FOREIGN AFFAIRS COMMITTEE DELEGATION TOURS ACP WORK SITES

* * * * *

A GROUP OF NINE MEMBERS OF THE FOREIGN AFFAIRS COMMITTEE (FAC) OF THE BRITISH PARLIAMENT WERE BRIEFED TODAY (SUNDAY) ON THE LATEST DEVELOPMENTS ON THE AIRPORT CORE PROGRAMME (ACP) PROJECTS.

DURING A FOUR-HOUR BOAT TOUR, THE MEMBERS SAW PROGRESS ON PROJECTS SUCH AS THE WEST KOWLOON RECLAMATION, THE TSING MA AND KAP SHUT MUN BRIDGES, THE NORTH LANTAU EXPRESSWAY, THE TUNG CHUNG NEW TOWN RECLAMATION AND THE AIRPORT SITE AT CHEK LAP KOK.

THEY WERE ADDRESSED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE NEW AIRPORT PROJECTS CO-ORDINATION OFFICE (NAPCO), MR BILLY LAM ON THE OVERALL PROGRESS OF THE ACP.

THE MEMBERS ALSO VISITED CHEK LAP KOK FOR A CLOSE-UP VIEW OF THE WORKS THERE.

THEY WERE BRIEFED ON THE PROGRESS OF NEW AIRPORT WORKS ON THE ISLAND BY THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE PROVISIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY, DR HENRY TOWNSEND.

MAINTENANCE OF INSIDE PLUMBING

* * * * *

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE WATER SUPPLIES DEPARTMENT TODAY (SUNDAY) ADVISED WATER CONSUMERS TO PAY MORE ATTENTION TO THE MAINTENANCE OF THEIR INTERNAL PLUMBING IN ORDER TO ALLEVIATE THE PROBLEM OF DISCOLORED WATER.

HE POINTED OUT THAT CORROSION OF PLUMBING FACILITIES INSIDE BUILDINGS WAS ONE OF THE MAIN CAUSES OF DISCOLOURATION.

"CONSUMERS WITH DISCOLORED WATER PROBLEM SHOULD EMPLOY LICENSED PLUMBERS TO CHECK THE PIPEWORK SYSTEM WITHIN THEIR PREMISES AND TO REPLACE THE CORRODED PIPES IF NECESSARY," HE SAID.

ACCORDING TO THE WATERWORKS ORDINANCE, A REGISTERED CONSUMER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF HIS INTERNAL PLUMBING FACILITIES WHICH INCLUDE ALL THE WATER PIPES AND FITTINGS WITHIN HIS LOT OR BUILDING BOUNDARY.

IF THE PROBLEM ORIGINATED FROM THE COMMUNAL PART OF THE PLUMBING FACILITIES OF BUILDINGS, INCLUDING PUMPS, WATER TANKS AND COMMON WATER PIPES, THE RESPONSIBILITY OF MAINTENANCE WILL LIE WITH THE BUILDINGS' REGISTERED AGENTS.

HE EXPLAINED: "IN MOST CASES, INCLUDING GOVERNMENT PUBLIC HOUSING ESTATES, THE REGISTERED AGENTS ARE THE ESTATE MANAGEMENT OFFICES OR THE INCORPORATED OWNERS OF BUILDINGS."

THE SPOKESMAN NOTED THAT APART FROM DISCOLOURED WATER, MANY OTHER COMMON WATER SUPPLY PROBLEMS MIGHT ALSO HAVE BEEN CAUSED BY THE LACK OF PROPER MAINTENANCE OF INTERNAL PLUMBING FACILITIES BY CONSUMERS OR AGENTS.

"FOR EXAMPLE, POORLY MAINTAINED WATER PUMPS OFTEN LEAD TO DISRUPTION OF SUPPLY, WHILE CORROSION OF WATER PIPES MAY CAUSE CHOKAGE. THEREFORE, REGULAR CHECKING OF AN INTERNAL PLUMBING SYSTEM CAN IDENTIFY SMALL DEFECTS BEFORE THE SITUATION DETERIORATES," HE ADDED.

HE REITERATED THAT THE WATER SUPPLY DEPARTMENT WOULD HELP WITH ANY PROBLEM CONCERNING WATER QUALITY AND WOULD TAKE WATER SAMPLES FOR TESTING WHERE NECESSARY.

PUBLIC AWARENESS OF FIRE PREVENTION NEEDED

* * * * *

MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC ARE URGED TO PAY MORE ATTENTION TO FIRE SAFETY SO AS TO REDUCE ANY LOSS OF LIVES AND DAMAGE TO PROPERTIES IN FIRES.

