AUSTRALIAN PRIME MINISTER ARRIVING SUNDAY

A MEDIA FACILITY HAS BEEN ARRANGED FOR PHOTOGRAPHERS AND CAMERAMEN TO COVER THE ARRIVAL OF THE PRIME MINISTER OF AUSTRALIA, MR BOB HAWKE, IN HONG KONG ON SUNDAY (JANUARY 29).

MR HAWKE AND HIS PARTY WILL BE TRAVELLING ON A SPECIAL ROYAL AUSTRALIAN AIR FORCE AIRCRAFT, ETA 6 PM.

PHOTOGRAPHERS AND CAMERAMEN ASSIGNED TO COVER THE EVENT SHOULD ASSEMBLE AT THE AIRPORT PRESS CONFERENCE ROOM NOT LATER THAN 5 PM. AS THE PRESS POSITION WILL BE ON THE TARMAC AND QUITE FAR AWAY FROM THE AIRCRAFT, THEY ARE ADVISED TO BRING ALONG TELEPHOTO LENSES.

GIS OFFICERS WILL BE ON HAND TO ASSIST.

HIGHLY QUALIFIED LEADERS FOR TALKS ON HK'S FUTURE

\* \* \* \*

SIR RICHARD EVANS, BRITAIN'S NEW AMBASSADOR IN PEKING, AND MR ZHOU NAN, CHINA'S ASSISTANT FOREIGN MINISTER, ARE BOTH HIGHLY QUALIFIED AND EXPERIENCED LEADERS HEADING THE TWO COUNTRIES' DELEGATIONS TO THE TALKS ON THE FUTURE OF HONG KONG.

THE GOVERNOR, SIR EDWARD YOUDE, MADE THIS REMARK WHILE TALKING TO REPORTERS AT THE AIRPORT THIS (FRIDAY) AFTERNOON UPON HIS RETURN FROM PEKING AFTER THE EIGHTH ROUND OF SINO-BRITISH TALKS ON HONG KONG.

+SO WE WERE ABLE TO PICK UP WHERE WE LEFT OFF IN DECEMBER AND TO CONTINUE OUR DISCUSSIONS WITHOUT INTERRUPTION,+ SIR EDWARD SAID.

HE ADDED THAT, IN CONSEQUENCE, THE LATEST ROUND OF TALKS WAS +ANOTHER VERY USEFUL SESSION+.

SIR EDWARD SAID THAT MR ZHOU NAN HOSTED A DINNER LAST NIGHT FOR THE DELEGATES.

+WE HAD A VERY PLEASANT DINNER. THE TEMPERATURE OUTSIDE WAS VERY COLD; BUT INSIDE, LET ME ASSURE YOU, IT WAS QUITE WARM,+ HE SAID.

MR YAO GUANG, THE PREVIOUS HEAD OF THE CHINESE DELEGATION TO THE TALKS, ALSO GAVE A DINNER RECEPTION FOR SIR RICHARD EARLIER IN THE WEEK, SIR EDWARD ADDED.

+THESE ARE, OF COURSE, OCCASIONS ON WHICH THERE CAN BE INFORMAL EXCHANGES OF VIEWS.

+OTHERWISE, INFORMAL CONTACTS BETWEEN THE TWO DELEGATIONS WILL CONTINUE,+ HE SAID.

SIR EDWARD ALSO CONFIRMED THAT HE WOULD BE RETURNING TO PEKING ON FEBRUARY 21 FOR THE NEXT ROUND OF TALKS.

HE TOOK THE OCCASION TO WISH THE PRESS A HAPPY AND PROSPEROUS LUNAR NEW YEAR.

MEETING THE GOVERNOR AT THE AIRPORT WERE THE CHIEF SECRETARY, SIR PHILIP HADDON-CAVE; THE SENIOR UNOFFICIAL MEMBER OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, SIR S.Y. CHUNG; THE SENIOR UNOFFICIAL MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL, MR ROGER LOBO; AND THE VICE-CHIEF EDITOR OF THE XINHUA NEWS AGENCY (HONG KONG BRANCH), MR TAN GAN.

VOCATIONAL COMPLEX IS A TRAINING MILESTONE  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE GOVERNMENT LONG RECOGNISED THE CONTINUING NEED OF HONG KONG'S INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE FOR AN ADEQUATE SUPPLY OF WELL EDUCATED AND TRAINED MANPOWER AT ALL LEVELS, THE CHIEF SECRETARY, SIR PHILIP HADDON-CAVE SAID TODAY.

