SCHEME TO PROMOTE PHAB CONCEPT

* * * * *

THE DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE, MRS ELIZABETH WONG, TODAY (SATURDAY) CALLED FOR CLOSER CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE HANDICAPPED AND THE ABLE-BODIED IN SERVING THE COMMUNITY.

SHE WAS OFFICIATING AT THE SENDING-OFF CEREMONY FOR THE RECIPIENTS OF THE PHAB TRAVEL AWARD SCHEME IN A CENTRAL HOTEL.

THE 30 RECIPIENTS HAVE BEEN SELECTED FOR THEIR LONG AND DEDICATED CONTRIBUTION TO COMMUNITY SERVICE AND THEY COMPRISED 21 HANDICAPPED AND NINE ABLE-BODIED PERSONS.

MRS WONG SAID THE RECIPIENTS ALL HAD A POSITIVE OUTLOOK OF LIFE.

"WHAT IS MORE COMMENDABLE IS THAT THEY ARE WILLING TO DEVOTE THEIR LEISURE, ENERGY, EXPERTISE AND LOVE TO SERVE PEOPLE WHO ARE MORE IN NEED THAN THEY ARE," SHE SAID.

SHE COMPLIMENTED THE HONG KONG PHAB ASSOCIATION FOR ITS UNCEASING EFFORTS IN PROMOTING THE PHAB CONCEPT WHICH ENABLES HANDICAPPED AND ABLE-BODIED PERSONS TO JOIN TOGETHER FOR RECREATIONAL, EDUCATIONAL, VOCATIONAL TRAINING AND COMMUNITY SERVICE TRAINING ACTIVITIES TO IMPROVE MUTUAL CO-OPERATION AND UNDERSTANDING FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE HANDICAPPED IN PARTICULAR AND THE COMMUNITY IN GENERAL.

SHE ALSO APPEALED TO THE COMMUNITY AT LARGE AND THE COMMERCIAL ORGANISATIONS TO LEND THEIR SUPPORT TO MEANINGFUL ACTIVITIES SUCH AS THIS TRAVEL AWARD SCHEME WHICH IS CO-ORGANISED BY THE ASSOCIATION AND A TRAVEL AGENT AND SPONSORED BY A TV STATION.

THE RECIPIENTS WILL BE LEAVING FOR A TOUR ON SEPTEMBER 5 TO PEKING AND CANTON DURING WHICH THEY WILL VISIT REHABILITATION INSITUATIONS AND THE PHAB CLUBS THERE.

HONG KONG PAVILION A HIT AT SAN FRANCISCO'S PACIFIC RIM FAIR

* * * * *

HONG KONG AND SIX PACIFIC RIM SISTER CITIES ARE THE FOCAL POINT OF THE SAN FRANCISCO FAIR AND INTERNATIONAL EXPOSITION BEING HELD FROM AUGUST 27 TO 30.

AS MANY AS 100,000 PEOPLE ARE EXPECTED TO VISIT THE CIVIC CENTER IN THE HEART OF THE CITY TO ATTEND THE FOUR-DAY FAIR WITH ITS 'GATEWAY TO THE PACIFIC' THEME. SOME 170 PACIFIC RIM GROUPS ARE REPRESENTED, INCLUDING CONSUMER GOODS AND SERVICE ORGANISATIONS AS WELL AS NATIONAL PAVILIONS.

THE HONG KONG PAVILION, CO-SPONSORED BY THE HONG KONG ECONOMIC AFFAIRS OFFICE, HONG KONG TOURIST ASSOCIATION, CATHAY PACIFIC AIRWAYS AND HONG KONG TRADE DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL, IS PROVING TO BE ONE OF THE MOST POPULAR ATTRACTIONS AND PRESENTS FAIR GOERS WITH AN IMMEDIATE AND VITAL IMPRESSION OF THE TERRITORY AS A MODERN, DYNAMIC CITY FOR BUSINESS, TRADE AND TOURISM.

HIGHLIGHTING THE TWO-WAY LINKS BETWEEN THE TWO CITIES, THE PAVILION INCLUDES DISPLAYS OF CALIFORNIA'S MAJOR IMPORTS TO HONG KONG - FOR EXAMPLE, ORANGES, WINE, AND OTHER AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS - AS WELL AS HONG KONG'S EXPORTS TO THE UNITED STATES OF GARMENTS, TOYS AND ELECTRONIC ITEMS.

