WALLA-WALLA FARE INCREASES
* * * *

THE HIRE CHARGES FOR WALLA-WALLAS WILL BE INCREASED WITH EFFECT FROM SATURDAY (DECEMBER 1).

THE INCREASES WILL BE 100 PER CENT FOR MOST OF THE HIRINGS BOTH ON TIME AND JOURNEY BASIS.

THE FARE FOR THE LATE NIGHT WALLA-WALLA SERVICE BETWEEN KOWLOON PUBLIC PIER AND QUEEN'S PIER WILL BE INCREASED FROM \$1.50 TO \$3.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT SAID THE NEW RATES WERE AGREED FOLLOWING LENGTHY DISCUSSIONS WITH THE HONGKONG AND KOWLOON MOTOR BOATS ASSOCIATION AND A DETAILED EXAMINATION OF THE FUTURE VIABILITY OF THE OPERATION OF WALLA-WALLA SERVICES AGAINST THE RISING OPERATION COSTS, PARTICULARLY FOR CREWS AND FUEL.

DETAILS OF THE NEW CHARGES WILL BE DISPLAYED BOTH IN CHINESE AND ENGLISH IN EVERY BOAT AND AT THE WALLA-WALLA BOOKING OFFICES.

THE LAST INCREASE FOR WALLA-WALLA CHARGES WAS IN APRIL 1977.

NEW RE-ENTRY PERMIT OFFICE IN KOWLOON

THE IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT WILL OPEN A NEW RE-ENTRY PERMIT OFFICE IN YAU MA TEI ON MONDAY (DECEMBER 3) TO COPE WITH THE GROWING DEMAND FOR TRAVEL DOCUMENTS BY LOCAL RESIDENTS TRAVELLING TO CHINA AND MACAU.

THE NEW OFFICE ON THE SECOND FLOOR OF THE CANTON ROAD GOVERNMENT OFFICES IS TO REPLACE THE EXISTING TEMPORARY OFFICE IN MORRISON STREET ON HONG KONG ISLAND WHICH WILL BE CLOSED TOMORROW (FRIDAY).

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT SAID WITH THE OPENING OF THIS OFFICE, IT IS EXPECTED THAT THE WORKLOAD OF OTHER BRANCH OFFICES WILL BE CONSIDERABLY EASED.

THE CANTON ROAD OFFICE TOGETHER WITH THE EXISTING RE-ENTRY PERMIT OFFICE IN RUMSEY STREET, CENTRAL ONLY DEAL WITH THE ISSUE OF RE-ENTRY PERMITS TO HONG KONG RESIDENTS TRAVELLING TO AND FROM CHINA AND MACAU.

LIKE OTHER BRANCH OFFICES, THE NEW OFFICE WILL ACCEPT APPLICATIONS FROM 9 AM TO 4.30 PM ON WEEKDAYS- AND 9 AM TO 12.30 PM ON SATURDAYS.

THE SPOKESMAN ALSO URGED MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC WHO WISH TO TRAVEL DURING THE COMING CHRISTMAS AND LUNAR NEW YEAR HOLIDAYS TO APPLY EARLY FOR TRAVEL DOCUMENTS TO AVOID LAST MINUTE RUSH.

INLAND REVENUE DEPARTMENT MOVES TO WINDSOR HOUSE

SEVERAL SECTIONS OF THE INLAND REVENUE DEPARTMENT ON HONG KONG ISLAND WILL BE MOVING TO WINDSOR HOUSE AT 311 GLOUCESTER ROAD, CAUSEWAY BAY DURING THE NEXT FORTNIGHT.

THE MOVE TO THE NEW ADDRESS IS THE DEPARTMENT'S STAGE II REMOVAL. THE FIRST STAGE ALREADY TOOK PLACE IN JUNE THIS YEAR.

IN THE CURRENT STAGE OF REMOVAL, THE PROFITS TAX SECTION (UNIT 1) IN PERMANENT COMFORT BUILDING AND WORLD TRADE CENTRE WILL MOVE TO 21ST TO 25TH FLOORS WINDSOR HOUSE ON DECEMBER 1, 2, 8 AND 9.

