ACTING GOVERNOR OPENS TRAINING CENTRE FOR THE HANDICAPPED
* * * * *

THE ACTING GOVERNOR, SIR JACK CATER SAID TODAY (SATURDAY) THE DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION OF SOCIAL WELFARE SERVICES HAS, IN RECENT YEARS, BEEN ONE OF THE TOP PRIORITIES FOR THE GOVERNMENT.

HE SAID MUCH OF THE WORK IN THIS FIELD HAS ALWAYS BEEN, AND WILL CONTINUE TO BE, DEPENDENT ON THE INDISPENSIBLE CONTRIBUTION AND CO-OPERATION OF ENTHUSIASTIC AND DEVOTED VOLUNTARY AGENCIES.

SIR JACK WAS SPEAKING AT THE OPENING OF THE SALVATION ARMY'S LAI KING RESIDENTIAL TRAINING CENTRE AND SPECIAL SCHOOL.

THE \$9 MILLION TRAINING CENTRE WHICH CONTAINS A SWIMMING POOL, CLASSROOMS, WORKSHOPS AND RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES IS PURPOSE-BUILT FOR THE EDUCATION AND TRAINING OF MENTALLY HANDICAPPED YOUNG PEOPLE.

FOLLOWING IS THE FULL TEXT OF SIR JACK CATER'S SPEECH AT THE OPENING OF THE NEW LAI KING TRAINING CENTRE.

+IT IS VERY GOOD TO BE WITH YOU ALL THIS MORNING ON THIS IMPORTANT OCCASION - IMPORTANT NOT ONLY FOR THE SALVATION ARMY IN HONG KONG, BUT PARTICULARLY FOR SOME OF HONG KONG'S SPECIAL CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE. THIS OPENING CEREMONY OF THE SALVATION ARMY LAI KING RESIDENTIAL TRAINING CENTRE AND SPECIAL SCHOOL MARKS ANOTHER STEP FORWARD IN THE PROVISION OF EDUCATION AND TRAINING SERVICES FOR THE MENTALLY HANDICAPPED.

+THE CONSTRUCTION AND EQUIPPING OF THIS NEW HOME (WHICH HAS COST ALMOST HK\$9 MILLION) HAS BEEN MADE POSSIBLE THROUGH A GRANT OF NEARLY \$5 MILLION FROM THE LOTTERIES FUND- A GENEROUS DONATION FROM THE BRADBURY CHARITABLE TRUST FUND- AND ALSO FROM THE SIR ROBERT HO TUNG CHARITABLE FUND. AS WELL, THERE HAVE BEEN ADDED THE MONIES RAISED BY THE SPONSORING BODY ITSELF FROM OTHER GENEROUS DONORS. LAI KING REPLACES AND UPDATES, AS WELL AS EXPANDS, THE FACILITIES PROVIDED BY THE SALVATION ARMY FOR 12 YEARS AT THE HOME ON CHEUNG CHAU PEAK: IT IS PURPOSE-BUILT TO OFFER A GOOD ENVIRONMENT AND MODERN FACILITIES FOR THE EDUCATION AND TRAINING OF 126 MODERATELY MENTALLY HANDICAPPED YOUNG PEOPLE: 50 OF THEM BEING CHILDREN BETWEEN THE AGES OF 6 TO 16 AND OTHER 76 BEING YOUNG ADULTS UP TO THE AGE OF 30. AS IT IS FULLY EQUIPPED WITH A SWIMMING POOL (FOR THERAPEUTIC PURPOSES)- WITH CLASSROOMS, WORKSHOPS, RESIDENTIAL - AND ACCESS - FACILITIES, THE STUDENTS HERE ARE ASSURED OF A TRAINING WHICH WILL EMPHASISE THEIR ABILITIES, AND MINIMISE THEIR DISABILITIES. THE IMPORTANCE OF EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES HAS NOT BEEN OVERLOOKED AND OUTINGS OF MANY KINDS ARE ARRANGED FOR THESE YOUNG PEOPLE WHICH INCLUDE PICNICS, GAMES DAYS, CAMPS AND VISITS.