THE APPEAL CAME FROM THE CHIEF FIRE OFFICER (NEW TERRITORIES), MR TSANG KWONG-YU, AT THE OPENING CEREMONY OF A FIRE PREVENTION CAMPAIGN ORGANISED BY THE FIRE SERVICES DEPARTMENT'S NEW TERRITORIES COMMAND IN SHA TIN TODAY (SUNDAY).

HE SAID OVER 60 PER CENT OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF REPORTED FIRE WERE CAUSED BY HUMAN NEGLIGENCE, SUCH AS CARELESSNESS IN DISPOSING SMOKING MATERIALS, UNATTENDING TO LIGHTED STOVES AND NEGLECTING WORK AND HOME SAFETY.

HE SAID FIREMEN HAD FIRE PROTECTION DUTIES TO PERFORM. THESE ARE: TO APPROVE BUILDING PLANS AND FIRE SERVICE INSTALLATIONS, TO GIVE FIRE SAFETY ADVICE ON NEW PROJECTS, TO INSPECT MEANS OF ESCAPE IN BUILDINGS, STORAGE OF DANGEROUS GOODS AND FIRE INSTALLATIONS IN ALL PREMISES.

"TO MINIMISE DESTRUCTION BROUGHT ABOUT BY FIRE, THE FIRE SERVICES DEPARTMENT NEEDS THE FULL CO-OPERATION OF THE PUBLIC," HE STRESSED.

MR TSANG ADDED THAT THE DEPARTMENT WOULD CONTINUOUSLY ACQUIRE THE MOST SOPHISTICATED FIRE APPLIANCES, EQUIPMENT AND TOOLS TO MEET THE EVER GROWING DEMAND OF INCREASING POPULATION, AND COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENTS.

THE CAMPAIGN IS ONE OF THE COMMEMORATIVE ACTIVITIES ORGANISED TO MARK THE DEPARTMENT'S 125TH ANNIVERSARY.

ON DISPLAY TODAY WERE INFORMATION ON FIRE PROTECTION, RESCUE EQUIPMENT AND HISTORICAL FIRE SERVICES PHOTOGRAPHS.

CIVIC EDUCATION MESSAGES SPREAD ACROSS KOWLOON CITY

THE TASK OF PROMOTING CIVIC EDUCATION PLAYS AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN HELPING HONG KONG PEOPLE TO KEEP PACE WITH THE TERRITORY'S POLITICAL DEVELOPMENTS.

THIS WAS STATED BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE ON THE PROMOTION OF CIVIC EDUCATION, DR DANIEL TSE CHI-WAI, AT THE OPENING CEREMONY OF THE KOWLOON CITY DISTRICT CIVIC EDUCATION DAY TODAY (SUNDAY).

DR TSE SAID HE WAS GLAD THAT THE DISTRICT HAD HELPED PROMOTE THE TWO MAIN THEMES SET BY THE COMMITTEE THIS YEAR - THE SPIRIT OF RULE OF LAW AND HUMAN RIGHTS EDUCATION.

THE RULE OF LAW IS AN IMPORTANT FACTOR IN SECURING THE STABILITY AND PROSPERITY OF THE TERRITORY.

ITS SPIRIT LIES IN THE FACT THAT EVERYONE IN THE SOCIETY IS PROTECTED UNDER THE LAW AND ACTS ACCORDING.

"AND THE PURSUIT FOR JUSTICE AND FAIRNESS IS THE MAIN THEME FOR HUMAN RIGHTS," DR TSE SAID.

THEREFORE, THE RULE OF LAW AND HUMAN RIGHTS ARE CLOSELY RELATED BECAUSE HUMAN RIGHTS NEED TO BE ASSERTED BY LAW AND ITS IMPLEMENTATION RELIED ON A SOUND SYSTEM OF LEGISLATION, HE ADDED.

OVER 5,000 RESIDENTS TOOK PART IN TODAY'S ACTIVITY WHICH FEATURED A HUMAN RIGHTS EXHIBITION, GAME STALLS AND QUIZZES ON CIVIC EDUCATION.

YOUNGSTERS ALSO JOIN HANDS TO COMPLETE A LARGE DRAWING ON THE TOPIC OF CIVIC EDUCATION AND A PUBLICITY BUS ALSO TRAVELLED AROUND THE DISTRICT TO SPREAD CIVIC EDUCATION MESSAGES.

