### GOVERNOR MEETS COMMUNITY LEADERS

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THE GOVERNOR, SIR EDWARD YOUDE, AND LADY YOUDE, TODAY MET MORE THAN 1 000 PEOPLE FROM A WIDE CROSS SECTION OF THE COMMUNITY AT A SPRING RECEPTION HOSTED BY THE CITY AND NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION.

ADDRESSING THE GUESTS IN PUTONGHUA, THE GOVERNOR SAID ALTHOUGH HE HAD BEEN IN OFFICE FOR ONLY 10 MONTHS, HE APPRECIATED THAT THE PEOPLE OF HONG KONG WERE CAPABLE OF ADAPTING TO SITUATIONS IN A SPIRIT OF DILIGENCE, DETERMINATION AND COOPERATIVENESS.

+I HOPE THAT THE PEOPLE WILL CONTINUE TO WORK HARD FOR A MORE PROSPEROUS AND BETTER SOCIETY,+ HE SAID.

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THE DIRECTOR OF INFORMATION SERVICES, MR PETER TSAO, TODAY (THURSDAY) RECEIVED A CHEQUE FOR \$50 000 FROM LOCAL PUBLISHER AND BUSINESSMAN, MR LAW BUN, IN SUPPORT OF THE URBAN COUNCIL ELECTIONS PUBLICITY CAMPAIGN.

AT A PRESENTATION CEREMONY HELD IN THE GIS THEATRE THIS AFTERNOON, MR TSAO THANKED MR LAW FOR HIS GENEROUS SPONSORSHIP WHICH WILL HELP TO INCREASE PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THE COMING ELECTIONS ON MARCH 8, AND BOOST THE TURN-OUT RATE OF VOTERS ON THE DAY.

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POLL CARDS ISSUED TO URBCO VOTERS  
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ALL THE 568 537 VOTERS FOR TUESDAY'S (MARCH 8) URBAN COUNCIL ELECTIONS SHOULD HAVE RECEIVED A POLL CARD INFORMING THEM OF THE LOCATION OF THEIR POLLING STATIONS, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE CITY AND NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION SAID TODAY.

ANY ELECTOR WHO HAS NOT YET RECEIVED OR MISLAID HIS POLL CARD CAN TELEPHONE THE REGISTRATION OFFICER AT 5-270380 OR 5-270369, QUOTING HIS HONG KONG IDENTITY CARD NUMBER, TO ENQUIRE ABOUT HIS POLLING STATION.

HE STRESSED THAT AN ELECTOR COULD ONLY VOTE IN THE CONSTITUENCY WHERE HE HAD REGISTERED AND AT THE POLLING STATION SPECIFIED ON THE POLL CARD.

+THE POLL CARD IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR ENTRY INTO A POLLING STATION. BUT A VOTER MUST BRING WITH HIM HIS IDENTITY CARD,+ THE SPOKESMAN ADDED.

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## MORE CAREERS CONVENTIONS TO BE HELD

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THE LAST THREE OF A SERIES OF SIX REGIONAL CAREERS CONVENTIONS JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE YOUTH EMPLOYMENT ADVISORY SERVICE OF THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT AND THE HONG KONG ASSOCIATION OF CAREERS MASTERS FOR SECONDARY STUDENTS WILL BE HELD THIS MONTH.

ANNOUNCING THIS TODAY (THURSDAY), A SPOKESMAN FOR THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT POINTED OUT THAT THE FIRST THREE CONVENTIONS HAD ATTRACTED MORE THAN 10 000 STUDENTS.

THE FOURTH CONVENTION WILL BE HELD AT THE CNEC CHRISTIAN COLLEGE, 6 LEI PUI STREET, KWAI CHUNG, NEW TERRITORIES, TOMORROW (FRIDAY); THE FIFTH AT YU CHUN KEUNG MEMORIAL COLLEGE, 1 CHI FU CLOSE, POKFULAM, NEXT MONDAY (MARCH 7); AND THE SIXTH AT THE HONG KONG AND SZE YAP COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL ASSOCIATION WONG TAI SHAN MEMORIAL COLLEGE, 250 NAM CHEONG STREET, KOWLOON, NEXT FRIDAY (MARCH 11).

EACH CONVENTION, LASTING TWO DAYS, WILL COMPRISE A CAREERS DISPLAY STAGED BY STUDENTS OF PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS, A SERIES OF SPECIALIST TALKS AND SHOWING OF FILMS AND SLIDE SHOWS ON CAREERS.

THE TALKS WILL BE GIVEN BY REPRESENTATIVES FROM COMMERCE, INDUSTRY, SERVICE SECTOR, PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATIONS, TRAINING INSTITUTES AND GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS, AND THE TOPICS WILL INCLUDE HOTEL AND TOURISM, FURTHER STUDIES, BANKING, MASS COMMUNICATION, THE LEGAL PROFESSION AND ELECTRONIC DATA PROCESSING.