+THE DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION OF SOCIAL WELFARE SERVICES HAS, IN RECENT YEARS, BEEN ONE OF THE TOP PRIORITIES FOR THE HONG KONG GOVERNMENT. MUCH OF THE WORK IN THIS FIELD HAS ALWAYS BEEN, AND WILL CONTINUE TO BE, DEPENDENT ON THE INDISPENSIBLE CONTRIBUTION AND CO-OPERATION OF ENTHUSIASTIC AND DEVOTED VOLUNTARY AGENCIES LIKE THE SALVATION ARMY.

+THE SALVATION ARMY IN HONG KONG IS CELEBRATING ITS GOLDEN JUBILEE THIS YEAR. THROUGHOUT ITS 50 YEARS OF LOCAL ACTIVITIES, IT HAS OPERATED SCHOOLS, CLINICS, YOUTH CENTRES, DAY-CARE NURSERIES AND CRECHES, RESIDENTIAL - AND OTHER SERVICES FOR THE AGED. IT HAS MADE VALUABLE CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE COMMUNITY IN HONG KONG, GIVING CONTINUOUS DIRECT OR INDIRECT AID TO MORE THAN 10 000 OF OUR CITIZENS. THE INAUGURATION OF THE LAI KING HOME MARKS YET ANOTHER ADVANCE IN THE SALVATION ARMY'S SERVICES FOR THE NEEDY THROUGHOUT THIS TERRITORY, PUTTING INTO EFFECT THEIR WELL-PUBLICISED SLOGAN 'WHERE THERE'S NEED, THERE'S THE SALVATION ARMY'. A SLOGAN WHICH IS KNOWN AND UNDERSTOOD IN MANY AREAS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD: FROM THE LONG-TIME SERVICES OF THE 'SALLY ARMY' IN LONDON, TO THOSE OF THE 'SALVOS' IN SYDNEY.

+I AM CONFIDENT THAT THE SALVATION ARMY IN HONG KONG WILL CONTINUE TO GROW AND TO SERVE THE COMMUNITY, AND I WISH THIS HIGHLY RESPECTED, AND MUCH-LOVED, ORGANISATION EVERY POSSIBLE SUCCESS AS IT CONTINUES ITS MARCH FORWARD.

+I NOW HAVE MUCH PLEASURE IN DECLARING THE SALVATION ARMY LAI KING RESIDENTIAL TRAINING CENTRE AND SPECIAL SCHOOL OPEN.+

FEDERATION OF YOUTH GROUPS PROVIDES VALUABLE SERVICES
* * * * *

THE HONG KONG FEDERATION OF YOUTH GROUPS HAS PROVIDED VALUABLE SERVICES FOR YOUNG PERSONS THROUGH ITS YOUTH CENTRES, AND THERE CAN BE LITTLE DOUBT THAT MANY OF THEM, NOW ADULTS, HAVE DEVELOPED THEIR FULL POTENTIAL WITH ITS AID, THE SECRETARY FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES, MR DAVID AKERS-JONES, SAID TODAY (SATURDAY).

MR AKERS-JONES WAS SPEAKING AT THE OPENING OF THE FEDERATION'S 24TH YOUTH CENTRE IN CHO YIU ESTATE, TSUEN WAN.

COMMENDING THE CONTRIBUTION MADE BY THE FEDERATION OVER THE YEARS HE SAID MORE RECENTLY THE FEDERATION'S IMAGINATIVE AND EFFECTIVE OUTREACHING SOCIAL WORK UNIT HAD EXTENDED THE WORK BEING DONE IN THE CENTRES TO YOUNG PEOPLE WHO MIGHT NOT NORMALLY ATTEND THEM.

+OUTSIDE THEIR OWN WORK YOUR STAFF HAVE PARTICIPATED FREQUENTLY IN OUR COMMUNITY BUILDING EFFORTS IN TSUEN WAN NEW TOWN, THEREBY BRINGING SPORTS AND RECREATION TO A LARGER NUMBER OF BOYS AND GIRLS AND ALSO ASSISTING IN THE GROWTH OF COMMUNITY IDENTITY.

