THE SECRETARY FOR TRADE AND INDUSTRY, MR JOHN CHAN, LEFT HONG KONG TODAY (WEDNESDAY) FOR A GOODWILL VISIT TO SINGAPORE.

DURING HIS THREE-DAY STAY IN SINGAPORE, HE WILL CALL ON THE MINISTER FOR TRADE AND INDUSTRY, BRIGADIER GENERAL LEE HSIEN LOONG, FOR AN EXCHANGE OF VIEWS ON MATTERS OF COMMON INTEREST.

OVERWHELMING RESPONSE TO CAREERS QUIZ

A RECORD NUMBER OF 124,500 SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS TOOK PART IN THE ANNUAL CAREERS QUIZ ORGANISED BY THE CAREERS ADVISORY SERVICE OF THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT IN OCTOBER.

THE PARTICIPANTS WERE FORM 3 TO FORM 5 STUDENTS FROM 252 SCHOOLS. LAST YEAR, 115,000 STUDENTS FROM 253 SCHOOLS TOOK PART.

THROUGH PARTICIPATION IN THE QUIZ, STUDENTS WERE ENCOURAGED TO PLAN CAREFULLY FOR THEIR FUTURE BY FINDING OUT MORE ABOUT CAREERS AND OPPORTUNITIES FOR FURTHER EDUCATION.

TO MARK THE SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE EVENT, A PRIZE PRESENTATION CEREMONY WILL BE HELD TOMORROW (THURSDAY) FOR THE WINNING SCHOOLS AND STUDENTS.

PRIZES WILL ALSO BE PRESENTED ON THE OCCASION TO WINNERS OF THE PHOTO COMPETITION HELD EARLIER THIS YEAR AS PART OF THE CAREERS '90 EXHIBITION.

TWO MORE AIDS CASES CONFIRMED

* * * * *

TWO MORE PERSONS IN HONG KONG WERE CONFIRMED TO BE SUFFERING FROM ACQUIRED IMMUNE DEFICIENCY SYNDROME (AIDS), THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH ANNOUNCED TODAY (WEDNESDAY).

THIS BRINGS TO 32 THE TOTAL NUMBER OF CONFIRMED AIDS CASES TO DATE. OF THESE PATIENTS, 17 HAVE PASSED AWAY WHILE THE OTHER 15 ARE RECEIVING COUNSELLING AND TREATMENT.

ONE OF THE TWO (BOTH MALE) WAS AN INTRAVENOUS DRUG ABUSER WHILE THE OTHER WAS A HAEMOPHILIAC.

RELEASING THE MONTHLY STATISTICS ON THE AIDS SURVEILLANCE PROGRAMME FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, A DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID TWO MORE PERSONS WERE FOUND TO BE POSITIVE FOR THE HIV ANTIBODY TEST.

THE FIGURE BRINGS TO 166 THE TOTAL NUMBER OF PERSONS WHO WERE INFECTED BY THE AIDS VIRUS.

OF THE 166 CARRIERS, 55 WERE HAEMOPHILIACS, ONE WAS AN INTRAVENOUS DRUG ABUSER, 18 WERE PERSONS WHO ATTENDED SOCIAL HYGIENE CLINICS, 53 WERE PATIENTS FROM GOVERNMENT HOSPITALS AND CLINICS AND 39 WERE REFERRALS FROM PRIVATE DOCTORS AND SUBVENTED ORGANISATIONS.

UNDER THE AIDS SURVEILLANCE PROGRAMME STARTED IN 1985, A TOTAL OF 145,594 BLOOD SPECIMENS HAVE BEEN TESTED FOR THE AIDS VIRUS.

MEANWHILE, THE HONG KONG RED CROSS BLOOD TRANSFUSION SERVICE HAS ALSO SCREENED ALL BLOOD DONORS FOR AIDS.

UP TO NOVEMBER, A TOTAL OF 646,051 UNITS OF BLOOD HAD BEEN TESTED AND 10 WERE FOUND TO BE POSITIVE.

