### BUSY FIRST DAY FOR EXPO PAVILION

\* \* \*

AFTER EIGHT YEARS OF PLANNING AND CONSTRUCTION, THE 1986 WORLD EXPOSITION OPENED NEXT TO FALSE CREEK IN VANCOUVER, CANADA YESTERDAY (FRIDAY) AND THE HONG KONG PAVILION WAS ONE OF THE 90 PARTICIPANTS WHICH WELCOMED THE FIRST BATCH OF EXPO VISITORS.

SHORTLY BEFORE THE OPENING TIME AT 10 AM, PEOPLE ALREADY FLOCKED INTO THE SITE THROUGH THE FOUR MAIN ENTRANCES AND THEY STARTED TO SAMPLE THE EXHIBITS THROUGHOUT EXPO WHEN THE CLOCK STRUCK TEN.

AN AVERAGE OF 100 000 VISITORS IS EXPECTED A DAY THROUGHOUT THE 165 DAYS UNTIL EXPO CLOSES ON OCTOBER 13. ACCORDING TO EXPO OFFICIALS, A TOTAL OF 15 MILLION 'VISITS' HAVE ALREADY BEEN SOLD.

IT IS NOW EXPECTED THAT THE TOTAL VISITS TO BE SOLD WOULD BE MORE THAN 20 MILLIONS THROUGH THE SALES OUTLETS IN 39 COUNTRIES.

EXPO EMPLOYS MORE THAN 15 000 PEOPLE TO PROVIDE ENTERTAINMENT, RECREATIONAL AND ON-SITE CATERING FACILITIES AND TO MAN THE PAVILIONS. ANOTHER 15 000 ARE VOLUNTEER WORKERS.

THE FIRST DAY AT EXPO GAVE THEM A TASTE OF HOW BUSY AND ENJOYABLE IT WAS TO LOOK AFTER BATCHES AND BATCHES OF VISITORS.

AT THE HONG KONG PAVILION, THE SIGHT OF VISITORS QUEUEING UP TO GET A GLIMPSE OF LIFE IN HONG KONG SEEMED NEVER TO END.

THE OPENING DAY ALSO PROVED TO BE A BUSY DAY FOR THE COMMISSIONER OF THE HONG KONG PAVILION, MR PETER TSAO, WHO IS IN VANCOUVER TO SEE THAT THE HONG KONG SHOWPIECE IS UP AND RUNNING ACCORDING TO PLAN.

MR AND MRS TSAO ATTENDED THE OFFICIAL OPENING CEREMONY IN THE AFTERNOON AT THE BRITISH COLUMBIA PLACE STADIUM RIGHT NEXT TO THE EXPO SITE.

THE OPENING CEREMONY, OFFICIATED BY THE PRINCE AND PRINCESS OF WALES, WAS ATTENDED BY 60 000 PEOPLE, INCLUDING ALL COMMISSIONERS GENERAL OF THE PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES AND TERRITORIES AND VIP GUESTS.

EACH COUNTRY NOMINATED A REPRESENTATIVE TO CARRY ITS NATIONAL FLAG TO MARCH INTO THE STADIUM DURING THE CEREMONY AND A HONG KONG PAVILION HOSTESS, MISS PAT NG, REPRESENTED HONG KONG IN THE PROCESSION.

THE INVITATION TO ATTEND THE OPENING CEREMONY WAS EXTENDED TO THE PREMIER OF THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA, MR WILLIAM BENNETT, WHO PLAYS HOST TO THIS WORLD FAIR.

THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL OF CANADA, MADAM JEANNE SAUVE AND THE PRIME MINISTER OF CANADA, MR BRIAN MULRONEY, WERE ALSO PRESENT AT THE CEREMONY.

IN THE EVENING, AN OFF-SITE GALA OPENING OF THE EXPO WORLD FESTIVAL OF THE ARTS WAS STAGED IN THE DOWNTOWN ORPHEUM THEATRE.

THE PRINCE AND PRINCESS OF WALES PRESIDED AT THE OCCASION WHICH THE HONG KONG COMMISSIONER AND MRS TSAO ALSO ATTENDED.

MR AND MRS TSAO WILL BE AMONG THE AUDIENCE FOR THE FIRST ON-SITE GALA PERFORMANCE TO BE HELD TODAY AT THE EXPO THEATRE.

THROUGHOUT THE EXPO PERIOD, A TOTAL OF 43 000 FREE ENTERTAINMENT PROGRAMMES WILL BE PUT ON FOR THE ENJOYMENT OF VISITORS TO EXPO AND PEOPLE VISITING VANCOUVER.

THE GOVERNOR, SIR EDWARD YOUDE, WILL VISIT LONDON FROM MAY 13 TO 17. THIS VISIT WILL BE ANOTHER IN THE SERIES OF HIS REGULAR CONSULTATIONS WITH MINISTERS AND SENIOR OFFICIALS ON MATTERS OF CURRENT INTEREST.

MFA TALKS IN GENEVA END  
\* \* \* \*

THE MULTILATERAL DISCUSSION OF THE FUTURE OF THE MFA ENDED YESTERDAY (FRIDAY) AFTERNOON IN GENEVA.

