WIDE RANGE OF ACTIVITIES TO PROMOTE CIVIC EDUCATION  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE COMMITTEE ON THE PROMOTION OF CIVIC EDUCATION HAD EMBARKED ON A WIDE RANGE OF ACTIVITIES TOGETHER WITH GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND RESIDENTS BODIES TO PROMOTE A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF CIVIC EDUCATION AMONG RESIDENTS, THE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN, LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL MEMBER, MRS RITA FAN, SAID THIS (SATURDAY) EVENING.

SPEAKING AT A VARIETY SHOW TO MARK THE CLOSING OF THE KOWLOON CITY DISTRICT CIVIC EDUCATION CAMPAIGN, MRS FAN SAID THE COMMITTEE HAD SET ASIDE \$250 000 IN 1986-87 TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO COMMUNITY ORGANISATIONS IN ORGANISING CIVIC EDUCATION ACTIVITIES.

+AT THE SAME TIME, THE COMMITTEE WILL ALSO REVIEW REGULARLY THE OBJECTIVES AND SCOPE OF CIVIC EDUCATION TO MEET THE RAPID CHANGES OF OUR SOCIETY,+ SHE SAID.

+IN ADDITION, THE COMMITTEE IS COLLECTING REFERENCE MATERIALS IN PREPARING AN INFORMATION KIT ON A CIVIC EDUCATION RESOURCE INDEX.

+THE PROMOTION OF CIVIC EDUCATION IS ONE OF THE MOST PRESSING TASKS FOR HONG KONG AS THE COMMUNITY IS FACING AN IMPENDING REFORM ON ITS POLITICAL STRUCTURES.

+IN ORDER TO BUILD A STABLE AND PROSPEROUS SOCIETY, THE PUBLIC SHOULD BE MORE EDUCATED AND INVOLVED IN THESE RESPECTS,+ SHE SAID.

THE COMMITTEE ON THE PROMOTION OF CIVIC EDUCATION WAS FORMED BY THE GOVERNMENT LAST YEAR. ITS MEMBERS COMPRISE COMMUNITY LEADERS AND REPRESENTATIVES FROM VARIOUS GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS.

MRS FAN SAID SHE WAS PLEASED THAT THE KOWLOON CITY DISTRICT HAD TAKEN THE LEAD IN LAUNCHING A YEAR-LONG CIVIC EDUCATION CAMPAIGN IN 1986-87 AND THAT THE CAMPAIGN WOULD CONTINUE NEXT YEAR.

TONIGHT'S VARIETY SHOW FEATURED PERFORMANCES BY POPULAR SINGERS, THE KOWLOON CITY DISTRICT CHILDREN'S CHORUS AND THE KOWLOON CITY DISTRICT DANCE GROUP AS WELL AS A DRAMA BY THE HO MAN TIN SOUTH AREA COMMITTEE.

THE SHOW, SPONSORED BY THE KOWLOON CITY DISTRICT BOARD, WAS JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE KOWLOON CITY DISTRICT CIVIC EDUCATION CAMPAIGN ORGANISING COMMITTEE AND THE DISTRICT OFFICE.

MORE SERVICES FOR STREET SLEEPERS PLANNED

\* \* \* \* \*

REGIONAL OUTREACHING TEAMS WILL BE SET UP BY THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT TO AUGMENT EXISTING SERVICES FOR STREET SLEEPERS.

THIS WAS DISCLOSED BY THE DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE, MRS ANSON CHAN, AFTER VISITING THE HOME OF LOVE OPERATED BY THE MISSIONARIES OF CHARITY FOR STREET SLEEPERS IN THE EX-SHAM SHUI PO ARMY CAMP TODAY (SATURDAY).

DURING THE VISIT, SHE HANDED OVER TO THE SUPERVISOR, SISTER VICTORIA, THE KEYS FOR ADDITIONAL ACCOMMODATION TO BOOST THE HOME'S CAPACITY FROM 40 TO 60.

MRS CHAN SAID THAT A NUMBER OF MEASURES WOULD BE INTRODUCED TO STEP UP SERVICES FOR STREET SLEEPERS TO MARK THE OCCASION OF THE INTERNATIONAL YEAR OF SHELTER FOR THE HOMELESS.

