ALMOST \$14M ALLOCATED FROM LOTTERIES FUND  
FOR 3 COMMUNITY AND WELFARE PROJECTS

\* \* \* \* \*

NEARLY \$14 MILLION HAS BEEN ALLOCATED FROM THE LOTTERIES FUND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A COMMUNITY CENTRE IN HO MAN TIN AND A TOWN HALL IN SAI KUNG AND FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A TOY LIBRARY FOR MENTALLY HANDICAPPED CHILDREN.

THE ALLOCATIONS INCLUDE A GRANT OF \$11.4 MILLION TO THE LUTHERAN CHURCH — HONG KONG SYNOD FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A COMMUNITY CENTRE IN HO MAN TIN AND ANOTHER GRANT OF \$2 MILLION TO THE SAI KUNG TOWN HALL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE FIRST PHASE OF A TOWN HALL IN THE DISTRICT.

CARITAS HONG KONG WAS ALLOCATED \$429 430 TO ESTABLISH ON A TWO-YEAR EXPERIMENTAL BASIS A TOY LIBRARY FOR MENTALLY HANDICAPPED CHILDREN.

COMMENTING ON THE COMMUNITY CENTRE PROJECT, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT, SAID TODAY (SUNDAY) THAT IT WOULD PROVIDE A MUCH NEEDED VENUE FOR COMMUNITY AND RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES FOR THE 150 000 PEOPLE LIVING IN HO MAN TIN.

THE COMMUNITY CENTRE, TO BE BUILT ON A 2 600-SQUARE-METRE SITE AT THE JUNCTION OF CHUNG HAU STREET AND GOOD SHEPHERD STREET, WILL INCLUDE A BUILDING TO HOUSE THE SYNOD'S HEAD OFFICE, A NURSERY, CENTRES FOR THE ELDERLY AND THE DISABLED AND OTHER WELFARE UNITS.

AN AUDITORIUM, WITH A CAPACITY FOR 600 TO 800 PEOPLE, WILL SERVE AS A VENUE FOR CULTURAL, SOCIAL AND COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES.

THE ESTIMATED TOTAL COST OF THE PROJECT IS \$23.2 MILLION. THE SYNOD WILL CONTRIBUTE \$11.8 MILLION TOWARDS THE PROJECT AND IT HAS ALREADY RAISED \$1.5 MILLION FROM THE JOCKEY CLUB. IT WILL RAISE FUNDS TO MEET THE BALANCE.

TURNING TO THE PLANNED SAI KUNG TOWN HALL, THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT THE COMPLEX WAS TO BE BUILT IN TWO PHASES ON A 4 322-SQUARE-METRE SITE FOR THE PROMOTION OF COMMUNITY AND SPORTS ACTIVITIES IN SAI KUNG.

THE FIRST PHASE COSTING MORE THAN \$7 MILLION, WILL FEATURE A MULTI-PURPOSE AUDITORIUM AND A COMMUNITY WORKERS' OFFICE. THE TWO-STOREY AUDITORIUM, WITH A SEATING CAPACITY OF 1 000, CAN BE USED AS A CONCERT HALL OR AS A GYMNASIUM.

THE SECOND PHASE WILL FEATURE A FIVE-STOREY BUILDING HOUSING A PUBLIC LIBRARY, A NURSERY, A SOCIAL CENTRE FOR THE ELDERLY, ACTIVITIES ROOMS AND OTHER FACILITIES.

THE TOWN HALL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE, WHICH DEVELOPED THE PROJECT, IS A CHARITABLE ORGANISATION INCORPORATED IN 1981 TO PROVIDE EDUCATIONAL, RECREATIONAL AND OTHER FACILITIES FOR LOCAL RESIDENTS.

REFERRING TO THE CARITAS PROJECT, THE SPOKESMAN SAID THE PLAN WAS TO SET UP A TOY LIBRARY CENTRE AT CARITAS HOUSE IN CAINE ROAD FOR 75 MENTALLY HANDICAPPED CHILDREN UNDER SIX YEARS OF AGE.

APART FROM TRAINING SESSIONS FOR THE CHILDREN, THE PROGRAMMES TO BE PROVIDED WILL INCLUDE LECTURES, FILM SHOWS AND GROUP DISCUSSIONS FOR PARENTS.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THE TOY LIBRARY WAS A PILOT PROJECT WHICH HAD BEEN INCLUDED IN THE REHABILITATION PROGRAMME PLAN FOR IMPLEMENTATION.