THE CIVIC EDUCATION DAY IS JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE KOWLOON CITY DISTRICT CIVIC EDUCATION CAMPAIGN ORGANISING COMMITTEE, THE DISTRICT BOARD AND THE DISTRICT OFFICE.

A NUMBER OF ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING FILM SHOWS, A SLOGAN COMPETITION AND AN INTER-SCHOOL DEBATE, WILL BE HELD IN THE DISTRICT TO PROMOTE THE CAUSE.

INSPECTION CAMPAIGN TO ENHANCE FIRE AND CHEMICAL SAFETY

* * * * *

THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT WILL LAUNCH AN EXTENSIVE FIRE AND CHEMICAL SAFETY CAMPAIGN TOMORROW (MONDAY) TO AROUSE THE ATTENTION OF BOTH THE FACTORY OWNERS AND WORKERS ON THE IMPORTANCE OF PREVENTING FIRE HAZARDS AND SAFE HANDLING OF DANGEROUS CHEMICALS.

THE TWO-MONTH CAMPAIGN IS ALSO AIMED AT BRINGING DOWN THE NUMBER OF INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENTS INVOLVING FIRE AND CHEMICALS, DEPUTY CHIEF FACTORY INSPECTOR, MR KAN HON-SANG SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

MR KAN EXPLAINED THIS KIND OF CAMPAIGNS HAD BEEN PROVED TO BE EFFECTIVE IN MINIMISING FIRE AND CHEMICAL RISKS IN INDUSTRIAL UNDERTAKINGS, PARTICULARLY DURING THE APPROACHING DRY SEASON.

DURING THE CAMPAIGN, FACTORIES HOUSED IN POORLY MANAGED BUILDINGS AND THOSE INVOLVING WORK PROCESSES WITH HIGH FIRE HAZARDS AND THE USE OF INFLAMMABLE SUBSTANCES WILL BE SELECTED FOR INSPECTION.

FACTORY INSPECTORS WILL EXPLAIN TO EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES THEIR OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE FACTORIES AND INDUSTRIAL UNDERTAKINGS (FIRE PRECAUTIONS IN NOTIFIABLE WORKPLACES) REGULATION AND THE FACTORIES AND INDUSTRIAL UNDERTAKINGS (DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES) REGULATION AND HELP THEM IN COMPLYING WITH THE REQUIREMENTS, HE ADDED.

MR KAN SAID UNDER THE FACTORIES AND INDUSTRIAL UNDERTAKINGS (FIRE PRECAUTIONS IN NOTIFIABLE WORKPLACES) REGULATION, OWNERS OF INDUSTRIAL UNDERTAKINGS WERE REQUIRED TO MAINTAIN ALL ROUTES OF ESCAPE SUCH AS DOORWAYS, PASSAGEWAYS AND STAIRCASES IN GOOD CONDITION AND FREE FROM OBSTRUCTION.

"EXIT DOORS SHOULD BE CONSTRUCTED TO OPEN OUTWARD AND MAINTAINED UNLOCKED OR UNFASTENED AT ALL TIMES TO FACILITATE SPEEDY ESCAPE OF WORKERS IN CASE OF FIRE," HE SAID.

IN ADDITION, INFLAMMABLE SUBSTANCES SHOULD BE PROPERLY USED AND STORED.

IN PLACES WHERE SMOKING IS PROHIBITED, OWNERS ARE REQUIRED TO DISPLAY PROHIBITION NOTICES CONSPICUOUSLY AND ENSURE THAT NO PERSON SMOKES IN THE AREA," HE ADDED.

WITH REGARD TO THE HANDLING OF DANGEROUS CHEMICALS, MR KAN POINTED OUT THAT THE FACTORIES AND INDUSTRIAL UNDERTAKINGS (DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES) REGULATION REQUIRED THE CONTAINERS OF THESE SUBSTANCES TO BE PROPERLY LABELLED TO INDICATE ANY RISK INHERENT IN THE SUBSTANCES AND THE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS REQUIRED IN RESPECT OF THE SUBSTANCES.

EMPLOYERS SHOULD ALSO PROVIDE SAFETY INFORMATION, TRAINING, INSTRUCTIONS, SUPERVISION AND PROTECTIVE CLOTHING TO THE EMPLOYEES WHO WORK WITH DANGEROUS CHEMICALS, MR KAN SAID.