+WE BELIEVE THAT COMMUNITY EFFORTS IN THE DISTRICTS SHOULD BE ENCOURAGED, SO WE WILL BE INVOLVING VOLUNTEERS IN OUR REGIONAL OUTREACH TEAMS,+ SHE SAID.

FOUR TEAMS WILL BE ORGANISED TO COVER HONG KONG ISLAND, EAST KOWLOON, WEST KOWLOON AND THE NEW TERRITORIES.

THEY WILL CONTACT STREET SLEEPERS, DELIVER RELIEF ARTICLES AND BLANKETS TO THEM AND ESCORT THEM IF REQUIRED FOR APPLICATION OF IDENTITY CARDS, MEDICAL SERVICES AND ANY OTHER WELFARE SERVICES.

+OUR FAMILY SERVICES CENTRES ARE IN FACT RENDERING THESE SERVICES BUT IT IS HOPED THAT WITH THE SETTING UP OF SPECIAL TEAMS, GREATER EFFORTS CAN BE DEVOTED TO PERSUADING THESE PEOPLE TO LEAVE THE STREETS AND ACCEPT OUR SERVICES,+ MRS CHAN SAID.

ANOTHER PLAN TO MOBILISE COMMUNITY EFFORTS WOULD BE TO DEDICATE THIS YEAR'S OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUTH SCHEME TO HELPING THE HOMELESS, SHE ADDED.

THE SCHEME IS OPERATED BY THE DEPARTMENT TO SUBSIDISE YOUTH GROUPS IN CARRYING OUT INNOVATIVE COMMUNITY SERVICES PROJECTS WHICH ARE CONDUCTIVE TO THEIR PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT AS WELL AS BENEFITS TO THE COMMUNITY.

AS FOR STREET SLEEPERS SUSPECTED TO BE MENTALLY ILL, SHE NOTED THAT THE GREATEST DIFFICULTY WAS IN COMMUNICATING WITH THEM AND SUSTAINED AND FRIENDLY PERSUASION WAS NEEDED TO GET THEM TO ACCEPT ASSISTANCE.

+WE ARE PLANNING A NEW FACILITY CALLED DAY RELIEF CENTRE CUM TEMPORARY SHELTER FOR THIS SPECIAL TARGET GROUP,+ SHE SAID.

THE DAY RELIEF CENTRE WILL PROVIDE OUTREACHING SERVICE, INCLUDING FOOD DELIVERY AND COUNSELLING; PERSONAL CARE SERVICE SUCH AS BATHING, HAIR-CUTTING, FREE CLOTHING AND ESCORTING SERVICE FOR APPLICATION FOR IDENTITY CARDS, MEDICAL TREATMENT OR OTHER REHABILITATIVE SERVICES AS ADVISED BY MEDICAL DOCTORS OR MEDICAL SOCIAL WORKERS.

CENTRE STAFF WILL ALSO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LIAISING WITH GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS SUCH AS HOSPITALS, CLINICS OR VOLUNTARY AGENCIES TO WORK OUT LONG-TERM WELFARE PLANS FOR CLIENTS WHO WILL BE PROVIDED WITH TRANSIT ACCOMMODATION IN THE TEMPORARY SHELTER.

MRS CHAN SAID THAT THIS PROJECT WOULD BE RUN BY A VOLUNTARY AGENCY, WITH THE SUPPORT OF THE DEPARTMENT.

+SUBJECT TO EVALUATION, THIS MAY BECOME A LONG-TERM PROVISION,+ SHE SAID.

MEANWHILE, THE DEPARTMENT IS ALSO LIAISING WITH VOLUNTARY AGENCIES TO DISCUSS HOW THEIR EXISTING FACILITIES FOR STREET SLEEPERS CAN BE PUT TO BETTER USE.

+IN ADDITION, A STEERING GROUP WILL BE ESTABLISHED WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT TO CO-ORDINATE PROGRAMMES IN THIS AREA, TO MONITOR PROGRESS AND TO LIAISE WITH OTHER DEPARTMENTS AND VOLUNTARY AGENCIES.

+HOWEVER, SOME CO-ORDINATION AT THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT LEVEL IS CLEARLY DESIRABLE SINCE THE PROBLEMS FACING STREET SLEEPERS CALL FOR THE COMBINED EFFORTS OF A NUMBER OF GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS,+ MRS CHAN SAID.