+THE SERVICE WILL BE REVIEWED ONE YEAR AFTER OPERATION,+ HE SAID. +IF IT IS FOUND TO BE SUCCESSFUL, FURTHER FINANCING MAY BE PROVIDED THROUGH GOVERNMENT SUBVENTION.+

THE LOTTERIES FUND, CREATED IN 1965 MAINLY FOR FINANCING DEVELOPMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE SERVICES, IS ADMINISTERED BY THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT.

WARNING ON PROSECUTION

FACTORY OWNERS WHO FAIL TO ENSURE THAT THEIR BOILERS OR STEAM RECEIVERS ARE OPERATED UNDER THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF A COMPETENT PERSON, ARE LIABLE TO BE PROSECUTED BY THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT.

ISSUING THE WARNING TODAY (SUNDAY), THE PRINCIPAL SURVEYOR OF BOILERS AND PRESSURE RECEIVERS OF THE DEPARTMENT, MR B.S. MAKHIJA, POINTED OUT THAT UNDER THE LAW, NO BOILER OR STEAM RECEIVER SHOULD BE OPERATED EXCEPT UNDER THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF A COMPETENT PERSON, AND THAT THE MAXIMUM FINE FOR BREACH OF THIS STATUTORY REQUIREMENT WAS \$30 000.

AT THE SAME TIME, MR MAKHIJA URGED FACTORY OWNERS TO MAKE FULL USE OF THE FACILITIES BEING OFFERED BY THE DEPARTMENT AND THE HAKING WONG TECHNICAL INSTITUTE TO HELP THEM TO SECURE QUALIFIED BOILER OPERATORS.

ONE OF THE FACILITIES INTRODUCED EARLY LAST YEAR, HE EXPLAINED, WAS THE PROVISION OF ADDITIONAL SESSIONS FOR WRITTEN EXAMINATIONS FOR CERTIFICATES OF COMPETENCY IN ORDER TO REDUCE CANDIDATES' WAITING TIME.

THE OTHER WAS THE PROVISION OF A PART-TIME EVENING COURSE FOR BOILER OPERATORS RUN BY THE HAKING WONG TECHNICAL INSTITUTE CATERING MAINLY FOR THE TYPE OF BOILERS USED IN THE GARMENT INDUSTRY. CANDIDATES WHO COMPLETE THE COURSE AND ARE SUCCESSFUL IN THE INSTITUTE'S EXAMINATION ARE ISSUED WITH CERTIFICATES OF COMPETENCY BY THE DEPARTMENT'S PRESSURE EQUIPMENT UNIT, ENABLING THEM TO TEND CLASS III OR IIIA TYPE BOILERS.

MR MAKHIJA WENT ON TO SAY THAT THE UNIT ISSUED 12 GRADES OF CERTIFICATES, DEPENDING ON THE TYPE OF BOILER, AND INFORMATION REGARDING THE GRADE OF CERTIFICATE REQUIRED FOR ANY PARTICULAR TYPE OF BOILER WAS CONTAINED IN A BOOKLET PUBLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

THE BOOKLET, ENTITLED +A GUIDE AND SYLLABUS FOR PERSONS REQUIRING A CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BOILERS AND PRESSURE RECEIVER ORDINANCE, CAP. 56+ COULD BE OBTAINED FROM THE GOVERNMENT PUBLICATIONS CENTRE AT \$3 PER COPY.

FURTHER DETAILS MAY BE OBTAINED FROM THE UNIT SITUATED ON THE FOURTH FLOOR IN CANTON ROAD GOVERNMENT OFFICES, KOWLOON.

MR MAKHIJA STRESSED THAT NEGLECTING PROPER ATTENTION TO STEAM BOILERS COULD ENDANGER LIFE AND PROPERTY.

#### SEVEN LUNAR NEW YEAR FAIRS IN NT

\* \* \* \*

SEVEN LUNAR NEW YEAR FAIRS WILL BE HELD IN THE NEW TERRITORIES EARLY IN FEBRUARY AND A TOTAL OF 954 SITES SELLING FLOWERS, DRY GOODS, BOTTLED DRINKS, AND SNACKS AT THE FAIRS WILL BE PUT UP FOR PUBLIC AUCTION NEXT MONTH (JANUARY).

