GOVERNOR OPENS YOUTH HOSTEL

\* \* \*

THE GOVERNOR, SIR EDWARD YOUDE, TODAY (SATURDAY) OFFICIALLY OPENED THE MONG TUNG WAN YOUTH HOSTEL IN CHI MA WAN, LANTAU ISLAND.

THE 100-BED HOSTEL IS THE EIGHTH PROJECT COMPLETED BY THE HONG KONG YOUTH HOSTELS ASSOCIATION AND IS BUILT WITH A \$4 MILLION DONATION FROM THE ROYAL HONG KONG JOCKEY CLUB.

IN HIS ADDRESS TO GUESTS AT THE OPENING CEREMONY, SIR EDWARD NOTED THAT SINCE ITS INCEPTION IN 1975, THE HONG KONG YOUTH HOSTELS ASSOCIATION HAS DONE MUCH TO PROVIDE LEISURE OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUNG PEOPLE.

+THE HOSTELS ENABLE THEM TO GET AWAY FROM THE BUILT-UP URBAN AREAS, TO STAY IN THE COUNTRYSIDE AND TO ENJOY THEMSELVES IN NATURAL SURROUNDINGS AT A VERY LOW COST,+ HE SAID.

+BUT THE HOSTELS ALSO MAKE IT POSSIBLE FOR YOUNG AND ENTHUSIASTIC BUDGET TRAVELLERS FROM ABROAD TO VISIT HONG KONG AND GET TO KNOW ABOUT OUR CITY; AND IN RETURN AN EVER INCREASING NUMBER OF YOUR MEMBERS MAKE USE OF THE FACILITIES AVAILABLE TO THEM IN 66 COUNTRIES OVERSEAS WHEN THEY GO ON THEIR HOLIDAYS.

+THIS IS AN ENCOURAGING TREND AND REFLECTS BOTH THE STEADY IMPROVEMENT IN LIVING STANDARD AND THE DEEP INTEREST OF OUR YOUNGSTERS IN BROADENING THEIR OUTLOOK THROUGH TRAVEL,+ HE SAID.

SPEAKING AT THE SAME CEREMONY, THE CHAIRMAN OF THE HONG KONG YOUTH HOSTELS ASSOCIATION, MR JOHN MCLEAN, GAVE GUESTS A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE ASSOCIATION.

+THE YOUTH HOSTEL ASSOCIATION IN HONG KONG BEGAN WITH NO MONEY, ONLY AN IDEA, AN IDEA THAT SOMETHING MORE COULD SURELY BE DONE TO PROVIDE MEANS FOR THE YOUTH OF HONG KONG TO HAVE ACCESS TO THE COUNTRYSIDE,+ HE SAID.

+AND SO THE CONCEPT OF THE OLD YOUTH HOSTEL SYSTEM OF EUROPE THAT SOME OF US IN THAT FIRST COMMITTEE HAD OURSELVES EXPERIENCED BECAME THE FRAMEWORK AROUND WHICH WE WORKED IN HONG KONG.+

THE FIRST HOSTEL WAS BUILT FROM AN ABANDONED DORMITORY FOR CONSTRUCTION WORKERS AT PLOVER COVE DAM WITH A \$100 000 DONATION FROM THE HONG KONG AND SHANGHAI BANKING CORPORATION.

+WE NOW HAVE EIGHT OPERATING HOSTELS, WITH A CAPACITY OF 606 BEDS,+ MR MCLEAN SAID.

+FIVE YEARS AGO WE HAD ABOUT 6 500 MEMBERS. THIS YEAR WE HAVE 20 000 MEMBERS.+

THE ASSOCIATION HAD PROGRESSED SO FAR THAT HE WOULD LIKE TO THINK THAT SOON IT WOULD BE ABLE TO ASSIST CHINA IN EITHER THE PROVISION OF FACILITIES FOR YOUNG PEOPLE VISITING HONG KONG OR IN THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SIMILAR SYSTEM IN CHINA TO ASSIST BOTH THE YOUNG PEOPLE OF CHINA AND OF OTHER COUNTRIES, HE ADDED.

THE MONG TUNG WAN YOUTH HOSTEL, SET IN TRANQUIL SURROUNDINGS IN THE CHI MA WAN PENINSULA, HAS TWO DORMITORIES, A COMMUNAL BLOCK, SITTING OUT AREAS, CAMPING SITES AND BARBÉCUE PITS.

IT HAS BEEN SPECIALLY DESIGNED TO FIT HARMONIOUSLY INTO THE SURROUNDINGS, WITH STEEP PITCHED ROOFS BLENDING INTO THE BACKDROP OF STEEP HILLS BEHIND.

ALSO PRESENT AT TODAY'S OPENING CEREMONY WERE MR HAIDER BARMA, ACTING REGIONAL SECRETARY FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES, AND MR WILLIAM YAP, ISLANDS DISTRICT OFFICER.

MEN BORN IN 1957 AND 1956 WILL BE REQUIRED TO CHANGE THEIR OLD CARDS FOR NEW ONES DURING THE SIXTH PHASE OF THE NEW IDENTITY CARD ISSUE SCHEME, STARTING ON OCTOBER 31 (MONDAY).

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY (SATURDAY) THAT DURING THE FIVE-WEEK PERIOD TO DECEMBER 3, MEN IN THESE AGE GROUPS SHOULD CALL AT ANY OF THE EIGHT NEW I.D. CARD ISSUE OFFICES BETWEEN 8 AM AND 9.30 PM, MONDAYS TO SATURDAYS.

HE ESTIMATED THAT A TOTAL OF 120 000 APPLICANTS WILL TURN UP DURING THE NEW PHASE.

NEW AND CREATIVE ACTIVITIES MIGHT BE DIFFICULT TO START BUT WERE OF PARAMOUNT IMPORTANCE IN COMMUNITY BUILDING, THE REGIONAL SECRETARY FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES, MR HAIDER BARMA SAID TODAY (SATURDAY).

+WHILE TRADITIONAL ACTIVITIES READILY ATTRACT SUPPORT AND ARE EASY TO ORGANISE, IT IS THROUGH NEW AND CREATIVE ACTIVITIES THAT MORE RESIDENTS MAY COME FORWARD TO PROVIDE A BROAD BASE UPON WHICH A LIVELY AND HEALTHY COMMUNITY MAY BE BUILT,+ HE SAID.

MR BARMA WAS SPEAKING AT THE INAUGURATION CEREMONY OF THE NEWLY-FORMED BASEBALL TEAM, THE +SHA TIN MARTINS+, HELD AT THE JUBILEE SPORTS CENTRE.

THE +SHA TIN MARTINS+, THE FIRST BASEBALL TEAM SET UP IN THE NEW TERRITORIES FOR SCHOOL CHILDREN, IS FUNDED BY THE LOCAL DISTRICT BOARD AND COMES UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE SHA TIN SPORTS ASSOCIATION.

+I HOPE TEACHERS ALL OVER THE NEW TERRITORIES WILL QUICKLY SET UP TEAMS OF THEIR OWN IN THEIR SCHOOLS,+ HE ADDED.

MR BARMA ALSO PRAISED THE SPORTS ASSOCIATION FOR THEIR EFFORT IN PROMOTING ACTIVITIES FOR LOCAL RESIDENTS.

WITHIN LESS THAN TWO YEARS, HE SAID, THE ASSOCIATION HAD ACQUIRED LAND TO PROVIDE A LOCAL BASEBALL GROUND AND A CYCLE PARK IN SHA TIN.
