COMMON RECRUITMENT EXAM FOR 5 CIVIL SERVICE GRADES

* * * * *

UNIVERSITY GRADUATES WHO ARE INTERESTED IN THE WORK OF FIVE CIVIL SERVICE GRADES ARE ADVISED TO WATCH OUT FOR ADVERTISEMENTS IN AUGUST AND SEPTEMBER.

THE FIVE GRADES ARE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER, EXECUTIVE OFFICER II, ASSISTANT LABOUR OFFICER II, MANAGEMENT SERVICES OFFICER II AND ASSISTANT TRADE OFFICER II.

"IN GENERAL, GRADUATES WHO POSSESS A DEGREE FROM A HONG KONG OR BRITISH UNIVERSITY, OR EQUIVALENT, WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY," A SPOKESMAN FOR THE CIVIL SERVICE BRANCH SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

"UNDERGRADUATES WHO ARE TAKING THEIR FINAL DEGREE EXAMINATIONS IN SUMMER NEXT YEAR MAY ALSO APPLY.

"DIPLOMA HOLDERS MAY BE CONSIDERED FOR THE MANAGEMENT SERVICES OFFICER II POSTS, AND EXCEPTIONALLY FOR THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER II POSTS."

TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF SEPARATE EXAMINATIONS WHICH CANDIDATES HAVE TO TAKE FOR DIFFERENT CIVIL SERVICE JOBS, A COMMON RECRUITMENT EXAMINATION WILL BE HELD FOR THE FIVE GRADES IN EARLY OR MID-NOVEMBER, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

STARTED IN 1984, THE EXAMINATION HAS ESPECIALLY RELIEVED THE BURDEN OF MULTIPLE EXAMINATIONS ON UNDERGRADUATES WHO HAVE TO PREPARE FOR THEIR FINAL UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS.

AS IN THE PAST, THIS YEAR'S EXAMINATION WILL CONSIST OF THREE PAPERS: PAPER 1 (ONE HOUR) IS USE OF ENGLISH, PAPER 2 (1-1/4 HOURS) IS OBJECTIVE TESTS AND PAPER 3 (THREE HOURS) IS A TASK PAPER.

THE WEIGHTINGS ARE 30 PER CENT, 20 PER CENT AND 50 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY.

PAPERS 1 AND 2 ARE EXAMINED IN ENGLISH WHILE HALF OF PAPER 3 IS SET IN CHINESE AND MUST BE ANSWERED IN CHINESE.

VACANCIES FOR THE FIVE GRADES WILL BE ADVERTISED IN AN ENGLISH DAILY, A CHINESE DAILY AND A CHINESE EVENING DAILY IN LATE AUGUST AND EARLY SEPTEMBER. THE CLOSING DATE FOR APPLICATIONS WILL BE MID-SEPTEMBER.

BRIEF DESCRIPTIONS OF THE WORK OF THE FIVE GRADES ARE:

- * ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FORMULATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF GOVERNMENT POLICIES, CO-ORDINATION AND PLANNING OF PUBLIC PROGRAMMES, AND THE MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL OF RESOURCES. THEY ARE GENERALIST MANAGERS OCCUPYING KEY POSTS OF DIFFERENT NATURES IN SECRETARIAT BRANCHES AND GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS THROUGHOUT THEIR CAREER.

/* EXECUTIVE OFFICERS

- * EXECUTIVE OFFICERS II ARE MAINLY DEPLOYED ON ASSISTING IN THE DAY-TO-DAY ADMINISTRATIVE FUNCTIONS IN SUPPORT OF DEPARTMENTAL OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES, RESOURCE PLANNING AND CONTROL, PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT, AND COMMUNITY RELATIONS AS WELL AS DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION LIAISON FUNCTIONS.
- * ASSISTANT LABOUR OFFICERS II PROVIDE EMPLOYMENT SERVICES TO STUDENTS, JOB SEEKERS AND EMPLOYERS; AND ENFORCE LABOUR LEGISLATION.
- * MANAGEMENT SERVICES OFFICERS II CARRY OUT MANAGEMENT SERVICES WORK SUCH AS MANAGEMENT CONSULTANCIES, ORGANISATION REVIEWS, VALUE FOR MONEY STUDIES, AND OFFICE AUTOMATION STUDIES. THEY ALSO CONDUCT ASSIGNMENTS ON OFFICE ACCOMMODATION PLANNING AND USE OF OFFICE EQUIPMENT.
- * ASSISTANT TRADE OFFICERS II WORK EITHER IN DEPARTMENT OF TRADE OR INDUSTRY AND ASSIST IN RESEARCH AND ANALYSIS, LICENSING AND CONTROL MANAGEMENT, DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT OF COMPUTER SYSTEMS, AND INDUSTRIAL PROMOTION. THEY MAY HAVE OPPORTUNITIES TO ATTEND OVERSEAS CONFERENCES OR TO ASSIST IN OVERSEAS NEGOTIATIONS.

