TENDERS INVITED TO BUILD NEW POLICE HEADQUARTERS

\* \* \* \* \*

A NEW POLICE HEADQUARTERS COMPLEX IS TO BE BUILT ON THE SITE OF THE FORMER JUNIOR POLICE MARRIED QUARTERS BUILDING IN WAN CHAI.

THE COMPLEX, WHICH WILL RELIEVE A SHORTAGE OF SPACE IN THE EXISTING HEADQUARTERS BUILDING IN ARSENAL STREET, WILL BE CONSTRUCTED ON A SITE AREA OF 6 600 SQUARE METRES.

IT WILL CONSIST OF A ONE-LEVEL BASEMENT AND A SEVEN-STOREY PODIUM WITH TOWER BLOCKS ON TOP.

CONSTRUCTION WILL BE CARRIED OUT IN PHASES, WITH PRIORITY BEING GIVEN IN THE FIRST PHASE TO FACILITIES WHICH ARE MOST URGENTLY NEEDED TO MEET OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS.

THESE INCLUDE POLMIL HEADQUARTERS, HONG KONG ISLAND REGIONAL COMMAND AND CONTROL CENTRE AND THE ASSOCIATED COMPUTER SUITE, WORKSHOPS AND STORES OF THE COMMUNICATIONS BRANCH, VEHICLE SERVICING FACILITIES, VEHICLE PARKING SPACES, FITNESS TRAINING FACILITIES AND FIRING RANGES.

CONSTRUCTION OF PHASE I, WHICH INCLUDES THE BASEMENT AND PODIUM, IS DUE FOR COMPLETION IN EARLY 1989.

DEMOLITION OF THE POLICE QUARTERS HAS BEEN COMPLETED. PILING WORK STARTED ON THE SITE IN MARCH AND WILL BE COMPLETED IN OCTOBER.

WHEN THE BUILDING IS COMPLETED IT WILL HAVE A GROSS FLOOR AREA OF 34 900 SQUARE METRES.

TENDERS ARE BEING INVITED FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE BASEMENT, AS WELL AS FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF DIAPHRAGM WALLING AND ASSOCIATED WORKS.

THIS WORK WILL START IN DECEMBER AND TAKE SEVEN MONTHS.

DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING TENDERS IS NOON ON OCTOBER 17.

CONSTRUCTION OF THE PODIUM WILL START UNDER A SEPARATE CONTRACT ONCE THE BASEMENT HAS BEEN COMPLETED.

+AMONG THE MORE POPULAR SUBJECTS DEALT WITH WERE ENQUIRIES ABOUT TELEPHONE NUMBERS, LOCATIONS AND OPENING HOURS OF GOVERNMENT OFFICES; JOB VACANCIES IN THE CIVIL SERVICE; REQUEST FOR POSTERS, PAMPHLETS AND FORMS ISSUED BY GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS; AND SOCIAL FUNCTIONS AT THE DISTRICT LEVEL,+ A CNTA SPOKESMAN SAID.

+THE FREE LEGAL ADVICE SCHEME JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE LAW SOCIETY AND CNTA WAS ALSO WELL UTILISED WITH NEARLY 1 500 CASES REFERRED TO THE HONG KONG LAW SOCIETY,+ HE ADDED.

+DURING THE FIRST SIX MONTHS MORE THAN 5 600 PEOPLE CONSULTED THE RENT OFFICERS OF THE RATING AND VALUATION DEPARTMENT STATIONED IN THE 12 DISTRICT OFFICES FOR ADVICE ON RENT AND TENANCY PROBLEMS,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

HONG KONG'S UNIQUE EXERCISE IN COMMUNICATIONS AT EXPO '86, +OPERATION PEN-FRIEND+, WILL OFFICIALLY CLOSE ON AUGUST 31.

BY THEN MORE THAN 420 000 POSTCARDS BEARING PERSONALISED MESSAGES, EITHER IN ART OR WRITTEN FORM, WILL HAVE BEEN SENT TO THE HONG KONG PAVILION FOR DISTRIBUTION TO VISITORS. THIS NUMBER WILL BE SUFFICIENT TO LAST UNTIL EXPO '86 CLOSES ON OCTOBER 13.