THE TERRITORY'S COMMUNICATIONS ARE ON SHOW WITH A DISPLAY BY CATHAY PACIFIC AIRWAYS, WHILE FINANCE, ARCHITECTURE AND TRADE LINKS ARE ALSO PINPOINTED. TOURISM IS WELL REPRESENTED WITH SOME TYPICAL HONG KONG SCENES OF THE TERRITORY AND OVERHEAD STREET SIGNS. A HARBOUR NIGHT SCENE PROVIDES A HUGE PICTORIAL BACKDROP.

THIS ANNUAL FAIR HAS DEVELOPED OVER THE PAST SIX YEARS TO REPRESENT THE DIVERSE POPULATION OF SAN FRANCISCO AND ITS OVERSEAS LINKS, GIVING IT AN INCREASINGLY INTERNATIONAL FLAVOUR. SHARING SISTER CITY RELATIONSHIPS WITH SAN FRANCISCO, THE OTHER CITIES TAKING PART ARE MANILA, OSAKA, SEOUL, SHANGHAI, SYDNEY AND TAIPEI.

OPENING THE FAIR, CALIFORNIA SECRETARY OF STATE, MARCH FONG EU PRAISED HONG KONG AND THE SISTER CITIES FOR THEIR HELP IN PUTTING TOGETHER SUCH AN INTERNATIONAL DISPLAY, AND NOTED THE SUCCESSFUL AND GROWING BLEND BETWEEN EASTERN AND WESTERN CULTURES IN THE CITY OF SAN FRANCISCO.

"IN VIEW OF HONG KONG'S UNIQUE POSITION IN THE PACIFIC RIM IN TRADE, FINANCE, INVESTMENT AND TOURISM, IT IS NATURAL THAT HONG KONG'S PARTICIPATION, FOR THE FIRST TIME IN THE HISTORY OF THE FAIR, HAS ATTRACTED SO MUCH INTEREST AMONG THE NUMEROUS VISITORS," SAID DIRECTOR OF HONG KONG ECONOMIC AFFAIRS IN SAN FRANCISCO, BILLY LAM.

COMPUTER IMPROVES PRESSURE EQUIPMENT REGISTRATION

* * * * *

A MICRO-COMPUTER HAS BEEN INSTALLED BY THE PRESSURE EQUIPMENT DIVISION OF THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT TO FACILITATE REGISTRATION OF PRESSURE EQUIPMENT AND RETRIEVAL OF INFORMATION.

AT PRESENT THE DIVISION MAINTAINS SOME 110,000 RECORD CARDS ON ALL PRESSURE EQUIPMENT INSTALLED THROUGHOUT HONG KONG.

AS THE NUMBER OF SUCH EQUIPMENT GROWS, THE TIME NEEDED TO UPKEEP THE DATA AND THE DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY IN GETTING THE NECESSARY INFORMATION HAVE CORRESPONDINGLY INCREASED.

"WITH THE INSTALLATION OF THE COMPUTER SYSTEM WHICH COSTS ABOUT \$375,000, INFORMATION ON PRESSURE EQUIPMENT CAN BE MORE ACCURATELY AND SYSTEMATICALLY MAINTAINED, TRANSCRIBED, ANALYSED AND COMPILED INTO DIFFERENT TYPES OF REPORTS AND RECORDS," A LABOUR DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID.

"IT IS ALSO EXPECTED TO HELP ELIMINATE DUPLICATED INFORMATION, REDUCE BACKLOG, IMPROVE MANAGEMENT INFORMATION FOR FUTURE PLANNING, AND IMPOSE BETTER CONTROL ON THE SAFE USE OF THE PRESSURE EQUIPMENT REGISTERED."

THE SPOKESMAN SAID STAFF OF THE DIVISION WERE NOW ENTERING ALL THE EXISTING DATA AND RELEVANT INFORMATION INTO THE COMPUTER AND THE SYSTEM IS EXPECTED TO BE FULLY IMPLEMENTED BY THE END OF OCTOBER.

THE PRESSURE EQUIPMENT DIVISION ENFORCES THE BOILERS AND PRESSURE RECEIVERS ORDINANCE WHICH PROVIDES CONTROL OVER THE USE AND OPERATION OF BOILERS AND PRESSURE RECEIVERS TO ENSURE ACCEPTABLE STANDARDS OF SAFETY.

UP TO THE END OF 1986, THERE WERE 18,991 BOILERS AND 44,758 PRESSURE RECEIVERS REGISTERED WITH THE DIVISION RESPECTIVELY.

