SIR GEOFFREY HOWE ARRIVES FOR THREE-DAY VISIT

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THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR FOREIGN AND COMMONWEALTH AFFAIRS, SIR GEOFFREY HOWE, ARRIVED FROM LONDON TODAY (SUNDAY) FOR A THREE-DAY VISIT TO HONG KONG.

SPEAKING TO REPORTERS AT THE AIRPORT, SIR GEOFFREY SAID :

"THE WHOLE WORLD HAS CONDEMNED THE VIOLENCE AND REPRESSION WE'VE ALL WITNESSED IN CHINA IN THE LAST FEW WEEKS.

"NOWHERE HAS THAT VIEW BEEN MORE VIGOROUSLY EXPRESSED THAN IN BRITAIN AND IN HONG KONG.

"YOU FEEL THREATENED AND BELEAGUERED BY WHAT HAS HAPPENED.

"SO THAT'S WHY I'M HERE ON MY EIGHTH VISIT TO HONG KONG, TO EMPHASISE THAT BRITAIN'S COMMITMENT TO HONG KONG AND ITS PEOPLE IS RESOLUTE AND UNCHANGED.

"TO REAFFIRM BRITAIN'S DETERMINATION TO SECURE A DEMOCRATIC AND PROSPEROUS FUTURE FOR HONG KONG AND OUR BELIEF THAT THE JOINT DECLARATION STILL PROVIDES THE RIGHT FOUNDATION FOR SUCH A FUTURE IN BAD TIMES AS WELL AS IN GOOD.

"TO CARRY ON WORKING OUT TOGETHER WHAT WE CAN REALISTICALLY DO TO MEET YOUR ANXIETIES TODAY AND IN THE FUTURE, AND I UNDERLINE THE WORD 'TOGETHER', FOR IT IS IN PARTNERSHIP AND NOT IN CONFRONTATION THAT WE MUST FACE THE FUTURE.

"YOU HAVE NO STAUNCHER FRIEND THAN BRITAIN.

"I'VE COME TO LISTEN AS WELL AS TO EXPLAIN. SO I SHALL BE HAVING EXTENSIVE TALKS WITH THE GOVERNOR AND HIS ADVISERS, AND MEETING OMELCO AND A WIDE RANGE OF HONG KONG PEOPLE.

"I SHALL BE VISITING THE VIETNAMESE BOAT PEOPLE'S CAMPS AND EXPLAINING WHAT WE ARE DOING TO COPE WITH THAT PROBLEM WHICH HAS FOR TOO LONG BEEN A BURDEN ON HONG KONG.

"AND I SHALL SEE AT THE EASTERN HARBOUR CROSSING, AN EXAMPLE OF THE HONG KONG GOVERNMENT'S VIGOROUS DEVELOPMENT OF THE TERRITORY'S INFRASTRUCTURE AND THE COMMERCIAL CONFIDENCE IN THE FUTURE.

"UNDER BRITISH ADMINISTRATION, HONG KONG HAS CREATED A DISTINCTIVE AND UNIQUELY SUCCESSFUL ENTERPRISE CULTURE.

"THE OBJECTIVE REMAINS THE SAME. TO SAFEGUARD YOUR FREEDOMS, YOUR WAY OF LIFE AND PROSPERITY BEYOND 1997.

/"WE'RE NOT .....

"WE'RE NOT ABOUT TO GIVE THAT UP. WE REMAIN ABSOLUTELY, INDEED, PASSIONATELY, COMMITTED TO THAT TASK."

SIR GEOFFREY AND LADY HOWE WERE MET ON ARRIVAL BY THE GOVERNOR AND LADY WILSON; THE CHIEF SECRETARY, SIR DAVID FORD; THE COMMANDER BRITISH FORCES, MAJOR-GENERAL GARRY JOHNSON; THE SENIOR MEMBER OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, DAME LYDIA DUNN; THE SENIOR MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL, MR ALLEN LEE, AND THE SENIOR BRITISH TRADE COMMISSIONER, MR PETER HEAP.

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DISKETTE SUBMISSION SCHEME IMPLEMENTED

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THE GOVERNMENT HAS ALREADY IMPLEMENTED THE DISKETTE SUBMISSION SCHEME, UNDER WHICH TRADERS ARE PROVIDED WITH AN ADDITIONAL OPTION TO SUBMIT IMPORT AND EXPORT DECLARATIONS ON MICRO-COMPUTER DISKETTES, FROM YESTERDAY (JULY 1).

