NEW STAMP ISSUE TO FEATURE DISABLED ATHLETES
* * * *

THE THIRD FAR EAST AND SOUTH PACIFIC GAMES FOR THE DISABLED (FESPIC GAMES 1982) WILL BE THE THEME FOR A SPECIAL ISSUE OF FOUR POSTAGE STAMPS TO BE PUT ON SALE ON OCTOBER 20.

THE STAMP DESIGNS DEPICT DISABLED SPORTSMEN PLAYING TABLE TENNIS FROM THEIR WHEELCHAIRS (30 CENTS), DISABLED ATHLETES IN A WHEELCHAIR RACE (\$1), WHEELCHAIR BASKETBALL (\$1.30) AND ARCHERY (\$5), THE POSTMASTER GENERAL ANNOUNCED.

AS THIS ISSUE HIGHLIGHTS THE SPORTING ACTIVITIES OF THE PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED, POSTMASTERS HAVE BEEN ASKED TO ASSIST ANY HANDICAPPED PERSON WISHING TO PURCHASE STAMPS ON THE FIRST DAY OF ISSUE. THIS IS IN ADDITION TO THE SPECIAL COUNTER FOR THE DISABLED AT THE GENERAL POST OFFICE.

THE NEW STAMPS WILL BE ON DISPLAY ON THE FIRST FLOOR PUBLIC COUNTER OF THE GENERAL POST OFFICE, CONNAUGHT PLACE FROM OCTOBER 15, BETWEEN 9.30 AM AND 4.30 PM.

OFFICIAL FIRST DAY COVERS WILL BE PLACED ON SALE AT ALL POST OFFICES ON OCTOBER 7 AT 50 CENTS EACH. EACH COVER WILL BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN INSERT CARD CONTAINING INFORMATION ON FESPIC GAMES 1982 AND BRIEF PHILATELIC INFORMATION.

SUFFICIENT FIRST DAY COVERS HAVE BEEN PRINTED TO MEET ANTICIPATED PUBLIC DEMAND AND THERE WILL BE NO RESTRICTION ON THE NUMBER SOLD TO EACH PERSON.

ADVANCE ORDERS FOR SERVICING OF FIRST DAY COVERS WILL BE ACCEPTED UP TO 5 PM ON OCTOBER 15 AT THE GENERAL POST OFFICE, CONNAUGHT PLACE; KOWLOON CENTRAL POST OFFICE, NATHAN ROAD; AND TSIM SHA TSUI POST OFFICE, PEKING ROAD.

FOR THIS SERVICE, ADDRESSED FIRST DAY COVERS MUST BE HANDED IN WITH AN ORDER FORM TOGETHER WITH A REMITTANCE TO COVER THE COST.

THE CHARGE WILL BE \$8.60 PER COVER WHICH INCLUDES THE COST OF THE STAMPS (\$7.60) TOGETHER WITH A SERVICE FEE OF \$1.

THE COVERS MUST BE FULLY ADDRESSED BY THE APPLICANTS, AND NO LESS THAN 10 COVERS WILL BE ACCEPTED WITH EACH ORDER.

THE ORDER FORMS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE GENERAL POST OFFICE, KOWLOON CENTRAL POST OFFICE AND TSIM SHA TSUI POST OFFICE ON OCTOBER 7.

ANY PERSON ORDERING SERVICED COVERS ADDRESSED TO A LOCAL DESTINATION MAY COLLECT THEM ON OCTOBER 21 FROM THE POST OFFICE WHERE THE ORDER WAS PLACED.

COVERS ADDRESSED OVERSEAS WILL BE SENT FORWARD BY AIRMAIL.

A SERVICE WILL BE PROVIDED ON OCTOBER 20 AT ALL POST OFFICES WHEREBY UNREGISTERED FIRST DAY COVERS BEARING A LOCAL ADDRESS WILL BE ACCEPTED OVER THE COUNTER, IMPRESSED WITH THE NORMAL POST OFFICE DATESTAMP AND HANDED BACK TO THE PERSON.

A TEMPORARY POST OFFICE WILL BE OPENED IN THE FESPIC VILLAGE (THE PRINCE OF WALES HOSPITAL, SHA TIN WAI ROAD, SHA TIN) FROM OCTOBER 28 TO NOVEMBER 10 INCLUSIVE. THE FOLLOWING SERVICES WILL BE OFFERED: STAMPS AND REGISTRATION, PARCEL ACCEPTANCE AND MAIL COLLECTION. PHILATELIC ITEMS, INCLUDING FESPIC COVERS, WILL ALSO BE ON SALE.

A NOVEL FEATURE OF INTEREST TO PHILATELISTS IS THAT ALL MAIL POSTED AT THE VILLAGE POST OFFICE WILL BE SPECIALLY HANDSTAMPED, AND A HAND BACK SERVICE WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR LOCALLY ADDRESSED UNREGISTERED MAIL.

THIS IS THE FIRST TIME A TEMPORARY POST OFFICE HAS BEEN OPENED IN HONG KONG SINCE 1974. THE OPENING HOURS OF THE VILLAGE POST OFFICE WILL BE 9.45 AM - 12.15 PM AND 1.45 PM - 4.15 PM ON MONDAYS TO FRIDAYS AND 9.45 AM - 12.15 PM ON SATURDAYS.

ZONING PLAN AMENDED

* * *

THE TOWN PLANNING BOARD TODAY (FRIDAY) ANNOUNCED TWO AMENDMENTS TO THE DRAFT WANG TAU HOM AND TUNG TAU OUTLINE ZONING PLAN.

ONE OF THE AMENDMENTS INVOLVES THE REZONING OF THE GOVERNMENT, INSTITUTION AND COMMUNITY SITE TO THE NORTH OF LUNG CHEUNG ROAD FOR RESIDENTIAL (GROUP A) PURPOSE.

THIS SITE IS INTENDED FOR PRIVATE SECTOR PARTICIPATION OR MIDDLE INCOME HOUSING SCHEME. PRELIMINARY ASSESSMENT INDICATES THAT THE SITE CAN PRODUCE ABOUT 2 000 FLATS FOR 9 000 PERSONS.

THE SECOND AMENDMENT INVOLVES SLIGHT ADJUSTMENT OF THE MASS TRANSIT RAILWAY ALIGNMENT BETWEEN THE WONG TAI SIN AND LOK FU STATIONS AS SHOWN IN THE DRAFT OUTLINE ZONING PLAN.

PROPOSALS WERE ALSO MADE TO REVISE THE SCHEDULE OF NOTES OF THE PLAN.

THE AMENDED PLAN MAY BE INSPECTED AT THE TOWN PLANNING DIVISION, 17TH FLOOR, MURRAY BUILDING, GARDEN ROAD; THE CENTRAL AND WESTERN DISTRICT OFFICE PUBLIC ENQUIRY SUB-OFFICE, CENTRAL GOVERNMENT OFFICE, WEST WING ENTRANCE AND THE WONG TAI SIN DISTRICT OFFICE, SAN PO KONG GOVERNMENT OFFICE BUILDING, 4TH AND 5TH FLOOR, KING FUK STREET, SAN PO KONG, KOWLOON.

ANY PERSON AFFECTED BY THE AMENDMENT TO THE PLAN MAY SUBMIT HIS OBJECTIONS IN WRITING TO THE SECRETARY, TOWN PLANNING BOARD, C/O LANDS DEPARTMENT, MURRAY BUILDING, GARDEN ROAD, HONG KONG.

COPIES OF THE DRAFT PLAN ARE AVAILABLE AT THE SURVEY DIVISION, LANDS DEPARTMENT, 5TH FLOOR, MURRAY BUILDING, GARDEN ROAD, HONG KONG AT \$10 EACH UNCOLOURED AND \$60 EACH COLOURED.

REVIEW OF RENT INCREASE CERTIFICATES

* * *

THE TASK OF REVIEWING CERTIFICATES OF INCREASE IN RENT RELATING TO POST-WAR DOMESTIC PREMISES ISSUED UNDER PART II OF THE LANDLORD AND TENANT (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE IS TO BE UNDERTAKEN BY THE COMMISSIONER OF RATING AND VALUATION WITH APPEALS BEING DEALT WITH BY THE LANDS TRIBUNAL.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE RATING AND VALUATION DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY (FRIDAY) THAT THIS WAS A FURTHER MOVE TOWARDS IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS MADE BY LAST YEAR'S COMMITTEE OF REVIEW, LANDLORD AND TENANT (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE. THESE FUNCTIONS, HITHERTO UNDERTAKEN BY THE RENT TRIBUNAL AND THE DISTRICT COURT, WILL BE TRANSFERRED TO THE COMMISSIONER AND THE LANDS TRIBUNAL, RESPECTIVELY, FROM TODAY.

THE SPOKESMAN EXPLAINED THAT APPLICATIONS FOR REVIEW IN RESPECT OF RENT INCREASE CERTIFICATES ISSUED ON OR AFTER TODAY SHOULD BE MADE ON A NEWLY SPECIFIED FORM (FORM TR18) AND SUBMITTED IN DUPLICATE TO THE COMMISSIONER. NO FEE IS PAYABLE FOR THE REVIEW.

HOWEVER, FOR CERTIFICATES ISSUED PRIOR TO OCTOBER 1, THE FORMER REVIEW PROCEEDINGS ARE STILL APPLICABLE AND APPLICATIONS FOR REVIEW SHOULD BE MADE ON FORM TR10A TOGETHER WITH THE REVIEWING FEE OF \$50.

THE SPECIFIED FORMS ARE AVAILABLE, FREE OF CHARGE, AT THE RATING AND VALUATION DEPARTMENT, HENNESSY CENTRE, 500 HENNESSY ROAD, 17TH FLOOR, CAUSEWAY BAY, HONG KONG; AND ALSO AT ANY DISTRICT OFFICE/TOWN MANAGEMENT OFFICE IN THE NEW TERRITORIES.

MR YOUNG, MANAGING DIRECTOR OF SWIRE TRAVEL LTD., HAS BEEN AN APPOINTED MEMBER OF THE URBAN COUNCIL SINCE 1978. HE IS CLOSELY INVOLVED IN THE WORK OF THE COUNCIL AND IS CURRENTLY CHAIRMAN OF ITS CLEAN HONG KONG COMMITTEE.

THEY WERE THEN TAKEN TO THE HOME OWNERSHIP SCHEME SUI WO COURT OVERLOOKING SHA TIN AND WERE BRIEFED ON THE NEW TOWN'S DEVELOPMENT BY THE DISTRICT OFFICER, MR DONALD TSANG, AND THE PROJECT MANAGER, MR KEITH AUSTIN.

LATER ON, MRS TRIPPIER ALSO TOURED LEK YUEN AND WO CHE ESTATES AND VISITED A HOSTEL FOR THE ELDERLY.

USE SEAT BELT - TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT

IN A FURTHER EFFORT TO ENCOURAGE THE USE OF SAFETY BELTS, THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT WILL BE DISTRIBUTING STICKERS WITH THIS MESSAGE SHORTLY.

INITIALLY, CAR OWNERS WHOSE VEHICLES WERE MANUFACTURED AFTER AUGUST 1, 1976 WILL BE GIVEN +USE SEAT BELT+ STICKERS WHEN THEY RENEW THEIR LICENCES.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID THE COMPULSORY WEARING OF SAFETY BELTS IS EXPECTED TO BECOME LAW SOMETIME NEXT YEAR.

CLOTHING INDUSTRY MANPOWER SURVEY REPORT ON SALE

THE REPORT ON THE SIXTH MANPOWER SURVEY OF THE CLOTHING INDUSTRY IS NOW ON SALE AT \$13 AT THE GOVERNMENT PUBLICATIONS CENTRE, GENERAL POST OFFICE, HONG KONG. IT IS PUBLISHED IN ENGLISH AND CHINESE.

THE REPORT WAS PREPARED BY THE CLOTHING INDUSTRY TRAINING BOARD OF THE FORMER HONG KONG TRAINING COUNCIL, NOW REPLACED BY THE VOCATIONAL TRAINING COUNCIL.

THE REPORT PROVIDES DETAILED STATISTICAL INFORMATION ON THE EMPLOYMENT STRUCTURE OF THE INDUSTRY, I.E. THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES IN EACH PRINCIPAL JOB AND A FORECAST OF THE TRAINING NEEDS OF THE INDUSTRY. IT ALSO CONTAINS RECOMMENDATIONS ON MEASURES THAT SHOULD BE TAKEN TO MEET THE FORECAST MANPOWER DEMAND AND ON TRAINING ROUTES FOR TECHNOLOGISTS, TECHNICIANS, CRAFTSMEN AND OPERATIVES.

THE SURVEY WAS CONDUCTED IN SEPTEMBER 1981 BY THE CLOTHING INDUSTRY TRAINING BOARD WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT AND THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT.

TWO SITES IN CHAI WAN AWARDED FOR DEVELOPMENT

* * * * *

THE GOVERNMENT TODAY (FRIDAY) AWARDED TWO TENDERS FOR TWO SITES IN CHAI WAN UNDER THE PRIVATE SECTOR PARTICIPATION SCHEME ARRANGEMENTS.

THE TENDERS WERE AWARDED TO BILLION TOWN CO. LTD., A WHOLLY-OWNED SUBSIDIARY OF NEW WORLD DEVELOPMENT CO. LTD. WHICH BID A TOTAL OF \$303 300 000 FOR THE SITES.

THE GOVERNMENT LAND AGENT, MR T.J. MILLS, SAID THAT THE TWO SITES, ONE LOCATED TO THE NORTH OF THE JUNCTION OF HONG MAN STREET AND LEE CHUNG STREET AND THE OTHER AT THE JUNCTION OF CHAI WAN ROAD AND LOK MAN ROAD, MEASURE ABOUT 22 440 SQUARE METRES AND 10 400 SQUARE METRES RESPECTIVELY.

HE SAID THAT THE DEVELOPER PROPOSED TO PRODUCE ALTOGETHER 3 030 FLATS HAVING A TOTAL GROSS FLOOR AREA OF JUST OVER 195 000 SQUARE METRES.

+COMMERCIAL FACILITIES SUCH AS RESTAURANTS, RETAIL SHOPS AND A SUPERMARKET, COMPRISING A TOTAL OF ABOUT 3 410 SQUARE METRES, WILL ALSO BE PROVIDED TOGETHER WITH A KINDERGARTEN FOR EACH SITE,+ HE ADDED.

THE DEVELOPMENT OF THESE TWO SITES IS PROGRAMMED FOR COMPLETION IN ABOUT THREE YEARS.

THE NEW TERRITORIES DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT PLANS TO WIDEN A SECTION OF TSING WUN ROAD BETWEEN PUI TO ROAD AND LUNG MUN ROAD TO PROVIDE A DUAL TWO-LANE CARRIAGEWAY.

THE SCHEME FORMS PART OF THE CONTINUING PROGRAMME FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF TUEN MUN NEW TOWN.

THE PROJECT ALSO INCLUDES THE CONSTRUCTION OF FOUR NEW ROADS IN TSING SHAN TSUEN AND KAU HUI.

DETAILS OF THE PROPOSAL ARE PUBLISHED IN A NOTICE IN TODAY'S GOVERNMENT GAZETTE AND A NOTICE, IN ENGLISH AND CHINESE, CAN BE SEEN ON THE NOTICE BOARDS POSTED NEAR THE SITE OF THE PROPOSED WORKS.
