT, POINTED OUT THAT WORK EXPERIENCE FOR YOUNG PEOPLE STILL AT SCHOOL WAS SOMETHING COMPARATIVELY NEW IN HONG KONG AND WAS QUITE DIFFERENT FROM ORDINARY SCHOOL VISITS TO PUBLIC OFFICES AND FACTORIES WHERE THE STUDENTS OBSERVE OTHER PEOPLE AT WORK.

THE SCHEME INSTEAD GIVES THE YOUNG PEOPLE A CHANCE TO ACTUALLY EXPERIENCE FULL-TIME EMPLOYMENT AT A PARTICULAR JOB FOR A SHORT PERIOD, SHE SAID.

MORE THAN 300 SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS HAVE BENEFITED FROM THE SCHEME SINCE IT WAS IMPLEMENTED IN 1974 AND SOME 70 FIRMS AND ORGANISATIONS HAVE CONTRIBUTED TO IT BY PROVIDING WORK OPPORTUNITIES. THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS ALLOCATED PLACES HAS INCREASED FROM 58 IN THE FIRST YEAR TO 106 THIS SUMMER.

AS THERE HAS BEEN GOOD RESPONSE FROM BOTH THE STUDENTS AND THE SPONSORS, THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT WOULD BE LOOKING INTO THE POSSIBILITY OF EXPANDING THE SCHEME NEXT YEAR, MISS LAU INDICATED.

EACH YEAR, CIRCULARS AND INFORMATION ABOUT THE SCHEME ARE PASSED TO THE 245 MEMBER SCHOOLS OF THE ASSOCIATION OF CAREERS MASTERS FOR DISSEMINATION TO THE STUDENTS.

AFTER INTERVIEW BY A SELECTION PANEL, USUALLY HELD BEFORE THE BEGINNING OF THE VACATION, THE STUDENTS ARE ASSIGNED TO THE VARIOUS FIRMS AND ESTABLISHMENTS PARTICIPATING IN THE SCHEME, MISS LAU EXPLAINED.

THE ALLOCATIONS ARE MADE ACCORDING TO THEIR INTERESTS AND ABILITIES AND THEY WILL SPEND A PERIOD FROM SEVERAL WEEKS TO TWO MONTHS AT THE NEW WORK ENVIRONMENT, SHE SAID.

SHE ADDED THAT BESIDES PROMOTING THE SUMMER WORK EXPERIENCE SCHEME, THE CAREERS SECTION OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT IN CONJUNCTION WITH HONG KONG LAND CO., LTD. AND JOHN SWIRE AND SONS (H.K.) LTD. ALSO ARRANGES CAREERS GUIDANCE SEMINARS FOR SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS IN THE SUMMER.

SINCE 1974 A TOTAL OF 400 SECONDARY SCHOOL LEAVERS HAVE BENEFITED FROM THESE SEMINARS. CAREERS TALKS ARE ALSO ARRANGED AT FREQUENT INTERVALS FOR SENIOR STUDENTS OF SECONDARY SCHOOLS TO ACQUAINT THEM WITH THE OPPORTUNITIES AVAILABLE TO THEM AFTER FINISHING SCHOOL, SHE SAID.

ANTI-RABIES INOCULATION SERVICE FOR KOWLOON CITY AND WANG TAU HOM

THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT WILL PROVIDE ADDITIONAL DOG INOCULATION AND LICENSING SERVICE FOR RESIDENTS OF KOWLOON CITY AND WANG TAU HOM NEXT MONDAY AND TUESDAY (AUGUST 8 AND 9).

THIS WILL BE THE FOURTH DISTRICT ANTI-RABIES INOCULATION DRIVE TO BE CARRIED OUT IN KOWLOON.

DURING THE TWO-DAY OPERATION, THREE TEMPORARY DOG INOCULATION AND LICENSING CENTRES WILL BE SET UP AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

- * JUNCTION OF FUK CHEUNG STREET AND FU NING STREET
(AT SIDE OF CHRISTIAN ALLIANCE COLLEGE)=
- * JUNCTION OF HAU WONG ROAD AND CARPENTER ROAD
(AT SIDE OF LI KEE MEMORIAL DISPENSARY)=
- * JUNCTION ROAD AT SIDE OF LOK FU BUS TERMINUS
(NEAR HONG NIN BANK).

THESE CENTRES WILL BE OPEN FROM 9 A.M. TO 5 P.M. DAILY. DOG OWNERS LIVING IN THESE DISTRICTS ARE REQUESTED TO TAKE THE FIRST OPPORTUNITY TO GET THEIR PETS IMMUNISED AGAINST RABIES.