THE EMPHASIS OVER THE LAST TEN YEARS, SIR PHILIP SAID, HAD TENDED TO BE ON EXPANDING THE EDUCATION SYSTEM IN THE TECHNICAL AND TERTIARY FIELDS.

WHILE PLANS FOR EXPANDING TECHNICAL EDUCATION FURTHER WERE IN AN ADVANCED STAGE, THE FOCUS TODAY WAS ON INDUSTRIAL TRAINING, SIR PHILIP SAID.

SIR PHILIP WAS SPEAKING THIS AFTERNOON WHEN LAYING THE FOUNDATION STONE OF THE KOWLOON BAY TRAINING CENTRE COMPLEX, WHICH HE SAID +REPRESENTS A MILESTONE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF INDUSTRIAL TRAINING IN HONG KONG.+

THE NINE-STOREY COMPLEX IS BEING BUILT BY THE VOCATIONAL TRAINING COUNCIL (VTC) TO HOUSE THE FIVE TRAINING CENTRES WHICH WILL PROVIDE INDUSTRIES WITH MORE TRAINED MANPOWER.

THE GOVERNMENT WAS DETERMINED TO DEVELOP, THROUGH THE VOCATIONAL TRAINING COUNCIL, A FULL RANGE OF INDUSTRIAL TRAINING FACILITIES, HE STRESSED.

HE WAS SURE, SIR PHILIP SAID, THAT ONCE THIS, AND OTHER SIMILAR PROJECTS IN THE PIPELINE ARE COMPLETED, HONG KONG WILL HAVE TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING FACILITIES CAPABLE OF MEETING THE CHANGING MANPOWER NEEDS OF THE ECONOMY AND SOCIETY.

+THUS OUR INDUSTRY WILL BE ABLE TO DIVERSIFY FURTHER WITH CONFIDENCE INTO MORE TECHNOLOGICALLY SOPHISTICATED PRODUCTS, AND THE LATENT TALENTS OF OUR PEOPLE CAN BE FULFILLED,+ HE SAID.

/THE BUILDING .....

THE BUILDING COMPLEX, HE SAID, WOULD PROBABLY BE UNIQUE.

+NOWHERE ELSE IN THE WORLD HAVE FIVE TRAINING CENTRES COVERING VERY DIVERSE OCCUPATIONS BEEN INCORPORATED IN ONE MULTI-STOREY BUILDING, PARTLY BECAUSE OF LIMITATION OF SPACE.

+BUT ADMIRATION FOR THE INGENUITY AND THE PROFESSIONALISM OF ALL CONCERNED WITH THE PLANNING AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE BUILDING, SHOULD NOT BE DIMINISHED,+ SIR PHILIP SAID.

HE CONGRATULATED THE VTC AND ITS INDUSTRY TRAINING BOARDS AND COMMITTEES FOR THEIR EFFORTS IN FIRST IDENTIFYING HONG KONG'S MANPOWER NEEDS AND THEN IN ASSISTING THE GOVERNMENT TO IMPLEMENT SCHEMES TO MEET THESE NEEDS.

+THE GOVERNMENT WILL CONTINUE TO RENDER THE COUNCIL ITS FULL SUPPORT, FINANCIAL AND OTHERWISE, TO ENABLE THE COUNCIL TO CARRY OUT ITS TASK,+ HE SAID.

ALSO OFFICIATING AT THE CEREMONY WERE CHAIRMAN OF THE VTC, DR FRANCIS TIEN AND THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, MR MORRIS MORGAN.

DR TIEN THANKED THE GOVERNMENT FOR THE SUPPORT GIVEN TO THE COUNCIL AND IN PARTICULAR FOR GRANTING THE RESOURCES NEEDED TO CARRY OUT ITS FUNCTIONS.

THE KOWLOON BAY TRAINING CENTRE COMPLEX IS THE FIRST OF TWO TRAINING CENTRE COMPLEXES BEING BUILT BY THE VTC WITH FUNDS PROVIDED BY GOVERNMENT, HE SAID.

IT WILL HOUSE THE TRAINING CENTRES OF THE ELECTRONICS INDUSTRY, HOTEL, MACHINE SHOP AND METAL WORKING INDUSTRY, PLASTICS AND PRINTING INDUSTRIES.

A TOTAL OF 18 FULL-TIME AND TWO PART-TIME COURSES WILL BE OFFERED RANGING FROM 30 HOURS TO ONE YEAR.

