LANTERN COMPETITION FOR MID-AUTUMN FESTIVAL

ENTRIES ARE NOW INVITED FOR THE STUDENT LANTERN DESIGN COMPETITION AND EXHIBITION, TIMED TO COINCIDE WITH THE MID-AUTUMN FESTIVAL IN OCTOBER.

THE AIM OF THE EVENT, ORGANISED BY THE 1979 LANTERN CARNIVAL COMMITTEE, IS TO REVIVE PUBLIC INTEREST IN THE TRADITIONAL CHINESE ART OF LANTERN DESIGN.

NO ENTRY FEE IS REQUIRED AND STUDENTS CAN SUBMIT ANY NUMBER OF ENTRIES. THE COMPETITION IS DIVIDED INTO DIVISION A FOR PRIMARY SCHOOL STUDENTS AND DIVISION B FOR SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS.

THE LANTERNS WILL BE DISPLAYED AT MORSE PARK, KOWLOON FROM OCTOBER 4 TO 6 TO CELEBRATE THE MID-AUTUMN FESTIVAL.

TWENTY PRIZES IN THE FORM OF CERTIFICATES OF MERIT WILL BE AWARDED TO SPONSORING SCHOOLS WHICH SUBMIT LANTERNS OF OUTSTANDING DESIGN.

FOR INDIVIDUAL PRIZES, 100 OUTSTANDING ENTRIES WILL BE SELECTED, AND EACH WINNER WILL BE AWARDED A CERTIFICATE OF MERIT AND A BOOK TOKEN WORTH \$100.

EXPERIENCED ART AND DESIGN EDUCATIONISTS WILL BE INVITED TO SIT ON THE PANEL OF JUDGES.

ALL LANTERNS SUBMITTED SHOULD NOT EXCEED ONE METRE IN ANY DIMENSION, AND ANY MATERIAL MAY BE USED. HOWEVER, NO ADVERTISING SLOGANS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

ALL ENTRIES WILL BECOME THE PROPERTY OF THE ORGANISER AND NO ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED.

ENTRIES SHOULD BE MADE THROUGH HEADS OF SCHOOLS AND THEY ARE REQUESTED TO HAND IN ENTRY FORMS TO THE ART SECTION, CULTURAL CRAFTS CENTRE, EDUCATION DEPARTMENT, 4 PAK FUK ROAD, FIFTH FLOOR, NORTH POINT, HONG KONG ON OR BEFORE JULY 14.

THE CULTURAL CRAFTS CENTRE WILL ISSUE OFFICIAL LABELS FOR SCHOOLS TO BE AFFIXED TO EACH ENTRY.

ALL LABELLED LANTERNS MUST BE SENT TO THE RECEPTION DESK AT HO LAP COLLEGE, TSEUK LUK STREET, SAN PO KONG, KOWLOON, BETWEEN 9.30 A.M. AND 4.50 P.M. ON OCTOBER 2. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE INCLUDED FOR JUDGING.

TEACHERS TO LEARN MORE ABOUT INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

A SERIES OF SEMINARS ON INTERNAL ASSESSMENT IN PRIMARY SCHOOLS WILL BE HELD BETWEEN SEPTEMBER AND NOVEMBER FOR IN-SERVICE TEACHERS, ESPECIALLY THOSE TEACHING CHINESE, ENGLISH AND MATHEMATICS IN PRIMARY 5 AND 6.

THE AIM OF THE SEMINAR IS TO ACQUAINT PARTICIPANTS WITH MODERN CONCEPTS OF ASSESSMENTS AND TESTING, AND TO PROVIDE PRACTICAL SUGGESTIONS IN QUESTIONING TECHNIQUES, CONTENTS OF QUESTION PAPERS, MARKING SCHEMES, AND THE WEIGHTINGS OF DIFFERENT SUBJECT COMPONENTS.