1990 CRIME VICTIMISATION SURVEY TO BEGIN

* * * * *

ABOUT 20,000 RANDOMLY SELECTED HOUSEHOLDS WILL BE VISITED AND THE HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS INTERVIEWED BETWEEN JANUARY 8 AND 22 NEXT YEAR IN A SURVEY CONDUCTED BY THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE GOVERNMENT'S FIGHT CRIME COMMITTEE.

THE SURVEY IS THE CRIME VICTIMISATION SURVEY, WHICH WILL BE CONDUCTED FOR THE FOURTH TIME IN HONG KONG. THE MAIN PURPOSE OF THE SURVEY IS TO COLLECT UP-TO-DATE INFORMATION ABOUT CRIMES, OFFENDERS, AND VICTIMS AND THEIR ATTITUDES TOWARDS REPORTING CRIME. THE SURVEY WAS FIRST CONDUCTED IN 1979 AND THEN REPEATED IN 1982 AND 1987.

EACH HOUSEHOLD SELECTED FOR THE SURVEY WILL RECEIVE A LETTER NEXT WEEK NOTIFYING THEM OF THE SURVEY.

FROM JANUARY 8 TO 22, ENUMERATORS BEARING A GOVERNMENT IDENTITY CARD ISSUED BY THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT WILL VISIT THE SELECTED HOUSEHOLDS AND INTERVIEW ALL MEMBERS AGED 12 AND OVER IN THE HOUSEHOLD TO COLLECT DATA ON PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS AND ANY CRIMES WHICH AFFECTED THEM DURING 1989. HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS AGED 18 AND OVER WILL ALSO BE ASKED TO GIVE AN OPINION ON SOME ISSUES OF SENTENCING AND THE TRIAD RENUNCIATION SCHEME.

IN ADDITION, THE HEAD OF THE HOUSEHOLD WILL BE ASKED TO SUPPLY INFORMATION ON HOUSEHOLD CHARACTERISTICS AND ANY CRIMINAL ACTS WHICH AFFECTED THE HOUSEHOLD IN ANY WAY.

ALL INDIVIDUAL DATA COLLECTED IN THE SURVEY WILL BE TREATED IN STRICT CONFIDENCE AND WILL NOT BE RELEASED TO ANY PERSON OR ORGANISATION OUTSIDE THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT. ONLY AGGREGATE STATISTICS WILL BE PUBLISHED.

AS THE FINDINGS OF THE SURVEY ARE EXTREMELY USEFUL TO THE FIGHT CRIME COMMITTEE AND THE POLICE IN EVALUATING EXISTING CRIME PREVENTION AND ANTI-CRIME MEASURES AND IN DEVISING NEW ONES, THE COMMISSIONER FOR CENSUS AND STATISTICS APPEALS TO ALL SELECTED HOUSEHOLDS TO CO-OPERATE IN THE SURVEY.

TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS IN TSUEN WAN

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES THAT FROM 10 AM ON FRIDAY (DECEMBER 29), THE FOLLOWING ROAD SECTIONS WILL BE DESIGNATED URBAN CLEARWAYS FROM 7 AM TO 7 PM DAILY:

- * THE EASTBOUND CARRIAGEWAY OF THE SECTION OF YI PEI CHUN ROAD BETWEEN ITS JUNCTION WITH SHEK WAI KOK ROAD AND A POINT ABOUT 285 METRES WEST OF ITS JUNCTION WITH LO WAI ROAD.
- * THE WESTBOUND CARRIAGEWAY OF THE SECTION OF YI PEI CHUN ROAD BETWEEN ITS JUNCTION WITH SHEK WAI KOK ROAD AND A POINT ABOUT 230 METRES WEST OF ITS JUNCTION WITH LO WAI ROAD; AND
- * SHEK WAI KOK ROAD BETWEEN WAI TSUEN ROAD AND YI PEI CHUN ROAD.

ALSO, WO YI HOP INTERCHANGE WILL BE DESIGNATED A 24-HOUR URBAN CLEARWAY DAILY.

NO VEHICLES EXCEPT FRANCHISED BUSES WILL BE ALLOWED TO STOP FOR PASSENGERS OR GOODS THERE.

