TRANSPORT NEEDS OF NORTHWEST NEW TERRITORIES WILL BE MET

\* \* \* \* \*

THE GOVERNMENT IS COMMITTED TO IMPROVING THE TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM IN THE NORTHWEST NEW TERRITORIES TO MEET BOTH PRESENT AND FUTURE TRANSPORT NEEDS.

AS ONE OF THE MEASURES TO IMPROVE TUEN MUN'S EXTERNAL TRANSPORT LINK, PASSENGER CAPACITY OF FERRY SERVICE FROM CENTRAL TO TUEN MUN HAS RECENTLY BEEN INCREASED BY 800 WITH TWO ADDITIONAL SAILINGS DURING MORNING PEAK HOURS.

WORK IS ALSO AT AN ADVANCED STAGE TO EXTEND SOME OF THE FERRY SAILINGS DURING MORNING PEAK HOURS TO TSIM SHA TSUI EAST. IT IS HOPED THAT A DECISION CAN BE TAKEN SHORTLY.

FURTHERMORE, ACTIVE CONSIDERATION IS BEING GIVEN TO THE PROPOSAL TO INTRODUCE A FERRY SERVICE FROM SAM SHING HUI, TUEN MUN TO CENTRAL.

ON ROAD TRANSPORT, ACTION IS IN HAND TO INTRODUCE MORE BUS PRIORITY SCHEMES ON THE ROAD NETWORK IN THE REGION AS A WAY TO SHORTEN THE TRAVELLING TIME OF THIS IMPORTANT MASS TRANSPORT MODE.

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT IS ALSO DISCUSSING WITH KOWLOON MOTOR BUS COMPANY ON THEIR PLANS TO INTRODUCE NEW ROUTES TO THE URBAN AREA VIA THE TOLO HIGHWAY.

A NUMBER OF MAJOR NEW ROADS ARE NOW BEING BUILT INCLUDING THE YUEN LONG/TUEN MUN EASTERN CORRIDOR, THE YUEN LONG SOUTHERN BY-PASS AND THE FINAL SECTION OF THE NEW TERRITORIES CIRCULAR ROAD FROM AU TAU TO FAN KAM ROAD.

ON COMPLETION BY MID-1994, THE TUEN MUN ROAD WILL BE LINKED TO THE NEW TERRITORIES CIRCULAR ROAD VIA NEW DUAL TWO-LANE EXPRESSWAYS WHICH WILL GREATLY ENHANCE ROAD CAPACITY.

MEANWHILE, ABOUT 20 LOCAL TRAFFIC IMPROVEMENT SCHEMES ARE IN PLACE TO IMPROVE TRAFFIC FLOW ON CASTLE PEAK ROAD.

OTHER TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT MEASURES IN HAND INCLUDE THE INSTALLATION BY THE END OF THE YEAR OF TRAFFIC INDICATORS ON TUEN MUN ROAD TO GIVE ADVANCE WARNINGS OF ROAD CONDITIONS AHEAD SO THAT MOTORISTS CAN DIVERT TO OTHER ROUTES TO AVOID CONGESTION.

INSTALLATION OF WEIGHING DEVICES ON TUEN MUN ROAD TO DETECT OVERLOADING OF GOODS VEHICLES IS ALSO PLANNED.

IN ADDITION, THE POLICE WILL CONTINUE TO RESPOND TO BREAKDOWNS OF VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS ON TUEN MUN HIGHWAY AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE SO THAT OBSTRUCTION IS REDUCED TO A MINIMUM.

PLANS ARE IN HAND TO WIDEN THE UPHILL SECTIONS OF TUEN MUN HIGHWAY AND SECTIONS OF CASTLE PEAK ROAD.

PRELIMINARY DESIGN OF THE COUNTRY PARK SECTION OF ROUTE 3 BETWEEN AU TAU AND TSING YI IS IN HAND. IN PARALLEL, A CONSULTANCY STUDY ON THE BEST POSSIBLE OPTION TO FINANCE THIS PROJECT WILL BE COMPLETED BY THE END OF 1992.

THE SPOKESMAN ALSO REITERATED THAT THE OPTION TO BUILD A RAIL LINK WITH NORTHWEST NEW TERRITORIES IS STILL OPEN AND IS BEING EXAMINED WITH OTHER POSSIBLE OPTIONS IN THE RAILWAY DEVELOPMENT STUDY WHICH IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED BY THE END OF THE YEAR.