DETAILED REQUIREMENTS OF THE SCHEME, INCLUDING THE DECLARATION OUTPUT FORMATS, HAVE BEEN SPECIFIED IN A GAZETTE NOTICE PUBLISHED ON NOVEMBER 4, 1988.

THE PURPOSE OF THE DISKETTE SUBMISSION SCHEME IS TO FACILITATE TRADERS IN PREPARING TRADE DECLARATIONS IN A MORE EFFICIENT AND ACCURATE WAY THROUGH THE USE OF COMPUTERS.

TRADERS WHO WISH TO SUBMIT IMPORT AND EXPORT DECLARATIONS BY MEANS OF THE DISKETTE SUBMISSION SCHEME ARE REQUIRED TO BRING THE FOLLOWING TO ANY ONE OF THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE DEPARTMENT'S TRADE DECLARATION CHARGES COLLECTION OFFICES:

- (1) MICRO-COMPUTER DISKETTE(S) ON WHICH INDIVIDUAL DECLARATIONS ARE RECORDED;
- (2) THE CORRESPONDING DECLARATIONS IN THE FORM OF COMPUTER PRINTOUTS;
- (3) SUMMARY DECLARATION(S) SIGNED BY THE DECLARER; AND
- (4) CASH OR CHEQUE OF AN APPROPRIATE AMOUNT OF CHARGES.

THE FORMATS OF DOCUMENTS DESCRIBED IN ITEMS (1) TO (3) ABOVE ARE SPECIFIED IN THE GAZETTE NOTICE.

TO JOIN THE SCHEME, THE TRADER NEEDS A MICRO-COMPUTER SYSTEM WITH RUNS ON MS-DOS OF VERSION 2.0 OR HIGHER.

THE GOVERNMENT HAS MADE AVAILABLE A USER FRIENDLY SOFTWARE TO FACILITATE TRADERS IN PREPARING IMPORT AND EXPORT DECLARATIONS USING MICRO-COMPUTERS AND AT THE SAME TIME PRODUCING OUTPUTS THAT MEET ALL THE GOVERNMENT'S SPECIFIED FORMATS.

THE SOFTWARE AND WITH THE OPERATION MANUAL ARE NOW AVAILABLE AT \$110 PER COPY FROM THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT, WANCHAI TOWER I, 12 HARBOUR ROAD, WAN CHAI, HONG KONG.

ALTERNATIVELY, TRADERS CAN DEVELOP THEIR OWN SOFTWARES TO JOIN THE SCHEME SO LONG AS THE OUTPUT FORMATS OF DECLARATION CONFORM TO THOSE SPECIFIED IN THE GAZETTE NOTICE.

ASSISTANCE IS BEING OFFERED BY THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT FOR THOSE TRADERS WHO ARE INTERESTED IN THE SCHEME AND WANT TO KNOW MORE ABOUT IT BEFORE THEY ACTUALLY PARTICIPATE IN IT.

A NUMBER OF SEMINARS, DEMONSTRATIONS AND PILOT TESTS HAVE BEEN ORGANISED FOR SUCH PURPOSES AND MORE OF THESE WILL BE ORGANISED.

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CIVIL SERVICE COMMON RECRUITMENT EXAMINATION 1989-90  
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THE ANNUAL COMMON RECRUITMENT EXAMINATION (CRE) FOR FIVE CIVIL SERVICE GRADES WILL BE HELD ON A SATURDAY IN MID-NOVEMBER THIS YEAR A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

THE FIVE GRADES ARE: ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER (AO), EXECUTIVE OFFICER II (EO II), ASSISTANT LABOUR OFFICER (ALO), MANAGEMENT SERVICES OFFICER II (MSO II) AND ASSISTANT TRADE OFFICER II (ATO II).

"IN GENERAL, GRADUATES WHO POSSESS A DEGREE FROM A HONG KONG OR BRITISH UNIVERSITY, OR EQUIVALENT, WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY.