+THEY HELP IN THE ORGANISATION OF THE TSUEN WAN DISTRICT ADVISORY BOARD'S REGULAR ESTATE DAY PROGRAMMES AND SOME OF THEM ARE MEMBERS OF THE FOUR AREA COMMITTEES OF KWAI CHUNG SUB-DISTRICT, CONTRIBUTING GREATLY TO OUR EFFORTS TO PROMOTE THE WELL-BEING OF LOCAL RESIDENTS.

+INDEED, IT IS DIFFICULT TO CONCEIVE HOW OUR WORK CAN CONTINUE OR MEET ITS OBJECTIVES WITHOUT SUCH HELP,+ MR AKERS-JONES SAID.

THE CHO YIU CENTRE IS THE FEDERATION'S FIFTH CENTRE TO BE OPENED IN TSUEN WAN NEW TOWN. THE FIRST WAS OPENED IN KWAI CHUNG ESTATE IN 1965 AND THE OTHER THREE ARE LOCATED AT FUK LOI, SHEK LEI AND KWAI FONG ESTATES. CHO YIU ESTATE IS MANAGED BY THE HOUSING SOCIETY.

THE CENTRE OCCUPIES AN AREA OF 380 SQUARE METRES. IT BEGAN PARTIAL OPERATION LAST SEPTEMBER AND FULL OPERATION IN APRIL.

IT PROVIDES VARIOUS PROGRAMMES INCLUDING INTEREST/SKILL TRAINING GROUPS, SOCIAL/FRIENDSHIP GROUPS, STUDY/EDUCATIONAL GROUPS, SOCIAL SERVICE/VOLUNTEER GROUPS, OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES, AND COMMUNITY PROJECTS FOR YOUNG PEOPLE AGED BETWEEN 14 AND 21.

THE LOTTERIES FUND PROVIDED \$154 000 FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE CENTRE.

FIRST INDOOR GAMES HALL IN NT NEARS COMPLETION

* * * * *

THE FIRST INDOOR GAMES HALL IN THE NEW TERRITORIES WILL BE COMPLETED AT KWAI CHUNG LATE NEXT MONTH TO PROVIDE AN ADDITIONAL VENUE FOR RECREATIONAL AND SPORTS ACTIVITIES FOR YOUTH IN THE AREA.

WORKMEN ARE NOW PUTTING THE FINISHING TOUCHES TO THE INTERIOR OF THE GAMES HALL BEFORE IT IS HANDED OVER TO THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT FOR MANAGEMENT.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID THE GAMES HALL HAD BEEN BUILT AT A COST OF ABOUT \$7.35 MILLION PART OF WHICH WAS DONATED BY MR OMAR RAMJU SADICK IN REMEMBRANCE OF HIS LATE BROTHER, THEREFORE IT IS NAMED OSMAN RAMJU SADICK MEMORIAL GAMES HALL.

BUILT AT THE JUNCTION OF HING FONG ROAD AND KWAI ON ROAD IT COVERS AN AREA OF 4 100 SQUARE METRES.

IT HAS A GAMES AREA OF 36 METRES BY 32 METRES WHICH IS LARGE ENOUGH FOR TWO BASKETBALL COURTS OR EIGHT BADMINTON COURTS OR THREE VOLLEYBALL COURTS. THE TWO SPECTATOR STANDS AT BOTH ENDS OF THE HALL CAN SEAT 650 PEOPLE. THE GAMES AREA CAN ALSO BE USED FOR GYMNASTICS, JUDO, HANDBALL, WEIGHT-TRAINING, DANCING, AND FENCING. IN ADDITION, THERE ARE THREE GAMES ROOMS FOR PLAYING TABLE TENNIS.

OTHER FACILITIES, SUCH AS CHANGING ROOMS, TOILETS AND A TRAINING/LECTURE ROOM ARE ALSO PROVIDED.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT THE DESIGN OF THE NEW INDOOR GAMES HALL WAS BASED ON THE ONE AT ABERDEEN.

