POLICE MAKE REMARKABLE CONTRIBUTIONS IN 1989

\* \* \* \* \*

ALTHOUGH 1989 WAS A PARTICULARLY EVENTFUL YEAR, THE ROYAL HONG KONG POLICE FORCE MANAGED TO ACCOMPLISH SOME EXCELLENT ACHIEVEMENTS IN TERMS OF KEEPING CRIME RATE AT A LOW LEVEL, AND MAKING RECORD HEROIN SEIZURES IN THE FIGHT AGAINST DRUGS.

SUCH REMARKABLE CONTRIBUTIONS WERE MADE AMIDST THE MASSIVE PUBLIC DEMONSTRATIONS AND PROCESSIONS IN THE WAKE OF STUDENT PRO-DEMOCRACY EVENTS IN CHINA, AND THE CONTINUING, AND ESCALATING, PROBLEMS RELATED TO THE VIETNAMESE BOAT PEOPLE ISSUE.

THIS WAS STATED BY COMMISSIONER OF POLICE, MR LI KWAN-HA IN THE ROYAL HONG KONG POLICE FORCE REVIEW 1989, WHICH WAS RELEASED TODAY (SUNDAY).

ON THE CRIME FRONT, MR LI SAID THAT IT WAS PLEASING TO NOTE THAT THROUGHOUT THE DECADE, POLICE WERE ABLE TO CONTAIN THE AVERAGE ANNUAL FIGURE OF REPORTED CRIME AT A LITTLE OVER 81,000.

"ALTHOUGH SHOWING AN INCREASE OF 3.3 PER CENT OVERALL, THE 1989'S FIGURE OF A LITTLE UNDER 82,000 REPORTED CRIMES WAS MATCHED AGAINST ONE OF THE LOWEST TOTALS OF THE '80S REGISTERED IN 1988.

HOWEVER, MR LI EXPRESSED PARTICULAR CONCERN OVER THE RISE IN THE USE OF FIREARMS IN CRIME, AND THE INCREASING NUMBER OF FIREARMS SEIZED.

HE ADDED THAT THERE WERE ALSO ALARMING UPWARD TRENDS IN CRIME BEING COMMITTED BY YOUNG PEOPLE UNDER THE AGE OF 21, AND IN VIOLENT CRIMES INVOLVING JUVENILES.

POINTING OUT THAT 1989 WAS YET ANOTHER EXCEPTIONAL YEAR IN CRACKING DOWN ON DRUG TRAFFICKING, MR LI SAID THAT CONTINUED CLOSE COOPERATION WITH DRUG ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES ABROAD AND DILIGENT WORK BY HONG KONG'S DRUG FIGHTERS HAD LED TO RECORD HEROIN SEIZURES EXCEEDING 1,000 KILOGRAMMES AND IN THE NEUTRALISATION OF 16 HIGHLY ORGANISED LOCAL AND INTERNATIONAL SYNDICATES.

ON THE PROBLEM OF WASTAGE AND RECRUITMENT, THE POLICE CHIEF SAID THAT THERE WAS A SHORTFALL OF 470 IN STRENGTH AGAINST ESTABLISHMENT, A 1.7 PER CENT DEFICIENCY, AT THE END OF 1989. HE ALSO POINTED OUT THAT THERE WAS A CONSIDERABLE FALLING OFF IN APPLICATIONS FOR BOTH INSPECTORATE AND JUNIOR OFFICERS WHICH WAS DISTURBING.

"IN AN ATTEMPT TO ALLEVIATE THE SITUATION, WE HAVE INTENSIFIED OUR RECRUITING EFFORTS, AND ARE ADDRESSING THE PROBLEMS OF PAY AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT," MR LI SAID.

LOOKING AHEAD, MR LI SAID THAT THE POLICE FORCE WAS EMBARKING ON AN EXCITING ERA WHICH SAW THE REPLACEMENT OF THE AGEING COMMAND AND CONTROL SYSTEM, THE CONTINUATION OF THE BUILDING PROGRAMME TO COPE WITH THE GROWTH OF POLICE COMMITMENTS AS A RESULT OF THE OVERALL DEVELOPMENT OF THE TERRITORY, AS WELL AS THE TAKING OVER OF BORDER DUTIES FROM THE ARMY.

STUDY ON NORTH LANTAU DEVELOPMENT

\* \* \* \* \*

DEVELOPMENT IN TUNG CHUNG, THE FIRST PHASE OF NORTH LANTAU DEVELOPMENT, WILL FORM AN ESSENTIAL PART OF THE OVERALL NEW AIRPORT PROJECT.

