TEMPORARY SHELTERS AVAILABLE IN CASE OF STORM

THE HOME AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT HAS ARRANGED FOR THE OPENING OF 135 TEMPORARY TYPHOON SHELTERS TO HOUSE MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC SEEKING SAFER ACCOMMODATION DURING THE PASSAGE OF TROPICAL STORMS.

THESE SHELTERS IN THE URBAN AREAS CAN ACCOMMODATE 21,636 PEOPLE AND WILL BE OPENED WHEN TYPHOON SIGNAL NO. 8 IS HOISTED.

THE PUBLIC CAN CONTACT THEIR NEAREST CITY DISTRICT OFFICE IF SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS ARE REQUIRED.

MEANWHILE, THE PUBLIC ENQUIRY COUNTER AT THE HOME AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT HEADQUARTERS IS NOW MANNED ROUND-THE-CLOCK FOLLOWING THE HOISTING OF TYPHOON SIGNAL NO. 1.

SPECIAL EDUCATION COURSES FOR
PRIMARY AND SECONDARY TEACHERS
* * * *

TEACHERS IN PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS ARE INVITED TO ATTEND A SERIES OF INTRODUCTORY COURSES THIS MONTH ON EDUCATING CHILDREN WITH MENTAL OR PHYSICAL DISABILITIES.

THE COURSES AIM AT PROVIDING A BASIC KNOWLEDGE IN IDENTIFYING AND HELPING CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES IN THE ORDINARY SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT, AND IMPARTING USEFUL INFORMATION ON EDUCATIONAL SERVICES AND FACILITIES FOR THESE CHILDREN IN HONG KONG.

SEVEN COURSES HAVE BEEN ORGANISED TO TAKE PLACE BETWEEN JULY 18 AND 26 FOR TEACHERS IN PRIMARY SCHOOLS.

TOPICS INCLUDE EDUCATION OF HEARING IMPAIRED CHILDREN, CHILDREN WITH BEHAVIOUR PROBLEMS, PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED CHILDREN, VISUALLY HANDICAPPED CHILDREN, MENTALLY HANDICAPPED CHILDREN AND SLOW LEARNING CHILDREN, AND A PRACTICAL APPROACH TO HELPING SPEECH IMPAIRED CHILDREN IN ORDINARY SCHOOLS.

ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE FOR PARTICIPANTS ON THE COURSE OF EDUCATION FOR HEARING IMPAIRED CHILDREN TO VISIT A SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES CENTRE RUN BY THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT TO SEE AUDIOLOGICAL TESTING AND SPEECH AND HEARING TRAINING FACILITIES.

TWO COURSES HAVE BEEN ORGANISED FOR TEACHERS IN SECONDARY SCHOOLS — ONE ON THE EDUCATION OF CHILDREN WITH BEHAVIOUR PROBLEMS AND ONE ON THE EDUCATION OF SLOW LEARNING CHILDREN — WILL BE HELD ON JULY 27 AND 30 RESPECTIVELY.

APPLICATIONS FOR ALL THE ABOVE COURSES SHOULD BE MADE THROUGH HEADS OF SCHOOLS TO THE PRINCIPAL EDUCATION OFFICER, SPECIAL EDUCATION SECTION, EDUCATION DEPARTMENT, LEE GARDENS, HYSAN AVENUE, HONG KONG BEFORE JULY 9.

PRIORITY WILL BE GIVEN TO TEACHERS OF CULTURAL AND PRACTICAL SUBJECTS IN SCHOOLS WHICH WILL BE OPERATING SPECIAL OR RESOURCE CLASSES IN 1979-80.

APPLICATIONS INVITED FOR SWD'S OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUTH SCHEME
* * * * *

GROUPS OF YOUNG PEOPLE, WHO HAVE INITIATED THEIR OWN COMMUNITY PROJECTS BUT WHO NEED MONEY TO IMPLEMENT THEM, WILL NOW HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO DO SO UNDER A SUBSIDY SCHEME ADMINISTERED BY THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT.

THE DEPARTMENT IS INVITING APPLICATIONS FOR ITS OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUTH SCHEME WHICH AIMS AT ENCOURAGING YOUTH GROUPS, THROUGH SUBSIDY GRANTS, TO COME UP WITH AND TO CARRY OUT INNOVATIVE SERVICE PROJECTS.

SINCE THE SCHEME STARTED IN 1974, THE DEPARTMENT HAS ALLOCATED OVER \$489,000 AS SUBSIDIES FOR 423 PROJECTS, CARRIED OUT BY MORE THAN 16,100 YOUNG PEOPLE AND BENEFITTING AN ESTIMATED 675,600 PEOPLE.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY (THURSDAY) ANY YOUTH GROUP WITH AT LEAST SEVEN MEMBERS AGED 15 TO 25 YEARS, WHICH IS SPONSORED BY A SCHOOL OR A YOUTH AGENCY, MAY APPLY.

HE SAID ENQUIRIES ABOUT THE SCHEME AND APPLICATIONS CAN BE MADE AT THE DEPARTMENT'S COMMUNITY AND YOUTH OFFICES IN VARIOUS DISTRICTS, AND THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS IS JULY 31, 1979.

A SERVICE PROJECT MUST BE GEARED TOWARDS A SPECIFIC NEED OF THE COMMUNITY, AND THE PROJECT SPAN SHOULD NOT EXTEND BEYOND A PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS, HE SAID.

PREVIOUS PROJECTS SUPPORTED BY THE SCHEME INCLUDED SERVICES FOR THE ELDERLY, THE DISABLED AND YOUTH, RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES, WORKS PROJECTS AND COMMUNITY EDUCATION PROGRAMMES, HE ADDED.

