SUPPLEMENTARY PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICES
DURING LUNAR NEW YEAR HOLIDAYS

THE OPERATING HOURS OF PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICES WILL BE EXTENDED DURING THE LUNAR NEW YEAR HOLIDAYS AND IN SOME CASES SUPPLEMENTARY SERVICES WILL BE INTRODUCED.

THE HONGKONG AND YAUMATI FERRY COMPANY'S JUBILEE STREET TO KWUN TONG FERRY SERVICE AND THE SAI WAN HO TO KOWLOON CITY SERVICE WILL REMAIN OPERATIONAL ON FEBRUARY 18 AND 19.

SUPPLEMENTARY SERVICES WILL BE INTRODUCED ON THE HONG KONG TO TSUEN WAN FERRY SERVICE FROM FEBRUARY 18 TO 21.

THE TIMETABLE OF THE HONG KONG TO PO TOI EXCURSION FERRY SERVICE WILL BE REVISED ON FEBRUARY 18 TO OPERATE AT 9.25 A.M. AND 11.10 A.M. FROM HONG KONG AND 3.20 P.M. AND 4.40 P.M. FROM PO TOI.

THE EXCURSION SERVICES BETWEEN HONG KONG AND TUNG CHUNG, TSUEN WAN AND TUNG CHUNG AND MA LIU SHUI AND KAT O WILL NOT OPERATE ON FEBRUARY 18 AND 19 BUT WILL BE RESUMED ON FEBRUARY 20.

SIMILARLY, THE SPECIAL 8.15 A.M. SAILING ON SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS FROM KWUN TONG VIA JUBILEE STREET TO SILVERMINE BAY WILL BE SUSPENDED ON FEBRUARY 18 AND 19.

THE STAR FERRY WILL OPERATE ALL NIGHT SERVICES FROM MIDNIGHT TO 6 A.M. AT A 12-MINUTE FREQUENCY ON FEBRUARY 18.

BOTH KMB AND CMB WILL OPERATE SUPPLEMENTARY SERVICES ON FEBRUARY 15 AND 16 AND FROM FEBRUARY 18 TO 21. BUSES ON MOST ROUTES WILL RUN VERY LATE DURING THE LUNAR NEW YEAR HOLIDAYS.

HONG KONG TRAMWAYS WILL OPERATE ALL NIGHT SERVICES ON LUNAR NEW YEAR'S EVE ON ALL ITS ROUTES.

HK-BUILT YACHT TO COMPETE FOR ADMIRAL'S CUP
OCEAN RACING YACHT LAUNCHED BY MRS. BRAY

HONG KONG'S CHALLENGE FOR THE WORLD PREMIER OCEAN RACING EVENT, THE +ADMIRAL'S CUP+, MOVED A SIGNIFICANT STEP FORWARD TO-DAY WITH THE LAUNCHING OF THE YACHT +VANGUARD+.

MRS. BRAY, WIFE OF MR. DENIS BRAY, SECRETARY FOR HOME AFFAIRS, OFFICIATED AT THE LAUNCHING CEREMONY AT THE SUPERCRAFT YARD.

HONG KONG MADE ITS FIRST BID IN 1975 WITH A THREE YACHT TEAM WHICH DEFEATED ELEVEN OUT OF EIGHTEEN COMPETING COUNTRIES. IN 1977 A STRONG CHALLENGE IS BEING MOUNTED BY FOUR CONTENDERS WHO WILL COMPETE FOR PLACES IN THE TEAM OF THREE.

+VANGUARD+ IS THE ONLY ADMIRAL'S CUP YACHT BEING BUILT IN HONG KONG. DESIGNED BY ED DUBOIS THE BOAT IS 42 FT. LONG AND RATES AS A TWO TONNER. THE FIBRE GLASS HULL WAS SUPERVISED BY KEN RAYBOULD TO ENSURE THAT IT COMBINED THE LIGHTEST POSSIBLE CONSTRUCTION CONSISTENT WITH ADEQUATE STRENGTH.

HER CREW OF NINE WILL BE SKIPPED BY MR. BILL TURNBULL WHO WAS ONE OF HONG KONG'S 1975 ADMIRAL'S CUP SKIPPERS AND WHO WON THE SYDNEY HOBART RACE IN 1973. ALL ARE HONG KONG MEN EXCEPT JOHN OAKLEY OF MILLER AND WHITWORTH LTD. WHO WILL PROVIDE THE U.K. BACKUP FOR THE BOAT.

\$6.9 MILLION PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOL AT TUEN MUN

* * * * *

A \$6.9 MILLION PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOL IS TO BE BUILT AT TUEN MUN IN THE NEW TERRITORIES.

EIGHTY PER CENT OF THE COST WILL BE MET BY THE GOVERNMENT AND TWENTY PER CENT BY THE SPONSOR.

IT IS THE FIRST OF THREE NEW PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS SPONSORED BY THE MARDEN FOUNDATION AND TO BE MANAGED BY CARITAS - HONG KONG. WHEN COMPLETED, THE FULLY AIDED SCHOOL WILL BE THE NINTH TO OFFER THREE YEARS OF PREVOCATIONAL EDUCATION IN HONG KONG. IT WILL BE CALLED THE MARDEN FOUNDATION CARITAS PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOL - TUEN MUN.

THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE BUILDING IS SCHEDULED TO BE COMPLETED IN MID-1977 AND THE SCHOOL WILL ADMIT ITS FIRST BATCH OF 360 BOYS AND GIRLS NEXT SEPTEMBER.

ULTIMATELY THE WHOLE-DAY SCHOOL WILL HAVE AN ENROLMENT OF 1,080 PUPILS. THERE WILL BE 15 CLASSROOMS, A LIBRARY, A MULTI-PURPOSE HALL AND 19 SPECIAL ROOMS, LABORATORIES AND WORKSHOPS.

THE TECHNICAL SUBJECTS OFFERED ARE COMMERCIAL AND RETAIL STUDIES, DOMESTIC AND HOTEL SERVICE STUDIES, ELECTRICAL STUDIES, MECHANICAL STUDIES, TEXTILE AND TAILORING STUDIES AS WELL AS WOODWORK STUDIES SPREAD OVER THE THREE YEARS' COURSE.

THE SECRETARY FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES, MR. DAVID AKERS-JONES WILL UNVEIL A COMMEMORATIVE STONE ON WEDNESDAY TO MARK THE COMMENCEMENT OF WORK ON BUILDING THE NEW SCHOOL. THE ROMAN CATHOLIC BISHOP OF HONG KONG, THE MOST REV. JOHN B. WU, WILL BLESS THE STONE, THE SITE AND THE CONSTRUCTION WORK DURING THE CEREMONY.

DETAILS OF UNREGISTRABLE DOCTORS' EXAM. ANNOUNCED

THE LICENTIATE COMMITTEE OF THE MEDICAL COUNCIL OF HONG KONG TODAY ANNOUNCED THE DATES, CHARGES AND OTHER DETAILS OF THE LICENTIATE EXAMINATION FOR UNREGISTRABLE DOCTORS.

PART I OF THE EXAMINATION, THE MULTIPLE CHOICE QUESTION PAPER ON PROFESSIONAL KNOWLEDGE, WILL BE HELD ON MARCH 15 AND THE FEE FOR THIS PART WILL BE \$750.

PART II, THE WRITTEN ENGLISH PAPER, THE FEE FOR WHICH WILL BE \$250, WILL BE HELD ON APRIL 15.

PART III, THE ORAL EXAMINATION ON PROFESSIONAL KNOWLEDGE, WILL BE HELD IN JULY AND THE FEE WILL BE \$550.

CANDIDATES WILL BE REQUIRED TO PASS PART I BEFORE THEY WILL BE ALLOWED TO TAKE PART II AND TO PASS PART II BEFORE THEY WILL BE ALLOWED TO TAKE PART III.

ORDINARILY THEY WILL BE ALLOWED THREE ATTEMPTS AT EACH PART SUBJECT TO THE DISCRETION OF THE EXAMINATIONS SUB-COMMITTEE AND ANY CANDIDATE WHO FAILS TO PASS PART II OR PART III IN THREE SUCCESSIVE ATTEMPTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO RETAKE PART I.

SUBJECT TO REVIEW BY THE LICENTIATE COMMITTEE, THE LICENTIATE EXAMINATION WILL BE HELD ANNUALLY.

BY FEBRUARY 25, 1977 ALL ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES SHOULD HAVE RECEIVED DETAILS IN WRITING OF HOW, WHEN AND WHERE TO PAY THE EXAMINATION FEE FOR PART I AND WHEN AND WHERE TO GET THEIR EXAMINATION ADMISSION PASSES AND INSTRUCTIONS.

CAMBRIDGE UNIVERSITY ENGLISH EXAMINATIONS

THE FIRST CERTIFICATE IN ENGLISH EXAMINATION (F.C.E.) AND THE CERTIFICATE OF PROFICIENCY IN ENGLISH EXAMINATION (C.P.E.) OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CAMBRIDGE ARE SCHEDULED TO BE HELD BETWEEN JUNE 14 AND 16.

THESE EXAMINATIONS ARE OPEN ONLY TO CANDIDATES ABOVE THE AGE OF 16 AND WHOSE MOTHER TONGUE IS NOT ENGLISH.

ALL CANDIDATES MUST MAKE THEMSELVES AVAILABLE FOR ORAL/AURAL TESTS AT A TIME TO BE SPECIFIED ON ANY DAY WITHIN THE PERIOD MAY 30 TO JUNE 18.

ENTRY FORMS FOR PRIVATE CANDIDATES WILL BE AVAILABLE AT EXAMINATIONS DIVISION, EDUCATION DEPARTMENT, CANTON ROAD GOVERNMENT OFFICES, 393 CANTON ROAD, 11TH FLOOR, KOWLOON FROM FEBRUARY 28.

COMPLETED ENTRY FORMS, TOGETHER WITH PASSPORT OR HONG KONG IDENTITY CARD AND TWO RECENT PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE APPLICANT (SIZE 2-1/2" X 2") MUST BE PRESENTED IN PERSON AT THE ABOVE ADDRESS BETWEEN 9 A.M. AND 4 P.M. FROM FEBRUARY 28 TO MARCH 4. LACK OF IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTS, INCLUDING STANDARD PHOTOGRAPHS, WILL DISQUALIFY A CANDIDATE FROM REGISTERING.
