SIR JACK OPENS SPORTS-FOR-ALL CELEBRATION  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE ACTING GOVERNOR, SIR JACK CATER TODAY (WEDNESDAY) PULLED THE STRING TO UNROLL A COUPLET WRITTEN IN CHINESE TO MARK THE OFFICIAL OPENING OF THE ROYAL WEDDING SPORTS-FOR-ALL CELEBRATION.

THE COUPLET WAS SPECIALLY PREPARED FOR THE WEDDING OF HRH THE PRINCE OF WALES AND LADY DIANA SPENCER.

ADDRESSING THE GUESTS AND THOUSANDS OF RESIDENTS WHO HAD TURNED UP AT MORSE PARK TO JOIN IN THE CELEBRATION, SIR JACK SAID IT WAS FITTING THAT THE HAPPY DAY WAS MARKED BY A PUBLIC HOLIDAY, WITH ACTIVITIES DESIGNED TO GIVE FUN AND ENJOYMENT TO AS MANY PEOPLE AS POSSIBLE.

HE POINTED OUT THAT THE RECREATION AND SPORT SERVICE, ORGANISER OF THE EVENT, HAD PRESENTED SOME 15 000 RECREATIONAL PROJECTS FOR A TOTAL OF TWO MILLION PARTICIPANTS OVER THE PAST SIX YEARS.

SIR JACK ALSO TOOK THE OPPORTUNITY TO PAY TRIBUTE TO LOCAL LEADERS AND ORGANISATIONS FOR THEIR EFFORT AND PUBLIC SPIRIT IN CONTRIBUTING TO THIS ACHIEVEMENT.

FOLLOWING THE CEREMONY, SIR JACK, ACCOMPANIED BY THE ACTING COMMISSIONER FOR RECREATION AND CULTURE, MR A.P. BENNETT AND PRINCIPAL RECREATION AND SPORT OFFICER, MR DICKEN YUNG, TOURED THE VENUE AND SAW THE MANY RECREATION AND SPORT ACTIVITIES BEING HELD.

ON REACHING THE STARTING POINT OF THE 8 000-METRE ROAD RACE, SIR JACK STRUCK A GONG TO COMMENCE THE EVENT IN WHICH 300 MEN AND WOMEN TOOK PART.

ONE OF THE MAIN ATTRACTIONS WAS A TELEMATCH COMPETITION OPEN TO GROUPS AND ORGANISATIONS.

SIX GROUPS, INCLUDING REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE ROYAL HONG KONG POLICE FORCE, TELEVISION BROADCASTS LTD AND HSIN CHONG HOLDINGS LTD, COMPETED FOR THE GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP.

OTHER SPECIAL FEATURES WERE A CHINESE MARTIAL ARTS DISPLAY, A TAI CHI SWORD DEMONSTRATION, A FOOTBALL MATCH, A DISCO DANCE-IN, TABLE-TENNIS AND BADMINTON FOR FUN AND A MODIFIED THREE-A-SIDE, KNOCK-OUT BASKETBALL MATCH.

THERE WAS A SKIPPING FOR FUN EVENT FOR CHILDREN, IN ADDITION TO THE POTTED SPORTS CONTEST. FOR THE PEOPLE OVER 50 YEARS OF AGE, THERE WAS A SERIES OF POTTED SPORTS CONTESTS, SPECIALLY SUITED TO THEM.

HEALTH CENTRE NEARLY COMPLETED

WORK ON THE LEI MUK SHUE HEALTH CENTRE IS NEARLY COMPLETE.

LOCATED AT THE JUNCTION OF WO YI HOP ROAD AND LEI SHU ROAD, THE \$8-MILLION HEALTH CENTRE CONSISTS OF A GENERAL OUT-PATIENT DEPARTMENT, A FAMILY HEALTH SERVICE CENTRE, A 24-BED MATERNITY HOME AND ANCILLARY FACILITIES SUCH AS STAFF CANTEEN, KITCHEN AND STAFF CHANGING ROOMS.

MR YEE-SUN WU AND HIS BROTHER MR JIEH-YEE WU OF WING LUNG BANK HAVE JOINTLY PLEDGED A DONATION OF \$2 MILLION TOWARDS THE CONSTRUCTION COST OF THE FOUR-STORY CLINIC WHICH WILL BE NAMED AFTER THEIR MOTHER, MRS WU YORK-YU.

