## YOUTH AGAINST DRUGS SCHEME PRAISED

\* \* \*

HONG KONG YOUTHS HAVE BECOME MORE INVOLVED IN THE FIGHT AGAINST DRUG ADDICTION AS A RESULT OF THE RECENT +YOUTH AGAINST DRUGS SCHEME+ LAUNCHED BY THE ACTION COMMITTEE AGAINST NARCOTICS, SAID MR PETER LEE, COMMISSIONER FOR NARCOTICS.

HE WAS SPEAKING AT THE PRIZE-PRESENTATION CEREMONY OF AN ANTI-NARCOTICS PROJECT HELD THIS (SATURDAY) AFTERNOON AT ST JOSEPH ANGLO-CHINESE SCHOOL IN NGAU CHI WAN, KOWLOON.

MR LEE PRAISED THE STUDENTS OF THE SCHOOL FOR THEIR EXCELLENT EFFORTS IN ORGANISING THE YOUTH AGAINST DRUGS PROJECT.

HE TOLD THE STUDENTS THAT THE AIM OF THE +YOUTH AGAINST DRUGS SCHEME+ WAS TO ENCOURAGE AN ACTIVE AND DIRECT YOUTH PARTICIPATION IN ANTI-NARCOTICS WORK THROUGH PREVENTIVE EDUCATION AND PUBLICITY.

UNDER THE SCHEME, HE SAID, YOUNG PEOPLE ARE ABLE TO PLAN AND IMPLEMENT ANTI-NARCOTICS EDUCATIONAL PUBLICITY PROJECTS IN THEIR OWN WAY.

MR LEE POINTED OUT THAT THIS NEW APPROACH WOULD ENABLE YOUNG PEOPLE TO KNOW AND UNDERSTAND MORE ABOUT THE PROBLEM OF DRUG ABUSE AND AT THE SAME TIME PASS ON THE ANTI-NARCOTICS MESSAGES TO THE YOUNG GENERATION IN THEIR OWN LANGUAGE.

THE SCHEME IS LAUNCHED FOR THE FIRST TIME BY THE ACAN AS PART OF ITS PREVENTIVE EDUCATION AND PUBLICITY PROGRAMME. IT IS OPEN TO ANY YOUTH GROUP COMPRISING AT LEAST 10 OR MORE MEMBERS WHO ARE AT THE AGE OF 15 OR ABOVE.

THE SCHEME COMMENCED IN SEPTEMBER LAST YEAR AND A TOTAL OF 19 PROJECTS WERE APPROVED. EACH PROJECT WAS GIVEN AN AMOUNT RANGING FROM \$1 000 TO \$3 000 TO MEET THE EXPENSES.

TODAY'S PROJECT WAS ORGANISED BY THE +PREFECTS CLUB+ OF ST JOSEPH ANGLO-CHINESE SCHOOL. THE PROJECT INCLUDED AN INTER-SCHOOL CHINESE AND ENGLISH ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION, AS WELL AS A POSTER DESIGN COMPETITION, AN EXHIBITION AND A GAME STALL DESIGN COMPETITION.

WINNERS OF THE COMPETITIONS WERE AWARDED PRIZES AND SOUVENIRS AT A PRESENTATION CEREMONY HELD LATER THIS AFTERNOON.

OFFICIATING AT THE CEREMONY WERE MR PETER LEE- MR R.T. SULLIVAN, POLICE COMMUNITY RELATIONS OFFICER (KWUN TONG)- MR TIMOTHY TSO, ASSISTANT CITY DISTRICT OFFICER (KWUN TONG)- BROTHER PAUL SUN, SUPERVISOR OF ST JOSEPH ANGLO-CHINESE SCHOOL- AND MR KENNETH CHAN, PRINCIPAL OF THE SCHOOL.

NEW CLINIC FOR NGAU TAU KOK

\* \* \*

A NEW CLINIC CONVENIENTLY LOCATED IN THE DENSELY POPULATED NGAU TAU KOK AREA WILL BEGIN RENDERING SERVICE TO THE PUBLIC NEXT THURSDAY.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE MEDICAL AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT SAID THE OPENING OF THE CLINIC IS PART OF THE DEPARTMENT'S PLAN TO IMPROVE MEDICAL FACILITIES FOR THE POPULATION IN THE FAST DEVELOPING EAST KOWLOON REGION.