CHANGING ROAD USERS' BEHAVIOUR CAN IMPROVE ROAD SAFETY

* * * * *

ROAD USER ERRORS ACCOUNT FOR ABOUT 95 PER CENT OF ROAD ACCIDENTS AND THE GOVERNMENT IS PLACING MUCH EMPHASIS ON THE NEED TO IMPROVE ROAD SAFETY.

THIS WAS STATED BY THE COMMISSIONER FOR TRANSPORT, MR GORDON SIU KWING-CHU, TODAY (SUNDAY) AT THE OPENING CEREMONY OF THE ROAD COURTESY CAMPAIGN 1992 ORGANISED BY THE ROTARY CLUB OF HONG KONG NORTHEAST.

MR SIU SAID THERE WAS A NEED TO RAISE THE LEVEL OF UNDERSTANDING AND SKILLS OF ROAD USERS AND TO CHANGE THEIR ATTITUDES AND BEHAVIOUR.

ALTHOUGH THERE WAS A DOWNWARD TREND OF ROAD ACCIDENTS FROM 1982 TO 1986 AND SINCE THEN THE NUMBER OF ACCIDENTS HAD REMAINED STABLE, A TOTAL OF 15,327 ACCIDENTS OCCURRED ON THE ROADS IN HONG KONG LAST YEAR WITH 315 PEOPLE KILLED AND OVER 20,000 INJURED, HE SAID.

"IN FINANCIAL TERMS, ROAD ACCIDENTS RESULT IN LOSS OF RESOURCES TO THOSE INVOLVED AND TO OTHER ROAD USERS," MR SIU SAID, ADDING THAT MORE IMPORTANTLY THAT CASUALTIES LEAD TO SUFFERING.

"THIS IS WHY THE GOVERNMENT PLACES SO MUCH EMPHASIS ON THE NEED TO IMPROVE ROAD SAFETY," HE ADDED.

MR SIU SAID EFFORTS MUST THEREFORE BE KEPT UP ON ROAD SAFETY EDUCATION, DRIVER TRAINING AND PUBLICITY.

AS PART OF THE PUBLICITY EFFORT, MR SIU SAID IN 1992, THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ISSUED A LIST OF DO'S AND DON'TS FOR MOTORISTS AND PEDESTRIANS AND PUBLICISED THEM AT EVERY LEVEL IN ADDITION TO PROVIDING THE PUBLIC WITH INFORMATION ON TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS BLACKSPOTS THROUGH VARIOUS CHANNELS.

TRAINING COURSES ON NATURE EDUCATION FOR TEACHERS

* * * * *

SOME 300 PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS ATTENDED A SERIES OF TRAINING COURSES ON CONSERVATION AND NATURE EDUCATION ORGANISED BY THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT AND THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT IN THE PAST TWO WEEKS.

THE COURSES, ATTENDED MAINLY BY GEOGRAPHY, BIOLOGY AND NATURE SCIENCE TEACHERS, CONSISTED OF TALKS AND A VISIT TO THE LIONS NATURE EDUCATION CENTRE IN TSIU HANG.

"THE MAIN OBJECTIVE OF THE COURSES IS TO INTRODUCE THE LIONS NATURE EDUCATION CENTRE TO THE TEACHERS AS AN IDEAL PLACE AND RESOURCE FOR NATURE EDUCATION," SENIOR CONSERVATION OFFICER OF THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT, MR MARTIN LEUNG, SAID.

"THE CENTRE HAS LIVING SPECIMENS AND STATIC DISPLAYS TO HELP VISITORS UNDERSTAND AND APPRECIATE HONG KONG'S WILDLIFE, VEGETATION, NATURAL RESOURCES AND THE EVOLUTION OF THE PRIMARY INDUSTRIES.

