SWD PAYS OUT \$177 MILLION AS SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS

\* \* \* \* \*

THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT, AMID CONTINUED EXPANSION IN OTHER FIELDS OF WELFARE SERVICE, HAS PAID OUT \$177 MILLION AS NON-CONTRIBUTORY SOCIAL SECURITY CASH BENEFITS IN THE FIRST FIVE MONTHS OF 1979.

THE MONEY WENT TO MORE THAN 300,000 PEOPLE AS PUBLIC ASSISTANCE, OLD AGE ALLOWANCE AND DISABILITY ALLOWANCE ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT'S 26 SOCIAL SECURITY FIELD UNITS.

THE AMOUNT WAS ABOUT \$62 MILLION MORE THAN IN THE SAME PERIOD LAST YEAR AND REPRESENTED A DAILY AVERAGE PAYOUT OF \$1.2 MILLION.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY (TUESDAY) THE INCREASE IN PAYOUT WAS MAINLY DUE TO THE LOWERING, FROM 75 TO 70, OF THE QUALIFYING AGE FOR THE OLD AGE ALLOWANCE WHICH HAD RESULTED IN AN ADDITIONAL 62,000 CASES.

THESE EXTRA CASES, HE SAID, REPRESENT ABOUT 84 PER CENT OF THE 74,000 PEOPLE ESTIMATED TO BE IN THE 70-74 AGE GROUP, AND THEY BRING TO 134,600 THE TOTAL NUMBER OF OLD AGE ALLOWANCE CASES.

ANOTHER FACTOR FOR THE INCREASED PAYOUT WAS THE INTRODUCTION IN APRIL LAST YEAR OF MAJOR IMPROVEMENTS IN THE SOCIAL SECURITY SCHEMES WHICH PROVIDED NEW OR INCREASED BENEFITS, HE SAID.

THESE INCLUDED THE PROVISION OF A LONG-TERM SUPPLEMENT, AN OLD AGE SUPPLEMENT AND A DISREGARDED INCOME SYSTEM FOR ELIGIBLE PUBLIC ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS, AND THE EXTENSION OF THE OLD AGE AND DISABILITY ALLOWANCES TO PEOPLE UNDER INSTITUTIONAL CARE, HE ADDED.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT OF THE \$177 MILLION, \$82 MILLION WERE PAID OUT AS PUBLIC ASSISTANCE, \$74 MILLION AS OLD AGE ALLOWANCE, AND \$21 MILLION AS DISABILITY ALLOWANCE.

THE MEANS-TESTED PUBLIC ASSISTANCE SCHEME PROVIDES MONTHLY CASH ASSISTANCE TO BRING THE INCOME OF A HOUSEHOLD IN NEED UP TO A LEVEL WHERE ESSENTIAL NEEDS SUCH AS FOOD AND CLOTHING CAN BE MADE.

THE NON-MEANS TESTED OLD AGE AND DISABILITY ALLOWANCE PROVIDE A MONTHLY CASH GRANT, ON TOP OF ANY PUBLIC ASSISTANCE PAYMENT, AS ADDITIONAL SUPPORT FOR THE FAMILY TO LOOK AFTER AN ELDERLY OR SEVERELY DISABLED MEMBER AND TO ENCOURAGE HIM TO REMAIN FOR AS LONG AS POSSIBLE WITHIN THE COMMUNITY.

AT PRESENT, THE DEPARTMENT'S SOCIAL SECURITY FIELD UNITS HANDLE ABOUT 46,500 PUBLIC ASSISTANCE CASES, 134,600 OLD AGE ALLOWANCE CASES AND 21,740 DISABILITY ALLOWANCE CASES.

HK CONTRIBUTES FOR FIFTH CONSECUTIVE YEAR  
TO UN FUND FOR DRUG ABUSE CONTROL

\* \* \* \* \*

THE HONG KONG GOVERNMENT TODAY (TUESDAY) CONTRIBUTED FOR THE FIFTH CONSECUTIVE YEAR, \$100,000 TO THE UNITED NATIONS FUND FOR DRUG ABUSE CONTROL (UNFDAC), DEMONSTRATING ITS FIRM COMMITMENT TO INTERNATIONAL ACTION AGAINST THE WORLD-WIDE PROBLEM OF DRUG ABUSE AND TRAFFICKING.

THE AMBASSADOR AND UNITED KINGDOM PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE TO THE UNITED NATIONS OFFICE AT GENEVA, SIR JAMES MURRAY, ON BEHALF OF THE HONG KONG GOVERNMENT, PRESENTED A CHEQUE TO THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE UNFDAC, PROFESSOR BROR REXED, AT THE UNFDAC OFFICE IN GENEVA THIS MORNING.

