SPEECH BY GOVERNOR AT DINNER FOR JLG TEAMS
* * * * *

FOLLOWING IS A SPEECH BY THE GOVERNOR, SIR EDWARD YOUDE, AT A DINNER FOR THE JOINT LIAISON GROUP AT GOVERNMENT HOUSE THIS (MONDAY) EVENING:

+AMBASSADOR KE, DR WILSON, LADIES AND GENTLEMEN,

+FIRST I WOULD LIKE TO WELCOME AMBASSADOR KE ZAISHUO AND HIS FELLOW CHINESE MEMBERS OF THE JOINT LIAISON GROUP. WE ALSO WELCOME DR WILSON AND HIS BRITISH COLLEAGUES FROM LONDON AND PEKING.

+UNDER THE JOINT DECLARATION THE JOINT LIAISON GROUP HAS IMPORTANT RESPONSIBILITIES. TO CARRY THEM OUT SUCCESSFULLY WILL CALL FOR JOINT EFFORTS AND A GREAT DEAL OF SERIOUS WORK.

+AS THE KEY ORGAN OF LIAISON THE JOINT LIAISON GROUP IS DEALING WITH MAJOR ISSUES WHICH WILL AFFECT THE CONFIDENCE OF THE HONG KONG COMMUNITY, THE PROSPECTS FOR OUR BUSINESSMEN AND THE INDIVIDUAL LIVES OF THE PEOPLE.

+THIS MEETING IS OF PARTICULAR SIGNIFICANCE FOR HONG KONG. THIS IS THE FIRST TIME THAT THE JOINT LIAISON GROUP HAS MET HERE AND THE PEOPLE OF HONG KONG WILL BE WATCHING IT CLOSELY. GOOD WORK HAS ALREADY BEEN DONE IN THE PEKING AND LONDON MEETINGS.

+YOUR AGENDA IS A FULL AND IMPORTANT ONE AND I AM SURE THAT BOTH SIDES IN THE LIAISON GROUP WILL TACKLE IT WITH SERIOUS PURPOSE. WE THUS LOOK FORWARD TO SIMILARLY SUCCESSFUL RESULTS FROM THIS MEETING HERE.

+IN ADDITION, AMBASSADOR KE, WE HOPE TO TAKE THE OPPORTUNITY OF SHOWING YOU AND YOUR COLLEAGUES SOMETHING OF HONG KONG. HONG KONG HAS MADE REMARKABLE PROGRESS OVER THE LAST DECADE AND THERE IS MUCH TO SEE.

+WITH THOSE REMARKS I WOULD ASK ALL PRESENT TO RAISE THEIR GLASSES TO THE HEALTH OF AMBASSADOR KE AND DR WILSON, TO THEIR COLLEAGUES FROM THE CHINESE AND BRITISH TEAMS AND TO THE CONTINUED PROGRESS IN THE JOINT LIAISON GROUP.+

SENIOR GOVERNMENT POSTINGS ANNOUNCED

THE SECRETARY (GENERAL DUTIES), MR PETER WILLIAMS, WILL LEAVE THE SERVICE ON COMPLETION OF HIS CONTRACT AT THE END OF 1986, IT WAS ANNOUNCED TODAY. MR WILLIAMS WILL HAVE BEEN IN POST FOR ABOUT TWO YEARS.

THE NEW SECRETARY (GENERAL DUTIES) WILL BE MR BARRIE WIGGHAM, WHO IS CURRENTLY REGIONAL SECRETARY (HONG KONG AND KOWLOON). MR WIGGHAM WILL LEAVE HIS PRESENT POST IN MAY 1986 AND WILL INITIALLY UNDERTAKE LANGUAGE STUDIES.

AFTER A PERIOD OF LEAVE HE IS TO BE SECONDED TO HM DIPLOMATIC SERVICE FOR A TEMPORARY APPOINTMENT AS COUNSELLOR AT THE BRITISH EMBASSY IN PEKING BETWEEN JULY AND OCTOBER, BEFORE RETURNING TO HONG KONG TO TAKE OVER FROM MR WILLIAMS.