CONTENTS OF THE SEMINARS WILL INCLUDE TALKS ON INTERNAL ASSESSMENTS AND THE ACADEMIC APTITUDE TEST IN CONNECTION WITH THE SECONDARY SCHOOL PLACES ALLOCATION SCHEME.

TALKS AND DISCUSSIONS WILL BE CONDUCTED BY INSPECTORS OF CHINESE, ENGLISH AND MATHEMATICS OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT'S ADVISORY INSPECTORATE.

THESE SEMINARS WILL BE HELD IN SIX DIFFERENT CENTRES IN HONG KONG, KOWLOON AND THE NEW TERRITORIES.

SINCE SIMILAR SEMINARS HELD LAST YEAR WERE GREATLY OVERSUBSCRIBED, HEADS OF SCHOOLS ARE ADVISED NOT TO RECOMMEND TEACHERS WHO HAD PREVIOUSLY PARTICIPATED IN SUCH MEETINGS.

APPLICATIONS SHOULD BE MADE ON OR BEFORE JULY 14 TO THE SENIOR EDUCATION OFFICER, SECONDARY SCHOOL PLACES ALLOCATION SECTION, EDUCATION DEPARTMENT, LEE GARDENS, FIFTH FLOOR, HYSAN AVENUE, HONG KONG.

PUBLIC DUMP AT WESTERN RECLAMATION RE-OPENED

THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT THE PUBLIC DUMP AT WESTERN RECLAMATION STAGE I WOULD BE RE-OPENED FROM TOMORROW (SUNDAY).

DUMPING LICENCES MAY BE OBTAINED FREE OF CHARGE ON APPLICATION TO THE CHIEF ENGINEER, PORT WORKS DIVISION, P.W.D. AT MURRAY BUILDING, FIRST FLOOR, GARDEN ROAD, HONG KONG.

HOLDERS OF VALID DUMPING LICENCES FOR PUBLIC DUMPS IN HONG KONG WILL BE PERMITTED TO DUMP MATERIALS SUCH AS APPROVED SOFT MATERIAL, BUILDING DEBRIS AND CERTAIN SIZE OF STONES PROVIDING THEY ARE WELL MIXED WITH EARTH.

THE ENTRANCE TO THE DUMP IS AT CONNAUGHT ROAD WEST NEAR ITS JUNCTION WITH WHITTY STREET.

ALL DUMPING MUST BE CARRIED OUT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE INSTRUCTIONS OF THE DUMP SUPERVISORS.

**TEMPORARY WATER CHARGES COLLECTION CENTRES IN
SHEUNG SHUI AND FANLING**

THE TAI PO DISTRICT OFFICE WILL SET UP TEMPORARY COLLECTION CENTRES AT SHEUNG SHUI AND FANLING NEXT WEEK TO FACILITATE PAYMENTS OF WATER CHARGES FOR THE FIRST PERIOD THIS YEAR, A DISTRICT OFFICE SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY (SATURDAY).

FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE TWO AREAS, THE SPOKESMAN SAID, THE TWO TEMPORARY CENTRES WILL BE LOCATED AT THE SHEUNG SHUI PUBLIC ENQUIRY CENTRE AT SHEK WU HUI AND AT THE FANLING RURAL COMMITTEE OFFICE AT LUEN WO HUI.

+THE FANLING COLLECTION CENTRE WILL OPERATE ON JULY 9 AND 10 WHILE THE SHEUNG SHUI CENTRE WILL RECEIVE WATER CHARGES PAYMENTS FROM JULY 11 TO 13,+ HE SAID.

COLLECTION HOURS AT THE TWO CENTRES WILL BE FROM 9 A.M. TO 1 P.M.

APART FROM THE TWO TEMPORARY COLLECTION CENTRES, THE ACCOUNTS OFFICE OF THE TAI PO DISTRICT OFFICE AT TAI PO MARKET WILL CONTINUE TO RECEIVE PAYMENTS TO THE GOVERNMENT INCLUDING WATER CHARGES, THE SPOKESMAN ADDED.
