MACLEHOSE FUND

* * *

A BILL PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MACLEHOSE FUND IS PUBLISHED TODAY.

THE FUND WAS PROPOSED BY UMECO TO COMMEMORATE SIR MURRAY MACLEHOSE'S GOVERNORSHIP AND UNLIKE SIMILAR FUNDS IN THE PAST, ITS USES WILL NOT BE CONFINED TO ANY PARTICULAR SOCIAL SERVICE AREA.

THE ONLY CONDITION IS THAT IT IS TO BE USED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PEOPLE OF HONG KONG AS DECIDED BY THE GOVERNOR, A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN SAID.

+THE SECRETARY FOR HOME AFFAIRS WILL BE THE TRUSTEE OF THE FUND UNDER THE SIR MURRAY MACLEHOSE TRUST FUND BILL NOW GAZETTED, AND AN ANNUAL ACCOUNT OF THE FUND WILL BE TABLED IN THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

+TO ENABLE THE FUND TO BE PUT TO IMMEDIATE USE, THE BILL ALLOWS THE SPENDING OF UP TO \$10 MILLION OF THE CAPITAL BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1985,+ HE SAID.

AS AT MAY 13, 1982, A TOTAL OF \$21.6 MILLION HAS BEEN RAISED.

DONATIONS, IN ANY AMOUNT, CAN BE SENT BY CROSSED CHEQUE TO THE HONORARY TREASURER OF THE MACLEHOSE FUND, INTERNATIONAL BUILDING, 19TH FLOOR, 141 DES VOEUX ROAD CENTRAL, HONG KONG.

THEY CAN ALSO BE MADE AT ALL CITY AND NEW TERRITORIES DISTRICT OFFICES AND BRANCHES OF THE HONG KONG AND SHANGHAI BANK, CHARTERED BANK, HANG SENG BANK AND BANK OF EAST ASIA.

THE BUS ONLY LANE ON POTTINGER STREET BETWEEN CONNAUGHT ROAD CENTRAL AND DES VOEUX ROAD CENTRAL WILL BE RESCINDED FOR ABOUT TWO WEEKS DUE TO EMERGENCY WATER MAINS WORK.

THIS WILL ALSO APPLY TO THE SOUTHERN CARRIAGEWAY OF DES VOEUX ROAD CENTRAL BETWEEN BANK STREET AND QUEEN VICTORIA STREET, BUT ONLY FROM 7 AM TO 10 AM AND 4 PM TO 7 PM DAILY.

TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT LOOKS INTO THE FUTURE

* * * * *

THE COMMISSIONER FOR TRANSPORT, MR ALAN ARMSTRONG-WRIGHT ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT HIS DEPARTMENT WILL BE CARRYING OUT AN IN-DEPTH STUDY INTO DETERMINING THE NEED FOR RESTRUCTURING ALL PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICES BY 1986 WHEN THE MASS TRANSIT RAILWAY'S ISLAND LINE COMES INTO OPERATION.

THE RESEARCH, HE ADDED, IS ALSO AIMED AT DEVELOPING A MORE +INTEGRATED PUBLIC TRANSPORT SYSTEM+ (DIPTRANS) FOR THE ISLAND CORRIDOR FROM 1986 ONWARDS.

TWO CONSULTANCY FIRMS - A BRITISH AND AN AMERICAN - HAVE BEEN ENGAGED TO HELP IN THE STUDIES AND MR ARMSTRONG-WRIGHT TODAY SIGNED AN AGREEMENT WITH REPRESENTATIVES FROM HALCROW FOX AND ASSOCIATES AND WILBUR SMITH AND ASSOCIATES.

ALTHOUGH THIS IS THE FOURTH DIPTRANS STUDY - THE PREVIOUS THREE HAVING BEEN CARRIED OUT BEFORE AND AFTER THE COMMISSIONING OF THE MTR'S MODIFIED INITIAL SYSTEM AND BEFORE THE OPENING OF THE TSUEN WAN EXTENSION - IT WILL BE THE FIRST TO BE HEADED AND SUPERVISED BY A TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT OFFICER.

