SIR JACK TO HEAD LONDON OFFICE

SIR JACK CATER, THE CHIEF SECRETARY, WILL BE GOING TO LONDON TO TAKE UP THE APPOINTMENT OF HONG KONG COMMISSIONER TOWARDS THE END OF THE YEAR, A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN ANNOUNCED TODAY.

THE SECRETARY OF STATE HAS APPROVED THE APPOINTMENT OF SIR PHILIP HADDON-CAVE TO SUCCEED SIR JACK AS CHIEF SECRETARY AND OF MR JOHN BREMRIDGE TO BE FINANCIAL SECRETARY.

SIR JACK WILL HAND OVER HIS DUTIES IN EARLY NOVEMBER TO SIR PHILIP.

BEFORE RETURNING TO HONG KONG IN MID-MAY, MR BREMRIDGE, FORMER CHAIRMAN OF THE SWIRE GROUP IN HONG KONG, WILL BE ENGAGED ON AN INTENSIVE PROGRAMME OF BRIEFINGS, VISITS AND ATTACHMENTS. HE WILL TAKE OVER THE POST OF FINANCIAL SECRETARY FROM SIR PHILIP AS FROM JUNE 1.

FLOWER SHOW IN NT NORTH DISTRICT

A FOUR-DAY FLOWER SHOW WILL OPEN IN NEW TERRITORIES NORTH DISTRICT ON MARCH 21 AT FANLING PLAYGROUND.

THE SHOW IS THE FIFTH TO BE HELD IN THE DISTRICT. ON DISPLAY WILL BE MORE THAN 80 SPECIES OF FLOWERS, AS WELL AS HIGH-CLASS ROSES GROWN LOCALLY AND OVERSEAS.

THERE WILL BE COMPETITIVE SECTIONS TO INCLUDE CUT FLOWERS, SCENTED CUT FLOWERS, POT PLANTS, MINIATURE POT PLANTS, ORCHIDS AND BONSAI TYPE PLANTS.

ABOUT 700 ENTRANTS WILL TAKE PART IN THE COMPETITIONS. EIGHTEEN NON-COMPETITIVE EXHIBITORS, INCLUDING THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT AND THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT, HAVE ALSO BEEN INVITED TO ENTER.

TSUEN WAN FIGHT CRIME EXHIBITION OPENS ON SATURDAY

A FIVE-DAY EXHIBITION TO INCREASE PUBLIC AWARENESS OF CRIME AND ITS PREVENTION WILL OPEN IN TSUEN WAN ON SATURDAY.

THE EXHIBITION, ORGANISED BY THE TSUEN WAN DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME COMMITTEE, WILL BE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC FROM 10 AM TO 8 PM DAILY IN THE CULTURAL ACTIVITIES HALL OF TSUEN WAN TOWN HALL.

TWENTY-TWO ORGANISATIONS, INCLUDING TSUEN WAN DISTRICT OFFICE, ARE TAKING PART IN THE EXHIBITION.

THEY WILL EACH OPERATE A STALL EXPLAINING THEIR ROLE IN FIGHTING CRIME. THESE ORGANISATIONS INCLUDE SECURITY FIRMS, BANKS, YOUTH CENTRES, WELFARE GROUPS AND JUNIOR POLICE CALL UNITS OF KWAI CHUNG AND TSUEN WAN.

THERE WILL BE SLIDE AND FILM SHOWS, AND PHOTOGRAPHS, CHARTS AND SECURITY ITEMS ON DISPLAY. THERE WILL ALSO BE A CROSSWORD PUZZLE COMPETITION.