MR CHAU TAK-HAY, PRESENTLY DEPUTY REGIONAL SECRETARY (HONG KONG AND KOWLOON), WILL TAKE OVER FROM MR WIGGHAM AND BECOME REGIONAL SECRETARY IN MAY.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

MR PETER WILLIAMS, CBE

AGED 59. JOINED THE CIVIL SERVICE IN FEBRUARY 1953 AS A CADET OFFICER CLASS II AND ROSE THROUGH A SERIES OF PROMOTIONS TO THE RANK OF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER STAFF GRADE A IN AUGUST 1975. HE RETIRED FROM THE CIVIL SERVICE IN AUGUST 1978. DURING 1979 AND 1980, HE SERVED AS SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE STANDING COMMISSION ON CIVIL SERVICE SALARIES AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE AND WAS THEN COMMISSIONER OF THE INDEPENDENT COMMISSION AGAINST CORRUPTION FROM 1980 TO THE END OF 1984. HE WAS RE-APPOINTED TO HIS PRESENT RANK OF SECRETARY, GOVERNMENT SECRETARIAT IN JANUARY 1985 AND SINCE THEN HAS BEEN THE SECRETARY (GENERAL DUTIES).

MR BARRIE WIGGHAM, JP

AGED 49. JOINED THE CIVIL SERVICE IN SEPTEMBER 1961 AS AN ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER AND WAS PROMOTED TO HIS PRESENT RANK OF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER STAFF GRADE A IN SEPTEMBER 1985. HE HAS SERVED IN A NUMBER OF DEPARTMENTS AND BRANCHES INCLUDING THE URBAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT, THE THEN COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY DEPARTMENT, THE ECONOMIC BRANCH AND THE FINANCE BRANCH. MORE RECENTLY, HE WAS DEPUTY SECRETARY, NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION FROM 1974 TO 1976, DEPUTY SECRETARY OF THE HOME AFFAIRS AND INFORMATION BRANCH FROM 1976 TO 1979 AND COMMISSIONER FOR RECREATION AND CULTURE FROM 1979 TO 1983. HE HAS BEEN IN HIS PRESENT POST OF REGIONAL SECRETARY (HONG KONG AND KOWLOON) SINCE SEPTEMBER 1983.

MR CHAU TAK-HAY, JP

AGED 43. JOINED THE CIVIL SERVICE IN JULY 1967. HE HAS SERVED FOR THE MAJORITY OF HIS CAREER IN THE FORMER COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY, AND TRADE INDUSTRY AND CUSTOMS DEPARTMENTS, WHERE HE BECAME A DEPUTY COMMISSIONER IN JULY 1979. HE TRANSFERRED AS AN ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER STAFF GRADE B IN JULY 1982 WHILE POSTED TO GENEVA AS COUNSELLOR (HONG KONG AFFAIRS). FOLLOWING HIS RETURN FROM GENEVA IN 1984 HE SERVED FIRST AS DEPUTY SECRETARY (HEALTH AND WELFARE) AND SINCE NOVEMBER 1985 HAS BEEN DEPUTY REGIONAL SECRETARY (HONG KONG AND KOWLOON).

CENTRAL WATER MAIN DIVERTED FOR UNDERPASS
* * * * *

THE WATER SUPPLIES DEPARTMENT HAS BEGUN WORK ON THE DIVERSION OF A MAJOR 42-INCH FRESH WATER MAIN ALONG CONNAUGHT ROAD EASTBOUND NEAR ITS JUNCTION WITH CONNAUGHT PLACE AND PEDDER STREET.

THE DIVERSION IS TO MAKE WAY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN UNDERPASS LATER THIS YEAR.

THE UNDERPASS WILL CARRY TRAFFIC IN BOTH DIRECTIONS ALONG CONNAUGHT ROAD UNDER THE JUNCTION WITH CONNAUGHT PLACE AND PEDDER STREET SO AS TO RELIEVE TRAFFIC CONGESTION.

THE DIVERSION WORKS WILL INVOLVE THE EXCAVATION OF A 1.5-METRE TO 2-METRE-WIDE TRENCH FOR THE LAYING OF THE NEW PIPELINE, AND THE CLOSING OF ONE TRAFFIC LANE IN STAGES ALONG SECTIONS OF CONNAUGHT ROAD EASTBOUND AND CONNAUGHT PLACE.