THE DONATION INDICATES HONG KONG'S CONTINUING RECOGNITION OF, AND TRIBUTE TO, THE RESULTS WHICH HAVE SO FAR BEEN ACHIEVED BY THE UNFDAC, THE COMMISSIONER FOR NARCOTICS, MR. E. I. LEE SAID TODAY.

+HONG KONG'S ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION IS BY FAR THE LARGEST AMONGST DEVELOPING COUNTRIES AND EVEN LARGER THAN THOSE FROM SOME DEVELOPED COUNTRIES. HONG KONG'S TOTAL CONTRIBUTION TO DATE IS \$500,000.+

MR. LEE ADDED THAT, APART FROM CASH DONATIONS, HONG KONG HAS ALSO MADE ITS ANTI-NARCOTICS EXPERTISE AND FACILITIES FREELY AVAILABLE TO THE UNITED NATIONS FOR THE TRAINING OF ANTI-NARCOTICS OFFICIALS FROM ASIAN COUNTRIES WHO ARE SPONSORED BY THE UNITED NATIONS DIVISION, OTHER UNITED NATIONS AGENCIES, THE COLOMBO PLAN BUREAU OR THEIR OWN GOVERNMENTS UNDER BILATERAL ARRANGEMENTS.

+SINCE 1974, A TOTAL OF 344 TRAINEES/VISITORS, INCLUDING ADMINISTRATORS, DOCTORS, PSYCHIATRISTS, PROBATION, POLICE AND CUSTOMS OFFICERS AND SOCIAL WORKERS, HAVE BEEN RECEIVED BY HONG KONG. STATISTICS FROM THE NARCOTICS DIVISION SHOW THAT THERE WERE 35 TRAINEES/VISITORS IN 1974, 50 IN 1975, 48 IN 1976, 115 IN 1977 AND 96 IN 1978.

+THE COST OF SUCH A DONATION-IN-KIND IS NOT INCONSIDERABLE AND A CONSERVATIVE ESTIMATE SHOWS THAT FOR 1978 ALONE, THE REAL COST WAS \$150,000.

+IN 1979, THE NUMBER OF TRAINEES SO FAR HAS CONTINUED TO INCREASE. HONG KONG HAS RECENTLY AGREED TO HOST A MONTH-LONG TRAINING COURSE FOR 20 DOCTORS FROM VARIOUS ASIAN COUNTRIES IN OCTOBER-NOVEMBER THIS YEAR IN COLLABORATION WITH THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANISATION'S (WHO) DRUG DEPENDENCE DIVISION,+ MR. LEE SAID.

+IN HONG KONG, WE HAVE LONG RECOGNISED THAT OUR DRUG ABUSE PROBLEM CANNOT BE SOLVED BY OUR OWN INTERNAL EFFORTS ALONE, BUT WILL NEED DETERMINED, EFFECTIVE AND CO-ORDINATED ACTION AT THE INTERNATIONAL LEVEL.

+THE GOVERNMENT'S POLICY IS THEREFORE TO GIVE ACTIVE SUPPORT TO COLLECTIVE INTERNATIONAL ACTION IN ALL FIELDS OF ANTI-NARCOTICS WORK,+ MR. LEE SAID.

HONG KONG GROWS NO OPIUM POPPIES AND PRACTICALLY ALL NARCOTICS ABUSED HERE COME, THROUGH THAILAND, FROM THE +GOLDEN TRIANGLE+ -- THE OPIUM GROWING AREA WHERE THE BORDERS OF THAILAND, BURMA AND LAOS MEET.

IN THIS RESPECT, MR. LEE SAID, +WE ARE ENCOURAGED BY THE HIGHLY SUCCESSFUL OUTCOME OF THE UNITED NATIONS/THAI CROP SUBSTITUTION PILOT PROJECT IN NORTHWEST THAILAND, AND AWAIT WITH CONCERNED INTEREST, THE RESULTS OF THE FIRST MAJOR EXTENSION WORK TO EMANATE FROM IT IN THE 'MAE CHAEM' WATERSHED AREA.+

IN THE FIELD OF ANTI-DRUG LAW ENFORCEMENT, HONG KONG HAS TAKEN PART FOR FIVE CONSECUTIVE YEARS IN THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE FAR EAST REGION OPERATIONAL HEADS OF NATIONAL NARCOTICS LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES HELD IN BANGKOK, JAKARTA, MANILA, PATTAYA AND COLOMBO.

THESE MEETINGS, ALL FINANCED BY THE UNFDAC, HAVE BEEN MOST EFFECTIVE IN PROMOTING BILATERAL AND MULTI-LATERAL CO-OPERATION AND THE EXCHANGE OF OPERATIONAL INFORMATION AMONG PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES.