"UNDERGRADUATES WHO ARE TAKING THEIR FINAL DEGREE EXAMINATIONS IN SUMMER 1990 MAY ALSO APPLY WHILE DIPLOMA HOLDERS MAY ALSO BE CONSIDERED FOR THE MSO II POSTS, AND EXCEPTIONALLY FOR THE EO II POST," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

FIRST HELD IN 1984, THE EXAMINATION HAS BEEN USED TO SHORTLIST FOR INTERVIEW THE LARGE NUMBER OF CANDIDATES WHO MEET THE MINIMUM ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS.

THE SPOKESMAN NOTED THAT BEFORE 1984, MOST OF THE GRADES CONDUCTED THEIR OWN OPEN RECRUITMENT EXAMINATIONS.

"CONSEQUENTLY, CANDIDATES HAD TO SIT A SUCCESSION OF WRITTEN EXAMINATIONS FOR THE POSTS THEY APPLIED FOR.

"AS THE EXAMINATIONS WERE SIMILAR BOTH IN CONTENT AND NATURE, IT WAS DECIDED THAT THE CRE SHOULD BE INTRODUCED TO RELIEVE THE BURDEN ON THE CANDIDATES, PARTICULARLY THE UNDERGRADUATES WHO ARE PREPARING FOR THEIR FINAL EXAMINATIONS," HE SAID.

THIS YEAR'S CRE WILL FOLLOW THE PATTERN OF PREVIOUS YEARS' AND CONSIST OF THREE PAPERS.

PAPER 1 IS "USE OF ENGLISH", PAPER 2 IS "OBJECTIVE TESTS" WHILE PAPER 3 IS "TASK PAPER". THE WEIGHTINGS ARE 30 PER CENT, 20 PER CENT AND 50 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY.

PAPER 1 AND 2 ARE EXAMINED IN ENGLISH WHEREAS HALF OF PAPER 3 MUST BE ANSWERED IN CHINESE.

"CANDIDATES SHOULD NOTE THAT FURTHER CONSIDERATION OF THEIR APPLICATIONS WILL BE BASED ON THEIR OVERALL PERFORMANCE IN THIS EXAMINATION," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

CANDIDATES INTERESTED IN THE WORK OF THE FIVE GRADES ARE REQUESTED TO WATCH OUT FOR THE NEWSPAPER ADVERTISEMENTS ON CIVIL SERVICE VACANCIES ON SATURDAYS IN EARLY SEPTEMBER. THE CLOSING DATE FOR APPLICATIONS WILL BE IN THE THIRD OR FOURTH WEEK OF SEPTEMBER.

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#### SEMINAR ON SELF-REGULATORY SAFETY PROGRAMME

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MORE THAN 90 PEOPLE FROM OVER 70 INDUSTRIAL ESTABLISHMENTS WILL TAKE PART IN A RESIDENTIAL SEMINAR ON IN-PLANT SAFETY AT THE CHINESE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG IN SHA TIN STARTING FROM TUESDAY (JULY 4).

THE THREE-DAY SEMINAR, ENTITLED SELF-REGULATORY APPROACHES IN LABOUR INSPECTION, IS DESIGNED MAINLY FOR MEMBERS OF SAFETY COMMITTEES AND PERSONS RESPONSIBLE FOR SAFETY AND HEALTH AT WORK IN INDUSTRY.

IT IS ALSO THE SECOND SUCH SEMINAR ORGANISED IN HONG KONG JOINTLY BY THE ASIAN AND PACIFIC PROJECT FOR LABOUR ADMINISTRATION (ARPLA) OF THE INTERNATIONAL LABOUR ORGANISATION AND THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT.

THE SEMINAR PROVIDES A FORUM FOR PARTICIPANTS TO EXCHANGE VIEWS ON THE PROBLEMS ARISING FROM THE IMPLEMENTATION OF IN-PLANT SAFETY PROGRAMMES AND TO DEVISE POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS.

IT WILL ALSO FOCUS ON THE NEED FOR A SELF-REGULATORY APPROACH IN THE PROMOTION OF SAFETY AND HEALTH AT WORK.

EXPERTS IN THE FIELD INCLUDING MR MUINUDDIN KHAN OF ARPLA IN BANGKOK; PLANT MANAGER OF SONCA PRODUCTS LTD., MR PHILIP LEUNG; SOLICITOR OF JOHNSON, STOKES AND MASTER, MR W.K. SUNG; AND REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT WILL BE INVITED TO ADDRESS THE SEMINAR.