THE PUBLIC WILL BE CONSULTED BEFORE THE ADMINISTRATION TAKES A VIEW ON THE ALIGNMENT OF THIS NEW RAILWAY, IF IT IS DECIDED THAT IT SHOULD GO AHEAD.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID ALL THESE PROJECTS AND MEASURES SHOWED GOVERNMENT'S DETERMINATION IN MEETING THE TRANSPORT NEEDS OF THE REGION IN BOTH SHORT AND LONG TERMS.

MOTORISTS URGED TO BE COURTEOUS AND SELF-DISCIPLINED

THE SECRETARY FOR TRANSPORT, MR MICHAEL LEUNG, TODAY (SUNDAY) URGED MOTORISTS TO EXERCISE COURTESY AND SELF-DISCIPLINE TO REDUCE TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS ON THE BUSY AND CROWDED ROADS IN HONG KONG.

SPEAKING AT THE CLOSING CEREMONY OF THE ROAD COURTESY CAMPAIGN ORGANISED BY THE ROTARY CLUB OF HONG KONG NORTHEAST, MR LEUNG SAID TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS ARISING FROM CARELESSNESS AND IMPATIENCE BROUGHT NOT ONLY LOSS OF TIME AND PROPERTY BUT ALSO LOSS OF VALUABLE LIVES.

LAST YEAR 20,321 ROAD USERS WERE INJURED IN TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS WHILE 315 WERE KILLED, REPRESENTING A DAILY AVERAGE OF 55 INJURIES AND ONE DEATH.

"SUCH CASUALTY FIGURES ARE AS WORRYING AS THOSE BROUGHT ABOUT BY CANCER OR HEART DISEASE. WHILE DOCTORS ARE STILL TRYING HARD TO FIND A CURE FOR CANCER, ONE QUICK AND SIMPLE WAY TO REDUCE THE FATALITIES IN TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS IS PATIENCE AND COURTESY ON THE PART OF MOTORISTS," MR LEUNG SAID.

MR LEUNG POINTED OUT THAT LAST YEAR, 4,147 ELDERLY PEDESTRIANS WERE INJURED AND 113 KILLED IN TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS.

HE REMINDED MOTORISTS TO EXERCISE GREATER CARE AND PATIENCE WHEN ELDERLY PEDESTRIANS MADE THEIR CROSSINGS AS THEY WERE SLOWER IN MOVEMENTS AND MORE PRONE TO INACCURATE JUDGEMENT ON ROAD CONDITIONS.

NEW PROCEDURE FOR SECONDARY 6 ADMISSION

\* \* \* \* \*

STUDENTS ACHIEVING 14 OR MORE POINTS IN SIX SUBJECTS IN THE HONG KONG CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION EXAMINATION CAN APPLY FOR SECONDARY 6 PLACES IN THEIR OWN/CONSORTIUM/FEEDER-LINK SCHOOLS FROM 9 AM TO 3.30 PM ON TUESDAY (AUGUST 11).

REMINDING STUDENTS OF THE REVISED SECONDARY 6 ADMISSION PROCEDURE, AN EDUCATION DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN TODAY (SUNDAY) SAID STUDENTS WITH 14 POINTS OR MORE WHO WISH TO APPLY FOR SECONDARY 6 PLACES IN OTHER SCHOOLS CAN DO SO FROM 9 AM TO 3.30 PM ON WEDNESDAY AND, IF SUCCESSFUL, THEY SHOULD REGISTER WITH THE SCHOOL BEFORE 3.30 PM ON THURSDAY.

FOR THOSE OBTAINING RESULTS THAT ARE BETTER THAN THE NEW MINIMUM A-LEVEL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS, THEY CAN APPLY ON FRIDAY BEFORE 3.30 PM TO THEIR OWN SCHOOL OR LINKED SCHOOL IF IT STILL HAS VACANCIES.

IF STUDENTS STILL HAVE NOT OBTAINED A PLACE ON MONDAY (AUGUST 17), THEY MAY APPLY BEFORE 3.30 PM ON THE DAY TO OTHER SCHOOLS INCLUDING PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS AND BOUGHT-PLACE SCHOOLS WHICH HAVE VACANCIES AND, IF SUCCESSFUL, THEY SHOULD REGISTER WITH THE SCHOOL BY 3.30 PM ON TUESDAY (AUGUST 18).

CURRENT YEAR HONG KONG CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION EXAMINATION CANDIDATES WISHING TO APPLY FOR SECONDARY 6 PLACES THROUGH CENTRAL ALLOCATION CAN SUBMIT THEIR APPLICATION AT FOUR CENTRES BETWEEN 9 AM AND 3.30 PM ON WEDNESDAY (AUGUST 19).