THE TEAM WILL BE HEADED BY CHIEF TRANSPORT OFFICER, MR ERNEST LEE AND WILL INCLUDE TEN OF HIS COLLEAGUES, THREE EXPERTS FROM THE TWO CONSULTANCY FIRMS, A SYSTEM ANALYST, AN ECONOMIST, AND A PUBLIC TRANSPORT PLANNER.

THE STUDIES WILL BEGIN ON MAY 17 AND ARE EXPECTED TO TAKE EIGHT MONTHS TO COMPLETE.

+THE STUDY WILL ENABLE US TO PROJECT THE NUMBER OF PASSENGERS MAJOR TRANSPORT MODES WILL BE CARRYING ON HONG KONG ISLAND BY 1986, 1991 AND 1996,+ MR LEE SAID.

+THE RESEARCH WILL BE BASED ON A SET OF ASSUMPTIONS SPECIFYING POPULATION DISTRIBUTION, PRIVATE CAR GROWTH RATE, THE NUMBER OF PUBLIC TRANSPORT TRIPS MADE PER PERSON, FARE LEVELS AND SEVERAL OTHER FACTORS,+ HE ADDED.

MR LEE SAID ANOTHER IMPORTANT ASPECT OF THE STUDY WAS THAT THE DATA OBTAINED WILL GREATLY ASSIST TRANSPORT ADMINISTRATORS TO DECIDE THE RATE OF BUS FLEET EXPANSION BEFORE AND AFTER THE OPENING OF THE MTR'S ISLAND LINE.

+THE EFFECTS THE ISLAND LINE WILL HAVE ON FERRY SERVICES AND PUBLIC LIGHT BUSES, AND THE OPTION TO CURTAIL TRAM SERVICES WILL ALSO BE RESEARCHED IN DETAIL,+ MR LEE SAID.

RESIDENTIAL COACH SERVICES

* * *

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT HAS GRANTED 27 LICENCES TO OPERATORS OF A NEW TYPE OF RESIDENTIAL COACH SERVICES ON HONG KONG ISLAND AND IN KOWLOON AND THE NEW TERRITORIES.

+THE MAIN PURPOSE OF THIS LATEST SERVICE IS TO MEET THE TRANSPORT NEEDS OF OUTLYING RESIDENTIAL AREAS, ESPECIALLY PRIVATE DEVELOPMENTS WITHOUT ADEQUATE BUS AND MAXICAB SERVICES,+ A SPOKESMAN EXPLAINED.

APPLICATIONS WERE FIRST INVITED IN FEBRUARY AND 88 WERE RECEIVED. SIXTEEN HAVE BEEN REJECTED BECAUSE OF THE AVAILABILITY OF ADEQUATE ALTERNATIVE TRANSPORT SERVICES.

THE REMAINING 45 APPLICATIONS WILL BE RECONSIDERED IN MID-JUNE.

+THIS IS BECAUSE SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES MAY BE BROUGHT ABOUT BY THE PARTIAL ELECTRIFICATION OF THE KOWLOON-CANTON RAILWAY, THE OPENING OF THE MTR TSUEN WAN EXTENSION AND THE ASSOCIATED RE-ORGANISATION OF BUS AND MAXICAB ROUTES IN SHA TIN AND TSUEN WAN.

+CHANGES IN THE TRAVEL PATTERN COULD THEREFORE BE EXPECTED AND FOR THIS REASON THE DEPARTMENT CONSIDERS IT MORE ADVISABLE TO RE-ASSESS THESE APPLICATIONS IN MID-JUNE WHEN THE DEMAND PATTERN WOULD HAVE SETTLED DOWN,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

BILL ON ADDITIONAL GEOTECHNICAL CONTROLS PUBLISHED
* * * * *

A BILL SEEKING TO IMPOSE ADDITIONAL GEOTECHNICAL CONTROLS ON BUILDING WORKS IN THE MID-LEVELS AREA WILL BE INTRODUCED INTO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ON WEDNESDAY.