THE NGAU TAU KOK JOCKEY CLUB CLINIC HAS BEEN BUILT WITH FUNDS FROM THE ROYAL HONG KONG JOCKEY CLUB WHICH CONTRIBUTED ABOUT 70 PER CENT OF THE TOTAL CONSTRUCTION COST.

THE \$11.5 MILLION CLINIC AT TING ON STREET IS A FIVE-STOREY BUILDING WITH AN UNDERGROUND BASEMENT.

IN ADDITION TO A GENERAL OUT-PATIENT DEPARTMENT ON THE GROUND FLOOR, IT ALSO ACCOMMODATES A FAMILY HEALTH SERVICE CENTRE, A MATERNITY WARD, A GERIATRIC DAY HOSPITAL AND PSYCHIATRIC DAY CENTRE ON THE FLOORS ABOVE.

IT IS A NEW STANDARD TYPE URBAN CLINIC WITH SIX CONSULTATION ROOMS AND TWO TREATMENT ROOMS FOR THE GENERAL OUT-PATIENT DEPARTMENT.

THE CLINIC WILL BE OPENED IN PHASES, BEGINNING WITH THE OUT-PATIENT SERVICE IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE LUNAR NEW YEAR, TO BE FOLLOWED BY THE MATERNITY WARD WITH 24 BEDS IN EARLY MARCH.

THE FAMILY HEALTH SERVICE CENTRE ON THE FIRST FLOOR WILL BE OPEN LATER PROVIDING AN EXTENSIVE RANGE OF MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH SERVICES, INCLUDING ANTE-NATAL AND POST-NATAL HEALTH CARE, A COMPREHENSIVE OBSERVATION SCHEME FOR CHILDREN AND FAMILY PLANNING .

THE TWO TOP FLOORS, WHICH WILL BE OCCUPIED BY THE GERIATRIC DAY HOSPITAL AND PSYCHIATRIC DAY CENTRE EACH WITH A CAPACITY OF 40 SPACES, WILL BE PUT IN USE IN THE LATTER PART OF THE YEAR.

### PUBLIC WARNED ABOUT BOGUS CIVIL SERVANTS

\*\*\*

A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN TODAY WARNED MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC AGAINST SWINDLERS POSING AS CIVIL SERVANTS OR USING THE NAMES OF THE CIVIL SERVANTS UNIONS TO CANVASS FOR PAID ADVERTISEMENTS IN PUBLICATIONS.

THE POLICE AND THE ICAC HAVE, IN THE PAST, RECEIVED A LOT OF COMPLAINTS FROM THE PUBLIC AGAINST PEOPLE CLAIMING TO BE OFFICE-BEARERS OF STAFF UNIONS OR THEIR PUBLISHERS AND USING DUBIOUS METHODS TO CANVASS FOR ADVERTISEMENTS.

THE SPOKESMAN POINTED OUT THAT A CIVIL SERVANTS UNION MUST FIRST OBTAIN PERMISSION FROM THE SECRETARY FOR THE CIVIL SERVICE TO PRODUCE ANY PUBLICATION CONTAINING PAID ADVERTISEMENTS.

PERMISSION IS GIVEN ONLY ON A NUMBER OF CONDITIONS. TWO OF THESE CONDITIONS STATE THAT:

- (A) CANVASSING MUST BE DONE BY LETTER- NO DIRECT APPROACH EITHER BY TELEPHONE OR IN PERSON SHOULD BE MADE TO THE POTENTIAL ADVERTISERS-
- (B) ADVERTISERS MUST BE ASKED TO MAKE PAYMENT BY CROSSED CHEQUE MADE OUT TO THE STAFF UNION CONCERNED AND SENT BY MAIL TO ITS REGISTERED ADDRESS. CASH PAYMENTS MUST NOT BE ACCEPTED.

MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC ARE ASKED TO CHECK WITH THE STAFF RELATIONS DIVISION OF THE CIVIL SERVICE BRANCH (TEL. NO.: 5-225409) IF THEY WISH TO ASCERTAIN WHETHER ANY ORGANISATION WHICH HAS APPROACHED THEM WITH A VIEW TO CANVASSING FOR PAID ADVERTISEMENTS IS A BONA-FIDE CIVIL SERVANTS UNION, AND WHETHER PROPER APPROVAL HAS BEEN GIVEN FOR THE UNION TO DO SO.

IF DUBIOUS METHODS CONTRARY TO THE CONDITIONS SET OUT ABOVE ARE EMPLOYED, CHANCES ARE THAT THE CANVASSERS ARE SWINDLERS, IN WHICH CASE THE PUBLIC SHOULD IMMEDIATELY REPORT TO THE POLICE.

### STUDENT WINS LOGO DESIGN COMPETITION

AN 18-YEAR-OLD STUDENT HAS DESIGNED A LOGO FOR TAI PO DISTRICT BOARD AND WON HIMSELF \$3 000.

A DESIGN COMPETITION HELD LAST MONTH ATTRACTED A TOTAL OF 58 ENTRIES.

MR CHEUNG KIN-HO, WHO ATTENDS SHA TIN GOVERNMENT SECONDARY SCHOOL, SAID HE BASED HIS WINNING DESIGN ON THE SECOND CHARACTER OF THE DISTRICT'S CHINESE NAME.

THE MIDDLE PART OF THE DESIGN RESEMBLED THE EXTERIOR OF A BUILDING REPRESENTING DEVELOPMENT IN THE DISTRICT, HE SAID.

THE WHOLE DESIGN WAS BALANCED TO CONVEY THE EFFECT OF THE DISTRICT BOARD AS A BRIDGE BETWEEN GOVERNMENT AND THE PUBLIC.

THE PANEL OF JUDGES COMPRISED THE DISTRICT OFFICER, MR NICKY LO-DISTRICT BOARD MEMBERS, MR WONG YUEN-CHEUNG, MR CHEUNG HON-KAU AND MR HUNG CHEUNG-HO- AND AN INSPECTOR OF SCHOOLS, MR YEUNG WAI-FUNG.

THERE WERE ALSO FIVE OUTSTANDING AWARDS, EACH WITH A CASH PRIZE OF \$200.

THE BUDGET FOR THE COMPETITION WAS \$6 000 WHICH THE DISTRICT BOARD PROVIDED.

#### NORTH DISTRICT TO HOLD CROSS COUNTRY RACE

NORTH DISTRICT BOARD HAS APPROVED \$10 000 TOWARDS SPONSORING A LUNAR NEW YEAR CROSS COUNTRY RACE.

THE RACE WILL BE HELD ON FEBRUARY 28 (SUNDAY) AND WILL BE DIVIDED INTO SECTIONS FOR MEN AND WOMEN.

THE MEN'S RACE WILL START AT SING PING SCHOOL IN TA KWU LING AND FINISH AT SHEK WU HUI PLAYGROUND, A COURSE OF 10 KILOMETRES.

THE WOMEN'S RACE WILL COVER A DISTANCE OF EIGHT KILOMETRES ALONG THE SAME ROUTE AS THE MEN'S SECTION, EXCEPT THAT THE STARTING POINT WILL BE AT HUNG LENG.

THE RACE IS OPEN TO ANYONE AGED OVER 16 WHO MUST BE CERTIFIED FIT TO PARTICIPATE IN A LONG DISTANCE RACE BY A DOCTOR.

ENTRY FORMS ARE OBTAINABLE FROM SHEUNG SHUI SPORTS ASSOCIATION, SHEUNG SHUI SOCIAL SERVICE CENTRE, THE RECREATION AND SPORT SERVICE'S NORTH DISTRICT OFFICE AT TAI PO GOVERNMENT OFFICES, AND THE PACIFIC TRAVEL SERVICE AT SAN FUNG AVENUE.

THE DEADLINE FOR ENTRY IS FEBRUARY 25.