THE COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE AND THE HEADQUARTERS UNIT IN BASKERVILLE HOUSE WILL MOVE TO 26TH FLOOR WINDSOR HOUSE ON DECEMBER 15 AND 16 WHILE THE INVESTIGATION SECTION (UNIT 4) IN BASKERVILLE HOUSE IS SCHEDULED TO MOVE TO 20TH FLOOR ON DECEMBER 16.

SECTIONS NOW OPERATING IN WINDSOR HOUSE INCLUDE THE INSPECTORATE, DEFAULT, COLLECTIONS, STAMP DUTY, BUSINESS REGISTRATION AND ESTATE DUTY, COMPUTER, TRAINING, PROPERTY TAX, INTEREST TAX, PERSONAL ASSESSMENT AND SALARIES TAX.

MOST NT SWIMMING FACILITIES TO CLOSE FOR WINTER

THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT WILL CLOSE THE KWAI CHUNG SWIMMING POOL COMPLEX AND FACILITIES AT ALL GAZETTED BEACHES IN THE NEW TERRITORIES FROM SATURDAY (DECEMBER 1) UNTIL THE END OF NEXT FEBRUARY.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY (THURSDAY) +IN VIEW OF THE COLD WINTER WEATHER WHEN FEWER PEOPLE GO SWIMMING, WE SHALL BE CLOSING THE KWAI CHUNG SWIMMING POOL FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR+.

+THIS WINTER, THE WORK WILL INCLUDE CLEARING REFUSE FROM INSIDE THE FILTRATION PLANT, REPLACING THE DAMAGED MOSAIC TILES AND CHECKING THE CHLORINATOR AND DRAINAGE SYSTEM OF THE SWIMMING POOLS.+

+HOWEVER,+ THE SPOKESMAN ADDED, +SWIMMERS IN THE FANLING AREA WILL BE ABLE TO USE THE HEATED POOL OF THE FANLING SWIMMING POOL COMPLEX WHICH WILL OPERATE THREE SESSIONS A DAY DURING THIS PERIOD FROM 9.45 AM TO 12 NOON, 1 PM - 4 PM AND 4.30 PM - 6.45 PM.+

ACTING GOVERNOR TO OPEN ASIAN YOUTH MUSIC CAMP

THE ACTING GOVERNOR, SIR JACK CATER, WILL OFFICIALLY OPEN THE 1979 ASIAN YOUTH MUSIC CAMP TO BE HELD AT THE WU KAI SHA YOUTH CAMP ON TUESDAY (DECEMBER 4).

THE CAMP, THE THIRD OF ITS KIND TO BE HELD IN ASIA, IS JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE MUSIC ADMINISTRATOR'S OFFICE AND THE ASIAN YOUTH MUSIC CAMP ASSOCIATION IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE URBAN COUNCIL.

THE OPENING CEREMONY WILL BEGIN AT 3 PM AND WILL BE ATTENDED BY PARTICIPANTS FROM 11 COUNTRIES. THE 1979 ASIAN YOUTH ORCHESTRA, THE HONG KONG YOUTH SYMPHONIC BAND AND THE HONG KONG YOUTH CHINESE ORCHESTRA WILL PERFORM DURING THE CEREMONY.

NEED FOR CO-OPERATION BETWEEN SCHOOL AND INDUSTRY

A PAPER WILL SHORTLY BE CIRCULATED AMONG INDUSTRIALISTS AND EDUCATIONAL GROUPS PROPOSING A FRAMEWORK OF CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE BUSINESS WORLD AND THE SCHOOL, THE DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION, MR. KENNETH TOPLEY, SAID TODAY (THURSDAY).

HE WAS SPEAKING AT THE 7TH SPEECH DAY CUM 10TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION OF THE ISLAMIC COLLEGE IN ITS SCHOOL HALL IN CLOUDVIEW ROAD, NORTH POINT.