HE SAID FACTORY INSPECTORS WOULD DISTRIBUTE TO FACTORY MANAGEMENT A SPECIALLY DESIGNED WARNING NOTICE ON SAFETY PRECAUTIONS TO BE TAKEN IN HANDLING DANGEROUS CHEMICALS.

THE MANAGEMENT WILL BE URGED TO DISPLAY THE NOTICE PROMINENTLY IN THE WORKPLACE TO REMIND WORKERS OF THE NEED TO MAINTAIN GOOD VENTILATION AND TO WEAR PROTECTIVE CLOTHING.

ON THE OTHER HAND, EMPLOYEES WILL ALSO BE ADVISED TO CO-OPERATE WITH THEIR EMPLOYERS IN ADOPTING AND FOLLOWING SAFETY MEASURES, HE ADDED.

MR KAN REMINDED OWNERS AND EMPLOYEES THAT FACTORY INSPECTORS WOULD CARRY OUT VIGOROUS ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS AGAINST OFFENDERS WHO IGNORED THEIR STATUTORY OBLIGATIONS TO ENHANCE FIRE AND CHEMICAL SAFETY.

OWNERS WHO CONTRAVENE THE PROVISIONS OF THE FACTORIES AND INDUSTRIAL UNDERTAKINGS (FIRE PRECAUTIONS IN NOTIFIABLE WORKPLACES) REGULATION WILL BE LIABLE TO A MAXIMUM FINE OF \$30,000 AND SIX MONTHS' IMPRISONMENT.

THOSE WHO FAIL TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE FACTORIES AND INDUSTRIAL UNDERTAKINGS (DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES) REGULATION WILL BE SUBJECT TO A MAXIMUM FINE OF \$30,000.

EMPLOYEES WHO CONTRAVENE THE PROVISIONS OF THE TWO REGULATIONS WILL FACE A MAXIMUM FINE OF \$10,000.

IN THE INTEREST OF THEIR OWN SAFETY AND HEALTH, MR KAN CALLED ON ALL EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES TO CLOSELY OBSERVE THE LAW AND WORK TOGETHER TO KEEP THE WORKPLACE SAFE.

ELVIS STAMP PRODUCTS ON SALE

THE ACTING POSTMASTER GENERAL MRS DORIS HO, ANNOUNCED TODAY (SUNDAY) THAT THREE PRODUCTS OF THE ELVIS STAMP ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICES WOULD BE AVAILABLE AT THE PHILATELIC COUNTER OF THE GENERAL POST OFFICE AS FROM OCTOBER 26.

THESE PRODUCTS INCLUDE THE ELVIS COMMEMORATIVE ALBUM, THE FIRST DAY CEREMONY PROGRAMME AND SHEETS OF 40 ELVIS STAMPS.

THE COMMEMORATIVE ALBUM CONSISTS OF A SPECIALLY DESIGNED JACKET CONTAINING A BOOK WITH FULL COLOUR ILLUSTRATIONS OF THE LIFE OF ELVIS PRESLEY AND A POSTER WITH AN ELVIS STAMP CANCELLED WITH THE FIRST DAY SPECIAL POSTMARK.

THE FIRST DAY CEREMONY PROGRAMME CONTAINS THE STORY BEHIND THE ELVIS STAMP AND LISTS THE CEREMONIES HELD BY THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICES TO LAUNCH THE STAMP.

SPECIAL PAPER JACKET IS PROVIDED FOR THE SHEETS OF MINT ELVIS STAMP AND THE STAMP PRODUCTS HAVE BEEN HIGHLY POPULAR INTERNATIONALLY.

THE PRODUCTS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THEIR FACE VALUE: THE COMMEMORATIVE ALBUM AT \$156, THE FIRST DAY CEREMONY PROGRAMME AT \$46.50 AND THE MINT STAMP AT \$90.50 EACH SHEET.

BECAUSE OF THE LIMITED QUANTITIES AVAILABLE, THERE WILL BE A RESTRICTION OF NOT MORE THAN TWO ALBUMS AND TWO CEREMONY PROGRAMMES PER CUSTOMER QUEUING ON OCTOBER 26.

FOR ADVANCE INFORMATION OF THE PUBLIC, THE PRODUCTS WILL BE DISPLAYED AT THE PHILATELIC COUNTER, GENERAL POST OFFICE AS FROM OCTOBER 20.

WORKSHOP TO PROMOTE "GREEN" FARMING METHODS

* * * * *

HONG KONG FARMERS ARE EXPECTED TO BECOME MORE ENVIRONMENTALLY CONSCIOUS AFTER THE COMPLETION OF A WORKSHOP ORGANISED BY THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT (AFD) AND THE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG'S KADOORIE AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH CENTRE (KARC).