DURING THE RACE, THE POLICE WILL ASSIST IN TRAFFIC CONTROL AND THE AUXILIARY MEDICAL SERVICE WILL PROVIDE FIRST AID SERVICES ALONG THE ROUTE.

A SIMILAR RACE HELD LAST YEAR ATTRACTED MORE THAN 300 PARTICIPANTS. IT IS EXPECTED THAT THE SAME NUMBER WILL TAKE PART THIS YEAR.

THE RACE IS BEING ORGANISED BY SHEUNG SHUI SPORTS ASSOCIATION WITH THE HELP OF THE RECREATION AND SPORT SERVICE, SHEUNG SHUI SOCIAL SERVICE CENTRE OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT, THE POLICE CADET TRAINING SCHOOL AND THE POLICE COMMUNITY RELATIONS UNIT OF THE POLICE FRONTIER DIVISION.

### CONSTRUCTION OF FANLING BYPASS

\* \* \*

THE NEW TERRITORIES DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT WILL START WORK IN THE MIDDLE OF THIS YEAR ON A MAJOR ROAD PROJECT - FANLING BYPASS.

THE PROJECT MAINLY INVOLVES THE CONSTRUCTION OF A THREE-KILOMETRE DUAL THREE-LANE NEW TRUNK ROAD FROM WO HOP SHEK TO THE WEST OF THE ROAD JUNCTION OF FAN KAM ROAD AND SAN FUNG AVENUE, WHICH WILL FORM PART OF THE NEW TERRITORIES CIRCULAR ROUTE.

ALSO INCLUDED WILL BE THE CONSTRUCTION OF CYCLE-TRACKS, FOOTPATHS AND ROAD SIDE AMENITY AREAS ALONG THE ROAD AND PEDESTRIAN SUBWAYS AND FOOTBRIDGES TO PROVIDE SAFE CROSSINGS FOR RESIDENTS IN THE TOWN.

IN CONJUNCTION WITH THIS PROJECT, THE ROAD JUNCTIONS AT PAK FUK TSUEN ROAD AND FANLING PLAYGROUND ROAD AND AT TAI PO ROAD AND FAN KAM ROAD AND A SECTION OF TAI PO ROAD BETWEEN FAN LENG NAM WAI AND FAN KAM ROAD WILL BE RECONSTRUCTED.

IN ADDITION, A 250-METRE-LONG SECTION OF CASTLE PEAK ROAD TO THE WEST OF FAN KAM ROAD AND A 400-METRE-LONG SECTION OF SAN FUNG AVENUE AT ITS JUNCTION WITH TAI PO ROAD TO THE NORTH OF THE EXISTING KOWLOON-CANTON RAILWAY LEVEL CROSSING WILL BE CLOSED AFTER ALTERNATIVE ROUTES HAVE BEEN PROVIDED.

A NOTICE CONCERNING THE PROPOSED UNDERTAKING WAS PUBLISHED IN TODAY'S GOVERNMENT GAZETTE.

ANY PERSON OBJECTING TO THE PROPOSED PROJECT MUST SEND HIS OBJECTION IN WRITING TO THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS SO AS TO REACH HIS OFFICE NOT LATER THAN FEBRUARY 22, 1982.

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT TODAY REMINDED MOTORISTS THAT THE AREA SURROUNDING STATUE SQUARE IN CENTRAL DISTRICT WILL BE DESIGNATED A PEDESTRIAN PRECINCT THROUGHOUT THE LUNAR NEW YEAR HOLIDAYS.

STARTING FROM TOMORROW (SUNDAY), NEW TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS WILL ALSO BE INTRODUCED IN CAUSEWAY BAY BECAUSE OF THE LARGE TURN-OUT EXPECTED AT THE FLOWER FAIR IN VICTORIA PARK.

FURTHERMORE, A SECTION OF EDINBURGH PLACE AND QUEEN'S PIER WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL VEHICULAR TRAFFIC FROM 7 PM TO 11 PM ON LUNAR NEW YEAR DAY (JANUARY 25) FOR THE FIREWORKS DISPLAY IN VICTORIA HARBOUR.