+AS A RESULT, COLLABORATION BETWEEN LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES IN THE SOUTHEAST ASIAN REGION IS NOW WORKING WELL AND HAS PRODUCED INCREASED SEIZURES OF DRUGS AND ARRESTS OF OFFENDERS,+ MR. LEE SAID.

THE UNFDAC, ESTABLISHED IN MARCH 1971 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO GOVERNMENTS AND THEIR PEOPLE IN THE FIGHT AGAINST DRUG ABUSE, HAS FINANCED MORE THAN 80 PROJECTS ALL OVER THE WORLD.

FUNDING THE UNFDAC IS ENTIRELY DEPENDENT ON CONTRIBUTION FROM GOVERNMENTS ALL OVER THE WORLD. UP TO THE END OF 1978, THE UNFDAC HAD RECEIVED CONTRIBUTION TOTALLING ABOUT \$250 MILLION FROM 72 CONTRIBUTING COUNTRIES, OF WHICH ABOUT \$125 MILLION HAVE COME FROM THE UNITED STATES.

EIGHT QUESTIONS AT LEGCO TOMORROW

\* \* \* \*

UNOFFICIAL MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL WILL RAISE A TOTAL OF EIGHT QUESTIONS AT THE COUNCIL MEETING TOMORROW (WEDNESDAY).

THE HON. HILTON CHEONG-LEEN WILL ASK HOW THE REPORTED 4.75 PER CENT SAVING IN ENERGY LAST MONTH HAS BEEN ARRIVED AT AND WHETHER THERE IS A NEED TO CONSIDER FURTHER ENERGY SAVING MEASURES FOR THE THIRD AND FOURTH QUARTERS OF THIS YEAR.

MR. CHEONG-LEEN WILL ALSO ASK WHAT MEASURES ARE TAKEN DURING THE WET SEASON TO MONITOR DAILY THE 25 BLACKSPOTS KNOWN TO BE PARTICULARLY SUSCEPTIBLE TO LANDSLIPS AND FLOODING IN ORDER THAT NEARBY RESIDENTS MAY BE QUICKLY EVACUATED SHOULD THE NEED ARISE.

ANOTHER QUESTION ON A SIMILAR SUBJECT WILL BE RAISED BY THE HON. WONG LAM ON THE PRECAUTIONS TO MAINTAIN THE STABILITY OF SLOPES IN THE VICINITY OF QUARRIES, PARTICULARLY IN KWUN TONG.

DR. THE HON. HO KAM-FAI IS TO ASK IF THE GOVERNMENT CAN EXERCISE FURTHER INFLUENCE OVER TELEVISION PROGRAMMES, WHICH GIVE UNDUE EMPHASIS TO SEX AND VIOLENCE, TO ENSURE THE HEALTHY DEVELOPMENT OF THE YOUNG GENERATION.

OTHER QUESTIONS TO BE RAISED BY UNOFFICIAL MEMBERS CONCERN THE READY-TO-WEAR FESTIVAL, LAND OFFICE RECORDS, DC-10 AIRCRAFT AND THE GENERAL CLEANLINESS, MAINTENANCE AND APPEARANCE OF BUSES AND TRAMS.

FOUR BILLS WILL BE INTRODUCED IN THE COUNCIL FOR FIRST AND SECOND READINGS. THEY ARE THE ESTATE DUTY (AMENDMENT) (NO.2) BILL 1979, THE RATING AMENDMENT BILL 1979, THE IMMIGRATION (AMENDMENT) (NO.2) BILL 1979 AND THE MERCHANT SHIPPING (AMENDMENT) (NO.2) BILL 1979.

DEBATE WILL RESUME ON THE LAW AMENDMENT AND REFORM (CONSOLIDATION) (AMENDMENT) BILL 1979, THE LABOUR TRIBUNAL (AMENDMENT) BILL 1979, THE IMMIGRATION (AMENDMENT) (NO.2) BILL 1979 AND THE TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF BUILDING DEVELOPMENT (MID-LEVELS) BILL 1979.

### 3.4 MILLION PEOPLE VISITED CITY DISTRICT OFFICES

STAFF AT THE 24 PUBLIC ENQUIRY COUNTERS OF THE HOME AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT LAST YEAR HANDLED 1.3 MILLION ENQUIRIES AND DISTRIBUTED 2.1 MILLION FORMS AND PAMPHLETS TO THE PUBLIC.

+THIS MEANS THAT SOME 3.4 MILLION PEOPLE VISITED THE VARIOUS DISTRICT OFFICES FOR ONE TYPE OF SERVICE OR ANOTHER,+ MRS. DORA TAYLOR, SENIOR EXECUTIVE OFFICER (INFORMATION) OF THE DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY (TUESDAY).

