EDUCATION COSTS STUDY GETS GO-AHEAD

\* \* \* \* \*

THE SECRETARY FOR EDUCATION AND MANPOWER, MR RON BRIDGE, TODAY (MONDAY) SIGNED A \$2.5 MILLION CONTRACT FOR A COMPREHENSIVE STUDY FOR THE DESIGN OF A COMPUTERISED SYSTEM OF LINKED FINANCIAL MODELS TO HELP IN THE DETERMINATION OF COSTS IN HONG KONG'S EDUCATIONAL POLICY.

THE CONTRACT WAS SIGNED WITH INTERNATIONAL CONSULTANTS COOPERS AND LYBRAND ASSOCIATES LIMITED.

"THE PROPOSAL FOR THIS CONSULTANCY STUDY WAS ORIGINALLY MADE BY THE EDUCATION COMMISSION IN ITS REPORT NO. 2," A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN SAID.

"THE COMMISSION'S TERMS OF REFERENCE REQUIRE IT TO TAKE ACCOUNT OF THE EFFECT OF THEIR RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE GOVERNMENT'S EDUCATION BUDGET.

"THE PROPOSED COMPUTER MODELS WILL HELP THE COMMISSION IN THIS TASK. THEY WILL ALSO HELP GOVERNMENT OFFICERS TO STUDY THE FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS OF FUTURE CHANGES IN EDUCATION POLICY."

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THE PRESENT STUDY, WHICH WOULD TAKE SIX MONTHS TO COMPLETE, WAS THE FIRST STAGE OF THE COMPUTER MODEL DEVELOPMENT.

"IT WILL COMPRISE THE DESIGN OF AN INTEGRATED SYSTEM CAPABLE OF STORING AND ANALYSING DATA FROM ACROSS ALL SECTORS OF THE EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM," HE SAID.

"DATA FROM ALL SECTORS WILL BE AVAILABLE TO A 'MASTER' MODEL OPERATED BY THE EDUCATION AND MANPOWER BRANCH OF THE GOVERNMENT SECRETARIAT.

"THE INFORMATION TO BE COMPILED BY THE CONSULTANTS RELATES TO THE PRE-PRIMARY, PRIMARY, SECONDARY, SIXTH FORM, TECHNICAL, TERTIARY, SPECIAL EDUCATION AND TEACHER TRAINING SECTORS."

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THE RESULTS OF THE DESIGN STUDY WOULD PAVE THE WAY FOR THE FINAL STAGE OF THE PROJECT, THAT WAS ACTUALLY TO DEVELOP THE FINANCIAL MODELS AND TO MAKE SURE THEY WORK.

"AT THE END OF THIS FINAL STAGE, OFFICERS IN THE EDUCATION AND MANPOWER BRANCH AND IN OTHER CONCERNED GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS WILL BE ABLE TO OPERATE THE MODELS THROUGH DESK-TOP COMPUTER TERMINALS."

THE CONSULTANTS FORM PART OF COOPERS AND LYBRAND INTERNATIONAL WHICH PROVIDES PUBLIC AND ACCOUNTING MANAGEMENT CONSULTANCY SERVICES FROM 520 OFFICES IN OVER 100 COUNTRIES.

NEW SCHEME TO HELP MANUFACTURERS

\* \* \* \* \*

A NEW SCHEME AIMING AT ASSISTING THE MANUFACTURING INDUSTRY TO SOLVE PROBLEMS WAS LAUNCHED TODAY (MONDAY) BY THE INDUSTRY DEPARTMENT.

ANNOUNCING THE INDUSTRIAL EXTENSION SERVICE (IES) SCHEME, THE DIRECTOR OF INDUSTRY, MR K.Y. YEUNG, SAID THE SERVICE HAD THREE MAIN AIMS.

"FIRSTLY, TO RAISE THE AWARENESS OF THE RANGE OF SUPPORT SERVICES AVAILABLE; SECONDLY, TO EXPLAIN TO MANUFACTURERS EXACTLY HOW THESE SERVICES CAN HELP THEM SOLVE THEIR PARTICULAR PROBLEMS; AND THIRDLY, TO REFER PARTICULAR PROBLEMS TO THE ORGANISATIONS BEST ABLE TO DEAL WITH THEM."

MR YEUNG SAID THE STAFF FOR THE IES WOULD BE ORGANISED INTO TWO-MAN TEAMS, EACH CONSISTING OF ONE QUALIFIED ENGINEER WITH INDUSTRIAL EXPERIENCE AND ONE TRADE OFFICER.

"THE TRADE OFFICER WILL BE PARTICULARLY FAMILIAR WITH THE WORK OF THE GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS WHICH MANUFACTURERS MOST OFTEN COME INTO CONTACT WITH. THE ENGINEER WILL BE ABLE TO GIVE ADVICE ON PROBLEMS OF A TECHNICAL NATURE," HE SAID.

THERE WOULD BE FOUR TEAMS, SAID MR YEUNG, EXPLAINING THAT ALTHOUGH THE NUMBER MIGHT NOT SEEM LARGE, A PILOT SCHEME RUN LAST YEAR SHOWED THAT THE BEST RESPONSE CAME FROM MEDIUM-SIZED FACTORIES WITH BETWEEN 50 AND 200 WORKERS AND THAT THERE WERE ONLY ABOUT 2,000 FACTORIES IN THIS GROUP IN HONG KONG.