+THERE SHOULD BE A POSITIVE ATTITUDE IN SCHOOLS TOWARDS THE WORLD OF WORK AND AN EQUALLY POSITIVE ATTITUDE IN INDUSTRY TOWARDS THE SCHOOLS FROM WHICH THE FUTURE WORKERS AND MANAGERS WILL BE COMING,+ MR. TOPLEY SAID.

THEREFORE, HE FELT IT WAS NOW TIME FOR THE TWO PARTIES TO FORM A COMMON PURPOSE AND A COMMON PLAN OF CO-OPERATION.

+MY DEPARTMENT WILL SHORTLY BE CIRCULATING IN INDUSTRIAL AND EDUCATIONAL CIRCLES A PAPER WHICH MAKES PROPOSALS FOR A FRAMEWORK OF CO-OPERATION AND SUGGESTIONS ABOUT WHEN AND HOW TO START,+ THE DIRECTOR SAID.

THE PAPER WOULD PROPOSE WAYS AND MEANS ON HOW THE WORLD OF WORK AND THE WORLD OF LEARNING COULD MOVE TOWARDS MORE EFFECTIVE MUTUAL UNDERSTANDING.

MR. TOPLEY SAID CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE SCHOOL AND INDUSTRY WAS IMPORTANT BECAUSE PREPARATION FOR THE WORKING WORLD WAS AN IMPORTANT ASPECT OF SCHOOL LIFE.

+IT IS POSSIBLE TO RECEIVE JUST AS NASTY A CULTURAL SHOCK BY ENTERING THE WORKING WORLD AS BY GOING TO LIVE IN ANOTHER COUNTRY.

+BUT EVEN MORE IMPORTANT IS THE FACT THAT INDUSTRY, THE WORLD OF WORK, AND I INCLUDE COMMERCE AND SERVICES, CREATES THE WEALTH THAT SUPPORTS OUR STANDARDS OF LIFE AND IMPROVEMENTS THEREIN,+ HE SAID.

MR. TOPLEY COMMENDED THE SCHOOL AND ITS SPONSOR, THE CHINESE MUSLIM CULTURAL AND FRATERNAL ASSOCIATION FOR THEIR SUCCESSFUL WORK IN THE PAST DECADE.

HE ALSO NOTED THAT THE CURRENT SCHOOL YEAR MARKED THE BEGINNING OF THE COLLEGE'S CONVERSION TO FULLY AIDED STATUS WHICH WOULD BE ACHIEVED BY 1982.

GOVERNMENT GRANTS LAND TO POK OI HOSPITAL

* * * *

THE GOVERNMENT HAS GRANTED A SITE BY PRIVATE TREATY TO POK OI HOSPITAL IN YUEN LONG TO BUILD A STAFF QUARTERS AS PART OF ITS EXPANSION PROGRAMME.

THE LEASE FOR A 2 192 SQUARE METRE SITE AT AU TAU NEAR YUEN LONG WAS SIGNED TODAY (THURSDAY) BETWEEN MR. JOHN TODD, DEPUTY SECRETARY FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES AND MR. SIMON YEUNG CHUN-POI, CHAIRMAN OF THE HOSPITAL'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

A FOUR-STOREY BUILDING WILL BE CONSTRUCTED CONTAINING QUARTERS FOR DOCTORS AND NURSES WHO ARE REQUIRED TO RESIDE AT THE HOSPITAL ON OPERATIONAL GROUNDS. SIX OF THE QUARTERS WILL BE FOR MARRIED PERSONNEL, TWO FOR SENIOR NURSING STAFF AND THE REMAINING 14 FOR OTHER NURSING STAFF.

COST OF THE QUARTERS WILL BE \$7.42 MILLION, OF WHICH GOVERNMENT WILL PROVIDE \$5.57 MILLION. THE BUILDING COVENANT IS \$1.54 MILLION TO BE FULFILLED WITHIN 36 MONTHS.