THE CENTRE, WHEN COMPLETED NEXT WEEK, WILL PROVIDE THE MUCH NEEDED CLINIC FACILITIES FOR THE RESIDENTS IN KWAI CHUNG WHICH OVER THE YEARS HAS EXPERIENCED RAPID INCREASES IN POPULATION AS A RESULT OF EXTENSIVE PUBLIC HOUSING PROGRAMMES.

ACTION TAKEN FOR LABOUR LAW VIOLATIONS

A TOTAL OF 972 CONVICTIONS, WITH FINES TOTALLING MORE THAN \$882 000, RESULTED FROM 986 PROSECUTIONS BROUGHT BY THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT IN JUNE FOR BREACHES OF LABOUR LEGISLATION.

MOST OF THE CASES CONCERNED BREACHES OF THE FACTORIES AND INDUSTRIAL UNDERTAKINGS ORDINANCE AND ITS VARIOUS SUBSIDIARY REGULATIONS, THE EMPLOYMENT ORDINANCE AND THE WOMEN AND YOUNG PERSONS (INDUSTRY) REGULATIONS.

CASES RELATING TO VIOLATIONS OF SAFETY REGULATIONS TOTALLED 355, RESULTING IN FINES TOTALLING \$554 150.

THIS INCLUDED 168 CASES (WITH \$150 350 IN FINES) FOR BREACH OF THE FACTORIES AND INDUSTRIAL UNDERTAKINGS (GUARDING AND OPERATION OF MACHINERY) REGULATIONS AND 125 CASES (WITH \$317 800 IN FINES) FOR BREACH OF THE CONSTRUCTION SITES (SAFETY) REGULATIONS.

OFFENCES IN CONNECTION WITH EMPLOYMENT OF WOMEN AND YOUNG PEOPLE ACCOUNTED FOR 531 CASES WITH \$264 800 IN FINES.

OF THE OTHER PROSECUTIONS, 22 CASES RELATED TO FAILURE TO KEEP RECORDS OF EMPLOYEES AND TO PRODUCE SUCH RECORDS FOR INSPECTION BY LABOUR INSPECTORS, LEADING TO \$14 450 IN FINES.

WARNING ON SALES OF CONTROLLED MEDICINES

\* \* \* \* \*

MEDICINE DEALERS ARE WARNED NOT TO SELL CONTROLLED DRUGS WITHOUT AUTHORISATION AS THE FORENSIC PHARMACY SECTION OF THE MEDICAL AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT IS STEPPING UP ACTION AGAINST SALES OF MEDICINES WITHOUT A LICENCE.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE MEDICAL AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY THAT FORENSIC PHARMACISTS RECENTLY MADE ANOTHER LARGE SEIZURE -- A TOTAL OF 188 ITEMS OF CONTROLLED DRUGS, VALUED AT OVER \$15 000 IN THE MARKET, DURING A RAID ON THE PREMISES OF TWO MEDICINE RETAILERS IN WAN CHAI.

THEY CARRIED OUT THE RAID ON JULY 21, AFTER INTENSIVE INVESTIGATION INTO THE DISTRIBUTION OF +SOFT DRUGS+ FROM MEDICINE SHOPS IN THE DISTRICT.

AMONG THE SEIZURE WERE TRANQUILISERS AND SLEEPING PILLS WHICH ARE CLASSIFIED AS +SOFT DRUGS+ AND ARE COMMONLY ABUSED BY YOUNGSTERS.

THE MANAGERS OF THE MEDICINE COMPANIES HAVE BEEN PLACED ON POLICE BAIL OF \$2 000 EACH PENDING FURTHER INVESTIGATION.

IF THE DEALERS ARE CONVICTED, THEIR LICENCES TO SELL PART II POISONS SUCH AS HOUSEHOLD INSECTICIDES, COLD REMEDIES AND SOME COUGH PREPARATIONS WILL BE LIABLE TO CANCELLATION, HE WARNED.

A RAID CARRIED OUT ON JUNE 30 BY THE FORENSIC PHARMACISTS RESULTED IN SEIZURE OF \$200 000 WORTH OF UNREGISTERED MEDICINES, THE LARGEST QUANTITY SEIZED SO FAR.

NGAN MOK STREET IN CAUSEWAY BAY WILL BE DESIGNATED A PUBLIC LIGHT BUS CLEARWAY BETWEEN 7 AM AND MIDNIGHT FROM 10 AM ON SATURDAY, AUGUST 1.