WITH A TOTAL AREA OF ABOUT 570 HECTARES, TUNG CHUNG AND TAI HO, TOGETHER WITH OTHER PARTS OF NORTH LANTAU WILL BE DEVELOPED INTO AIRPORT SUPPORTING COMMUNITIES WITH RESIDENTIAL AND AIRPORT-RELATED COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL ESTABLISHMENTS.

THE DEVELOPMENT ZONE WILL ALSO INCLUDE RECLAIMED LAND ALONG THE NORTH LANTAU COAST FROM SHAM SHUI KOK TO THE AIRPORT FOR GENERAL INDUSTRY PURPOSES.

THE PLANNING OF EACH OF THE NEW TOWN DEVELOPMENTS IN TUNG CHUNG AND TAI HO IS AIMED AT PROVIDING A BALANCED COMMUNITY WITH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE HOUSING AS WELL AS A FULL RANGE OF SUPPORTING COMMUNITY AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES.

THE GOVERNMENT WILL ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH A CONSULTANCY FIRM ON WORKS RELATING TO THE NORTH LANTAU DEVELOPMENT.

THE ACTING DIRECTOR OF TERRITORY DEVELOPMENT, MR CHOW CHE-KING, WILL SIGN THE AGREEMENT WITH REPRESENTATIVES FOR MOTT MACDONALD HONG KONG LIMITED, CONSULTANT ENGINEERS ON TUESDAY (AUGUST 7).

THE CONSULTANCY AGREEMENT WILL INCLUDE A COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT STUDY OF THE NORTH LANTAU AREA AND THE SUBSEQUENT DESIGNS AND WORKS SUPERVISION OF THE CONTRACTS.

SWD HOTLINE SERVICE WELL PATRONISED

\* \* \* \* \*

THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT'S HOTLINE SERVICE HAS HANDLED MORE THAN 12,000 ENQUIRIES IN THE FIRST SIX MONTHS OF THIS YEAR, REPRESENTING A TWO-FOLD INCREASE OVER THE SAME PERIOD LAST YEAR.

A DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN ATTRIBUTED THE INCREASE TO THE INTRODUCTION OF NEW SERVICES SUCH AS OCCASIONAL CHILD CARE SERVICE, AFTER-SCHOOL CARE SERVICE AND THE LOWERING OF ELIGIBILITY AGE FOR OLD AGE ALLOWANCE TO 66.

"THE HIGHEST NUMBER WAS RECORDED IN MARCH WHEN THE HOTLINE RECEIVED 2,600 CALLS. MOST OF THE ENQUIRIES ARE IN CONNECTION WITH THE REVISION OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE PAYMENT AND THE ELIGIBILITY AGE FOR OLD AGE ALLOWANCE," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

HE SAID THE HOTLINE SERVICE ALSO PROVIDED ASSISTANCE TO PROBLEM FAMILIES.

"SOME PEOPLE CALLED IN BECAUSE THEY HAD A CHILD CARE PROBLEM. OUR SOCIAL WORKERS WHO MANNED THE HOTLINE WOULD REFER THEM TO FAMILY SERVICES CENTRES FOR ASSISTANCE.

"IN CASES WHEN THE CALLER EXPRESSED PROBLEM WITH OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS, OUR DUTY OFFICER WOULD TRY TO PACIFY THEIR EMOTION AND REFER THEM TO SOCIAL WORKERS OF FAMILY SERVICES CENTRES FOR COUNSELLING AND OTHER FORM OF ASSISTANCE," HE ADDED.

HE SAID THE HOTLINE PROVED TO BE AN EFFECTIVE CHANNEL FOR THE PUBLIC TO OBTAIN IMMEDIATE INFORMATION ON THE DEPARTMENT'S SERVICES, TO PROVIDE ON-LINE COUNSELLING AND FOLLOW-UP SERVICE.

THE HOTLINE IS MANNED BY FOUR SOCIAL WORK ASSISTANTS BY ROTATION FROM 9 AM TO 10 PM MONDAY TO SATURDAY AND FROM 1 PM TO 10 PM ON SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS. AN AUTOMATIC RECORDING SYSTEM ALSO OPERATES OUTSIDE NORMAL WORKING HOURS.

"MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC MAY TELEPHONE 343 2255 IF THEY REQUIRE ANY FORM OF SOCIAL WELFARE ASSISTANCE OR ADVICE," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

CNTA'S ENQUIRY CENTRES ASSIST NEARLY NINE MILLION PEOPLE

DURING THE FIRST SIX MONTHS OF THIS YEAR, MORE THAN 8.8 MILLION PEOPLE SOUGHT ASSISTANCE FROM THE CITY AND NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION'S (CNTA) 70 PUBLIC ENQUIRY SERVICE CENTRES (PESC'S).

A CNTA SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY (SUNDAY) THAT THE FIGURE REPRESENTED AN INCREASE OF 0.5 MILLION PEOPLE, OR 5.8 PER CENT, OVER THE SAME PERIOD LAST YEAR.