+BUT SOME IMPROVED FEATURES HAVE BEEN INCORPORATED,+ HE SAID. THESE INCLUDE SECTIONAL LIGHTING CONTROLLED BY A DIMMER IN THE GAMES AREA.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THERE WAS NO SIMILAR VENUE IN THE DISTRICT, EITHER PRIVATE OR PUBLIC, FOR HOLDING INDOOR SPORTS OR RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES, THEREFORE IT WAS EXPECTED THAT THIS NEW FACILITY WOULD BECOME A POPULAR VENUE FOR INDOOR GAMES AND IN WHICH MOST OF THE INDOOR SPORTS EVENTS OF THE SECOND TSUEN WAN SPORTS FESTIVAL WOULD BE HELD.

WORK ARRANGEMENTS DURING TROPICAL STORM
* * * *

EMPLOYERS WERE TODAY (SATURDAY) ADVISED TO REACH PRIOR AGREEMENT WITH THEIR EMPLOYEES ON THE RULES FOR WORK, AND THE RELEASE FROM WORK, DURING OR ON THE APPROACH OF A TROPICAL STORM.

A LABOUR DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID, +SUCH AN AGREEMENT SHOULD INCLUDE THE METHOD OF CALCULATING WAGES TO BE PAID UNDER VARIOUS CIRCUMSTANCES.+

THE SPOKESMAN WAS COMMENTING ON PAST EXPERIENCE WHEN THE DEPARTMENT RECEIVED MANY ENQUIRIES SEEKING ADVICE ON SUCH MATTERS DURING THE TYPHOON SEASON.

HE SAID: +ALTHOUGH THE LAW DOES NOT LAY DOWN ANY PARTICULAR PROCEDURES TO FOLLOW IT IS, BASICALLY, A MATTER OF DECISION BETWEEN EACH EMPLOYER AND HIS EMPLOYEE, TAKING INTO ACCOUNT THE NATURE OF EMPLOYMENT AND THE INDIVIDUAL EMPLOYEE'S PLACE OF RESIDENCE, AVAILABILITY OF TRANSPORT AND OTHER FACTORS.+

THE SPOKESMAN WENT ON TO SAY THAT CONFUSION, OR EVEN DISPUTES, COULD ARISE IF THERE WAS A LACK OF PRIOR UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES AS TO WHAT TO DO DURING A TYPHOON.

HE ADVISED THAT THE IMPORTANT THING TO CONSIDER ON SUCH OCCASIONS WAS THE EMPLOYEES' SAFETY, BOTH AT THE PLACE OF WORK AND DURING THE JOURNEY TO AND FROM HOME.

+FOR EXAMPLE, FIRMS SHOULD SEND THEIR EMPLOYEES HOME WHEN TYPHOON SIGNAL NUMBER EIGHT OR HIGHER IS HOISTED, OR WHEN PUBLIC TRANSPORT IS ABOUT TO STOP.+

+OF COURSE, EMPLOYEES WHO ARE REQUIRED TO PERFORM ESSENTIAL AND EMERGENCY DUTIES DURING A TYPHOON WOULD BE EXCEPTIONS,+ HE ADDED.

THE SPOKESMAN POINTED OUT THAT EMPLOYERS COULD ALWAYS APPROACH THE LABOUR RELATIONS SERVICE OF THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT FOR APPROPRIATE ADVICE WHEN DRAFTING OR PREPARING THEIR AGREEMENTS CONCERNING TYPHOON ARRANGEMENTS.

EMPLOYERS REMINDED OF FLOATING HOLIDAY.

* * * * *

A LABOUR DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN TODAY (SATURDAY) REMINDED EMPLOYERS THAT IF THEY HAVE NOT DESIGNATED A DATE FOR THE FLOATING HOLIDAY AND HAVE NOT GIVEN THEIR EMPLOYEES A DAY OFF ON JULY 1 (THE FIRST WEEK-DAY IN JULY), THEY SHOULD GIVE THE STAFF THE DAY OFF ON AUGUST 4 (THE FIRST MONDAY IN AUGUST).

UNDER THE EMPLOYMENT ORDINANCE, THE FLOATING HOLIDAY - ONE OF THE 10 STATUTORY HOLIDAYS IN A YEAR - MUST BE DESIGNATED BY EMPLOYERS AND NOTIFIED TO EMPLOYEES BY A NOTICE PLACED IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE BY THE END OF THE PRECEDING YEAR.