AT THE SAME TIME, THE SHEK WAI KOK BUS TERMINUS WILL BE DESIGNATED A BAN ZONE. ALL MOTOR VEHICLES, EXCEPT FRANCHISED BUSES AND THOSE WITH PERMITS ISSUED BY THE COMMISSIONER FOR TRANSPORT, WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM ENTERING THIS BUS TERMINUS 24 HOURS DAILY.

IN ADDITION, LO WAI ROAD AND THE SECTION OF CHEUNG SHAN ESTATE ROAD WEST BETWEEN SHING MUN ROAD AND CHEUNG PEI SHAN ROAD WILL BE DESIGNATED 24-HOUR DAILY PUBLIC LIGHT BUS BAN ZONES.

ALL PUBLIC LIGHT BUSES, EXCEPT THOSE WITH PERMITS ISSUED BY THE COMMISSIONER FOR TRANSPORT, WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM ENTERING THE BAN ZONE.

MEANWHILE, THE PUBLIC LIGHT BUS BAN ZONE ON THE SECTION OF SHEK WAI KOK ROAD BETWEEN SHEK ON STREET AND THE ACCESS ROAD LEADING TO SHEK TSUI HOUSE; AND THE BAN ZONE ON SHEK ON STREET BETWEEN SHEK KWAI STREET AND THE ACCESS ROAD TO THE ESTATE CARPARK WILL BE CANCELLED.

THE BAN ZONE FOR ALL VEHICLES OR COMBINATIONS OF VEHICLES EXCEEDING 10 METRES IN LENGTH AT SHEK WAI KOK WILL ALSO BE CANCELLED.

ON THE OTHER HAND, THE SECTION OF SHEK ON STREET BETWEEN ITS JUNCTIONS WITH SHEK WAI KOK ROAD AND SHEK KWAI STREET WILL BE DESIGNATED A PUBLIC LIGHT BUS BAN ZONE.

ALL PUBLIC LIGHT BUSES, EXCEPT THOSE WITH PERMITS ISSUED BY THE COMMISSIONER FOR TRANSPORT, WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM ENTERING THE AREA 24 HOURS DAILY.

TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS IN LOK MA CHAU

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES THAT FROM 9 AM ON FRIDAY (DECEMBER 29), THE EASTBOUND CARRIAGEWAY OF NEW TERRITORIES CIRCULAR ROAD FROM SHEK WU WAI TO CHAU TAU (NEAR PAK SHEK AU INTERCHANGE) WILL BE SUBJECT TO A SPEED LIMIT OF 80 KILOMETRES PER HOUR.

AT THE SAME TIME, THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS OF ROADS WILL BE DESIGNATED 24-HOUR URBAN CLEARWAYS :

- * THE EASTBOUND CARRIAGEWAY OF NEW TERRITORIES CIRCULAR ROAD FROM SHEK WU WAI TO CHAU TAU (NEAR PAK SHEK AU INTERCHANGE) INCLUDING ALL ITS SLIP ROADS;
- * ALL THE SLIP ROADS LEADING TO/FROM THE WESTBOUND CARRIAGEWAY OF THE SECTION OF NEW TERRITORIES CIRCULAR ROAD BETWEEN CHAU TAU (NEAR PAK SHEK AU INTERCHANGE) AND SHEK WU WAI; AND
- * THE SECTION OF SAN SHAM ROAD BETWEEN SAN TIN INTERCHANGE AND A POINT ABOUT 400 METRES NORTH OF THE SAME INTERCHANGE.

ON THE OTHER HAND, FROM 10 AM ON FRIDAY, THE WESTERN SIDE OF THE SOUTHBOUND CARRIAGEWAY OF THE SECTION OF KUK TING STREET FROM ITS JUNCTION WITH SAI TAI STREET TO A POINT APPROXIMATELY 80 METRES SOUTHWEST OF THE SAME JUNCTION WILL BE DESIGNATED AN URBAN CLEARWAY FROM 7 AM TO 10 AM AND FROM 4 PM TO 7 PM DAILY.