"IT SERVES AS A UNIQUE PLACE FOR FIELD STUDIES AND PROVIDES RECREATION FOR STUDENTS, TEACHERS AND MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC. ADMISSION TO WHICH IS FREE.

"IT IS HOPED THAT VISITORS WILL HAVE A MORE POSITIVE ATTITUDE TOWARDS ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION AFTER THEIR VISITS TO THE CENTRE," HE SAID.

AT PRESENT, THERE ARE THREE EXHIBITION HALLS OF ABOUT 800 SQUARE METRES DESIGNED IN TRADITIONAL CHINESE STYLE FOR THE DISPLAY OF MATERIALS RELATED TO RURAL HERITAGE, PRIMARY INDUSTRIES, COUNTRYSIDE RESOURCES AND NATURE CONSERVATION.

OTHER ATTRACTIONS OF THE CENTRE INCLUDE AN ARBORETUM, A SPECIMEN ORCHARD, A CHINESE HERBAL GARDEN, A CITRUS ORCHARD, A ROCK AND MINERAL CORNER AS WELL AS A NUMBER OF SELECTED FIELD CROPS.

OFFICIALLY OPENED IN JUNE LAST YEAR, IT HAS ATTRACTED MORE THAN 310,000 VISITORS IN THE PAST 12 MONTHS.

GUIDED TOURS CAN BE ARRANGED BY THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT FOR GROUPS UPON REQUEST, ALTHOUGH THE NUMBERS ARE LIMITED.

THE COURSES WILL HELP TEACHERS TO MAKE THE BEST USE OF THE CENTRE AND MAKE FUTURE VISITS BY SCHOOL GROUPS MORE FRUITFUL AND INTERESTING.

MORE SUCH TRAINING COURSES MAY BE CONSIDERED IF THEY ARE PROVED TO BE USEFUL AND POPULAR AMONG TEACHERS.

REMINDER TO FIT GOODS VEHICLES WITH SIDEGUARDS AND REARGUARDS

* * * * *

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT TODAY (SUNDAY) REMINDED GOODS VEHICLE AND TRAILER OWNERS THAT THE GRACE PERIOD FOR FITTING SIDEGUARDS AND REARGUARDS ON THEIR VEHICLES WILL EXPIRE ON JULY 1 NEXT YEAR.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID THIS REQUIREMENT WOULD APPLY TO GOODS VEHICLES WHICH HAD PERMITTED GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT EXCEEDING 5.5 TONNES AND THE DISTANCE BETWEEN THE CENTRES OF ANY TWO CONSECUTIVE AXLES EXCEEDED THREE METRES.

"THIS WILL ALSO APPLY TO TRAILERS WHICH HAS A PERMITTED GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT EXCEEDING TWO TONNES AND THE DISTANCE BETWEEN THE CENTRES OF ANY TWO CONSECUTIVE AXLES EXCEEDED THREE METRES.

"SEMI-TRAILERS WHICH HAVE A PERMITTED GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT EXCEEDING TWO TONNES AND THE DISTANCE BETWEEN THE CENTRE OF ITS FIRST AXLE AND THE CENTRE OF THE KING PIN EXCEEDS 4.5 METRES ARE ALSO INCLUDED," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

"THE LEGISLATION TOOK EFFECT ON JULY 1, 1990, BUT THERE IS A THREE-YEAR GRACE PERIOD FOR VEHICLES REGISTERED BEFORE THIS DATE," HE ADDED.

"SIDEGUARDS ARE DESIGNED TO PREVENT MOTOR CYCLISTS OR PEDESTRIANS FROM BEING TRAPPED BETWEEN THE AXLES IN THE EVENT OF A COLLISION AND REARGUARDS ARE DESIGNED TO PREVENT VEHICLES FROM UNDERRUNNING INTO THE VEHICLES AT THE FRONT IN THE EVENT OF A COLLISION," HE ADDED.

THE SIDEGUARDS AND REARGUARDS MUST BE FITTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LEGAL REQUIREMENTS. CERTAIN CATEGORIES OF VEHICLE ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS ON GROUNDS OF THE SPACE CONSTRAINTS AND OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS.

THE SPOKESMAN ADDED THAT FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE REQUIREMENTS WAS AN OFFENCE AND WAS LIABLE ON CONVICTION TO A FINE OF \$10,000 AND IMPRISONMENT FOR SIX MONTHS.