THE SPOKESMAN POINTED OUT THAT UNDER THE ORDINANCE ALL MANUAL EMPLOYEES, INCLUDING DOMESTIC SERVANTS, IRRESPECTIVE OF THEIR EARNINGS, AND ALL NON-MANUAL EMPLOYEES EARNING NOT MORE THAN \$3 500 A MONTH, ARE ENTITLED TO THE HOLIDAY.

THEY MUST ALSO BE PAID FOR THE DAY OFF IF THEY HAD WORKED CONTINUOUSLY FOR THREE MONTHS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE STATUTORY HOLIDAY.

HOLIDAY PAY SHOULD BE EQUIVALENT TO THE EMPLOYEE'S EARNINGS, OTHER THAN OVERTIME PAY, ON A NORMAL WORKING DAY. WHERE THE EARNINGS VARIED FROM DAY TO DAY, HOLIDAY PAY SHOULD BE THE AVERAGE OF THE DAILY EARNINGS DURING A PERIOD OF 28 DAYS PRECEDING THE HOLIDAY. PAYMENT SHOULD BE MADE ON THE NORMAL PAY DAY.

IF AN EMPLOYEE WAS REQUIRED TO WORK ON THE HOLIDAY, THE SPOKESMAN CONTINUED, HE MUST BE GIVEN AN ALTERNATIVE DAY OFF WITHIN 60 DAYS BEFORE OR AFTER THAT DAY.

IF THE ALTERNATIVE HOLIDAY WAS TO BE GRANTED BEFORE THE STATUTORY HOLIDAY, THE EMPLOYER MUST NOTIFY THE EMPLOYEE 48 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF THE ALTERNATIVE HOLIDAY. IN THE CASE WHERE AN ALTERNATIVE HOLIDAY WAS TO BE GIVEN AFTER STATUTORY HOLIDAY, THE EMPLOYEE MUST BE NOTIFIED OF THE ARRANGEMENT AT LEAST 48 HOURS BEFORE THE STATUTORY HOLIDAY.

IF BOTH EMPLOYER AND EMPLOYEE AGREE, ANY DAY WITHIN 30 DAYS OF A STATUTORY HOLIDAY OR ALTERNATIVE HOLIDAY COULD BE TAKEN BY THE EMPLOYEE AS A SUBSTITUTED HOLIDAY, HE SAID.

NEW ROADS FOR SHA TIN

THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT IS INVITING TENDERS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS AND DRAINAGE NEAR SHA TIN WAI AND CHAP WAI KON IN SHA TIN NEW TOWN.

THE WORKS FORM PART OF STAGE ONE OF THE NEW TOWN DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME.

A PWD SPOKESMAN SAID, +THE PROJECT INVOLVES THE CONSTRUCTION OF ABOUT TWO KILOMETRES OF DISTRIBUTOR ROADS TOGETHER WITH ASSOCIATED DRAINAGE, FOOTPATHS AND CYCLE TRACKS.

+ON COMPLETION, THESE ROADS WILL PROVIDE ACCESS TO DEVELOPMENTS IN THE NORTH EASTERN PART OF THE NEW TOWN WHERE THE SHA TIN TEACHING HOSPITAL AND A HOME OWNERSHIP SCHEME BUILDING ARE UNDER CONSTRUCTION.+

HE SAID THE CONTRACT WOULD ALSO INCLUDE THE EXTENSION OF AN EXISTING STORMWATER CULVERT NEAR TSANG TAI UK FOR THE SUBSEQUENT FORMATION OF A 5.6-HECTARE SITE FOR PUBLIC HOUSING.

WORK ON THE PROJECT WILL START IN OCTOBER AND WILL TAKE ABOUT 17 MONTHS TO COMPLETE.

THE PROJECT HAS BEEN DESIGNED AND CONSTRUCTION WILL BE SUPERVISED BY MAUNSELL CONSULTANTS ASIA, CONSULTING ENGINEERS TO PWD'S NEW TERRITORIES DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT.