THEY WILL DISCUSS SUCH TOPICS AS ORGANISATION OF SAFETY ACTIVITIES, HOW FACTORY INSPECTORS CAN HELP IN THE PROMOTION OF SAFETY AND HEALTH AT WORK, EXPERIENCE IN SELF-REGULATORY APPROACH IN THE CONTROL OF IN-PLANT SAFETY PROBLEMS AND CONCEPT OF IN-PLANT SAFETY PROGRAMMES.

OTHER SUBJECTS INCLUDE DUTIES OF EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES UNDER INDUSTRIAL SAFETY AND HEALTH LEGISLATION IN HONG KONG, AN OVERVIEW OF THE EMPLOYEES' COMPENSATION ORDINANCE, AND CIVIL LIABILITY OF EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES REGARDING SAFETY AND HEALTH.

THE SEMINAR WILL BE OPENED ON TUESDAY (JULY 4) BY MR MUINUDDIN KHAN OF ARPLA; THE COMMISSIONER FOR LABOUR, MR TONY HAMMOND; THE CHAIRMAN OF THE HONG KONG FEDERATION OF TRADE UNIONS, MR CHENG YIU-TONG; AND THE CHAIRMAN OF THE HONG KONG PLASTICS MANUFACTURERS ASSOCIATION LTD., MR K.Y. TONGSON.

ON ARRIVAL, THE CHOIR GROUP WAS MET BY MR LAM CHIT PWAN, STAFF OFFICER, TRAINING, AT POLICE HEADQUARTERS AND MR IDRIS YUSOF, DIRECTOR OF MUSIC OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE POLICE.

THEY HAD A TIGHT SCHEDULE DURING THE STAY. THEY LEARNED A POPULAR MALAY SONG, REHEARSED MANY TIMES, PERFORMED AT LARGE SHOPPING CENTRES, SANG TOGETHER WITH THE RSP SINGING GROUP IN COMBINED CONCERTS, AND RECEIVED INTERVIEWS.

SOPRANO WOMAN SENIOR INSPECTOR RITA CHU ATTACHED TO AUXILIARY POLICE HEADQUARTERS SAID: "LIFE THERE IS COMPARATIVELY SIMPLE, NOT SO BUSY AS IN HONG KONG, BUT PEOPLE ARE FRIENDLY. WE WERE WARMLY APPLAUDED BY A LARGE CROWD OF ENTHUSIASTIC SPECTATORS DURING OUR PUBLIC PERFORMANCES."

CHOIRMASTER ALEX CHEUNG COMMENTED: "MEMBERS WORKED VERY HARD IN REHEARSALS AND THEIR PERFORMANCES WERE VERY GOOD."

"WE SANG ONLY SONGS IN MANDARIN AND ENGLISH AND MIXED WELL WITH THE SINGAPORE BAND IN SINGING TWO SONGS IN THE COMBINED CONCERT."

"WE ALSO GAVE IMPROMPTU PERFORMANCES AND EVERY MEMBER ENJOYED THE MUSICAL ATMOSPHERE AND HAD A WONDERFUL TIME IN SINGAPORE. THIS VERY FIRST OVERSEAS PERFORMING TOUR HAS ADDED VALUABLE EXPERIENCE TO MEMBERS OF THE CHOIR."

TRIBUTE TO WAN CHAI KAIFONG ASSOCIATION

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THE WAN CHAI KAIFONG ASSOCIATION WAS A PIONEER IN ORGANISING ACTIVITIES FOR RESIDENTS AND PLAYED A VERY IMPORTANT ROLE IN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DURING THE 1950'S AND 1960'S. THE REGIONAL SECRETARY FOR HONG KONG AND KOWLOON, MR DAVID LAN, SAID THIS (SUNDAY) EVENING.

OVER THE YEARS, MR LAN CONTINUED, THE ROLE OF KAIFONG ASSOCIATIONS IN DISTRICT MATTERS HAD CHANGED TO CATER FOR RESIDENTS' NEEDS, WHILE THEIR MAIN OBJECTIVES OF SERVING THE PUBLIC AND PROMOTING MUTUAL HELP REMAINED UNCHANGED.