COMMENTING ON THE TWO-DAY TALKS, THE DIRECTOR OF TRADE, MR HAMISH MACLEOD, SAID THAT A MAJORITY OF THE MAIN ELEMENTS OR ISSUES HAD NOW RECEIVED AT LEAST PRELIMINARY CONSIDERATION, ALTHOUGH AT THIS STAGE ACTUAL DRAFTING HAD NOT COMMENCED AND THE MAIN NEGOTIATING PHASE STILL LAY AHEAD.

FURTHER INFORMAL-FORMAL TALKS WOULD TAKE PLACE IN EARLY JUNE, AND AGAIN IN LATE JUNE, AND A MORE INTENSIVE FINAL PHASE WAS LIKELY TO OCCUPY MUCH OF JULY.

ANTI-RABIES INOCULATION STEPPED UP  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT WILL CONTINUE ITS ANTI-RABIES INOCULATION DRIVE THIS MONTH ON AN EXPANDED BASIS, A DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY (SATURDAY).

THE DEPARTMENT WAS STEPPING UP THE ACTIVITIES TO GIVE FULLER COVERAGE TO THE REMOTE PARTS OF THE NEW TERRITORIES, HE ADDED.

IN ADDITION TO MOBILE SERVICES TO INOCULATE DOGS IN RURAL VILLAGES ON A DISTRICT BASIS, INOCULATION TEAMS WOULD ALSO BE VISITING VARIOUS FISH CULTURE ZONES TO MAKE THEIR SERVICE AVAILABLE TO DOG OWNERS THERE.

+THE MOBILE TEAMS WILL VISIT TAI PO FROM MAY 5 TO 30; TUEN MUN FROM MAY 7 TO 31 AND SAI KUNG FROM MAY 13 TO 29,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

+DURING THE SAME PERIOD, THEY WILL ALSO CALL ON FISH RAFTS IN THE MARICULTURE ZONES OF SHA TAU KOK, AP CHAU, MA NAM WAT, TAI TAU CHAU, TIU CHAM WAN, YUNG SHUE AU, YIM TIN TSAI, CHEUNG SHA WAN AND TUNG CHUNG.+

TAI PO VILLAGES INCLUDE TAI WO TSUEN, YUEN LING LEE UK TSUEN, YUEN LING YIP UK TSUEN, KAU LUNG HANG, TAI HANG TSUEN, NAM WAH PO, MUI SHU HANG, SHUI WAI, WAI TAU TSUEN, KAU LIU HA, HANG HA PO, FONG MA PO, SAN UK TSAI, CHUNG UK TSUEN, TONG MIN TSUEN (TONG SHEUNG TSUEN) AND MA PO MEI.

/THE VILLAGES .....

THE VILLAGES IN TUEN MUN ARE NAI WAI, KWONG SHAN TSUEN, FU TEI, TUEN MUN SUN TSUEN, TAO YUEN WAI, TSENG TAU HA TSUEN, TSENG TAU CHUNG TSUEN, CHUNG WONG TOI, TUEN TSZ WAI, SUNG HING TSUEN, TSZ TIN TSUEN, PO TONG HA, SIU HANG TSUEN, KEI LUN WAI, SUN WAI TSAI, LEUNG TIN AND TSING SHAN KURK.

THE SAI KUNG VILLAGES ARE TSENG LAN SHUE, TAI PO TSAI, HANG HAU, SHUI PIN, SEUNG SZ WAN, SHEUNG YEUNG, HA YEUNG, MAU WU TSAI, MA YAU TONG, TSEUNG KWAN O, YAU YUE WAN AND PO TOI O.

THE SPOKESMAN URGED DOG OWNERS IN THESE VILLAGES AND FISH CULTURE ZONES TO USE THE MOBILE SERVICE TO HAVE THEIR DOGS INOCULATED AND LICENSED.

+THE DOGS AND CATS ORDINANCE REQUIRES EVERY DOG OVER FIVE-MONTH-OLD TO BE INOCULATED AND LICENSED. FAILURE TO DO SO WOULD RENDER THE OWNER LIABLE TO A MAXIMUM FINE OF \$5 000 AND SIX MONTHS' IMPRISONMENT,+ HE SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT ALTHOUGH THE GOVERNMENT HAD BEEN SUCCESSFUL IN CONTAINING THE THREAT OF RABIES OVER THE PAST FEW YEARS, IT WAS IMPORTANT TO MAINTAIN VIGILANCE TO PREVENT A RESURGENCE OF THE DEADLY DISEASE.

THE +KILOPAK+, AN ENVELOPE INTRODUCED FOR POSTING URGENT DOCUMENTS BY SPEEDPOST AT DISCOUNT RATE, WILL BE ON SALE AT \$5 EACH AT ALL SPEEDPOST ACCEPTANCE COUNTERS FROM MONDAY (MAY 5).

UNDER THE NEW ARRANGEMENT, SPEEDPOST DOCUMENTS IN +KILOPAKS+ WILL BE OFFERED A DISCOUNT OF \$10 TO THE POSTAGE RATE WHICH IS BASED ON THE ONE KILOGRAM SPEEDPOST RATE TO THE DESTINATION CONCERNED.

THERE WILL BE NO MAXIMUM WEIGHT LIMIT FOR THE DOCUMENTS POSTED IN THESE ENVELOPES.
