TWELVE HONG KONG PRODUCTS REMAIN ON GSP LIST  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE EUROPEAN ECONOMIC COMMUNITY'S GENERALISED SYSTEM OF PREFERENCES FOR 1986 WILL NOT EXCLUDE ANY PRODUCT FROM HONG KONG, THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF TRADE, MR JOSPEH WONG, SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

THE EUROPEAN COUNCIL OF MINISTERS HAS REJECTED THE COMMISSION'S ORIGINAL PROPOSAL TO EXCLUDE 12 HONG KONG PRODUCTS FROM THE GENERALISED SYSTEM OF PREFERENCES. THESE PRODUCTS WILL THEREFORE CONTINUE TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR GSP BENEFITS ALTHOUGH THE QUOTA LEVEL (I.E. THE LEVEL WITHIN WHICH DUTY-FREE BENEFITS ARE GIVEN) IN 1986 WILL BE ABOUT HALF OF THE 1985 LEVEL.

THE 12 PRODUCTS INCLUDE TRAVEL GOODS OF MATERIALS OTHER THAN ARTIFICIAL PLASTIC SHEETING; PROTECTIVE GLOVES OF LEATHER OR LEATHER COMPOSITION FOR ALL TRADES; RUBBER FOOTWEAR; FOOTWEAR WITH OUTER SOLES OF LEATHER OR COMPOSITION LEATHER; IMITATION JEWELLERY; PORTABLE ELECTRIC BATTERY AND MAGNETIC LAMPS OTHER THAN MINER'S SAFETY LAMPS; COLOUR TELEVISIONS; DIODES; TRANSISTORS; QUARTZ WATCHES; DOLLS; OTHER TOYS; EQUIPMENT FOR PARLOUR, TABLE AND FUNFAIR GAMES.

EXPORTS OF THESE 12 PRODUCTS TO THE EEC FOR THE FIRST 10 MONTHS OF 1985 AMOUNTED TO \$3 792 MILLION OR 21 PER CENT OF TOTAL EXPORTS TO THE EEC OF \$18 152 MILLION.

TO PUT THE 1986 SCHEME IN PERSPECTIVE, MR WONG SAID THAT THE EEC HAS MADE A SIGNIFICANT IMPROVEMENT TO ALL BENEFICIARIES BY INCREASING THE QUOTA LEVELS OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS GENERALLY BY 9.5 PER CENT. THIS IS TO TAKE ACCOUNT OF THE ACCESSION OF SPAIN AND PORTUGAL INTO THE EEC FROM JANUARY 1, 1986.

INCREASES ON THE QUOTA LEVELS OF A NUMBER OF HONG KONG PRODUCTS VARY BETWEEN 9.5 PER CENT AND 76 PER CENT. THEY INCLUDE TRAVEL GOODS OF ARTIFICIAL PLASTIC SHEETING; ARTICLES OF APPAREL AND CLOTHING ACCESSORIES OF LEATHER OR COMPOSITION LEATHER; FOOTWEAR WITH UPPERS OF LEATHER; UMBRELLAS AND SUNSHADES; LOCKS AND PADLOCKS; SOUND RECORDERS OR REPRODUCERS; CARNIVAL ARTICLES; KNIVES; TABLEWARE; GLASS INNERS FOR VACUUM FLASKS; OTHER ARTICLES OF IRON AND STEEL; SPOONS; STAINLESS STEEL FORKS; AND MOUNTED PIEZO-ELECTRIC CRYSTALS.

EXPORTS OF THESE 13 PRODUCTS TO THE EEC FOR THE FIRST 10 MONTHS OF 1985 WERE HK\$586 MILLION, OR 3 PER CENT OF TOTAL EXPORTS TO THE EEC.

THAT HONG KONG CONTINUES TO BE A BENEFICIARY IN RESPECT OF ALL PRODUCTS UNDER THE 1986 SCHEME REAFFIRMS A WELCOME RECOGNITION BY THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY OF HONG KONG'S STATUS AS A DEVELOPING TERRITORY ELIGIBLE FOR PREFERENTIAL BENEFITS UNDER THE GENERALISED SYSTEM OF PREFERENCES, SAID MR WONG.

IN 1984, THE TOTAL VALUE OF EEC IMPORTS FROM HONG KONG WAS ABOUT HK\$28 000 MILLION, OF WHICH ABOUT HK\$4 900 MILLION, OR 18 PER CENT, ENTERED THE EEC DUTY-FREE UNDER THE GSP.

HONG KONG EXPORTS ABOUT 140 INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS TO THE EEC. THE EEC DUTY TARIFF ON INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS VARIES BETWEEN 0.6 PER CENT AND 21 PER CENT.