THE PHASING OF WORK, EXPECTED TO TAKE THREE TO FOUR MONTHS, IS TO MINIMISE DISRUPTION TO TRAFFIC.

FURTHER EXCAVATION WORKS FOR DIVERSION OF AIR CONDITIONING MAINS SERVING ADJACENT BUILDINGS AND FOR LAYING OF TELEPHONE CABLES WILL FOLLOW THE WATER MAIN DIVERSION.

MANPOWER BOOST SEEN FOR BANKING INDUSTRY
* * * * *

THE BANKING INDUSTRY IS EXPECTED TO EMPLOY MORE PEOPLE IN THE NEXT FEW YEARS, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE VOCATIONAL TRAINING COUNCIL SAID TODAY.

THIS IS REFLECTED IN THE FINDINGS OF A SURVEY PUBLISHED BY THE COUNCIL'S BANKING INDUSTRY TRAINING BOARD WHICH SHOWED THAT MANPOWER IN THE INDUSTRY ROSE FROM 53 200 IN 1982 TO 55 600 IN 1984.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID FOR THE NEXT THREE YEARS TO 1989 THE ANNUAL GROWTH IN THE NUMBER OF BANK EMPLOYEES WOULD BE ABOUT TWO PER CENT WHILE THE GROWTH RATE FOR DEPOSIT-TAKING COMPANIES WOULD BE 3.4 PER CENT.

DURING THE PERIOD BETWEEN 1982 AND 1984, THE NUMBER OF BANKS INCREASED FROM 132 TO 139, AND THE NUMBER OF BRANCHES WENT UP FROM 1 346 TO 1 547, AN INCREASE OF 15 PER CENT.

ACCORDING TO THE SURVEY, THE ONLY SECTOR IN THE INDUSTRY WHICH SHOWED A DECLINE WAS REGISTERED DEPOSIT-TAKING COMPANIES, WITH A MANPOWER DROP OF 32 PER CENT FROM 5 300 TO 3 600.

THE BOARD ATTRIBUTED THIS TO THE FACT THAT DURING THE PERIOD A LARGE NUMBER OF MAJOR REGISTERED DEPOSIT-TAKING COMPANIES CHANGED THEIR STATUS TO LICENSED DEPOSIT-TAKING COMPANIES.

THE SURVEY FINDINGS ALSO SHOWED THAT SMALL BANKS IN HONG KONG WERE NOT PROVIDING ENOUGH TRAINING FOR THEIR STAFF, EVEN THOUGH THE ARRANGING OF ON-THE-JOB TRAINING WAS NOT BEYOND THEIR ABILITY.

THE SURVEY FOUND THAT LARGER BANKS DID MORE OFF-THE-JOB TRAINING THAN OTHER FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS AND MEDIUM-SIZED BANKS PROVIDED MORE ON-THE-JOB TRAINING.

THE SURVEY ESTIMATED THAT IT WAS NECESSARY FOR AN ADDITIONAL 5 500 EMPLOYEES IN BANKING INDUSTRIES TO BE GIVEN OFF-THE-JOB TRAINING EACH YEAR.

THE BANKING TRAINING BOARD HAS THEREFORE PROPOSED THE SETTING UP OF A TRAINING CENTRE TO OFFER OFF-THE-JOB TRAINING. THIS PROPOSAL HAS BEEN SUBMITTED TO THE VOCATIONAL TRAINING COUNCIL FOR CONSIDERATION.

THE REPORT, CONTAINING DETAILED MANPOWER STATISTICS AND TRAINING REQUIREMENTS OF THE HONG KONG BANKING INDUSTRY, IS ON SALE AT THE GOVERNMENT PUBLICATION SALES CENTRE AT \$25 A COPY.

MEDICAL STAFF AWARDED LONG SERVICE CERTIFICATES
* * * * *

A TOTAL OF 383 MEMBERS OF THE MEDICAL AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT, INCLUDING DOCTORS, NURSES, PARA-MEDICAL STAFF, WORKMEN, DRIVERS, WARD ATTENDANTS, AMAHS AND DARKROOM TECHNICIANS, WERE PRESENTED WITH LONG SERVICE MERIT CERTIFICATES TODAY (MONDAY).