THE BUILDINGS (AMENDMENT) BILL 1982 WAS PUBLISHED IN THE GOVERNMENT GAZETTE TODAY (FRIDAY).

A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN SAID THAT THE PROPOSED LEGISLATION WAS DESIGNED TO IMPROVE CONTROL OF BUILDING OPERATIONS TO SAFEGUARD THE STABILITY OF ADJACENT GROUND.

IF ENACTED, THE ORDINANCE TOGETHER WITH REGULATIONS MADE UNDER IT WILL ENABLE THE BUILDING AUTHORITY TO:

- * LIMIT THE AMOUNT OF EXCAVATION DURING THE CARRYING OUT OF BUILDING WORK,
- * REQUIRE THE BUILDING WORKS BE CARRIED OUT IN A PARTICULAR SEQUENCE,
- * ENABLE DUE CONSIDERATION TO BE GIVEN TO THE EFFECT ON GROUND STABILITY OF THE FOUNDATION SYSTEM,
- * IMPOSE REQUIREMENTS FOR GROUNDWATER DRAINAGE WORKS,
- * REQUIRE A DEVELOPMENT TO BE DESIGNED TO RESIST LANDSLIP DEBRIS WHERE THE BUILDING AUTHORITY CONSIDERS IT NECESSARY, AND
- * REQUIRE A PERFORMANCE REVIEW TO SHOW THAT THE GEOTECHNICAL DESIGN ASSUMPTIONS UPON WHICH THE BUILDING WORKS HAVE BEEN BASED ARE VALID.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT ON ENACTMENT OF THE BILL THE TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF BUILDING DEVELOPMENT (MID-LEVELS) ORDINANCE WOULD BE REPEALED.

THE AREA TO WHICH THE NEW CONTROLS WILL APPLY EXTENDS A SHORT DISTANCE DOWNSLOPE OF THE AREA OF THE PRESENT STATUTORY MORATORIUM BETWEEN GLENEALY AND THE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID: +ENACTMENT OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS WILL IMPOSE A SUBSTANTIAL CHECKING BURDEN ON THE PRIVATE BUILDING DIVISION OF THE GEOTECHNICAL CONTROL BRANCH OF THE BUILDINGS ORDINANCE OFFICE.

+TO COPE WITH THE ADDITIONAL WORKLOAD, A MID-LEVELS DEVELOPMENT UNIT IS BEING SET UP WITHIN THE B.O.O.+

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT THE PROPOSED LEGISLATION DID NOT BAN ANY DEVELOPMENTS IN ANY PART OF THE MID-LEVELS.

THE BILL, HE ADDED, WOULD NOT AFFECT THE ADMINISTRATIVE RESTRICTIONS ON LEASE MODIFICATIONS AND NEW LAND SALES WHICH WERE IMPOSED IN 1973 ON TRAFFIC GROUNDS AND WHICH WOULD CONTINUE TO BE MAINTAINED ON THOSE GROUNDS FOR THE TIME BEING.

A STUDY OF MID-LEVELS TRAFFIC CONDITIONS WOULD COMMENCE LATER THIS YEAR TO TRY AND SOLVE THE PROBLEMS THAT WOULD ARISE IF THE ADMINISTRATIVE RESTRICTIONS WERE RELAXED.

A PLAN SHOWING THE AREA TO BE AFFECTED MAY BE INSPECTED ON THE NOTICE BOARD OF THE BUILDINGS ORDINANCE OFFICE AT THE LIFT LOBBY ON THE 10TH FLOOR, MURRAY BUILDING, GARDEN ROAD AND AT THE GEOTECHNICAL CONTROL BRANCH OFFICE, 5TH FLOOR, EMPIRE CENTRE, 68 MODY ROAD, KOWLOON.