THE COMPLEX HAS CAPACITY FOR 4 200 TRAINEES A YEAR.

TO GIVE THE TRAINEES A FEEL OF THE INDUSTRIAL ENVIRONMENT, THEY WILL BE TRAINED UNDER AS NEAR ACTUAL WORKING CONDITIONS AS POSSIBLE TO ARRANGE, DR TIEN SAID.

RECREATIONAL AREAS AND COMMON FACILITIES INCLUDING A CANTEEN, AN ASSEMBLY HALL, A LIBRARY, CONFERENCE ROOMS, FIRST AID ROOM ARE ALSO AVAILABLE FOR THE USE OF TRAINEES AND STAFF OF THE CENTRES.

THE COMPLEX IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED AND OPERATIONAL EARLY NEXT YEAR.

### FERRY TERMINAL FACILITY SOUGHT BY TENDER

\* \* \* \*

THE GOVERNMENT HAS DECIDED TO PUT OUT FOR PUBLIC TENDER THE DEVELOPMENT OF A CHINA PASSENGER FERRY TERMINAL TO ENSURE THE EARLY PROVISION OF THIS FACILITY.

A SITE OF ABOUT 1.5 HECTARES IN CANTON ROAD TOGETHER WITH AN AREA OF 8-800 SQUARE METRES OF SEABED, INCLUDING KOWLOON PUBLIC PIER NO 54, WILL BE PUT UP FOR SALE, MOST LIKELY IN THE FIRST HALF OF THE COMING FINANCIAL YEAR.

ANNOUNCING THIS TODAY, A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN POINTED OUT THAT THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER FOR THIS +SOUTH CAMBER+ SITE, WOULD BE REQUIRED TO CONSTRUCT AND HAND OVER TO THE GOVERNMENT A THREE-STOREY CONCOURSE STRUCTURE OVER THE PIER, AND RELATED TERMINAL FACILITIES.

+THESE FACILITIES WILL BE INCORPORATED IN A FOUR-LEVEL PODIUM WITHIN THE SOUTH CAMBER SITE ON WHICH A MULTI-STOREY COMMERCIAL-RESIDENTIAL TOWER BLOCK WILL BE CONSTRUCTED.

+AFTER HAVING PROVIDED THESE DEVELOPMENTS, WHICH WILL HAVE TO BE HANDED TO THE GOVERNMENT WITHIN 36 MONTHS OF THE COMPLETION OF THE CONDITIONS OF SALE, THE DEVELOPER WILL BE ABLE TO KEEP THE COMMERCIAL SPACE ON THE PODIUM LEVELS AND THE COMMERCIAL-RESIDENTIAL TOWER BLOCK ABOVE,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN POINTED OUT THAT AT PRESENT, IN THE ABSENCE OF PROPER TERMINAL FACILITIES, PART OF THE TAI KOK TSUI PIER IS USED AS A TEMPORARY TERMINAL FOR FERRY AND HOVERFERRY SERVICES TO AND FROM CHINA.

BUILT FOR INTERNAL HARBOUR SERVICES, THE PIER HAS LIMITED BERTHING SPACE AND HAS NO PROPER IMMIGRATION, CUSTOMS OR BAGGAGE HANDLING FACILITIES.

THE PURPOSE-BUILT TERMINAL NOW ENVISAGED WILL REMEDY THIS UNSATISFACTORY SITUATION AND WILL COPE WITH INCREASING FERRY AND HOVERCRAFT SERVICES TO AND FROM CHINA, HE SAID.

HE ALSO NOTED THAT THERE HAD BEEN DISCUSSIONS IN THE PAST BETWEEN THE HONG KONG AND KOWLOON WHARF AND GODOWN COMPANY AND THE GOVERNMENT REGARDING THE POSSIBILITY OF GRANTING THE SOUTH CAMBER SITE TO THE COMPANY, INCLUDING THE FERRY TERMINAL DEVELOPMENT, IN EXCHANGE FOR ITS SHARP STREET TRAM DEPOT SITE. HOWEVER, IT IS NO LONGER NECESSARY FOR THE GOVERNMENT TO ACQUIRE THE SHARP STREET DEPOT SITE.

+IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED THAT A PUBLIC TENDER ON A JOINT VENTURE BASIS WOULD ENSURE THE COMPLETION OF THE MUCH REQUIRED TERMINAL FACILITIES WITHIN THE SHORTEST POSSIBLE TIME,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

## SCOPE OF TRUSTEE INVESTMENTS WIDENED

\* \* \* \*

TRUSTEES HAVE BEEN GIVEN A SLIGHTLY WIDER CHOICE OF INVESTMENTS AS A RESULT OF AN ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AND PUBLISHED IN THE GAZETTE TODAY.

THE CLASSES OF INVESTMENT WHICH THE ORDER NOW ADDS BY AMENDING THE SECOND SCHEDULE TO THE TRUSTEE ORDINANCE, INCLUDE ADDITIONAL HONG KONG AND UNITED KINGDOM STOCKS AND SECURITIES, AS WELL AS BILLS, NOTES AND BONDS ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES TREASURY.

COMMENTING ON THE ORDER, A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN EXPLAINED THAT SINCE TRUST INSTRUMENTS WERE GENERALLY DRAFTED TO PROVIDE WIDER INVESTMENT POWERS, PROBABLY ONLY A FEW TRUSTS WERE IN PRACTICE BOUND BY THE SECOND SCHEDULE.

THE AMENDMENTS, HE ADDED, HAD BEEN PROPOSED AFTER A THOROUGH REVIEW WHICH TOOK INTO ACCOUNT THE VIEWS OF INTERESTED PROFESSIONAL BODIES.

+THE AIM WAS TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE A SATISFACTORY RANGE OF INVESTMENTS BUT WITHOUT, SO FAR AS COULD REASONABLY BE EXPECTED, ALLOWING EXPOSURE TO UNDUE RISK,+ HE SAID.

THE SCHEDULE, HE INDICATED, WOULD BE REVIEWED FROM TIME TO TIME, AS CIRCUMSTANCES REQUIRED.

HE ALSO SAID THAT IN CASES WHERE INVESTMENTS BY A GOVERNMENT-SUBVENTED ORGANISATION WERE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE FINANCIAL SECRETARY, THE FINANCIAL SECRETARY WOULD CONTINUE, AS A MATTER OF ADMINISTRATIVE PRACTICE TO CONFINE HIS APPROVAL TO INVESTMENTS LISTED IN THE SECOND SCHEDULE TO THE TRUSTEE ORDINANCE, UNLESS THERE WERE SPECIAL AND COMPELLING REASONS FOR ACTING DIFFERENTLY.

AT THE SAME TIME, THE ORDER RAISES FROM \$30 MILLION TO \$100 MILLION THE MINIMUM SHARE CAPITAL REQUIREMENT FOR HONG KONG COMPANIES WHOSE SECURITIES MAY QUALIFY AS TRUSTEE INVESTMENTS.

ALSO, THE QUALIFYING CRITERION REQUIRING SUCH A COMPANY TO HAVE A FIVE-YEAR RECORD OF DIVIDEND PAYMENTS HAS BEEN MODIFIED BY STIPULATING THAT EACH SUCH PAYMENT MUST HAVE BEEN IN CASH, EXCEPT TO THE EXTENT THAT SHAREHOLDERS MAY THEMSELVES HAVE OPTED TO ACCEPT IT OTHER THAN IN CASH.

THE CLASSES OF INVESTMENT ADDED TO THE SECOND SCHEDULE MAY BE SUMMARISED AS FOLLOWS:

- \* VARIABLE-INTEREST UK GOVERNMENT STOCKS AND CERTAIN OTHER VARIABLE-INTEREST SECURITIES IN THE UK;
- \* CERTAIN QUOTED UK COMPANY SECURITIES;
- \* BILLS, NOTES AND BONDS ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES TREASURY;
- \* UNIT TRUSTS AND MUTUAL FUNDS THAT ARE AUTHORISED BY THE SECURITIES COMMISSION IN HONG KONG;
- \* DEPOSITS WITH LICENSED DEPOSIT-TAKING COMPANIES.

STREET ALTERATION FOR MTR ISLAND LINE  
\* \* \* \*

A PERMANENT STREET ALTERATION WILL BE INTRODUCED IN THE EASTERN DISTRICT TO FACILITATE THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ENTRANCE TO THE QUARRY BAY STATION OF THE MTR ISLAND LINE AT THE SOUTHERN END OF MODEL LANE.

A NOTICE TO THIS EFFECT IS PUBLISHED IN TODAY'S GOVERNMENT GAZETTE.