+IT IS HOPED THAT BY ATTENDING THE CONVENTIONS, THE STUDENTS CAN FREELY CHOOSE THE TOPIC THAT FITS THEIR INTEREST AND BE ENCOURAGED TO EXPLORE THE WORLD OF WORK BY TAKING PART IN THE COLLECTION OF CAREERS INFORMATION FOR THE DISPLAY.

+IN ORGANISING THE CONVENTIONS, CAREERS TEACHERS CAN ALSO HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO EXCHANGE VIEWS AND INFORMATION AND UNDERSTAND MORE ABOUT THE NEEDS OF THEIR STUDENTS,+ THE SPOKESMAN ADDED.

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## SCHOOL TEXTBOOK ASSISTANCE SCHEME

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GOVERNMENT AND AIDED SCHOOLS WILL ADOPT A NEW PROCEDURE TO ENSURE THAT PARENTS TAKING PART IN THE SCHOOL TEXTBOOKS ASSISTANCE SCHEME RECEIVE THE GRANTS.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT SAID THERE WERE INSTANCES WHERE SOME SCHOOLS HAD FOUND IT DIFFICULT TO PAY THE TEXTBOOK AND STATIONERY GRANTS TO SOME PARENTS OR GUARDIANS BECAUSE OF PROBLEMS IN BANK TRANSFER.

+IN MANY CASES THE TRANSFER HAS BEEN REJECTED DUE TO THE FACT THAT THE BANK ACCOUNT NUMBERS SUBMITTED WERE INCORRECT OR THE ACCOUNTS HAVE BEEN CLOSED,+ HE SAID.

/TO OVERCOME .....

TO OVERCOME THIS DIFFICULTY, THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT HAS AUTHORISED SCHOOLS TO ISSUE CHEQUES TO EFFECT PAYMENT TO PARENTS OR GUARDIANS IF THE ORIGINAL BANK TRANSFER WAS REJECTED.

IN DOING SO, THE SCHOOLS MUST ADOPT THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES:

- THE CHEQUES MUST BE DRAWN PAYABLE ONLY TO THE RESPECTIVE PARENTS/GUARDIANS AS SHOWN IN THE APPLICATION FORMS;
- THE CHEQUES MUST BE CROSSED AND MARKED +A/C PAYEE ONLY+;
- THE CHEQUE NUMBERS WILL BE ENTERED AGAINST THE RESPECTIVE REJECTS IN THE BANK'S REJECTION LIST;
- A RECEIPT FORM TOGETHER WITH THE CHEQUE WILL BE HANDED TO THE PUPIL CONCERNED WITH INSTRUCTION TO HAND OVER THE CHEQUE TO HIS PARENT/GUARDIAN AND TO RETURN THE RECEIPT TO THE SCHOOL, DULY SIGNED BY HIS PARENT/GUARDIAN;
- THE SCHOOL WILL ENSURE ALL RECEIPTS ARE RETURNED, DULY SIGNED AND SIGNATURES ARE CHECKED TO BE IDENTICAL TO THAT IN THE APPLICATION FORM. IF NOT IDENTICAL, FRESH SIGNATURES MUST BE OBTAINED; AND,
- THE RECEIPTS, DULY CHECKED TO BE IN ORDER, AND THE BANK'S REJECTION LIST SHOULD BE PROPERLY FILED TOGETHER WITH ALL OTHER BANK TRANSFER RECEIPTS FOR AUDITING PURPOSES.

AS A RESULT OF THESE ARRANGEMENTS REQUIRING SCHOOLS CONCERNED TO DEAL WITH THE BANK REJECTS, THE DEADLINE DATE FOR REFUND OF UNPAID BALANCES TO THE GOVERNMENT WILL BE EXTENDED TO MARCH 31, 1983, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

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#### CBF PRAISES FIRE SERVICES \* \* \*

HE SAID: +SOME TIME OR OTHER IN THE FUTURE, YOU WILL TAKE A RISK ON BEHALF OF OTHER CITIZENS OF THE TERRITORY.

+THERE COULD BE NO GREATER DEMAND PLACED UPON A PERSON AND THE RECORD OF THE HONG KONG FIRE SERVICES IN THIS RESPECT IS SECOND TO NONE,+ HE SAID.

URBAN CLEARWAY RESTRICTION AT KING HONG STREET  
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URBAN CLEARWAY RESTRICTION WILL BE IMPOSED ON THE SECTION OF KING HONG STREET BETWEEN KING FUK STREET AND PRINCE EDWARD ROAD EAST IN SAN PO KONG FROM 10 AM TOMORROW TO IMPROVE TRAFFIC FLOW.

THE CLEARWAY RESTRICTION WILL BE ON A 24-HOUR BASIS.

ALL MOTOR VEHICLES OTHER THAN FRANCHISED BUSES WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM STOPPING FOR PASSENGERS OR GOODS WITHIN THE ROAD SECTION.

AT THE SAME TIME, VEHICLES WITH AN UNLADEN WEIGHT OF MORE THAN 2-1/2 TONS WILL BE BANNED FROM THE SECTION OF KING HONG STREET BETWEEN PRINCE EDWARD ROAD EAST AND THE ACCESS ROAD TO THE SAN PO KONG FLATTED FACTORIES.
