FIGHT CRIME COMMITTEE COMMENDED

YUEN LONG DISTRICT BOARD CHAIRMAN, MR TAI KUEN, TODAY (SATURDAY) COMMENDED THE DISTRICT'S FIGHT CRIME COMMITTEE FOR ITS CONTINUOUS EFFORTS IN PROMOTING CRIME PREVENTION IN THE DISTRICT FOR THE PAST 12 YEARS.

SPEAKING AT THE CEREMONY TO LAUNCH THE DISTRICT'S FIGHT CRIME CAMPAIGN, MR TAI SAID THE COMMITTEE'S EFFORTS HAD RESULTED IN A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF CRIME PREVENTION AMONG RESIDENTS.

+IT HAD ALSO UNDERLINED THE IMPORTANCE OF MUTUAL CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE PUBLIC AND THE POLICE,+ HE SAID.

THE CHAIRMAN OF THE DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME COMMITTEE, MR LEUNG SHUI-FAT, SAID THE COMMITTEE AND THE POLICE WILL BE SELECTING A NUMBER OF RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS TO IMPLEMENT A NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH SCHEME.

THE FIGHT CRIME CAMPAIGN WAS LAUNCHED TODAY WITH A POP CONCERT FOR ABOUT 900 RESIDENTS.

APPROVAL GIVEN TO BUY AMBULANCE MOTORCYCLES

THE AMBULANCE SERVICE REVIEW STEERING GROUP HAS GIVEN APPROVAL FOR THE PURCHASE OF SEVEN AMBULANCE AID MOTORCYCLES FOR THE FIRE SERVICES DEPARTMENT'S AMBULANCE COMMAND.

THEY WILL BE USED TO SUPPORT THE EXISTING FLEET OF AMBULANCES IN AREAS WHERE ACCESS IS HAMPERED BY TRAFFIC CONGESTION OR OTHER CAUSES.

THE MOTORCYCLES WILL BE EQUIPPED WITH RADIO AND LIFE SUPPORT EQUIPMENT TO PROVIDE STABILISING TREATMENT TO INJURED PERSONS BEFORE THE ARRIVAL OF AN AMBULANCE.

A FULL EVALUATION OF THE SCHEME WILL BE CARRIED OUT TO ENSURE THAT IT IS APPLIED IN AREAS OF GREATEST NEED AND THAT MAXIMUM BENEFIT TO THE PUBLIC IS ACHIEVED. IF SUCCESSFUL CONSIDERATION MAY BE GIVEN TO EXTENDING THE SCHEME.

A BUILDING CONTRACTOR COMPANY WAS FINED \$5 000 BY A KWUN TONG MAGISTRATE FOR ALLOWING MOSQUITO BREEDING AT A CONSTRUCTION SITE AT NGAU TAU KOK ESTATE.

THE COURT WAS TOLD THAT THE DEFENDANT HAD BEEN CHARGED WITH SIMILAR OFFENCES ON EIGHT PREVIOUS OCCASIONS SINCE AUGUST 1983, RESULTING IN A TOTAL FINE OF \$21 500.

COMMENTING ON THE CASE, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE URBAN COUNCIL SAID THAT TO ALLOW MOSQUITO BREEDING IS NOT ONLY ANTI-SOCIAL BUT ALSO COSTLY.

+UNDER THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND URBAN SERVICES ORDINANCE, OFFENDERS OF SUCH OFFENCE ARE LIABLE TO A MAXIMUM FINE OF \$10 000,+ HE WARNED.

THE SPOKESMAN CALLED ON MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO SUPPORT THE CURRENT ANTI-MOSQUITO CAMPAIGN WHICH IS BEING LAUNCHED BY THE COUNCIL TO REMIND THE PUBLIC TO PREVENT MOSQUITO NUISANCE IN LATE SUMMER.