THE 70 CENTRES, STRATEGICALLY LOCATED THROUGHOUT THE TERRITORY, PROVIDE A WIDE RANGE OF PUBLIC SERVICES.

THESE SERVICES RANGE FROM HANDLING GENERAL ENQUIRIES, ADVISING ON GOVERNMENT SERVICES, DISTRIBUTING FORMS AND OTHER PUBLICITY MATERIALS, ADMINISTERING DECLARATIONS AND OATHS, AND MANAGING THE FREE LEGAL ADVICE SCHEME AND THE RENT OFFICER SCHEME.

DURING THE PERIOD, 445,000 DECLARATIONS AND OATHS WERE ADMINISTERED, MAINLY FOR THE TRUE COPY OF DOCUMENTS, EMIGRATION, DISPUTES, EDUCATION AND EXAMINATION.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT UNDER THE FREE LEGAL ADVICE SCHEME WHICH IS JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE LAW SOCIETY AND THE CNTA, A TOTAL OF 1,872 CASES WERE REFERRED TO THE LAW SOCIETY.

FROM JANUARY TO JUNE THIS YEAR, 9,571 PEOPLE CONSULTED THE RENT OFFICERS OF THE RATING AND VALUATION DEPARTMENT POSTED AT THE 16 DISTRICT OFFICES TO HANDLE RENT AND TENANCY PROBLEMS.

THE POST OFFICE WILL SET UP A SALES BOOTH AT THE EXHIBITION TO PROMOTE AND SELL HONG KONG'S PHILATELIC PRODUCTS.

ACCORDING TO THE EXPERIENCE OF THE RECIPROCAL SALES ARRANGEMENTS BETWEEN SINGAPORE POST OFFICE AND HONG KONG POST OFFICE, SPECIAL STAMPS ON THE 12 LUNAR NEW YEAR ANIMALS ARE POPULAR IN SINGAPORE.

NEW FIRE STATION FOR SHA TIN

THE ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT IS INVITING TENDERS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SUB-DIVISIONAL FIRE STATION AT A 3,370-SQUARE-METRE SITE IN AREA 14B, SHA TIN.

DB HELPS SOLVE RESIDENTS' PROBLEMS

OBSTRUCTIONS TO AN ACCESS ROAD TO POK FU LAM VILLAGE HAVE NOW BEEN CLEARED AFTER A CIVIC-MINDED RESIDENT RELAYED THE PROBLEM TO THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT BOARD.

USING THE "MY SUGGESTION TO SOUTHERN DISTRICT BOARD" POSTGRAMME, THE RESIDENT INFORMED THE DISTRICT BOARD THAT THE ACCESS ROAD, NEAR THE JUNCTION OF POK FU LAM ROAD AND CHI FU ROAD, WAS OFTEN BLOCKED BY REFUSE AND ILLEGALLY PARKED VEHICLES.

/THE DISTRICT .....

THE DISTRICT BOARD SOUGHT ASSISTANCE FROM THE DISTRICT LANDS OFFICE. CLEARANCE OPERATIONS WERE SUBSEQUENTLY HELD AND THE ACCESS ROAD HAD SINCE BEEN KEPT CLEAR.

IN ANOTHER CASE, THE PLIGHT OF TWO HOMELESS MEN CAME TO LIGHT AFTER A KIND-HEARTED LADY WROTE TO THE DISTRICT BOARD ON THEIR BEHALF.

THE TWO ELDERLY MEN WERE EVENTUALLY REHOUSED IN PUBLIC HOUSING FOLLOWING THE REFERRAL ON THE CASE TO THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT.

THE POSTGRAMME SCHEME WAS INTRODUCED BY THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT BOARD IN 1983 TO FACILITATE RESIDENTS TO VOICE THEIR VIEWS.

THE SCHEME ALSO ENABLED RESIDENTS TO SEEK HELP FROM THE DISTRICT BOARD, A DB SPOKESMAN SAID.

BETWEEN JANUARY AND JULY THIS YEAR, THE DISTRICT BOARD HAD HANDLED MORE THAN 30 POSTGRAMMES COVERING SUBJECTS RANGING FROM ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT, TRAFFIC, TRANSPORT, HOUSING, AND COMMUNITY BUILDING TO POSTAL SERVICE.

THE POSTAGE-FREE POSTGRAMMES ARE OBTAINABLE AT MORE THAN 70 DISTRIBUTION POINTS THROUGHOUT THE DISTRICT. THESE INCLUDE THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT OFFICE AND ITS SUB-OFFICES, POST OFFICES, GOVERNMENT OFFICES, COMMUNITY HALLS, PETROL STATIONS AND RESIDENTS' ORGANISATIONS.