REGIONAL COUNCIL'S ROLE IN SPORTS PROMOTION PLEDGED  
\* \* \* \*

THE REGIONAL COUNCIL HAS EARMARKED \$1 MILLION AS FINANCIAL SUPPORT IN PROMOTING SPORTS ACTIVITIES ORGANISED BY OUTSIDE BODIES IN THE COMING FINANCIAL YEAR, THE CHAIRMAN OF THE PROVISIONAL REGIONAL COUNCIL, MR CHEUNG YAN-LUNG, SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

SPEAKING AT THE PRIZE-PRESENTATION CEREMONY OF THE 1985-86 CHILDREN'S FOOTBALL DEVELOPMENT SCHEME AT THE JUBILEE SPORTS CENTRE, MR CHEUNG SAID THAT THE PROVISIONAL REGIONAL COUNCIL WAS FULLY AWARE OF THE ROLE THE REGIONAL COUNCIL WOULD PLAY WHEN IT WAS ESTABLISHED ON APRIL 1 NEXT YEAR.

+THE RECREATION AND CULTURE SELECT COMMITTEE OF THE PROVISIONAL REGIONAL COUNCIL HAS EXAMINED RECENTLY THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE REGIONAL COUNCIL, THE URBAN COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL FOR RECREATION AND SPORT IN THE FUNDING OF SPORTS ACTIVITIES.

+IT IS BELIEVED THAT THE REGIONAL COUNCIL WILL CONTINUE, THROUGH THE REGIONAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT, TO MANAGE SPORTS FACILITIES AND ORGANISE SPORTS EVENTS, COMPETITIONS AND TRAINING PROGRAMMES FOR RESIDENTS IN THE REGIONAL COUNCIL AREA,+  
MR CHEUNG ADDED.

THREE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED CHILDREN AGED BETWEEN NINE AND 14 TOOK PART IN THIS YEAR'S FOOTBALL DEVELOPMENT SCHEME WHICH IS JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE HONG KONG FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION, THE URBAN COUNCIL, THE REGIONAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT, THE JUBILEE SPORTS CENTRE AND THE BOTTLERS OF +COCA-COLA+.

THE SCHEME PROVIDES BASIC TRAINING IN SOCCER TO THE PARTICIPANTS AND THOSE WITH POTENTIAL ARE SELECTED FOR LONG-TERM TRAINING IN THE SPORT.

NEIGHBOURS HELP TO FIGHT CRIME STRESSED

COOPERATION AMONG RESIDENTS IS VITAL IN THE FIGHT AGAINST CRIME AND THE NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH SCHEME CONCEPT WILL ENHANCE THEIR SENSE OF RESPONSIBILITY AND ALERTNESS, SOUTHERN DISTRICT OFFICER, MR EDDY CHAN, SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

HE SAID THE NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH SCHEME, IN WHICH SEVERAL HOUSEHOLDS JOIN TO FORM SMALL GROUPS TO SUPPORT EACH OTHER, WILL HELP IMPROVE THE LAW AND ORDER SITUATION.

SPEAKING AT THE OPENING CEREMONY OF THE DISTRICT'S FIGHT CRIME CAMPAIGN, MR CHAN SAID THAT IN THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT, MORE THAN 1 200 HOUSEHOLDS FROM WAH FU, SHEK PAI WAN, WONG CHUK HANG AND AP LEI CHAU ESTATES PLAN TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SCHEME, AND ABOUT 72 NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH UNITS WOULD BE FORMED IN SOME 20 PUBLIC AND PRIVATE HOUSING BLOCKS.

CHAIRMAN OF THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME CAMPAIGN CO-ORDINATING COMMITTEE, MR JOSEPH CHAN, ALSO CALLED ON RESIDENTS TO CONTRIBUTE TO CRIME PREVENTION BY BEING MORE CAUTIOUS WITH THEIR BELONGINGS AND KEEPING THEIR CARS AND PROPERTIES LOCKED.

THE DISTRICT'S FIGHT CRIME CAMPAIGN, JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME COMMITTEE, THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT OFFICE AND THE WESTERN POLICE DISTRICT, IS DIRECTED THIS YEAR AT THE NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH SCHEME AND DRUG ABUSE.

TO SPREAD THE MESSAGE, THERE ARE ARRANGEMENTS FOR SCHOOL CHILDREN TO VISIT VARIOUS POLICE INSTITUTIONS, SEMINARS WITH AREA COMMITTEES ON THE NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH SCHEME, SCHOOL VISITS AND FORUMS BY POLICE OFFICERS, AND COMPETITIONS IN STORY WRITING AND CARTOON DRAWING ABOUT HOUSEHOLD SECURITY AND NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH.

+THESE ACTIVITIES WILL IMPROVE RESIDENTS' UNDERSTANDING ABOUT POLICE WORK, AND PROMPT THEM TO GIVE DEEPER THOUGHT TO CRIME PREVENTION,+ HE SAID.

TODAY'S OPENING CEREMONY WAS FOLLOWED BY A CARNIVAL SPONSORED BY THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT BOARD. ABOUT 2 000 RESIDENTS ARE TREATED TO FUN AND GAMES IN THE CARNIVAL FEATURING PERFORMANCES BY WELL-KNOWN ARTISTES AND SINGERS, ACROBATIC ACTS, KARATE DEMONSTRATION AND A LION DANCE.