TO ENSURE CONTROL AND COMPLIANCE WITH STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS, INSPECTORS (LAND BOILERS) FROM THE DIVISION CONDUCTED 3,122 SPOT CHECKS ON SUCH EQUIPMENT LAST YEAR RESULTING IN 268 PROSECUTIONS FOR BREACHES OF THE ORDINANCE.

TEACHERS RETURN FROM UK TRAINING COURSE

* * * * *

SEVENTY TEACHERS OF ENGLISH IN SECONDARY SCHOOLS WHO JUST COMPLETED A FOUR-WEEK "TOTAL IMMERSION" LANGUAGE TRAINING COURSE IN BRITAIN HAVE RETURNED TO HONG KONG.

THE ACTING DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION, MR DAVID LAN, WILL HOLD A TEA PARTY FOR THE TEACHERS AT LEE GARDENS HOTEL ON TUESDAY (SEPTEMBER 1) AFTERNOON.

THE TRAINING COURSE WAS PART OF A TWO-PRONGED PILOT SCHEME TO EXTEND THE CURRENT PACKAGE OF MEASURES OF STRENGTHENING THE TEACHING OF ENGLISH IN SECONDARY SCHOOLS. THE OTHER MEASURE IS A TWO-YEAR PILOT SCHEME TO EMPLOY EXPATRIATE TEACHERS OF ENGLISH TO TEACH IN SECONDARY SCHOOLS.

THE TEACHERS HAD ALREADY ATTENDED A 16-WEEK REFRESHER COURSE ORGANISED BY THE INSTITUTE OF LANGUAGE IN EDUCATION OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT AND A THREE-WEEK RESIDENTIAL COURSE IN THE CHINESE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG.

DURING THEIR STAY IN BRITAIN, THE TEACHERS STUDIED IN VARIOUS INSTITUTIONS WHICH HAD EXPERIENCE IN RUNNING COURSES FOR OVERSEAS TEACHERS OF ENGLISH AND LIVED WITH ENGLISH-SPEAKING FAMILIES.

THE TRAINING PROGRAMME OFFERED AN OPPORTUNITY FOR IN-SERVICE TEACHERS OF ENGLISH IN SECONDARY SCHOOLS TO FURTHER DEVELOP THEIR COMMUNICATIVE SKILLS.

PIERS FOR WESTERN WHOLESALE MARKET TO BE BUILT

* * * * *

WORK ON BUILDING THREE PIERS FOR THE WESTERN WHOLESALE MARKET IS EXPECTED TO START IN NOVEMBER.

THE WORK ALSO INCLUDES CONSTRUCTING A SEAWATER PUMPHOUSE AND ASSOCIATED MARINE FACILITIES AT THE MARKET NOW BEING DEVELOPED IN TWO PHASES ON WESTERN RECLAMATION OPPOSITE WHITTY STREET.

ON COMPLETION IN ABOUT 27 MONTHS, THE PIERS WILL FACILITATE LOADING AND UNLOADING ACTIVITIES AT THE MARKET AND THE PUMPHOUSE WILL SUPPLY COOLING WATER TO THE AIR-CONDITIONING SYSTEM SERVING THE MARKET COMPLEX.

THE CIVIL ENGINEERING SERVICES DEPARTMENT IS INVITING TENDERS WHICH SHOULD BE SUBMITTED BEFORE NOON ON SEPTEMBER 11.

THE DEPARTMENT'S PORT WORKS DIVISION HAS+ DESIGNED AND WILL SUPERVISE THE WORK.

TWO OTHER PIERS WILL ALSO BE BUILT FOR THE MARKET AT A LATER STAGE.

CONSTRUCTION OF LRT BRIDGE PROPOSED

THE TERRITORY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT PROPOSES TO CONSTRUCT A LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT (LRT) BRIDGE ALONGSIDE PUI TO ROAD AND CASTLE PEAK ROAD (SAN HUI) IN TUEN MUN.

ASSOCIATED WITH THE BRIDGEWORK, TWO ELEVATED WALKWAYS WILL BE BUILT TO CONNECT THE FUTURE LRT STOP ON THE LRT BRIDGE WITH TWO BUILDING DEVELOPMENTS.

LANDSCAPING WORKS, ASSOCIATED DRAINAGE AND ANCILLARY WORKS WILL ALSO BE CARRIED OUT.

THE CLOSURE AND REPROVISIONING OF AN EXISTING VEHICULAR ACCESS, REALIGNMENT OF EXISTING FOOTPATHS AND MODIFICATIONS OF AN EXISTING BOX CULVERT CROSSING TUEN MUN HEUNG SZE WUI ROAD ALSO FORM PART OF THE PROJECT.