THE MAXIMUM GRANT FOR EACH APPROVED PROJECT IS \$2,500, HE SAID, AND THE DEPARTMENT'S COMMUNITY AND YOUTH OFFICERS WILL MAINTAIN A CLOSE WORKING RELATIONSHIP WITH PARTICIPATING GROUPS.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THE SCHEME PROVIDES USEFUL OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUNG PEOPLE TO PUT THEIR IDEALS INTO PRACTICE AND TO BETTER UNDERSTAND THE COMMUNITY.

+THE PROCESS IS BOTH CREATIVE AND EDUCATIONAL. IT TAPS IMAGINATION, DEVELOPS LEADERSHIP POTENTIALS AND STRENGTHENS ORGANISING ABILITIES.

+THROUGH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THEIR OWN PROJECTS, IT IS POSSIBLE TO DEVELOP A CO-OPERATIVE SPIRIT AND A SENSE OF CIVIC RESPONSIBILITY, AS WELL AS TO BROADEN UP SOCIAL AWARENESS,+ HE SAID.

HE SAID EACH PROJECT SUBMISSION WOULD BE ASSESSED FOR ITS YOUTH INVOLVEMENT, COMMUNITY BENEFITS, INNOVATION, FEASIBILITY AND OPTIMUM USE OF RESOURCES.

PWD AWARDED 29 CONTRACTS IN MAY

THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AWARDED A TOTAL OF 29 CONTRACTS WORTH MORE THAN \$38.63 MILLION IN MAY.

OF THESE, SEVEN WERE AWARDED ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CENTRAL TENDER BOARD AND 22 ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PWD TENDER BOARD.

THE BIGGEST CONTRACT WAS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A 1.2-KILOMETRE ROAD ON THE RECLAIMED LAND SOUTH OF TAI YUEN ESTATE NOW UNDER CONSTRUCTION IN TAI PO.

THE PROJECT, WHICH FORMS PART OF THE TAI PO DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME, INCLUDES THE LAYING OF A 1.5-KILOMETRE TRUNK SEWER AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BUS TERMINUS.

OTHER MAJOR CONTRACTS AWARDED IN MAY INCLUDED THE AIR CONDITIONING AND VENTILATION INSTALLATION FOR THE DENTAL TEACHING HOSPITAL IN SAI YING PUN AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE SHA TIN GENERAL CLINIC.

YUEN LONG'S FA CUP TRIUMPH

THE SECRETARY FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES, MR. DAVID AKERS-JONES WILL OFFICIATE AT A COLOURFUL PAGEANT TO BE HELD AT THE YUEN LONG STADIUM ON WEDNESDAY (JULY 11) TO CELEBRATE YUEN LONG'S RECENT FA CUP TRIUMPH.

THE EVENT HAS BEEN ORGANISED BY THE YUEN LONG SPORTS ASSOCIATION.

ALSO ATTENDING THE PAGEANT WILL BE PROMINENT LOCAL DIGNITARIES, CIVIC AND RURAL COMMUNITY LEADERS, SENIOR GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND SOME 4,000 INVITED GUESTS AND TEAM SUPPORTERS.

MORE THAN 1,000 PEOPLE WILL TAKE PART IN A PARADE WHICH WILL START AT 6 P.M. AT THE YUEN LONG EASTERN BUS TERMINUS AND PASS THROUGH YUEN LONG MAIN ROAD BEFORE REACHING THE STADIUM WHERE THE MAIN CELEBRATION WILL BE STAGED.

THE PROGRAMME FEATURES A VARIETY OF PERFORMANCES INCLUDING THE 145-FOOT SILVER DRAGON WHICH MADE ITS DEBUT DURING HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS, THE PRINCE OF WALES VISIT TO YUEN LONG IN MARCH THIS YEAR, EIGHT LIONS, TWO BRASS BANDS, A FLAG MARCHING TEAM AND A FLORAL VEHICLE CARRYING ALL MEMBERS OF THE WINNING TEAM AND THE FA CUP.

TWELVE WESTERN BUILDINGS IN DANGEROUS CONDITION

THE BUILDING AUTHORITY TODAY (THURSDAY) DECLARED 12 BUILDINGS AT NOS. 6 TO 28 (EVEN NOS.) TSZ MI ALLEY, WESTERN DISTRICT, TO BE IN A DANGEROUS CONDITION.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE BUILDING ORDINANCE OFFICE SAID THAT THESE EARLY PRE-WAR BUILDINGS HAD BEEN UNDER PERIODICAL SURVEILLANCE FOR SEVERAL YEARS AND HAD BEEN RECENTLY RE-SURVEYED FOLLOWING THE COLLAPSE OF A KITCHEN AT NO. 6.

THESE BUILDINGS WERE FOUND TO BE IN AN EXTREMELY DILAPIDATED CONDITION, MAINLY DUE TO THE FAILURE OF THE BRICKWORK FORMING THE LOAD-BEARING WALLS, HE SAID.

+IN EVERY BUILDING THERE ARE AREAS OF BADLY ERODED, FRACTURED AND OPEN-JOINTED BRICKWORK. WHERE ORIGINAL CHINA FIR TIMBERS REMAIN, THESE ARE INVARIABLY DEFECTIVE,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

+AS THERE IS A SERIOUS RISK OF COLLAPSE, IT IS NECESSARY TO CLOSE AND DEMOLISH THEM,+ HE ADDED.

ACCORDINGLY, NOTICES OF INTENTION TO APPLY FOR CLOSURE ORDERS IN VICTORIA DISTRICT COURT AT 9.30 A.M. ON AUGUST 8, 1979 WERE POSTED TODAY.