ALSO OFFICIATING AT THE CEREMONY WERE DISTRICT COMMANDER WESTERN POLICE DISTRICT, MR D. DEPTFORD, AND SOUTHERN DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME COMMITTEE MEMBERS, MR LAM KWOK-KWONG, MR KAN MAN-LEE, MR KWOK WAI-MING AND MISS YAU YUK-LAN.

ANTI-NARCOTICS CARNIVAL AT VICTORIA PARK

PARENTS ARE URGED TO DEVOTE AS MUCH TIME AND ATTENTION TO THEIR CHILDREN AS POSSIBLE TO PREVENT THEM FROM WANDERING INTO THE HANDS OF DRUG PEDLARS.

THE APPEAL WAS MADE TODAY (SUNDAY) BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE ACTION COMMITTEE AGAINST NARCOTICS' SUB-COMMITTEE ON PREVENTIVE EDUCATION AND PUBLICITY, MR KARL STUMPF, AT THE OPENING CEREMONY OF THE ANTI-NARCOTICS CARNIVAL.

MR STUMPF STRESSED THAT AN UNCARING FAMILY ENVIRONMENT, WITHOUT PARENTAL LOVE, WARMTH AND GUIDANCE OF SECURITY, MIGHT CAUSE A CHILD TO RESORT TO DRUGS AS A MEANS OF ESCAPE.

TODAY'S CARNIVAL, ORGANISED BY THE ACAN YOUTH VOLUNTEER GROUP UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE NARCOTICS DIVISION, GOVERNMENT SECRETARIAT, IS AIMED AT ENCOURAGING YOUNG PEOPLE TO PARTICIPATE IN HEALTHY PURSUITS AND TO KEEP AWAY FROM DRUGS.

MR STUMPF POINTED OUT THAT THE PREVENTIVE EDUCATION AND PUBLICITY PROGRAMME OF THE ACAN WAS AIMED AT CREATING PUBLIC AWARENESS OF DRUG MENACE AND WAS DESIGNED TO ENCOURAGE COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT IN THE FIGHT AGAINST DRUGS.

+THE ACAN YOUTH VOLUNTEER GROUP HAS PLAYED AN IMPORTANT ROLE TO HELP ACHIEVE THESE OBJECTIVES,+ HE SAID.

THE GROUP'S MAIN FUNCTION IS TO ASSIST IN IMPLEMENTING ANTI-NARCOTICS EDUCATION AND PUBLICITY PROJECTS ORGANISED BY THE NARCOTICS DIVISION, GOVERNMENT SECRETARIAT.

SINCE ITS ESTABLISHMENT IN 1981, IT HAS TAKEN PART IN MORE THAN 100 ANTI-NARCOTICS PREVENTIVE EDUCATION AND PUBLICITY ACTIVITIES.

THE CARNIVAL, WHICH STARTED AT 2 PM AT VICTORIA PARK, FEATURED ANTI-NARCOTICS EXHIBITIONS, A DEMONSTRATION BY DRUG SNUFFER DOGS FROM THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE DEPARTMENT, GAMES STALL DESIGN COMPETITION, A VARIETY SHOW AND A GIANT INFLATABLE GORILLA FOR CHILDREN.

#### MORE ROADS FOR TSING YI ISLAND

A SERIES OF ROADS, TOTALLING FOUR KILOMETRES, ARE TO BE BUILT IN THE NORTH-EASTERN PART OF TSING YI ISLAND.

THE ROADS WILL LINK TSING YI NORTH BRIDGE NOW UNDER CONSTRUCTION, TO THE EXISTING ROAD NETWORK WHICH LEAD TO NEW DEVELOPMENTS ON THE ISLAND.

THESE DEVELOPMENTS INCLUDE FOUR PUBLIC HOUSING ESTATES AND A HOME OWNERSHIP SCHEME ESTATE DESIGNED TO ACCOMMODATE UP TO 72 000 PEOPLE.

THE NEW TERRITORIES DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT IS INVITING TENDERS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE ROADS.

WORK IS EXPECTED TO START IN MARCH NEXT YEAR AND TAKE ABOUT 24 MONTHS TO COMPLETE.

ROAD IN CHAI WAN CLOSED FOR ESTATE REDEVELOPMENT

THE SECTION OF WAH HA STREET BETWEEN ITS EASTERN JUNCTION WITH WAN TSUI ESTATE ACCESS ROAD AND CHAI WAN ROAD WILL BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC FROM 10 AM ON WEDNESDAY (JANUARY 1) FOR THE REDEVELOPMENT OF WAN TSUI ESTATE.

AT THE SAME TIME, CMB ROUTES 82, 82A AND 84 WILL BE DIVERTED TO OPERATE ALONG CHAI WAN ROAD WITHOUT PASSING THROUGH WAN TSUI ESTATE.