36 NAMED GOOD CITIZENS IN MONG KOK

THIRTY-SIX MONG KOK RESIDENTS WHO HAVE DEMONSTRATED OUTSTANDING BRAVERY AND INITIATIVE IN COMBATING CRIMES RECEIVED THE 1986 GOOD CITIZEN AWARDS TODAY (SATURDAY).

NOTING THAT THE FIGURE WAS MORE THAN DOUBLE THAT OF THE PREVIOUS YEAR, THE CHAIRMAN OF THE DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME COMMITTEE, MR CHAN LAI-SANG, SAID THAT IT SHOWED THAT MONG KOK PEOPLE HAD BECOME MORE READY AND DETERMINED TO WIPE OUT CRIMINAL ACTIVITIES.

OFFICIATING AT THE AWARD PRESENTATION CEREMONY, HE PRAISED RECIPIENTS FOR THEIR CIVIC-MINDEDNESS IN REPORTING AND DETECTING CRIMES, AS WELL AS IN ASSISTING THE POLICE TO APPREHEND CRIMINALS.

+THEY HAVE ALSO CO-OPERATED WITH THE POLICE IN SUBSEQUENT INVESTIGATIONS, IDENTIFICATION PARADES AND TESTIFYING IN COURT TO BRING THE CULPRITS TO JUSTICE,+ HE SAID.

THE RECIPIENTS, 31 MEN AND FIVE WOMEN AGED BETWEEN 13 AND 70, HELPED THE POLICE IN CASES INCLUDING BURGLARY, ROBBERY, THEFT AND INDECENT ASSAULT.

A 70-YEAR-OLD RESIDENT, MR LAW SIN-CHEUNG, WHO IS ALSO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE MONG KOK NORTH AREA COMMITTEE, WAS AMONG THE RECIPIENTS.

IMPORTANCE OF CO-ORDINATION IN SPORTS DEVELOPMENT

THE NEED FOR CO-ORDINATION IN THE PROMOTION AND DEVELOPMENT OF SPORTS WAS STRESSED AT A SEMINAR FOR SPORTS LEADERS HELD AT THE FORMER LEGCO CHAMBER TODAY (SATURDAY).

REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE GOVERNMENT, THE URBAN COUNCIL (UC), THE REGIONAL COUNCIL (RC) AND THE JUBILEE SPORTS CENTRE (JSC) ALL MADE GOOD USE OF THE OPPORTUNITY TO TALK ABOUT THEIR WORK IN SPORTS AND RECREATION.

IT WAS NOTED THAT THE LAST SEMINAR WAS HELD IN OCTOBER 1980.

TALKS WERE GIVEN BY THE SECRETARY FOR MUNICIPAL SERVICES; MR A.K. CHUI, CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNCIL FOR RECREATION AND SPORT (CRS); MR F.K. HU, MR SAMUEL WONG REPRESENTING THE URBAN COUNCIL; MR LAM KIN-MING REPRESENTING THE REGIONAL COUNCIL; AND THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OF THE JUBILEE SPORTS CENTRE, MR HOWARD WELLS.

THE CHAIRMAN OF THE JUBILEE SPORTS CENTRE BOARD, MR DENIS BRAY, WAS ALSO PRESENT.

IN POINTING OUT THAT THE GOVERNING SPORTS BODIES PLAYED AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN SPORTS DEVELOPMENT, MR HU, WHO INITIATED THE SEMINAR, SAID IN THIS MAJOR ENTERPRISE, THE EFFORTS OF THE GOVERNING BODIES, THE JSC, THE UC AND RC, AND THE CRS MUST BE PROPERLY CO-ORDINATED.

+IT IS NECESSARY TO ENSURE THAT OUR EFFORTS ARE NOT DUPLICATED. INSTEAD, IT SHOULD BE ORGANISED IN SUCH A WAY THAT THEY COMPLEMENT EACH OTHER IN THE PURSUIT OF THE COMMON OBJECTIVE TO PROMOTE SPORT, RECREATION AND THE UTILISATION OF FACILITIES, SO THAT RESOURCES ARE MADE USE OF IN THE MOST EFFICIENT MANNER. THIS IS THE MESSAGE OF THE SEMINAR,+ HE SAID.