THE PROJECT BEGAN WITH A COMPETITION IN MARCH IN WHICH ABOUT 470 SCHOOLS TOOK PART. TOGETHER, THE SCHOOLS SENT IN ALMOST 300 000 HAND-DRAWN POSTCARDS.

SUPPORT HAS ALSO COME FROM THE COMMUNITY CONTRIBUTING ABOUT 120 000 CARDS THROUGH COLLECTION POINTS AT BEACONSFIELD HOUSE AND THE GOVERNMENT PUBLICATIONS CENTRE.

THE ARTISTIC QUALITY OF MANY OF THE POSTCARDS HAS BEEN OF SUCH HIGH STANDARD THAT A SELECTION WAS PUT ON DISPLAY FOR FOUR DAYS IN MAY AT THE LANDMARK.

USD ALL-OUT EFFORTS TO KEEP BEACHES CLEAN

THE URBAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT IS TAKING VARIOUS MEASURES, INCLUDING THE USE OF MECHANICAL DEVICES, TO KEEP THE 12 GAZETTED BEACHES ON HONG KONG ISLAND CLEAN AND TIDY.

+DURING THE FIRST HALF OF THIS YEAR, 4.7 MILLION PEOPLE VISITED THE 12 BEACHES, LEAVING BEHIND A TOTAL OF 4 208 TONNES OF REFUSE,+ SAID A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT TODAY.

+IN JULY ALONE, SOME 1.8 MILLION PEOPLE VISITED THE BEACHES AND ABOUT 1 254 TONNES OF REFUSE WERE COLLECTED.+

THE SPOKESMAN POINTED OUT THAT ABOUT 90 USD STAFF HAD TO WORK DAILY TO CLEAN UP THE LARGE AMOUNT OF RUBBISH ON THE BEACHES.

+THE CLEANSING WORK HAS TO BE DONE AT DAWN AND AFTER SUNSET TO AVOID INCONVENIENCE CAUSED TO SWIMMERS,+ HE SAID.

+AS FAR AS POSSIBLE, MECHANICAL DEVICES ARE USED FOR THE CLEAN-UP SO AS TO INCREASE EFFICIENCY. IN PLACES THAT CANNOT BE REACHED BY MACHINES, OUR CLEANSING TEAM HAS TO PICK UP RUBBISH MANUALLY.+

THE SPOKESMAN SAID REFUSE IN THE SEA WAS PICKED UP BY EIGHT MECHANICAL BOATS, +SEA CATS+, WHILE RUBBISH ON THE BEACH WAS REMOVED BY SEVEN MOTORISED HANDCARTS, +HILLY BILLIES+, AND A FARM TRUCK.

+TWO MODERN BEACH CLEANSING VEHICLES WHICH CAN SWEEP UP A LARGE AMOUNT OF RUBBISH AT ONE TIME ARE STATIONED AT POPULAR BEACHES SUCH AS REPULSE BAY AND SHEK O,+ HE SAID.

+REFUSE BOOMS ARE ALSO INSTALLED AT REPULSE BAY AND DEEP WATER BAY TO PREVENT RUBBISH FROM BEING CARRIED ON TO THE SWIMMING AREAS FROM OUTSIDE WATERS.

FIGHT CRIME CAMPAIGN FOR SAI KUNG DISTRICT

A SERIES OF ACTIVITIES HAS BEEN PLANNED FOR THE 1986-87 SAI KUNG DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME CAMPAIGN AIMED AT AROUSING PEOPLE'S CONCERN TO PREVENT CRIME IN THE DISTRICT.

THE ACTIVITIES, ORGANISED BY A WORKING GROUP UNDER THE SAI KUNG DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME COMMITTEE FOR ALL RESIDENTS, SCHOOL TEACHERS AND STUDENTS IN SAI KUNG ARE ALSO AIMED AT ENHANCING A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF CRIME PREVENTION AND ENCOURAGING PEOPLE TO MAINTAIN CLOSER CO-OPERATION WITH THE POLICE.