THE ONE-WEEK WORKSHOP, TO BE HELD FROM TOMORROW (MONDAY) AT THE KARC AT LAM KAM ROAD, SHEK KONG, WILL BE ATTENDED BY MORE THAN 100 PARTICIPANTS COMPRISING FARMERS, FARM MANAGERS, POST-SECONDARY STUDENTS AND TEACHING STAFF.

AN AFD SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY (SUNDAY) THAT THE AIM OF THE WORKSHOP WAS TO PROMOTE THE USE OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL-FRIENDLY METHODS IN VEGETABLE PRODUCTION AMONG LOCAL FARMERS.

APART FROM PEOPLE IN THE TRADE, POST-SECONDARY STUDENTS AND RESEARCHERS AS WELL AS TEACHING STAFF MAY ALSO PRACTISE MODERN FARMING TECHNIQUES DURING THE WORKSHOP.

"WE HOPE THAT THROUGH THE COURSE THE LATEST DEVELOPMENT OF VARIOUS ENVIRONMENTAL-FRIENDLY FARMING METHODS, WHICH DO NOT INVOLVE THE USE OF PESTICIDES, CAN BE EXAMINED AND PROMOTED," HE SAID.

TWO ACADEMICS FROM THE SOUTH CHINA AGRICULTURAL UNIVERSITY OF GUANGZHOU HAVE BEEN INVITED TO CONDUCT THE WORKSHOP. THEY ARE THE PROFESSOR IN ENTOMOLOGY, MR LIANG GUANGWEN AND ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR IN PLANT PATHOLOGY, MISS GAO QIAOWAN.

TWO AGRICULTURAL OFFICERS FROM AFD'S PLANT PROTECTION SECTION, MISS WENDY KO AND MR CLIVE LAU, WILL ALSO TALK ON THE SUBJECT IN RELATION TO THE TERRITORY'S SITUATION.

TOPICS TO BE COVERED INCLUDE: CHINA'S ENVIRONMENTAL-FRIENDLY VEGETABLE PRODUCTION METHODS, THE FORECASTING AND MONITORING OF PESTS OCCURRENCE ON BOTH LEAFY AND FRUIT VEGETABLES AND THE INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS AS WELL AS THE IDENTIFICATION OF PESTICIDE RESIDUE AND SO ON.

THERE WILL ALSO BE GROUP DISCUSSIONS AND PRACTICAL SESSIONS.

PENSIONERS' WELFARE UNIT ON MOVE

THE PENSIONERS' WELFARE UNIT OF THE CIVIL SERVICE BRANCH HAS MOVED FROM ROOM 704 TO ROOM 1009A ON THE 10TH FLOOR OF THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT OFFICES, WEST WING, ICE HOUSE STREET, ON OCTOBER 7 (THURSDAY).

SET UP IN DECEMBER 1987, THE UNIT PROVIDES ENQUIRY SERVICE FOR RETIRED CIVIL SERVANTS AND DISSEMINATES INFORMATION OF INTEREST TO PENSIONERS.

THE UNIT ALSO PROVIDES PRE-RETIREMENT COUNSELLING AND ORGANISES SEMINARS ON PREPARATIONS FOR RETIREMENT AND THE BENEFITS PAYABLE ON RETIREMENT FROM SERVICE.

POST-RETIREMENT COUNSELLING REGARDING ARRANGEMENTS FOR PENSIONS PAYMENT, CONTRIBUTIONS TO DEPENDENT PENSIONS SCHEMES, TAX LIABILITY, MEDICAL AND DENTAL TREATMENT, AND ASSISTANCE IN HARDSHIP CASES, IS ALSO PROVIDED.

THE UNIT ALSO OFFERS ASSISTANCE TO PENSIONERS WHO ENCOUNTER DIFFICULTIES, INCLUDING MANAGING A PENSIONERS' WELFARE FUND.

PENSIONERS, THEIR SURVIVING SPOUSE OR DEPENDENT CHILDREN MAY APPLY FOR ASSISTANCE FROM THE FUND IRRESPECTIVE OF THEIR PLACE OF RESIDENCE TO MEET MEDICAL OR FUNERAL EXPENSES OR EXPENSES ARISING FROM DISTRESS.

ASSISTANCE IS IN THE FORM OF A ONE-OFF GRANT NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.