MORE PLAY AREAS IN SAI KUNG

A CHILDREN'S PLAYGROUND AND A BASKETBALL COURT AT PO LO CHE, BUILT WITH A CONTRIBUTION OF ABOUT \$240 000 BY THE SAI KUNG DISTRICT BOARD, WERE OPENED TODAY (FRIDAY) BY THE DISTRICT OFFICER, MR CHAN SUI-JEUNG.

THE 600 SQUARE-METRE PLAYGROUND IS SITED ON A SLOPE OVERLOOKING INNER PORT SHELTER, AND HAS A SLIDE, A SWING AND OTHER PLAY EQUIPMENT, IN ADDITION TO SITTING BENCHES, FLOWER BEDS AND CHESS TABLES.

WORK ON THE PLAYGROUND STARTED LAST OCTOBER WHEN PRISONERS OF PIK UK HELPED FORM THE SITE.

THE BASKETBALL FIELD ACROSS THE PO LO CHE ROAD WAS ALSO BUILT AS PART OF THE DISTRICT BOARD'S MINOR ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMME LAST YEAR.

IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE OPENING, BASKETBALL TEAMS FROM TAI PING TSUEN AND SHUNG TSUN MIDDLE SCHOOL PLAYED A FRIENDLY MATCH TO MARK THE OCCASION.

THE BOARD WILL SPEND \$550 000 ON VARIOUS ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE DISTRICT THIS YEAR.

ALSO OFFICIATING AT TODAY'S CEREMONY WERE THE CHAIRMAN OF PO LO CHE TSUEN MUTUAL AID COMMITTEE, MR WONG PING-KIN- THE CHAIRMAN OF TAI PING TSUEN MUTUAL AID COMMITTEE, MR LOK KWONG-MING- AND THE VILLAGE REPRESENTATIVE OF PAK KONG AU TSUEN, MR LAU WAN-HEI.

ELECTRIC TRAINS TO SHA TIN RACE COURSE PROVE POPULAR

THE NEW ELECTRIC TRAIN SERVICE BETWEEN THE KOWLOON AND SHA TIN RACE COURSE STATIONS HAS PROVED POPULAR AMONG RACE-GOERS, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE KOWLOON CANTON RAILWAY SAID TODAY (FRIDAY).

MORE THAN 15 000 PASSENGERS USED THE SPECIAL ELECTRIC SERVICE LAST SUNDAY, HE SAID.

THE FIGURE WAS FIVE TIMES MORE THAN THE AVERAGE FIGURE OF 3 000 PASSENGERS, WHO USED THE DIESEL-HAULED TRAINS IN PREVIOUS RACE DAYS, A KCR SPOKESMAN SAID.

A SIMILAR SERVICE WILL BE RUN TO THE SHA TIN RACE COURSE TOMORROW (SATURDAY) AND RACE-GOERS ARE REMINDED TO BUY TICKETS IN ADVANCE FROM ALL RAILWAY STATIONS BECAUSE THE TICKETS ARE NOT SOLD AT THE ROYAL HONG KONG JOCKEY CLUB OFF-COURSE BETTING CENTRES.

TECHNICAL TEACHING COURSE
* * * *

THE HONG KONG TECHNICAL TEACHERS' COLLEGE IS INVITING APPLICANTS TO TAKE PART IN A ONE-YEAR, FULL-TIME TECHNICAL TEACHING COURSE COMMENCING IN SEPTEMBER.

THE COURSE IS INTENDED FOR YOUNG MEN AND WOMEN WITH SOME YEARS OF INDUSTRIAL EXPERIENCE WHO ARE INTERESTED IN TAKING UP TEACHING AS A PROFESSION.

INDUCEMENT GRANTS BETWEEN \$1 650 AND \$2 500 PER MONTH WILL BE GIVEN TO STUDENTS ATTENDING THE COURSE. THE AMOUNT OF SUCH GRANTS WILL DEPEND ON THE EXPERIENCE OF INDIVIDUAL COURSE MEMBERS.