LAUNCHED FOR THE FIRST TIME THIS YEAR, THE LONG SERVICE MERIT CERTIFICATE SCHEME WILL BE OPERATED ON AN ANNUAL BASIS BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE BEGINNING OF EACH YEAR.

THE DEPARTMENT HAS A STAFF OF 25 000 SERVING IN 85 DIFFERENT GRADES. THOSE WHO HAVE WORKED FOR 30 YEARS OR MORE AND HAVE PERFORMED THEIR DUTIES SATISFACTORILY WITHIN AT LEAST THE PAST 10 YEARS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE AWARD.

TO MARK THE LAUNCHING OF THE SCHEME, A PRESENTATION CEREMONY WAS HELD AT THE KWAI CHUNG HOSPITAL ASSEMBLY HALL THIS AFTERNOON.

PRAISING THE RECIPIENTS, DR THONG, WHO MADE THE PRESENTATION, SAID THE DEPARTMENT NOW PROVIDED A COMPREHENSIVE AND INCREASINGLY SOPHISTICATED SERVICE TO THE COMMUNITY AT LARGE.

THE PERFORMANCE OF THE DEPARTMENT COULD BE REFLECTED BY COMMONLY USED INDICATORS OF THE HEALTH OF A COMMUNITY.

HE SAID DURING THE PAST 30 YEARS, THE CRUDE DEATH RATE HAD DROPPED FROM 7.4 TO 4.7 PER THOUSAND POPULATION AND THE INFANT MORTALITY RATE HAD IMPROVED SUBSTANTIALLY FROM 60.9 TO 7.6 PER THOUSAND LIVE BIRTHS. AVERAGE LIFE EXPECTANCY WAS NOW 73 FOR MALES AND 79 FOR FEMALES.

DR THONG SAID THAT COMPARED TO THE EARLY 1950'S, THERE WAS AN EIGHT-FOLD INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF HOSPITAL BEDS AND A TEN-FOLD INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF PATIENTS TREATED.

+IN A HIGHLY MATERIALISTIC SOCIETY AND AMID EVER RISING COSTS, WE TEND TO ALL WHO SEEK OUR HELP, EVEN TO THOSE WHO CANNOT AFFORD THE NOMINAL CHARGES LEVIED.

+ZIN SHORT, PEOPLE IN HONG KONG ARE NOW HEALTHIER AND ENJOY MEDICAL CARE OF A VERY HIGH STANDARD.

+THESE GRATIFYING RESULTS WOULD NOT HAVE BEEN POSSIBLE WITHOUT THE PROFESSIONALISM AND DEDICATION OF INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS OF THE DEPARTMENT,+ DR THONG SAID.

REFRESHER COURSE IN ENGLISH FOR PRIMARY TEACHERS

THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT HAS COMMISSIONED THE BRITISH COUNCIL TO RUN A SERIES OF REFRESHER COURSES FOR TEACHERS OF ENGLISH IN PRIMARY SCHOOLS AND APPLICATIONS ARE NOW OPEN.

THE COURSES ARE AIMED AT ORIENTATING TEACHERS TO THE REVISED PRIMARY ENGLISH SYLLABUS AND TO INTRODUCE TEACHERS TO A RANGE OF COMMUNICATIVE TEACHING TECHNIQUES AS WELL AS TO IMPROVE FLUENCY AND ACCURACY IN SPOKEN ENGLISH AMONG TEACHERS.

THE 90-HOUR COURSE WILL BE HELD AT THE BRITISH COUNCIL AT HENNESSY ROAD, WAN CHAI, BETWEEN APRIL 14 AND JULY 4, AN EDUCATION DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID.

TO FURTHER IMPROVE PARTICIPANTS' PROFICIENCY IN ORAL ENGLISH, TEACHERS WHO HAVE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THE REFRESHER COURSE MAY ENROL (FREE OF CHARGE) FOR A TERM OF ABOUT THREE MONTHS IN ENGLISH CLASSES AT THE BRITISH COUNCIL.
