MRS. THATCHER VISITS FACTORIES

THE BRITISH CONSERVATIVE PARTY LEADER, MRS. MARGARET THATCHER, SPENT THE ENTIRE MORNING TODAY (MONDAY) VISITING FACTORIES -- ONE ON HONG KONG ISLAND AND TWO IN KOWLOON.

SHE STARTED THE TOUR WITH A VISIT TO W. HAKING INDUSTRIES (MECHANICS AND OPTICS) LIMITED.

THE OTHER TWO FACTORIES MRS. THATCHER VISITED WERE THE STELUX MANUFACTURING COMPANY LIMITED, MAKERS OF WATCH PARTS, ELECTRONICS PRODUCTS AND CAMERAS, AND THE MICRO ELECTRONICS LIMITED.

THE CONSERVATIVE PARTY LEADER WAS ACCOMPANIED ON THE THREE-HOUR TOUR BY THE DIRECTOR OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY, MR. DAVID JORDAN.

MRS. THATCHER SHOWED KEEN INTEREST IN WHAT SHE SAW AND ASKED BOTH THE PRINCIPALS OF THE FACTORIES AND THE WORKERS NUMEROUS QUESTIONS.

ALSO IN THE VISITING PARTY WERE MRS. THATCHER'S DAUGHTER, CAROL= THE OPPOSITION SPOKESMAN ON EUROPE, MR. DOUGLAS HURD, AND MRS. THATCHER'S PARLIAMENTARY PRIVATE SECRETARY, MR. J. P. STANLEY.

MANPOWER SURVEY OF ELECTRICAL INDUSTRY

A MANPOWER SURVEY OF THE ELECTRICAL INDUSTRY WILL BE CARRIED OUT BETWEEN MAY 2 AND 23 TO COLLECT UP-TO-DATE INFORMATION ON TRAINING REQUIREMENTS.

THE SURVEY, THE FOURTH IN THE SERIES, WILL BE CARRIED OUT BY THE ELECTRICAL INDUSTRY TRAINING BOARD OF THE HONG KONG TRAINING COUNCIL, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT AND THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT.

QUESTIONNAIRES AND EXPLANATORY LETTERS WERE SENT OUT TODAY TO ALL ESTABLISHMENTS INCLUDED IN THE SURVEY.

THE INFORMATION WHICH EMPLOYERS ARE REQUESTED TO SUPPLY INCLUDES:

THE NUMBER OF WORKERS PRESENTLY UNDER TRAINING=

DURING THE SURVEY, INTERVIEWING OFFICERS WILL VISIT EACH OF THE ESTABLISHMENTS CONCERNED AND HELP EMPLOYERS TO COMPLETE THE QUESTIONNAIRE.

THE CHAIRMAN OF THE ELECTRICAL INDUSTRY TRAINING BOARD, MR. WARNER YEH, ASSURED PROPRIETORS THAT THE INFORMATION COLLECTED WOULD BE HANDLED IN STRICT CONFIDENCE AND WOULD BE PUBLISHED ONLY IN THE FORM OF STATISTICAL SUMMARIES WITHOUT REFERENCE TO ANY INDIVIDUAL ESTABLISHMENT.

## INDUSTRIAL SAFETY POSTER COMPETITION

\* \* \* \* \*

A 17-YEAR-OLD STUDENT, YIU YAU-HUNG OF TSUEN WAN GOVERNMENT SECONDARY SCHOOL, TOPPED A LIST OF 280 ENTRIES FOR THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT'S INDUSTRIAL SAFETY POSTER AND SAFETY SLOGAN COMPETITION AND WON A CASH PRIZE OF \$250.

ANOTHER PRIZE OF \$200 WENT TO 14-YEAR-OLD LEUNG NAI-FAI OF KOWLOON TECHNICAL SCHOOL.

AS AN ENCOURAGEMENT TO THE STUDENTS, THE ORGANISERS HAVE DECIDED TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CONSOLATION PRIZES OF \$100 EACH FROM THREE TO SIX. THE WINNERS WERE CHOW YUK-HAM (16) OF JOCKEY CLUB GOVERNMENT SECONDARY TECHNICAL SCHOOL, LEE KAM-KWONG (16) OF VICTORIA TECHNICAL SCHOOL, CHAN CHI-HUNG (17) OF SHEUNG KWAI CHUNG GOVERNMENT TECHNICAL SCHOOL, LO YAN-PIN (14) OF KEI HEEP SECONDARY MODERN SCHOOL, CHIU CHUI-WAN (17) OF TSUEN WAN GOVERNMENT SECONDARY SCHOOL AND LAI SIU-MING (17) OF SHEUNG KWAI CHUNG GOVERNMENT SECONDARY SCHOOL.

ON THE SAFETY SLOGAN SIDE THE FIRST PRIZE OF \$150 WENT TO CATHERINE NG YUK-KING (15) OF OUR LADY'S COLLEGE, WHILE THE SECOND AND THIRD PRIZES OF \$120 AND \$80 WENT TO CHAN SHING-FAI (17) OF JOCKEY CLUB GOVERNMENT SECONDARY TECHNICAL SCHOOL AND ANGELA WONG WAI-WAH OF OUR LADY'S COLLEGE RESPECTIVELY. THERE WERE 130 ENTRIES FOR THE SAFETY SLOGAN COMPETITION.