BUT SMALLER FACTORIES WOULD NOT BE IGNORED BY THE SCHEME, MR YEUNG SAID. A HOTLINE HAD BEEN SET UP TO DEAL WITH ENQUIRIES FROM SMALL FACTORIES, ON 3-7360722.

MR YEUNG SAID THERE WERE A NUMBER OF ORGANISATIONS WHICH COULD HELP MANUFACTURERS TO IMPROVE THEIR PRODUCTIVITY AND PRODUCT QUALITY, AND GENERALLY TO USE THEIR RESOURCES MORE EFFICIENTLY.

THE MAIN ONES WERE THE HONG KONG PRODUCTIVITY COUNCIL, THE VOCATIONAL TRAINING COUNCIL AND THE CLOTHING INDUSTRY TRAINING AUTHORITY, THE POLYTECHNICS AND THE UNIVERSITIES, THE HONG KONG DESIGN INNOVATION COMPANY AND THE INDUSTRY DEPARTMENT.

"ALL THESE SERVICES HAVE BEEN PUBLICISED IN THE PAST BY CONVENTIONAL MEANS," HE SAID. "THIS HAS HELPED TO MAKE THEM KNOWN, BUT ONLY TO A LIMITED EXTENT.

"AS IT IS OUR OBJECTIVE TO HELP MANUFACTURERS TO IMPROVE THEIR PERFORMANCE, THEY MUST BE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO UNDERSTAND WHAT A SERVICE CAN DO FOR THEM IN PRACTICAL TERMS.

"THIS NEEDS DIRECT EXPLANATION AND PERSUASION BY TECHNICALLY KNOWLEDGEABLE PEOPLE. THIS REQUIRES AN INDUSTRIAL EXTENSION SERVICE."

NORMALLY A TEAM WOULD SPEND TWO OR THREE DAYS IN EACH FACTORY IT VISITED, MR YEUNG SAID. THEY WOULD DISCUSS THE COMPANY'S WORK WITH ITS SENIOR MANAGEMENT AND WOULD INTRODUCE THE INDUSTRIAL SUPPORT SERVICES AVAILABLE.

THEY WOULD EXPLAIN IN DETAIL HOW A PARTICULAR SERVICE WORKED AND HOW MUCH IT MIGHT COST. IT WOULD THEN BE UP TO THE MANUFACTURER WHETHER HE WISHED TO TAKE THE MATTER FURTHER. IF HE DID THEN ARRANGEMENTS WOULD BE MADE FOR THE RELEVANT ORGANISATION TO CONTACT HIM.

A STEERING GROUP WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF ALL THE MAJOR SUPPORT ORGANISATIONS HAD BEEN SET UP TO PLAN FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OF THE INDUSTRIAL EXTENSION SERVICE, HE ADDED.

THE PROPOSED BAN ON GOODS VEHICLES FROM USING THE SLIP ROAD BETWEEN 7 AM AND 8 AM, ON A TRIAL BASIS, WOULD ENABLE THE TIDAL FLOW SCHEME OPERATING AT THE LION ROCK TUNNEL TO BE EXTENDED TO 7.40 AM.

THE BAN WOULD ALSO REDUCE THE TRAFFIC QUEUE ON BOTH WESTBOUND LUNG CHEUNG ROAD AND NORTHBOUND WATERLOO ROAD DURING AND AFTER THE TIDAL FLOW PERIOD.

TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS FOR OPENING OF NEW ROADS IN TAI PO

\* \* \* \* \*

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCED THAT IN CONNECTION WITH THE OPENING OF ROAD D2, ROAD D1 BETWEEN NAM WAN ROAD AND ROAD D2, AND THE SLIP ROADS BETWEEN ROAD D2 AND TOLO HIGHWAY, SPECIAL TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE IMPLEMENTED FROM 10 AM ON THURSDAY (MARCH 23).

THE SLIP ROADS BETWEEN TOLO HIGHWAY AND ROAD D2 WILL BE SUBJECT TO A SPEED LIMIT OF 80 KILOMETRES PER HOUR.

ALL PUBLIC LIGHT BUSES WILL BE BANNED FROM ROAD D2, ROAD D1 BETWEEN NAM WAN ROAD AND ROAD D2, AND THE SLIP ROADS BETWEEN TOLO HIGHWAY AND ROAD D2.

AT THE SAME TIME, THE FOLLOWING ROAD SECTIONS WILL BE DESIGNATED 7 AM TO MIDNIGHT DAILY URBAN CLEARWAYS :

- \* ROAD D1 BETWEEN NAM WAN ROAD AND ROAD D2;
- \* TING KOK ROAD FROM A POINT ABOUT 200 METRES WEST OF ITS JUNCTION WITH ROAD D2 TO THE ACCESS ROAD LEADING TO YUE KOK VILLAGE; AND
- \* ROAD D2 FROM ITS JUNCTION WITH TING KOK ROAD TO A POINT ABOUT 125 METRES SOUTH OF ITS JUNCTION WITH ROAD D1.

MOREOVER, THE FOLLOWING TWO ROAD SECTIONS WILL BE MADE URBAN CLEARWAYS ROUND-THE CLOCK :