THE ALTERATION INVOLVES THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW ROAD AT THE SOUTHERN END OF MODEL LANE WHICH WILL PROVIDE ACCESS TO BLOCK F OF MODEL HOUSING ESTATE AND THE BRADBURY YOUTH CENTRE OPPOSITE.

THE NEW ROAD WILL HAVE A CARRIAGEWAY WIDTH OF FOUR METRES BETWEEN THE YOUTH CENTRE AND THE PROPOSED MTR ENTRANCE STRUCTURE AND 4.5 METRES BETWEEN BLOCK F OF THE MODEL HOUSING ESTATE AND THE ENTRANCE STRUCTURE. FOOTPATHS OF A MINIMUM WIDTH OF 0.5 METRE WILL ALSO BE PROVIDED AT BOTH SIDES OF THE CARRIAGEWAY.

DETAILS OF THE AFFECTED AREA ARE SHOWN ON PLAN MT/G/275. COPIES OF THE PLAN AND THE GOVERNOR'S ORDER AUTHORIZING THE STREET ALTERATION MAY BE INSPECTED DURING NORMAL OFFICE HOURS AT THE ENQUIRY SUB-OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT OFFICE (CENTRAL AND WESTERN) AT CGO WEST WING; THE DISTRICT OFFICE (EASTERN) AT 884-886 KING'S ROAD; OR THE LANDS DEPARTMENT, SURVEY DIVISION IN MURRAY BUILDING, COTTON TREE DRIVE.

CLAIMS FOR COMPENSATION IN RESPECT OF THE ALTERATION MUST BE MADE IN WRITING TO THE DIRECTOR OF ENGINEERING DEVELOPMENT AND MUST REACH HIS OFFICE WITHIN ONE YEAR AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THE ALTERATION.

TREVOR THORPE NAMED NEW AVIATION CHIEF

MR TREVOR THORPE SUCCEEDS MR BRIAN KEEP AS DIRECTOR OF CIVIL AVIATION AS FROM TODAY (FRIDAY).

MR THORPE JOINED THE HONG KONG GOVERNMENT AS A BRIEFING OFFICER IN 1956, AFTER COMMISSIONED FLYING SERVICE IN THE ROYAL AIR FORCE.

HE WORKED, IN HIS EARLY YEARS WITH THE CIVIL AVIATION DEPARTMENT, ON AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL, AND LATER CONCENTRATED ON OPERATIONS AND PLANNING.

AFTER SERVING AS ASSISTANT DIRECTOR (TECHNICAL AND PLANNING) HE BECAME DEPUTY DIRECTOR IN 1979.

HE IS A FELLOW OF THE CHARTERED INSTITUTE OF TRANSPORT, A MEMBER OF THE ROYAL AERONAUTICAL SOCIETY, AND A MEMBER OF THE AOCI TECHNICAL COMMITTEE.

/MR KEEP .....

MR KEEP JOINED THE GOVERNMENT AS A TELECOMMUNICATIONS OFFICER IN 1960, AFTER COMMISSIONED SERVICE IN THE ROYAL AIR FORCE.

HE MOVED FROM ELECTRONICS ENGINEERING AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS INTO PLANNING, AND DEVELOPED MANY ITEMS IN THE HONG KONG AIR TRANSPORT SYSTEM, PARTICULARLY IN AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL AND THE PASSENGER AND CARGO TERMINAL BUILDINGS.

MR KEEP SERVED AS DIRECTOR FROM 1979.

HE WAS MADE A FELLOW OF THE ROYAL AERONAUTICAL SOCIETY AND A MEMBER OF THE AOCI BOARD OF DIRECTORS IN 1981, AND WAS AWARDED THE O.B.E. LAST YEAR.

#### ELLIOT PUMPING STATION TO BE REBUILT

\* \* \* \*

THE WATER SUPPLIES DEPARTMENT IS INVITING TENDERS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW ELLIOT FRESH WATER AND SALT WATER PUMPING STATION AT POK FU LAM ROAD.

THE NEW STATION WILL BE BUILT AT THE BACK OF THE EXISTING PUMPING STATION, SITUATED OPPOSITE CHIU SHEUNG MIDDLE SCHOOL, WHICH HAS TO BE DEMOLISHED TO MAKE WAY FOR WIDENING POK FU LAM ROAD AND RE-DEVELOPMENT OF HONG KONG UNIVERSITY.

IT WILL BE A TWO-STORY, REINFORCED CONCRETE BUILDING WITH A FLOOR AREA OF ABOUT 420 SQUARE METRES.