POINTING OUT THAT THE FIGURE REPRESENTED AN INCREASE OF 36.6 PER CENT OVER THE PREVIOUS YEAR'S TOTAL, SHE SAID: +THIS SHOWS THE IMPORTANCE OF THE PUBLIC ENQUIRY COUNTERS IN HELPING TO SOLVE THE PROBLEMS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC.+

THE ENQUIRIES, SHE CONTINUED, COVERED ALMOST EVERY SUBJECT, BUT WERE MOSTLY ON HOME OWNERSHIP SCHEME (65,465 OR 4.9 PER CENT), GOVERNMENT JOBS AND VACANCIES (52,417 OR 3.9 PER CENT) AND APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HOUSING (51,601 OR 3.8 PER CENT).

+MEDIATION SERVICES ARE ALSO PROVIDED FOR PERSONAL DISPUTES, AND COMPLICATED CASES ARE HANDLED BY THE SPECIAL ADVISORY SERVICES UNIT WHICH ALSO HANDLES FAMILY DISPUTES INVOLVING CHINESE LAW AND CUSTOMS,+ SHE ADDED.

ALSO DURING THE YEAR, A TOTAL OF 157,520 STATUTORY DECLARATIONS WERE RECORDED, REPRESENTING AN INCREASE OF ABOUT 11 PER CENT OVER THE FIGURE OF THE PREVIOUS YEAR.

THE DECLARATIONS WERE ADMINISTERED AT ALL THE CITY DISTRICT OFFICES AND AT THE SPECIAL ADVISORY SERVICES UNIT OF THE DEPARTMENT.

### RECREATION GROUPS BACK SAVE FUEL CAMPAIGN

RECREATION GROUPS AND SPORTS ASSOCIATIONS HAVE RESPONDED ENTHUSIASTICALLY TO THE GOVERNMENT'S CALL TO HELP SAVE OIL BY AVOIDING UNNECESSARY FLOODLIGHTING, A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY (TUESDAY).

THE SPOKESMAN ADDED THAT LETTERS WILL SHORTLY BE SENT TO LANDLORDS AND PROPERTY COMPANIES INVITING THEM TO INTRODUCE ECONOMY MEASURES THAT WOULD CONTRIBUTE TO THE FUEL SAVING CAMPAIGN.

+OIL SUPPLIES ARE STILL UNCERTAIN AND THE CUMULATIVE EFFECT OF VOLUNTARY SAVINGS IN FUEL CONSUMPTION, HOWEVER SMALL, WILL HELP ENSURE HONG KONG'S INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL LIFE IS NOT DISRUPTED AS A RESULT OF SHORTAGES,+ HE COMMENTED.

THE GESTURES OF SUPPORT FROM RECREATION AND SPORTS GROUPS CAME IN RESPONSE TO A LETTER FROM THE SECRETARY FOR ECONOMIC SERVICES, MR. DAVID JEAFFRESON, WHO WROTE TO OVER 30 ASSOCIATIONS AND CLUBS, SEEKING THEIR CO-OPERATION IN LIMITING THE USE OF FLOODLIGHTING FOR NON-SPECTATOR SPORTS AND IN MAKING THE MOST OF DAYLIGHT HOURS.

THE ROYAL HONG KONG GOLF CLUB HAS SUSPENDED FLOODLIGHTING AT ITS DEEP WATER BAY COURSE AND OTHER ENERGY SAVING MEASURES HAVE BEEN TAKEN AT FANLING.

THE KOWLOON CRICKET CLUB HAS REDUCED ITS USE OF FLOODLIGHTING TO TWO NIGHTS A WEEK FOR LAWN BOWLS AND FOUR NIGHTS A WEEK FOR TENNIS.

THE HONG KONG FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION RE-SCHEDULED ITS F.A. CUP FINAL AND AN EXHIBITION MATCH AGAINST R.C.D. ESPANOL, BARCELONA TO DAYLIGHT HOURS.

AND MEMBER CLUBS OF THE HONG KONG LAWN BOWLS ASSOCIATION HAVE BEEN URGED TO TAKE ALL POSSIBLE STEPS TO SAVE FUEL.

+THE TEMPORARY RE-INTRODUCTION OF GREENWICH MEAN TIME PLUS NINE HAS OBVIOUSLY HELPED RECREATION GROUPS WHICH MIGHT OTHERWISE HAVE USED FLOODLIGHTING,+ SAID THE GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN.

+BUT,+ HE ADDED,+THE VOLUNTARY RE-SCHEDULING OF EVENTS WHICH SOME GROUPS HAVE UNDERTAKEN IS A WELCOME LEAD WHICH WE HOPE OTHER ASSOCIATIONS WILL FOLLOW.+