THE THEME FOR THIS YEAR'S CAMPAIGN WILL BE +HOME SECURITY+ AND +NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH+. A FORMER MISS HONG KONG, MISS ANGLIE LEUNG, WILL BE THE STANDARD BEARER OF THE SAI KUNG DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME CAMPAIGN.

THE FIRST PROGRAMME TO MARK THE CAMPAIGN WILL BE A VISIT TO THE TSO WO HANG MARINE EAST HEADQUARTERS ON AUGUST 28, TO BE FOLLOWED BY ANOTHER VISIT TO THE POLICE CADET TRAINING SCHOOL IN FANLING AND A HOME SECURITY DAY FOR LOCAL RESIDENTS IN SEPTEMBER.

THE HIGHLIGHT OF THE CAMPAIGN WILL BE A CRIME PREVENTION VARIETY SHOW AND PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY TO BE HELD AT THE SAI KUNG TOWN HALL AT THE END OF THE YEAR.

OTHER ACTIVITIES INCLUDE SEMINARS ON CRIME PREVENTION AS WELL AS SPEECH COMPETITIONS FOR PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS.

PUBLICITY BOOKLETS AND CALENDARS CONTAINING CRIME PREVENTION MESSAGES AND THE CONTACT NUMBER OF THE SAI KUNG DIVISIONAL POLICE STATION WILL BE PRINTED AND DISTRIBUTED TO RESIDENTS OVER THE NEXT FEW COMING MONTHS.

THE ESTIMATED COST FOR THIS YEAR'S DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME ACTIVITIES IS ABOUT \$60 000, SPONSORED BY THE SAI KUNG DISTRICT OFFICE AND THE DISTRICT BOARD.

THE MUSIC OFFICE WILL PRESENT A COMBINED CONCERT BY THE RENOWNED WASHINGTON D.C. YOUTH ORCHESTRA AND THE HONG KONG YOUTH SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA ON AUGUST 30 (SATURDAY) AT THE QUEEN ELIZABETH STADIUM.

THE AUDIENCE WILL BE TREATED TO A SUPERB PROGRAMME UNDER THE BATONS OF THREE CONDUCTORS. THEY ARE THE ASSISTANT MUSIC ADMINISTRATOR (PROFESSIONAL) OF THE MUSIC OFFICE, MR THOMAS WANG, AND THE CONDUCTOR AND ASSISTANT CONDUCTOR OF THE D.C. YOUTH ORCHESTRA, MR LYN MCLAIN AND MR ALFONSO POLLARD.

AS AN ADDED ATTRACTION, MRS SALLY MCLAIN, A DISTINGUISHED VIOLINIST AND A MEMBER OF THE KENNEDY CENTRE OPERA HOUSE ORCHESTRA, AND MR WILLIAM HAWTHORNE, PRINCIPAL BASS OF THE U.S. AIR FORCE SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA, WILL BE SOLOISTS.

THE HIGHLIGHT OF THE CONCERT, WHICH BEGINS AT 8 PM, WILL BE TCHAIKOVSKY'S 1812 OVERTURE, OP. 49 PLAYED JOINTLY BY THE TWO ORCHESTRAS.

PARTIAL CLOSURE OF PROMENADE FOR CABLE WORKS

THE GOVERNMENT IS PROPOSING TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE PART OF THE SEAVIEW PROMENADE AND THE LAND BETWEEN DEEP WATER BAY AND REPULSE BAY.

THIS IS TO ENABLE HONG KONG ELECTRIC COMPANY LIMITED TO LAY 132 KILO-VOLT ELECTRICITY TRANSMISSION CABLES LINKING WONG CHUK HANG ZONE STATION WITH THE PROPOSED CHUNG HOM KOK ZONE STATION.

THE NEW CABLE CIRCUIT IS NECESSARY TO MEET THE INCREASING DEMAND FOR ELECTRICITY AND TO MAINTAIN ADEQUATE POWER SUPPLY TO THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT OF HONG KONG ISLAND.

THE PROPOSED CLOSURE WILL REDUCE THE WIDTH OF THE PROMENADE TO A MINIMUM OF ONE METRE.