THE FAIRS WILL BE LOCATED AT KWAI CHUNG, TSUEN WAN, TUEN MUN, YUEN LONG, SHA TIN, TAI PO AND SHEUNG SHUI, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT SAID.

OF THE SEVEN NEW YEAR FAIRS THE BIGGEST WILL BE HELD AT THE YUEN LONG SPORTS GROUND WHICH WILL INCLUDE THE CAR PARK COMPOUND OUTSIDE YUEN LONG STADIUM. IT WILL HAVE 211 STALLS FOR SELLING FLOWERS AND DRY GOODS.

THE AUCTIONING OF THESE STALL SITES WILL BE HELD AT THE OFFICE OF PING SHAN RURAL COMMITTEE AT ON NING ROAD ON JANUARY 7.

THE SECOND BIGGEST FAIR WILL BE AT SHA TSUI ROAD PLAYGROUND IN TSUEN WAN WHERE 208 STALL SITES ARE EXPECTED TO BE PUT UP FOR AUCTION AT THE AUDITORIUM OF THE TSUEN WAN TOWN HALL ON JANUARY 12.

ANOTHER FAIR WILL BE HELD AT THE KWAI CHUNG SPORTS GROUND AND THE AUCTIONING OF ITS 112 STALL SITES WILL TAKE PLACE AT KWAI FONG COMMUNITY HALL AT LAI FONG STREET ON JANUARY 11.

AT SHA TIN, THE FAIR WILL AGAIN BE HELD AT THE CAR PARK OF THE SHA TIN RACECOURSE WITH 110 STALL SITES AVAILABLE. THEY WILL BE PUT UP FOR AUCTION AT LEK YUEN COMMUNITY HALL AT LEK YUEN ESTATE ON JANUARY 10.

AT THE TAI PO FAIR, WHICH WILL BE HELD AT THE TAI PO PLAYGROUND, THERE WILL BE 100 STALL SITES. THE AUCTION WILL BE HELD ON JANUARY 4 AT THE OFFICE OF TAI PO RURAL COMMITTEE AT PO HEUNG STREET.

A SIXTH FAIR WILL BE HELD AT TUEN MUN SAN HUI PLAYGROUND AND TRADERS WHO WISH TO BID FOR ONE OF THE 100 STALL SITES THERE ARE ADVISED TO GO TO THE TAI HING COMMUNITY HALL AT TAI HING ESTATE ON JANUARY 5 WHEN THE AUCTIONING OF THE STALL SITES WILL TAKE PLACE.

THE SHEUNG SHUI FAIR, TO BE HELD AT SHEK WU MARKET PLAYGROUND, WILL HAVE 113 STALL SITES AND THE AUCTIONING WILL TAKE PLACE AT FANLING SWIMMING POOL ON JANUARY 6.

THE UPSET PRICE FOR EACH SITE WOULD BE \$75 EACH AND THE HIGHEST BID, ON THE FALL OF THE HAMMER, WILL BE ACCEPTED IN ALL CASES.

SITE PLANS SHOWING THE STALLS TO BE AUCTIONED AT VARIOUS FAIRS WILL BE ON DISPLAY AT ALL DISTRICT OFFICES AND THE URBAN SERVICES OFFICES OF THE NTSD LATER THIS MONTH.

THE NEW TERRITORIES DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT PLANS TO WIDEN AND RE-ALIGN A SECTION OF LUNG MUN ROAD BETWEEN BUTTERFLY BEACH AND PILLAR POINT TO PROVIDE A DUAL TWO-LANE CARRIAGEWAY AND TO CONSTRUCT FIVE NEW ROADS OF A TOTAL LENGTH OF ABOUT 2.1 KILOMETRES ON RECLAIMED LAND NEAR PILLAR POINT, TUEN MUN.

THE SCHEME FORMS PART OF THE CONTINUING PROGRAMME FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF TUEN MUN NEW TOWN UNDERTAKEN BY THE TUEN MUN NEW TOWN DEVELOPMENT OFFICE.

A NOTICE CONCERNING THE PROPOSED WORKS WAS PUBLISHED IN THE GOVERNMENT GAZETTE.

TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS IN CAUSEWAY BAY

NEW TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE IMPLEMENTED IN CAUSEWAY BAY FROM 10 AM ON TUESDAY (DECEMBER 7) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE MTR CAUSEWAY BAY STATION.

UNDER THE ARRANGEMENTS, EAST POINT ROAD WILL BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC.

LOCKHART ROAD BETWEEN CANNON STREET AND EAST POINT ROAD WILL BE RE-ROUTED TWO WAYS, AND CANNON STREET FROM LOCKHART ROAD TO GLOUCESTER ROAD WILL BE RE-ROUTED ONE WAY NORTHBOUND.

WESTBOUND VEHICLES ALONG HENNESSY ROAD WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO TURN LEFT INTO PERCIVAL STREET SOUTHBOUND.

HOWEVER, THE EXISTING LEFT TURN BAN FROM PERCIVAL STREET SOUTHBOUND INTO HENNESSY ROAD EASTBOUND WILL BE LIFTED.

THE TRAFFIC LANE ON THE WESTBOUND TRAM TRACK OF HENNESSY ROAD BETWEEN PERCIVAL STREET AND EAST POINT ROAD WILL BE RESERVED EXCLUSIVELY FOR TRAMS.

CMB ROUTE NOS. 17 AND 72 TRAVELLING ALONG HENNESSY ROAD WESTBOUND TOWARDS MORRISON HILL ROAD WILL HAVE TO USE CANAL ROAD EAST INSTEAD OF PERCIVAL STREET AND LEIGHTON ROAD.

ROUTE NOS. 63 AND 81 TRAVELLING ALONG GLOUCESTER ROAD WESTBOUND TOWARDS YEE WO STREET WILL USE PERCIVAL STREET AND HENNESSY ROAD, INSTEAD OF CANNON STREET, LOCKHART ROAD AND EAST POINT ROAD.

AT THE SAME TIME, HONG KONG MAXICAB ROUTE NO. 5 TRAVELLING ALONG KAI CHIU ROAD TOWARDS PERCIVAL STREET WILL USE LEE GARDEN ROAD AND FOO MING STREET INSTEAD OF HENNESSY ROAD.

AND HONG KONG MAXICAB ROUTE NO. 30 TRAVELLING ALONG LOCKHART ROAD TOWARDS GREAT GEORGE STREET WILL USE STEWART ROAD AND HENNESSY ROAD INSTEAD OF EAST POINT ROAD.

TRAINING COURSES FOR TRADE AND WORKSHOP INSTRUCTORS

TRADE INSTRUCTORS AND WORKSHOP SUPERVISORS ARE INVITED TO ATTEND THREE BLOCK RELEASE COURSES IN INSTRUCTIONAL TECHNIQUE TO BE RUN BY THE HONG KONG TECHNICAL TEACHERS' COLLEGE EARLY NEXT YEAR.

THE COURSES, WITH EMPHASIS ON THE METHODS OF INSTRUCTION, WILL GIVE THE INSTRUCTORS AND SUPERVISORS AN OPPORTUNITY TO OBTAIN THE NECESSARY TRAINING FOR CARRYING OUT THEIR DAY TO DAY DUTIES.

EXPERIENCED WORKERS WHO WILL TAKE UP INSTRUCTION DUTIES MAY ALSO APPLY FOR THE COURSES.

TUTORS WILL VISIT STUDENTS AT THEIR OWN PLACES OF EMPLOYMENT TO GIVE FURTHER ADVICE WHEN THE COURSE IS COMPLETED.

THE THREE COURSES WILL BE CONDUCTED IN CANTONESE AND WILL COMMENCE ON JANUARY 24, APRIL 18 AND MAY 23 RESPECTIVELY. PARTICIPANTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND CLASSES FOR TWO WEEKS FULL TIME. THE COURSE FEE IS \$100.

APPLICATION FORMS ARE OBTAINABLE FROM THE HONG KONG TECHNICAL TEACHERS' COLLEGE, 373 QUEEN'S ROAD EAST, HONG KONG AND SHOULD BE RETURNED TO THE COLLEGE BY DECEMBER 18 FOR THE FIRST COURSE, MARCH 12 FOR THE SECOND COURSE AND APRIL 16 FOR THE LAST ONE.