NO VEHICLES EXCEPT FRANCHISED BUSES WILL BE ALLOWED TO STOP FOR PASSENGERS OR GOODS THERE.

- * ALL THE SLIP ROADS LEADING TO/FROM THE WESTBOUND CARRIAGEWAY OF NEW TERRITORIES CIRCULAR ROAD SECTION BETWEEN CHAU TAU (NEAR PAK SHEK AU INTERCHANGE) AND SHEK WU WAI; AND
- * SAN SHAM ROAD SECTION BETWEEN SAN TIN INTERCHANGE AND A POINT ABOUT 400 METRES NORTH OF THE SAME INTERCHANGE.

ALL PUBLIC LIGHT BUSES, EXCEPT THOSE WITH PERMITS ISSUED BY THE COMMISSIONER FOR TRANSPORT, WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM ENTERING THE PROHIBITED ZONES 24 HOURS DAILY.

AT THE SAME TIME, THE SECTION OF NEW TERRITORIES CIRCULAR ROAD BETWEEN CHAU TAU (NEAR PAK SHEK AU INTERCHANGE) AND SHEK WU WAI, AND SAN SHAM ROAD WILL BE DESIGNATED A LEARNER DRIVERS BAN ZONE.

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCED THAT TO FACILITATE THE CONSTRUCTION OF ROUTE 5, THE FOLLOWING TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS IN SHEK WAI KOK AND CHEUNG SHAN IN THE NEW TERRITORIES WILL BE IMPLEMENTED FROM 10 AM ON FRIDAY (DECEMBER 29):

THE SECTION OF CHEUNG PEI SHAN ROAD BETWEEN TSUEN KAM INTERCHANGE AND CHEUNG SHAN ESTATE ROAD WEST WILL BE CLOSED.

THE SECTION OF SHEK WAI KOK ROAD BETWEEN WAI TSUEN ROAD AND YI PEI CHUN ROAD WILL BE FULLY REOPENED.

WO YI HOP INTERCHANGE WILL BE OPENED.

SHEK ON STREET WILL BE RE-ROUTED FROM ONE-WAY NORTHBOUND TO TWO-WAY.

SHEK KWAI STREET WILL BE RE-ROUTED FROM ONE-WAY WESTBOUND TO TWO-WAY.

TRAFFIC FROM TSUEN KAM INTERCHANGE HEADING FOR KWAI CHUNG WILL BE DIVERTED TO OPERATE VIA WAI TSUEN ROAD, SHEK WAI KOK ROAD, YI PEI CHUN ROAD, SAM TUNG UK ROAD, WO YI HOP INTERCHANGE, WO YI HOP ROAD INSTEAD OF CHEUNG PEI SHAN ROAD, CHEUNG SHAN ESTATE ROAD WEST, THE ACCESS ROAD TO CHEUNG SHAN ESTATE, AND WO YI HOP ROAD.

TRAFFIC FROM WO YI HOP ROAD HEADING FOR TSUEN WAN WILL BE DIVERTED TO OPERATE VIA WO YI HOP INTERCHANGE, SAM TUNG UK ROAD, YI PEI CHUN ROAD, SHEK WAI KOK ROAD, WAI TSUEN ROAD, AND TSUEN KAM INTERCHANGE INSTEAD OF THE ACCESS ROAD TO CHEUNG SHAN ESTATE, CHEUNG SHAN ESTATE ROAD WEST, CHEUNG PEI SHAN ROAD AND TSUEN KAM INTERCHANGE.

TRAFFIC FROM WO YI HOP ROAD HEADING FOR SHEK WAI KOK WILL BE DIVERTED TO OPERATE VIA WO YI HOP INTERCHANGE, SAM TUNG UK ROAD, YI PEI CHUN ROAD AND SHEK WAI KOK ROAD, INSTEAD OF THE ACCESS ROAD TO CHEUNG SHAN ESTATE ROAD WEST, CHEUNG PEI SHAN ROAD AND TSUEN KAM INTERCHANGE, WAI TSUEN ROAD AND SHEK WAI KOK ROAD.