MR HU ALSO SPOKE ABOUT THE WORK OF THE CRS, THE DEMARCATION OF RESPONSIBILITY IN FUNDING SPORT BETWEEN THE CRS, THE UC AND THE RC= THE CRS'S SPORTS DEVELOPMENT AND ADMINISTRATION SCHEME AND THE STRATEGY IN THE PROMOTION OF SPORT IN HONG KONG.

APART FROM THE SEVEN STANDING COMMITTEES OF THE COUNCIL, MR HU SAID THERE WAS A WORKING PARTY ON SPORTS IN EDUCATION.

+WE ALL REALISE THAT HONG KONG IS A PLACE WHERE COMPETITION IS KEEN ON ALL FRONTS AND THERE IS EVERY URGE FOR STUDENTS TO ACHIEVE ACADEMIC SUCCESS, VERY OFTEN AT THE EXPENSES OF SPORT AND RELAXATION,+ HE SAID.

MR HU EXPLAINED THAT THE PURPOSE OF THE WORKING PARTY WAS TO EXAMINE WHETHER THERE WERE WAYS AND MEANS IN WHICH SPORT MIGHT BE INTEGRATED IN THE EDUCATION SYSTEM AND BE GIVEN PROPER RECOGNITION.

HE SAID THE WORKING PARTY HOPED TO COMPLETE ITS STUDY SOME TIME THIS YEAR.

THE SECRETARY FOR MUNICIPAL SERVICES, MR AUGUSTINE CHUI, WHO OPENED THE SEMINAR, TOLD THE DELEGATES THAT SINCE 1985 A NUMBER OF CHANGES HAD TAKEN PLACE.

WITHIN THE STRUCTURE OF THE GOVERNMENT, HE SAID, THE FORMER RECREATION AND CULTURE DEPARTMENT WAS DISSOLVED IN APRIL 1985 AND THE MUNICIPAL SERVICES BRANCH WAS FORMED TO ASSUME POLICY FUNCTIONS.

+RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE ORGANISATION AND FUNDING OF RECREATION AND SPORT ACTIVITIES AT DISTRICT LEVELS HAVE BEEN TRANSFERRED TO THE URBAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT AND THE REGIONAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT. THESE ORGANISATIONAL CHANGES HAVE HIGHLIGHTED THE NEED TO UNDERSTAND THE DIFFERENT ROLES UNDERTAKEN BY THE DIFFERENT BODIES SO AS TO ACHIEVE A CO-ORDINATED APPROACH,+ MR CHUI SAID.

+FOR MANY YEARS, BOTH THE CRS AND UC HAVE CONTRIBUTED SIGNIFICANTLY TO SPORTS DEVELOPMENT. THE FORMATION OF THE REGIONAL COUNCIL IN 1986 HAS ADDED TREMENDOUS IMPETUS TO SPORT,+ HE SAID.

+WITH THE IMPENDING DIVESTMENT OF JUBILEE SPORTS CENTRE, WHICH HAS BEEN GIVEN A JOCKEY CLUB ENDOWMENT OF \$350 MILLION, WE CAN EXPECT TO SEE GREAT ADVANCES MADE IN THE NOT TOO FAR OFF FUTURE. HOWEVER, THESE DIVERSE RESOURCES NEED TO BE CLOSELY CO-ORDINATED.

+IT IS THE AIM OF THIS SEMINAR, THEREFORE, TO EVALUATE THE CURRENT FUNDING ARRANGEMENTS AND DEMARCATION OF RESPONSIBILITIES AND TO CONSIDER HOW WE CAN BEST CO-ORDINATE AND IMPROVE THE UTILISATION OF THESE RESOURCES TO ENSURE AN ILLUSTRIOUS FUTURE FOR SPORT IN HONG KONG.+

FACILITIES AND THE LIVING ENVIRONMENT IN KWUN TONG WILL BE FURTHER IMPROVED FOLLOWING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A NUMBER OF WORKS PROJECTS AND MORE SYSTEMATIC TOWN PLANNING, THE KWUN TONG DISTRICT OFFICER, MR EDDY CHAN, SAID TODAY (SATURDAY).

SPEAKING AT THE OPENING CEREMONY OF THE +NEW DEVELOPMENTS IN KWUN TONG+ EXHIBITION, MR CHAN GAVE A BRIEF OUTLINE OF MAJOR WORKS PROJECTS TO BE CARRIED OUT IN THE DISTRICT.