THE HOSPITAL IS TO EXPAND IN FIVE PHASES UP TO 1984/85, AT A COST OF ALMOST \$41 MILLION. THE EXPANSION PROGRAMME INCLUDES VARIOUS EXTENSIONS, MORE STAFF QUARTERS, THE WIDENING OF AN ACCESS ROAD AND NEW OUT-PATIENT AND CASUALTY DEPARTMENTS. THE NUMBER OF BEDS WILL BE INCREASED FROM 218 AT PRESENT TO 290.

A PRESS CONFERENCE TO ANNOUNCE DETAILS OF THE AUCTION AND DEVELOPMENTS IN TUEN MUN WHICH WILL BECOME A MAJOR CITY OF 580 000 PEOPLE BY THE MID-1980'S WILL BE HELD AT THE CHIEF RESIDENT ENGINEER'S OFFICE, TUEN MUN AT 3 PM TOMORROW (FRIDAY).

PRESENT AT THE PRESS CONFERENCE WILL BE THE PROJECT MANAGER, TUEN MUN, MR. STAN BARDEN, AND THE SENIOR ESTATE SURVEYOR OF TUEN MUN DISTRICT OFFICE, MR. L.Y. LEUNG TO OUTLINE THE DEVELOPMENTS AND ANSWER PRESS QUESTIONS.

RADIO AND TELEVISION INTERVIEWS IN CHINESE AND ENGLISH WILL BE ARRANGED.

DSW VISITS NON-PROFIT MAKING NURSERY

THE DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE, MR. THOMAS LEE, TODAY (THURSDAY) VISITED THE CHIU YANG DAY NURSERY IN SHEUNG WAN, WHICH IS A NON-PROFIT MAKING AND SELF-SUPPORTING CHILD-CARE CENTRE.

THE VISIT WAS PART OF A SERIES BY MR. LEE TO INSTITUTIONS AND CENTRES RUN BY VOLUNTARY WELFARE AGENCIES TO KEEP HIMSELF INFORMED OF THEIR DAY-TO-DAY OPERATIONS AND DEVELOPMENT.

HE CALLED ON THE NURSERY THIS AFTERNOON AND WAS GREETED BY OFFICIALS OF THE CHIU YANG RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION OF HONG KONG.

THE SETTING UP OF NON-PROFIT MAKING AND SELF-SUPPORTING NURSERIES HAS BEEN ENCOURAGED BY THE GOVERNMENT TO CATER FOR MIDDLE-INCOME FAMILIES WHO CAN NEITHER AFFORD HIGH CHARGES BY PRIVATE NURSERIES NOR BECOME ELIGIBLE FOR SUBSIDISED CHILD-CARE PLACES.

OPERATED BY THE ASSOCIATION AND OPENED IN MARCH LAST YEAR, THE CHIU YANG DAY NURSERY IS THE SECOND SUCH NURSERY SET UP IN RESPONSE TO THE GOVERNMENT'S APPEAL.

WITH A CAPACITY FOR 60, THE NURSERY PROVIDES CHILD-CARE OF HIGH STANDARD TO CHILDREN AGED TWO TO SIX AT A REASONABLE CHARGE OF \$250 A MONTH TO MEET THE NEED OF WORKING PARENTS FROM THE MIDDLE-INCOME GROUP.

DURING THE VISIT, MR. LEE INSPECTED THE FACILITIES AT THE NURSERY AND DISCUSSED WITH THE NURSERY STAFF ABOUT ITS DAILY OPERATIONS.

APPLICATIONS FOR ADMISSION CAN BE MADE AT THE NURSERY WHICH IS ON THE SECOND FLOOR OF FUNG LOK COMMERCIAL BUILDING IN 157-163 WING LOK STREET, SHEUNG WAN.

FRESH WATER SUPPLY TO A NUMBER OF PREMISES IN TSIM SHA TSUI WILL BE TURNED OFF FOR SIX HOURS FROM MIDNIGHT TOMORROW (FRIDAY) TO 6 AM THE FOLLOWING DAY (DECEMBER 1) FOR A LEAKAGE TEST.