THE SPOKESMAN SAID APPLICATIONS FOR CENTRAL ALLOCATION WOULD BE PROCESSED ON AUGUST 20 AND 21 AND THE RESULTS WOULD BE DISPLAYED AT THE CENTRES ON TUESDAY (AUGUST 25).

/APPLICANTS FOR .....

APPLICANTS FOR CENTRAL ALLOCATION SHOULD GO TO THE SAME CENTRE WHERE THEY HAD PREVIOUSLY HANDED IN THEIR APPLICATIONS TO COLLECT AN ALLOCATION RESULTS SLIP AND SUBMIT IT TO THE SCHOOL FOR REGISTRATION BY 3.30 PM ON THE SAME DAY.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID STUDENTS CAN SEEK FURTHER ADVICE FROM THEIR SCHOOLS ON THE ADMISSION PROCEDURE AND GET NAMES OF CONSORTIUM AND FEEDER-LINK SCHOOLS.

THIS YEAR'S SECONDARY 6 ADMISSION PROCEDURE INCLUDES PRIVATE CANDIDATES AND STUDENTS OF EVENING SCHOOLS.

"PRIVATE CANDIDATES AND EVENING STUDENTS OF SCHOOLS WHICH DO NOT OPERATE SECONDARY 6, OR OPERATE SECONDARY 6 BUT CHOOSE TO HAVE A LINK WITH THE PLK VICWOOD KT CHONG SIXTH FORM COLLEGE AT 12 WILLOW STREET, MAY APPLY TO THE SCHOOL AS A FEEDER STUDENT ON THE DAY WHEN EXAMINATION RESULTS ARE RELEASED (AUGUST 11) IF THEY HAVE OBTAINED 14 POINTS OR MORE," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

PAST STUDENTS WHO HAVE OBTAINED RESULTS THAT MEET THE NEW MINIMUM A-LEVEL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS MAY APPLY TO THEIR OWN SCHOOL OR LINKED SCHOOL FOR A DISCRETIONARY PLACE.

BUT ADMISSION WILL BE SOLELY AT THE DISCRETION OF THE SCHOOL, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN REMINDED STUDENTS THAT THEY SHOULD NOT DETACH THE TEARAWAY PORTION OF THE EXAMINATION RESULTS SLIP WHICH WOULD BE RETAINED BY THE SCHOOL AFTER THE CANDIDATE HAS ACCEPTED THE OFFER OF A SECONDARY 6 PLACE AND REGISTERED WITH THE SCHOOL.

#### LABOUR ENQUIRY SERVICE DOUBLED

THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT HAS MORE THAN DOUBLED THE CAPACITY OF ITS SERVICE TO RESIDENTS MAKING TELEPHONE ENQUIRIES ON GENERAL LABOUR MATTERS.

"SINCE THE THIRD PHASE OF THE GENERAL ENQUIRY TELEPHONE SERVICE (GETS) CAME INTO OPERATION ON JUNE 1, WE HAVE ON AVERAGE HANDLED 798 ENQUIRIES EVERYDAY, COMPARED WITH 305 IN MAY," SENIOR LABOUR OFFICER (LABOUR INSPECTION), MR CHAN KWOK-KUEN, SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

IN OTHER WORDS, THE GETS RECEIVED 33,842 ENQUIRIES IN THE MONTHS OF JUNE AND JULY, MR CHAN SAID.

OF THESE ENQUIRIES, ABOUT 94 PER CENT OR 31,837 WERE ANSWERED DIRECTLY BY LABOUR INSPECTORS, WHILE 520 CALLS WERE ANSWERED BY A DATAPHONE WHICH PLAYED BACK PRE-RECORDED TAPES ON 29 SELECTED LABOUR TOPICS IN ENGLISH AND CHINESE.

THE REMAINING 1,485 ENQUIRIES, WHICH REQUIRED IN-DEPTH ANSWERS OR FOLLOW-UP ACTION, WERE REFERRED TO RELEVANT DIVISIONS OR TO OTHER GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS.

MR CHAN POINTED OUT THAT MOST OF THE ENQUIRIES RELATED TO PROVISIONS OF THE EMPLOYMENT ORDINANCE, WHILE OTHERS WERE ON THE EMPLOYMENT OF FOREIGN DOMESTIC HELPERS, THE EMPLOYEES' COMPENSATION ORDINANCE, WOMEN AND YOUNG PERSONS (INDUSTRY) AND EMPLOYMENT OF CHILDREN REGULATIONS AND OTHER LABOUR LAWS.