AS A RESULT, PUBLIC LIGHT BUSES WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED TO STOP AND PICK UP PASSENGERS AND GOODS AT THE PUBLIC LIGHT BUS STAND WITHIN THE RESTRICTED HOURS.

SIGNS WILL BE PUT UP TO INDICATE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CLEARWAY.

AMENITY PLOTS FOR LANTAU

THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT HAS ARRANGED A NUMBER OF EYE-CATCHING AMENITY PLOTS ALONG SOUTH LANTAU ROAD ON LANTAU ISLAND TO MAKE UP FOR THE LOSS OF WOODLAND AND ROADSIDE TREES, IN KEEPING WITH THE PLAN TO BEAUTIFY THE ENVIRONMENT, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID.

THE JOB OF PLANTING MORE THAN 100 SPECIES OF EVERGREEN SHRUBS AND TREES AND COLOURFUL FLOWERS AT FOUR AMENITY PLOTS, INCLUDING THE CONCOURSE OF MUI WO FERRY PIER AND ON THE BEACHES OF CHEUNG SHA, HAS JUST BEEN COMPLETED.

WORK ON TWO OTHER AMENITY PLOTS, AT THE ENTRANCE OF SHEK PIK RESERVOIR COMMEMORATIVE GARDEN AND SOUTH LANTAU ROAD, IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED AT THE END OF NEXT MONTH.

+THE AMENITY PLOTS ARE ARRANGED IN LINE WITH THE TOPOGRAPHY AND OTHER AVAILABLE NATURAL RESOURCES. SELECTION AND DISTRIBUTION OF PLANTS ARE ALSO METICULOUSLY PLANNED TO ATTAIN A DELIGHTFUL EFFECT,+ SAID THE DISTRICT AMENITIES OFFICER OF ISLANDS, MR NG SZE-KWONG, WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DESIGN AND SUPERVISION OF THE PROJECTS.

MR NG URGED PEOPLE NOT TO WALK ACROSS THE WOOD AND BAMBOO-STICK FENCING AREA OF THE AMENITY PLOTS AND NOT TO DAMAGE THE PLANTS WHILE ENJOYING THE SCENIC GARDEN PATCH.

ADULTS WILL HAVE TO PAY MORE FROM SATURDAY FOR A FERRY RIDE BETWEEN SAM KA TSUEN AND LEI YUE MUN.

A TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID THE FARE FOR ADULTS WOULD BE RAISED FROM 20 TO 30 CENTS, BUT THE FARE FOR CHILDREN UP TO THE AGE OF 12 WOULD REMAIN AT 10 CENTS.

A TOUR OF SAI KUNG DISTRICT, A LUNCH AND HINTS FROM A PROMINENT PHOTOGRAPHER ARE BEING OFFERED TO ENCOURAGE ENTRIES IN A PHOTOGRAPHIC COMPETITION ARRANGED BY SAI KUNG CULTURE AND RECREATION ADVANCEMENT ASSOCIATION.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT SAID THE WORK INCLUDED THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ALL-WEATHER RUNNING TRACK IN THE PLAYGROUND.

OTHER FACILITIES, SUCH AS THE LONG HIGH JUMP PITS, SPECTATOR STAND AND GATES OF THE PLAYGROUND, LOCATED NEAR THE JUNCTION OF HEUNG SZE WUI STREET AND WAN TAU STREET, WERE ALSO IMPROVED.

DURING THE SUMMER HOLIDAYS, THE CENTRE WILL BE OPEN EVERY MONDAY, WEDNESDAY AND FRIDAY FROM 9 AM TO 12.30 PM AND FROM 2 PM TO 4.30 PM.

HALF OF HO MAN TIN LORRY PARK CLOSED FOR PAVING WORK

THE EASTERN HALF OF THE HO MAN TIN TEMPORARY LORRY PARK IN GOOD SHEPHERD STREET WILL BE TEMPORARILY CLOSED FOR SURFACING WORK ON SATURDAY.

THE WORK WILL AFFECT ABOUT 40 PARKING SPACES AND LAST ABOUT SEVEN WEEKS.

ON COMPLETION, THE WESTERN HALF OF THE LORRY PARK WILL THEN BE CLOSED FOR A SIMILAR PERIOD FOR PAVING WORK.

THE NEW SURFACE WILL OVERCOME THE FLOODING PROBLEM IN THE LORRY PARK AND ALLOW FOR THE PROPER DEMARCATION OF PARKING SPACES.