THE SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE CHINESE MANUFACTURERS' ASSOCIATION, MR. LEE CHAK-PUI WILL PRESENT THE PRIZES TO THE WINNERS AT THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT'S INDUSTRIAL SAFETY TRAINING CENTRE IN KOWLOON ON WEDNESDAY.

COMMENTING ON THE COMPETITION, A LABOUR DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID : +FOR THE PAST EIGHT YEARS WE HAVE ORGANISED SIMILAR INDUSTRIAL SAFETY POSTER COMPETITIONS BUT THIS YEAR WE HAVE INCLUDED A NEW ITEM -- THE INDUSTRIAL SAFETY SLOGAN.

+THE AIM OF THESE COMPETITIONS IS TO AROUSE THE AWARENESS OF THE IMPORTANCE OF MACHINERY SAFETY AMONG FACTORY WORKERS.

+THIS YEAR'S COMPETITION IS ALSO TIMED TO COINCIDE WITH THE COMING INTO OPERATION OF THE NEWLY ENACTED FACTORIES AND INDUSTRIAL UNDERTAKINGS (GUARDING AND OPERATION OF MACHINERY REGULATIONS) WHICH HAVE BEEN INTRODUCED IN AN EFFORT TO KEEP THE RATE OF INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENTS DOWN AS FAR AS POSSIBLE.+

ANTI-CANCER EXHIBITION MOVES TO KOWLOON

CANCER AWARENESS '77 -- AN EXHIBITION DESIGNED FOR THE PUBLIC TO LEARN ALL ABOUT CANCER -- WILL MOVE ON TO THE DENSELY POPULATED AREAS OF KOWLOON AFTER A SUCCESSFUL RUN ON HONG KONG ISLAND.

THE EXHIBITION HAS PROVED TO BE IMMENSELY POPULAR WITH SOME 30,000 RESIDENTS TURNING UP AT CITY HALL AND QUEEN'S COLLEGE TO SEE THE DISPLAYS EARLIER THIS MONTH.

FOR THE BENEFIT OF RESIDENTS IN KOWLOON AND THE NEW TERRITORIES, SIMILAR EXHIBITION WILL BE HELD IN VARIOUS DISTRICTS DURING THE NEXT FIVE WEEKS -- AT TSIM SHA TSUI KAIFONG WELFARE ASSOCIATION BETWEEN APRIL 20 AND 23, YUEN LONG TOWN HALL BETWEEN APRIL 27 AND 30, TSUEN WAN PRINCESS ALEXANDRA COMMUNITY CENTRE BETWEEN MAY 4 AND 7, AND KWUN TONG VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE BETWEEN MAY 18 AND 21.

CANCER AWARENESS '77 IS JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE HONG KONG ANTI-CANCER SOCIETY AND THE CHURCH OF JESUS CHRIST OF LATTER-DAY SAINTS, AND ASSISTED BY THE MEDICAL AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND A NUMBER OF MEDICAL BODIES.

THE EXHIBITION IS DESIGNED TO PROVIDE INFORMATION ON THE PREVENTION, TREATMENT AND WARNING AND SYMPTOMS OF THE VARIOUS FORMS OF CANCER, WHICH IS HONG KONG'S NUMBER ONE KILLER DISEASE.

THERE ARE FILM SHOWS, SLIDES, PICTURES, MODELS, RECORDINGS AND ILLUSTRATIONS TO HELP MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC UNDERSTAND WHAT CANCER IS ALL ABOUT.

CREATORS OF THE DISPLAYS ARE MEMBERS OF THE INTERNATIONAL HEALTH TEAM OF THE CHURCH OF JESUS CHRIST OF LATTER-DAY SAINTS, WHICH CONSISTS OF SIX YOUNG WOMEN WHO HAVE TAKEN LEAVE FROM THEIR SCHOOLING AND JOBS IN THE UNITED STATES TO COME TO HONG KONG FOR ONE-AND-A-HALF YEARS OF VOLUNTARY SERVICE.

ADMISSION TO THE EXHIBITION IS FREE, AND THE ORGANISERS WILL BE ON HAND TO EXPLAIN AND DEMONSTRATE THE VARIOUS ITEMS OF EXHIBITS.

WATER SUPPLY TO A NUMBER OF PREMISES IN NORTH POINT ON HONG KONG ISLAND AND TSUEN WAN IN THE NEW TERRITORIES WILL BE TURNED OFF FOR FIVE HOURS FROM 1 A.M. ON WEDNESDAY (APRIL 20) TO ENABLE NIGHT LEAKAGE TESTS TO BE CARRIED OUT IN THESE TWO AREAS.

ON HONG KONG ISLAND, THE AREA AFFECTED IS BOUNDED BY THE SOUTH SIDE OF KING'S ROAD BETWEEN HEALTHY STREET WEST AND MANSION STREET, TSAT TSZ MUI ROAD AND PAK FUK ROAD, INCLUDING MODEL LANE, HEALTHY STREET EAST AND HEALTHY STREET CENTRAL.

IN TSUEN WAN, THE AFFECTED AREA IS BOUNDED BY TAI WO HAU ROAD, WO TONG TSUI STREET, KWAI CHUNG ROAD AND CASTLE PEAK ROAD, INCLUDING FU UK TSUEN, BLOCK NOS. 1 TO 5 OF KWAI CHUNG FACTORY AND ALL BLOCKS OF KWAI HING ESTATE.