HOWEVER, ENQUIRIES RELATING TO THE FACTORY INSPECTORATE DIVISION, OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH DIVISION AND THE PRESSURE EQUIPMENT DIVISION WERE STILL DEALT WITH SEPARATELY BECAUSE OF THEIR SPECIAL NATURE.

HE SAID THE GETS HOTLINE - 717 1771 - HAS 13 LINES OPERATING FROM 9 AM TO 5.30 PM INCLUDING LUNCH TIME, FROM MONDAY TO FRIDAY, AND FROM 9 AM TO NOON ON SATURDAYS.

NOTING THAT ENQUIRERS MAY HAVE DIFFICULTIES IN GETTING THROUGH THE BUSY HOTLINE, MR CHAN ASKED MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO CALL BETWEEN 11.30 AM AND 2 PM OR AFTER 4 PM FOR EASIER ACCESS.

PLEA ON NEIGHBOURHOOD HELP

THE DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE, MR M D CARTLAND, TODAY (SUNDAY) APPEALED TO THE COMMUNITY TO ESTABLISH MUTUAL HELP TO PREVENT YOUNG CHILDREN FROM BEING LEFT UNATTENDED AT HOME.

MR CARTLAND MADE THE CALL WHEN ADDRESSING THE OPENING CEREMONY OF THE PROJECT, "THE ELDERLY, THEY STILL CARE", JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE DRAGON JAYCEES, THE SALVATION ARMY AND THE HONG KONG ASSOCIATION OF SECRETARIES.

"PARENTS IN THE SAME NEIGHBOURHOOD SHOULD HELP EACH OTHER TO PROVIDE TEMPORARY CARE FOR CHILDREN WHEN THE NEED ARISES," HE SAID.

HE SAID THERE WERE INCREASING NUMBER OF FAMILIES THAT FACED ECONOMIC PRESSURES REQUIRING BOTH PARENTS TO GO TO WORK.

"SOME PARENTS ARE TEMPTED TO TAKE RISKS BY LEAVING THEIR CHILDREN AT HOME UNATTENDED," HE SAID.

NOTING THAT ACCIDENTS AND TRAGEDIES HAD OCCURRED FROM TIME TO TIME, HE SAID FAMILIES AT RISK IN THIS KIND OF SITUATION NEEDED HELP AND GUIDANCE.

"ONE OF THE MOST EFFECTIVE WAYS OF PROVIDING ASSISTANCE IS AT THE NEIGHBOURHOOD LEVEL WHERE THE ELDERLY AND THE RETIRED ARE WELL PLACED TO EMPHASISE THE IMPORTANCE OF PROPER CHILD CARE," MR CARTLAND ADDED.

HE POINTED OUT THAT THEY COULD ALSO HELP PUBLICISE THE AVAILABILITY OF CHILDMINDING FACILITIES AND PERHAPS EVEN TO PROVIDE CHILDMINDING SERVICES THEMSELVES BY OFFERING HELP TO THEIR NEIGHBOURS.

GOVT PROPOSES NEW BRIDGE FOR VILLAGERS ON LANTAU  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE GOVERNMENT PROPOSES TO PROVIDE A NEW FOOTBRIDGE AT HANG MEI, TAI O ON LANTAU ISLAND TO REPLACE AN EXISTING FOOTBRIDGE.

A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY (SUNDAY) THAT THE EXISTING FOOTBRIDGE WAS DILAPIDATING AND IT WAS NECESSARY TO PROVIDE THE VILLAGERS OF HANG MEI WITH A NEW ACCESS ROAD.

THIS PROJECT COMPRISES THE CONSTRUCTION OF A REINFORCED CONCRETE FOOTBRIDGE ACROSS A RIVER WEST OF HANG MEI AND THE SUBSEQUENT DEMOLITION OF THE EXISTING FOOTBRIDGE.

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS TO AND FROM HANG MEI WOULD BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES DURING THE CONSTRUCTION PERIOD, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

A NOTICE CONCERNING THE PROPOSED WORKS WAS PUBLISHED IN THE LATEST GAZETTE.

THE PLAN SHOWING THE EXTENT OF THE PROPOSED WORKS CAN BE SEEN AT THE GOVERNMENT OFFICES DURING OFFICE HOURS:
