CONSULTATIONS/DISCUSSIONS IN BRUSSELS, LONDON,  
GENEVA, OSLO AND STOCKHOLM  
\* \* \* \* \*

A TRADE, INDUSTRY AND CUSTOMS DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID THAT A DELEGATION, LED BY MR. LAWRENCE MILLS, DIRECTOR OF TRADE, WOULD BE LEAVING HONG KONG TOMORROW (JUNE 20) EVENING, BY SWISSAIR FLIGHT SR 307, FOR CONSULTATIONS AND DISCUSSIONS IN VARIOUS EUROPEAN CAPITALS FROM JUNE 22 TO JULY 3, 1978.

THE DELEGATION WILL FIRST HOLD TALKS ON JUNE 22 AND 23 WITH THE EEC COMMISSION IN BRUSSELS ON A NUMBER OF ISSUES ARISING FROM THE OPERATION OF THE CURRENT HK/EEC AGREEMENT. THESE INCLUDE CLASSIFICATION PROBLEMS AND DIFFICULTIES ENCOUNTERED BY LOCAL EXPORTERS AND MANUFACTURERS OF CERTAIN TEXTILES MADE-UP ARTICLES IN MEETING THE EEC ORIGIN CRITERIA.

THE DELEGATION WILL THEN MEET INFORMALLY WITH WHITEHALL OFFICIALS IN LONDON ON JUNE 26, THEN MOVE TO GENEVA FOR CONSULTATIONS ON JUNE 27 WITH THE SWISS AUTHORITIES REGARDING EXPORTS OF CERTAIN TEXTILES TO SWITZERLAND.

WHILE IN LONDON, BRUSSELS AND GENEVA, THE DELEGATION WILL ALSO HOLD INTERNAL DISCUSSIONS WITH THE OVERSEAS OFFICES THERE.

THE DELEGATION WILL THEN GO TO OSLO FOR CONSULTATIONS ON JUNE 28-30 WITH THE NORWEGIAN AUTHORITIES AS AGREED BY THE GATT COUNCIL FOLLOWING HONG KONG'S REFERENCE TO THE GATT OF THE PROBLEMS IT HAD ENCOUNTERED IN ITS TEXTILE TRADE WITH NORWAY.

FINALLY THE DELEGATION WILL TRAVEL TO STOCKHOLM ON JULY 3 FOR TALKS WITH THE SWEDISH AUTHORITIES ON TECHNICAL MATTERS CONNECTED WITH THE HONG KONG/SWEDEN TEXTILES AGREEMENT.

OTHER MEMBERS OF THE DELEGATIONS ARE: P.K.C. WONG, DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF TRADE= J.K.H. YUE, ASSISTANT DIRECTOR (COMMERCIAL RELATIONS)= N. YEK, PRINCIPAL TRADE OFFICER= AND MISS N. WU, ASSISTANT TRADE OFFICER.

‡ 15 MILLION CONTRACT FOR TRUNK SEWER SIGNED  
\* \* \* \* \*

A TRUNK SEWER WILL BE LAID IN THE RECLAIMED AREA OF CASTLE PEAK BAY LATER THIS MONTH TO SERVE THE SOUTHEASTERN SECTION OF TUEN MUN NEW TOWN.

CONTRACT FOR THE WORK COSTING MORE THAN \$14.9 MILLION WAS FORMALLY SIGNED TODAY.

MR. K.K. TANG, ACTING CHIEF ENGINEER OF THE TUEN MUN NEW TOWN DEVELOPMENT OFFICE, SIGNED ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNMENT AND MR. H. CHARITON SIGNED FOR LEIGHTON CONTRACTORS PTY. LTD.

THE WORK ON THE CONTRACT WOULD TAKE ABOUT 12 MONTHS TO COMPLETE.

MR. TANG SAID THE TRUNK SEWER WAS DESIGNED TO CARRY THE SEWAGE PRODUCED BY THREE PUBLIC HOUSING ESTATES NOW UNDER CONSTRUCTION IN SAM SHING HUI AND ON THE RECLAIMED LAND AT CASTLE PEAK BAY.

IT WOULD ALSO CARRY SEWAGE FROM INDUSTRIAL AND PRIVATE DEVELOPMENT AREAS IN THE SOUTHEASTERN PART OF THE NEW TOWN.

MR. TANG SAID: +THE SEWER, WHICH IS THE MAJOR PART OF THE SEWERAGE NETWORK SERVING A POPULATION OF 140,000, WOULD BE ABOUT 1,500 METRES LONG.

+IT WILL RUN FROM SAM SHING HUI ALONG THE TUEN MUN ROAD EXTENSION TO JOIN A TRUNK SEWER NOW BEING BUILT ON THE WEST SIDE OF TUEN MUN.+

MEANWHILE, WORK ON THE COMPREHENSIVE SEWERAGE SYSTEM IN TUEN MUN NEW TOWN IS WELL UNDERWAY.

THE \$16 MILLION PROJECT, WHICH INVOLVES THE CONSTRUCTION OF ABOUT 6,000 METRES OF SWERAGE PIPES WITHIN THE NEW TOWN, IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED EARLY NEXT YEAR.

SURVEYS ON WORKERS DENSITY AND LIVING CONDITIONS IN TSUEN WAN  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE TSUEN WAN DISTRICT OFFICE WILL CONDUCT TWO MAJOR SURVEYS FROM TOMORROW (TUESDAY) ON THE DENSITY OF THE WORKING POPULATION AND THE LIVING CONDITIONS IN RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS IN THE DISTRICT.

KWAI CHUNG TOWN OFFICER, MR. DEREK GOULD, WHO IS IN CHARGE OF THE TWO SURVEYS SAID TODAY: +THE SURVEYS ARE DESIGNED TO COLLECT VITAL INFORMATION TO ASSIST THE LOCAL DISTRICT OFFICE AND THE DISTRICT ADVISORY BOARD IN PLANNING ADEQUATE RECREATIONAL SERVICES FOR THE DISTRICT'S WORKING POPULATION, AND IN ASSESSING THE NEED FOR ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT LOCALLY.+

THE SURVEY ON WORKER DENSITY WILL COVER FACTORIES IN TSUEN WAN, INCLUDING THOSE IN KWAI CHUNG, AND ON TSING YI AND MA WAN ISLANDS, WHILE THAT ON THE LIVING CONDITIONS WILL BE RESTRICTED TO THE TOWN AREAS OF TSUEN WAN AND KWAI CHUNG.

A TOTAL OF 14 UNDERGRADUATES FROM THE HONG KONG AND CHINESE UNIVERSITIES AND THE BAPTIST COLLEGE WILL ASSIST IN THE TWO SURVEYS WHICH ARE EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED IN ABOUT TWO MONTHS.

DURING THE SURVEY PERIOD, THE UNDERGRADUATES WILL VISIT THE DISTRICT'S 4,300 FACTORIES, INTERVIEW MORE THAN 1,500 FACTORY WORKERS AND SURVEY ABOUT 1,000 FAMILIES LIVING IN RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS IN THE TOWN AREAS.

TO IDENTIFY THEMSELVES, THE FIELD WORKERS WILL CARRY THEIR HONG KONG IDENTITY CARDS AND A LETTER ISSUED BY THE DISTRICT OFFICE.

MR. GOULD SAID: +IN THE FACTORY SURVEY WE WILL FIND OUT THE NUMBER OF FACTORY BUILDINGS AND FACTORIES IN THE DISTRICT= THE TYPE OF TRADE AND THE TOTAL NUMBER OF WORKERS IN THESE FACTORIES= THE AREA OCCUPIED BY PER WORKER IN EACH TRADE= AND THE ADEQUACY OF EXISTING COMMUNITY FACILITIES PROVIDED FOR THEM.+

CONCERNING THE SURVEY ON LIVING CONDITIONS, MR. GOULD SAID: +FAMILIES TO BE INTERVIEWED WILL BE ASKED TO PROVIDE INFORMATION ABOUT THEIR LIVING SURROUNDINGS AND THEIR VIEWS AS TO WHETHER IMPROVEMENT IS NEEDED AND HOW TO BRING ABOUT SUCH IMPROVEMENT.+

MR. GOULD APPEALED TO FACTORY MANAGERMENTS, WORKERS AND FAMILIES FOR THEIR ASSISTANCE AND CO-OPERATION IN THE SURVEYS, THE SECOND TO BE HELD IN THE DISTRICT. THE FIRST SURVEY WAS CONDUCTED IN KWAI CHUNG LAST YEAR ON A MUCH SMALLER SCALE.

HE EMPHASISED THAT THE INFORMATION COLLECTED IN THESE TWO SURVEYS WILL BE TREATED IN THE STRICTEST CONFIDENCE.

AFTER THE SURVEYS, A COMPREHENSIVE REPORT WILL BE PREPARED ON WHICH THE DISTRICT'S FUTURE PLANS IN THESE FIELDS WILL BE BASED, HE ADDED.

PUPPETS ARE NEW MESSAGE MEDIUM  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE GOVERNMENT BROKE NEW GROUND TODAY BY INTRODUCING A PUPPET THEATRE AS A MEDIUM OF COMMUNICATION TO HELP CONVEY CAMPAIGN MESSAGES TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

TO LAUNCH THE PUPPET THEATRE, MR. PETER MOSS, ASSISTANT DIRECTOR (PUBLICITY) OF THE INFORMATION SERVICES DEPARTMENT, UNVEILED THE +POPIS+ DURING LUNCH-HOUR AT EDINBURGH PLACE.

THE +POPIS+, MR. MOSS EXPLAINED, ARE +PUPPETS OF PUBLIC INTEREST+, DESIGNED TO PUT ACROSS INFORMATION OF VALUE TO THE PUBLIC ON A WIDE VARIETY OF SUBJECTS AFFECTING THEIR INTERESTS.

HE SAID THE PUPPETS HAD EVOLVED FROM A PUBLICITY MEDIUM -- THE STREET THEATRE -- WHICH THE GOVERNMENT INFORMATION SERVICES PIONEERED IN HONG KONG IN 1974.

+THIS CONSISTED OF A RETIRED PUBLIC WORKS LORRY, CONVERTED AT MODEST EXPENSE SO THAT THE PLATFORM FOLDED OUT INTO A STAGE, FITTED WITH LIGHTING, A PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM AND ITS OWN PORTABLE GENERATOR.

+SINCE ITS INCEPTION FOUR YEARS AGO, THE STREET THEATRE HAS MOUNTED SOME 800 SHOWS, INVOLVING A WIDE VARIETY OF ACTS RANGING FROM DRAMA SKETCHES, CHOIRS AND POP GROUPS TO KUNG FU AND MAGIC ROUTINES,+ HE RECALLED.

+IT HAS TRAVELLED MANY ROADS, TAKING ENTERTAINMENT TO CROWDED WEEKEND BEACHES, TO INDUSTRIAL AREAS, TO DENSELY POPULATED RESIDENTIAL ESTATES AND TO FISHING COMMUNITIES.

+UNDERLYING THE ENTERTAINMENT HAS BEEN AN EQUALLY VARIED RANGE OF MESSAGES ON TOPICS OF PUBLIC INTEREST, FROM INDUSTRIAL SAFETY TO CRIME PREVENTION, FROM EDUCATIONAL AND EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES TO RABIES CONTROL, NOT FORGETTING THOSE FAMILIAR REMINDERS TO KEEP HONG KONG CLEAN.

+THE MESSAGE HAS NEVER BEEN OBTRUSIVE, BECAUSE WE BELIEVE IN THE PHILOSOPHY THAT IF YOU WANT TO KEEP THE AUDIENCE INTERESTED THE SHOW MUST COME FIRST,+ MR. MOSS SAID.

THE PRODUCER OF THE PUPPET SHOW WAS MR. BILL YIM, WHO DESIGNED THE CARICATURE FIGURES.

IMPROVEMENTS TO AERODROME LIGHTING SYSTEM  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TODAY AWARDED A \$4.6 MILLION CONTRACT FOR THE PROVISION OF NEW AIDS AND THE IMPROVEMENTS TO THE EXISTING AERODROME LIGHTING SYSTEM AT THE HONG KONG INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

THE CONTRACT WAS SIGNED TODAY IN THE ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL OFFICE, CAROLINE HILL ROAD, HONG KONG, BY MR. G.J. OSBORNE, PRINCIPAL GOVERNMENT ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL ENGINEER ON BEHALF OF P.W.D. AND MR. DENIS C.C. WEN FOR MESSRS. ENGINEERING SERVICE, THE CONTRACTOR.

WORK ON THE PROVISION OF NEW AIDS AND IMPROVEMENTS UNDER THE OVERALL SUPERVISION OF THE ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL OFFICE WILL TAKE 15 MONTHS TO COMPLETE.

THE PROJECT WILL INCLUDE A TAXI-TRACK GUIDANCE SIGNS SYSTEM= ADDITIONAL TAXI-TRACK STOPBARS= A SYSTEM OF PARKING BAY ILLUMINATED NUMBER SIGNS AND APRON FLOOD LIGHT CONTROL= A 'MAIN DISTRIBUTION FRAME' IN THE EXISTING CONTROL TOWER FOR INTERFACING WITH A NEW VISUAL DISPLAY UNIT MICROPROCESSOR SYSTEM (TO BE PROVIDED UNDER A SEPARATE CONTRACT TO BE SIGNED EARLY NEXT MONTH) AND AIRFIELD LIGHTING CONTROL CUBICLES FOR RUNWAY END LIGHTING CIRCUITS.

ALL THESE WORKS, WHEN COMPLETED TOGETHER WITH THE VISUAL DISPLAY UNIT MICROPROCESSOR SYSTEM WILL FACILITATE THE SMOOTH OPERATION AND CONTROL OF AIRCRAFT ON THE GROUND.

THE CONSULTANTS FOR THE PROJECT ARE SCOTT WILSON KIRKPATRICK AND PARTNERS AND KENNEDY AND DONKIN (FAR EAST).

TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS FOR MTR WORK IN CHEUNG SHA WAN  
\* \* \* \* \*

NEW TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS WILL COME INTO EFFECT IN THE SHAM SHUI PO AREA ON SUNDAY (JUNE 25) TO FACILITATE THE CONSTRUCTION OF MASS TRANSIT RAILWAY STATIONS AND TUNNELS IN CHEUNG SHA WAN ROAD IN CONNECTION WITH THE TSUEN WAN EXTENSION, A TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY.

IN THE CASE OF EAST-WEST ROUTINGS, LAI CHI KOK ROAD WILL CONTINUE TO BE OPEN TO TWO-WAY TRAFFIC BETWEEN LAI CHI KOK INTERCHANGE AND THE JUNCTION OF LAI CHI KOK ROAD AND YEE KUK STREET EXTENSION AS AT PRESENT.

TRAFFIC WILL BE EASTBOUND IN LAI CHI KOK ROAD BETWEEN YEE KUK STREET EXTENSION AND BOUNDARY STREET BUT WESTBOUND TRAFFIC WILL BE ALLOWED BETWEEN SHEK KIP MEI STREET AND KWEILIN STREET.

EASTBOUND TRAFFIC ON LAI CHI KOK ROAD, BOUND FOR SHANGHAI STREET, WILL BE REQUIRED TO GO VIA BOUNDARY STREET, TAI NAN STREET AND EITHER POPLAR STREET AND CEDAR STREET. WESTBOUND TRAFFIC WILL STILL BE PERMITTED BETWEEN SHANGHAI STREET AND BOUNDARY STREET.

YEE KUK STREET WILL BE RE-ROUTED ONE-WAY WESTBOUND FROM BOUNDARY STREET TO YEN CHOW STREET AND BY WAY OF A NEW EXTENSION TO LAI CHI KOK ROAD JUST WEST OF YEN CHOW STREET, PROVIDING AN WESTBOUND TRAFFIC ROUTE PARALLEL TO AND IN PLACE OF LAI CHI KOK ROAD.

SYCAMORE STREET WILL BE RE-ROUTED ONE-WAY WESTBOUND FROM PRINCE EDWARD ROAD TO TAI KOK TSUI ROAD TO PROVIDE A ROUTE FOR WESTBOUND TRAFFIC FROM TONG MI ROAD.

AS FOR NORTH-SOUTH ROUTINGS, HING WAH STREET BETWEEN CASTLE PEAK ROAD AND CHEUNG SHA WAN ROAD WILL REMAIN TWO-WAY. A NEW SECTION BETWEEN CHEUNG SHA WAN ROAD AND LAI CHI KOK ROAD IS UNDER CONSTRUCTION AND WILL BE COMPLETED ON JULY 16 BY WHICH TIME TRAFFIC WILL BE ONE-WAY FROM CHEUNG SHA WAN ROAD TO LAI CHI KOK ROAD.

TWO-WAY TRAFFIC WILL BE MAINTAINED ALONG TONKIN STREET, YEN CHOW STREET AND NAM CHEONG STREET. WONG CHUK STREET WILL REMAIN ONE-WAY NORTHBOUND AS AT PRESENT.

+BUS-ONLY+ LANES WILL BE RESERVED FOR FRANCHISED BUSES DAILY BETWEEN 7 A.M. AND 11 P.M. ON THE NORTHBOUND CARRIAGEWAY OF YEN CHOW STREET BETWEEN YEE KUK STREET AND LAI CHI KOK ROAD AND ON THE EASTBOUND CARRIAGEWAY OF LAI CHI KOK ROAD BETWEEN TONG MI ROAD AND POPLAR STREET.

PUBLIC LIGHT BUS RESTRICTIONS BETWEEN 7 A.M. AND MIDNIGHT WILL BE ENFORCED IN YEN CHOW STREET BETWEEN LAI CHI KOK ROAD AND THE SHAM SHUI PO FERRY CONCOURSE AND IN HAI TAN STREET BETWEEN BOUNDARY STREET AND YEN CHOW STREET.

PLB PROHIBITIONS WILL BE ENFORCED ROUND THE CLOCK IN YEE KUK STREET BETWEEN BOUNDARY STREET AND NAM CHEONG STREET= TUNG CHAU STREET BETWEEN YEN CHOW STREET AND TAI KOK TSUI ROAD= AND IN KWEILIN STREET BETWEEN HAI TAN STREET AND TUNG CHAU STREET.

URBAN CLEARWAY RESTRICTIONS WILL BE IMPOSED ON THE FOLLOWING ROADS:

- \* LAI CHI KOK ROAD BETWEEN BOUNDARY STREET AND YEE KUK STREET EXTENSION BETWEEN 7 A.M. AND 7 P.M. THE EXISTING CLEARWAY RESTRICTION BETWEEN SHEK KIP MEI STREET AND KWEILIN STREET WILL BE LIFTED FOR LOCAL CIRCULATION WESTBOUND=
- \* YEE KUK STREET EXTENSION BETWEEN YEN CHOW STREET AND LAI CHI KOK ROAD (24 HOURS)=
- \* BOUNDARY STREET BETWEEN LAI CHI KOK ROAD AND HAI TAN STREET FROM 7 A.M. TO 10 A.M. AND FROM 4 P.M. TO 7 P.M.
- \* YEN CHOW STREET BETWEEN LAI CHI KOK ROAD AND TUNG CHAU STREET FROM 7 A.M. TO 7 P.M. (THIS WILL BE IMPLEMENTED ON JUNE 23).

THE SPOKESMAN SAID NEW SETS OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS WILL BE INSTALLED AND CO-ORDINATED THROUGH THE AREA TRAFFIC CONTROL AND SURVEILLANCE COMPUTER SYSTEMS.

HE URGED MOTORISTS TO DRIVE WITH PARTICULAR CARE IN VIEW OF THE NEW TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS IN THE AREA.

TO AVOID INCONVENIENCE, HE SAID, THROUGH TRAFFIC CAN BYPASS THE AREA BY WAY OF LUNG CHEUNG ROAD AND CHING CHEUNG ROAD.

LORRY PARKING SPACES AND LOADING AND UNLOADING SPACES IN YEN CHOW STREET WILL BE CANCELLED IN ORDER TO FACILITATE TRAFFIC CIRCULATION IN AND OUT OF THE SHAM SHUI PO FERRY CONCOURSE.

A NEW OFF-STREET LORRY PARK WITH 160 SPACES HAS BEEN PROVIDED IN HING WAH STREET SOUTH OF CHEUNG SHA WAN ROAD AND IS NOW OPEN, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

BLACK'S LINK OPEN TO CARS AND TAXIS  
\* \* \* \* \*

BLACK'S LINK WILL SHORTLY BE OPENED TO PRIVATE CARS AND TAXIS TRAVELLING FROM WONG NAI CHUNG GAP TO MAGAZINE GAP DURING MORNING HOURS AS AN ALTERNATIVE ROUTE TO CENTRAL.

THIS SCHEME IS ON A TEMPORARY BASIS AND IS AIMED AT ALLEVIATING THE TRAFFIC CONGESTION AT THE STUBBS ROAD ROUNDABOUT PRIOR TO LONG-TERM MEASURES WHICH ARE ALREADY UNDERWAY TO IMPROVE THIS JUNCTION.

THE ROAD WILL BE OPENED BETWEEN 7 A.M. AND 10 A.M. FROM MONDAYS TO SATURDAYS ONLY.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT SAID THAT DESPITE RECENT ROAD IMPROVEMENTS, INCLUDING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NUMBER OF PASSING BAYS AND CONCRETE MARGINS ALONG THE ROAD, BLACK'S LINK IS STILL QUITE NARROW AND A NUMBER OF BENDS ARE FAIRLY TIGHT. LARGE CARS WIDER THAN SIX FEET ARE THEREFORE NOT ADVISED TO USE THIS ROUTE.

HE ALSO URGED MOTORISTS TO DRIVE WITH UTMOST CARE WHEN THE ROAD IS OPENED.

ARRANGEMENTS ARE BEING MADE TO SET UP APPROPRIATE TRAFFIC SIGNS AND WHEN THIS WORK IS COMPLETED, BLACK'S LINK WILL BE OPENED TO RESTRICTED TRAFFIC.

THE VICE-PRINCIPAL OF THE TECHNICAL TEACHERS' COLLEGE, MR. CHIU PAT-SUN, HAS RETIRED AFTER 19 YEARS' SERVICE WITH THE GOVERNMENT.

MR. CHIU JOINED THE HONG KONG GOVERNMENT IN 1959 AS AN ASSISTANT EDUCATION OFFICER (TECHNICAL). HE WAS PROMOTED TO EDUCATION OFFICER IN 1965.

THE EARLY PART OF HIS CAREER WAS SPENT IN TECHNICAL SCHOOLS AND HE WAS, AT ONE STAGE, THE PRINCIPAL OF THE TSUEN WAN SECONDARY TECHNICAL SCHOOL.

IN 1971, HE MOVED INTO TEACHER TRAINING AND TOOK UP THE POST OF HEAD OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TECHNICAL TEACHER AND WORKSHOP INSTRUCTOR TRAINING AT THE MORRISON HILL TECHNICAL INSTITUTE. WHEN THE TECHNICAL TEACHERS' COLLEGE WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1974, MR. CHIU BECAME ITS FIRST VICE-PRINCIPAL, THE POSITION HE HELD UNTIL HE RETIRED. ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS HE ACTED AS PRINCIPAL OF THE COLLEGE.

MR. CHIU WORKED AS A CIVIL ENGINEER BOTH LOCALLY AND OVERSEAS BEFORE JOINING THE GOVERNMENT SERVICE.