OBJECTION TO THE PROPOSED WORKS SHOULD BE SENT IN WRITING TO THE SECRETARY FOR TRANSPORT BY OCTOBER 27.

LOCAL OPEN SPACE FOR TUNG TAU INDUSTRIAL AREA

A LOCAL OPEN SPACE IS TO BE BUILT AT TUNG TAU INDUSTRIAL AREA, YUEN LONG, TO PROVIDE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES FOR WORKERS THERE.

TENDERS FOR THE PROJECT ARE BEING INVITED BY THE ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT.

COVERING ABOUT 14,400 SQUARE METRES, THE OPEN SPACE IS LOCATED AT THE JUNCTION OF WANG YIP STREET EAST AND KEUNG YIP STREET.

THERE WILL BE TWO MINI SOCCER PITCHES AND A SITTING-OUT AREA WITH ARBOURS AND BENCHES.

WORK IS EXPECTED TO START IN OCTOBER AND TAKE 10 MONTHS TO COMPLETE.

WAN CHAI LAUNCHES FIGHT CRIME CAMPAIGN

A VARIETY SHOW WILL BE HELD IN THE SOUTHORN PLAYGROUND AT 4 PM TOMORROW (SUNDAY) TO MARK THE OPENING OF THIS YEAR'S WAN CHAI DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME CAMPAIGN.

PARTICIPANTS OF THE FUNCTION WILL BE ENTERTAINED WITH SINGING, DANCES, LION DANCE, MUSICAL INSTRUMENT AND BAND PERFORMANCES AS WELL AS TAKEWONDO DEMONSTRATIONS.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE WAN CHAI DISTRICT OFFICE SAID THAT WITH A BUDGET OF \$25,000, THE CAMPAIGN THIS YEAR WILL EMPHASISE ON HOME SECURITY, NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH SCHEME, ANTI-TRIAD EFFORTS, AS WELL AS THE PREVENTION OF SHOP THEFT AND JUVENILE CRIME.

PROGRAMMES PLANNED FOR THE FIGHT CRIME DRIVE INCLUDE AN ANTI-TRIAD CAMPAIGN IN NOVEMBER, A 'LIFT DISPLAY PROJECT' IN DECEMBER, SEMINARS ON CRIME PREVENTION, SETTING UP OF NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH UNITS AND A SINGING COMPETITION.

SUMMER YOUTH PROGRAMMES 'MEANINGFUL'

* * * * *

WITH THE PROGRESS OF SOCIETY AND THE PROMOTION OF CIVIC EDUCATION, YOUNG PEOPLE HAVE ACQUIRED AN INCREASINGLY IMPORTANT ROLE IN COMMUNITY AND YOUTH PROGRAMMES HAVE ACCORDINGLY AROUSED MORE PUBLIC INTEREST, SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT'S REGIONAL SOCIAL WELFARE OFFICER (NEW TERRITORIES), MR CARLOS LEUNG, SAID TODAY (SATURDAY).

HE WAS SPEAKING AT THE CLOSING CEREMONY OF THE SUMMER YOUTH PROGRAMME ORGANISED BY THE EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH SOCIAL SERVICE OF HONG KONG SHA TIN CHILDREN AND YOUTH CENTRE.

HE SAID THAT AS THE ENERGETIC AND ADVENTUROUS YOUNG PEOPLE WERE EASILY SUSCEPTIBLE TO BAD INFLUENCE, IT WAS THE COMMON GOAL OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT AND THE VOLUNTARY AGENCIES TO PLAN AND ORGANISE A VARIETY OF MEANINGFUL SUMMER ACTIVITIES FOR THE YOUTH DURING THE LONG SUMMER VACATION.

"THE DEPARTMENT HAS THEREFORE SPARED NO EFFORT IN PROVIDING SUMMER YOUTH PROGRAMMES.

"FOR EXAMPLE, THE OPPORTUNITY FOR YOUTH SCHEME, WHICH IS HELD ANNUALLY BY THE DEPARTMENT, PROVIDES A GOOD OPPORTUNITY FOR YOUNG PEOPLE TO TAKE PART IN COMMUNITY AFFAIRS AND DEVELOP THEIR POTENTIALS.

"EARLIER THIS MONTH, ABOUT 1,000 YOUTH VOLUNTEERS WERE MOBILISED TO SPREAD THE MESSAGE OF CARE TO THE ELDERLY UNDER THE 'CONCERN VISIT BY YOUTH VOLUNTEERS TO ELDERLY SINGLE PERSONS' PROGRAMME ORGANISED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
