HELP AVAILABLE ON SWD FAMILY SERVICES HOTLINE

DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE, MRS ANSON CHAN TODAY APPEALED TO THE PUBLIC TO REFRAIN FROM MAKING FRIVOLOUS CALLS TO THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT'S HOTLINE IN ORDER TO LEAVE IT FREE FOR GENUINE USERS.

SPEAKING ON THE GOVERNMENT'S PROVISION OF FAMILY WELFARE SERVICES AT A LUNCHEON MEETING OF THE HONG KONG Y'S MEN'S CLUB, MRS CHAN SAID MANY COMPLAINTS HAD BEEN RECEIVED ABOUT SUCH CALLS WHICH MADE IT DIFFICULT FOR GENUINE USERS TO GET THROUGH.

SHE POINTED OUT THAT THE HOTLINE SERVICE, INTRODUCED ON A TRIAL BASIS IN OCTOBER, WAS INTENDED TO GIVE ON-THE-SPOT PROFESSIONAL GUIDANCE AND ADVICE IN URGENT CASES INVOLVING PERSONAL OR FAMILY PROBLEMS.

THE HOTLINE HAS SO FAR RECEIVED A TOTAL OF 5 800 CALLS, SHE SAID, OF WHICH ABOUT 42 PER CENT ARE LEGITIMATE AND NEARLY 17 PER CENT ARE ENQUIRIES ABOUT OTHER GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS OR ORGANISATIONS.

MRS CHAN SAID THAT WHILE THE SERVICE WAS WELL PATRONISED AND APPEARED TO BE MEETING A REAL NEED, THE DEPARTMENT WAS CONCERNED OVER THE HIGH NUMBER OF NON-ACTIONABLE CALLS -- ABOUT 40 PER CENT OF THE TOTAL RECEIVED.

MANY JUST HUNG UP, SOME WERE PLACED BY PRANKSTERS, AND ON OCCASIONS THE CALLER USED EMBARRASSING LANGUAGE, SHE SAID.

CALLING FOR PUBLIC COOPERATION, SHE SAID ENQUIRIES ABOUT SERVICES SHOULD BE DIRECTED TO THE NEAREST FAMILY SERVICES CENTRE OF THE DEPARTMENT BY TELEPHONING THE LISTED NUMBER OR CALLING IN PERSON.

+THIS WILL LEAVE THE HOTLINE FREE FOR PEOPLE WHO GENUINELY REQUIRE URGENT PROFESSIONAL ADVICE AND GUIDANCE,+ SHE SAID.

MRS CHAN SAID THAT OF ALL CALLS RECEIVED, THE LARGEST NUMBER CONCERNED MARITAL CONFLICTS, AND MANY CALLERS WERE EMOTIONALLY UPSET AND WANTED A SYMPATHETIC EAR. NEXT CAME PROBLEMS INVOLVING THE DISCIPLINE AND UPBRINGING OF CHILDREN AND YOUTH, SHE ADDED.

SHE SAID ONE OF THE REASONS FOR SETTING UP THE HOTLINE WAS TO MEET AN APPARENT PUBLIC CONCERN OVER CHILD ABUSE, BUT SO FAR ONLY TWO CALLS RECEIVED WERE POSSIBLE CHILD ABUSE CASES WHICH WERE IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWED UP AND NEITHER WAS SUBSTANTIATED.

OF ALL CALLS RECEIVED, 550 OR NINE PER CENT REQUIRED FOLLOW-UP ACTION BY THE DEPARTMENT, AS THE BULK WERE DEALT WITH SATISFACTORILY ON THE PHONE, SHE SAID.

SHE SAID THE DEPARTMENT WOULD REVIEW THE HOTLINE SERVICE AT THE END OF THIS MONTH IN THE LIGHT OF THREE MONTHS' OPERATION AND DECIDE WHETHER IT SHOULD BE MAINTAINED ON A PERMANENT BASIS.

THE HOTLINE -- 3-432255 -- IS MANNED BY ONE FULL-TIME AND 10 PART-TIME TRAINED SOCIAL WORKERS FROM 9 AM TO 10 PM FROM MONDAY TO SATURDAY, AND BETWEEN 1 PM AND 10 PM ON SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

AFTER 10 PM, CALLS ARE RECORDED FOR FOLLOW-UP ACTION THE NEXT DAY.

ON THE PROVISION OF FAMILY WELFARE SERVICES, MRS CHAN SAID THE DEPARTMENT PLACED GREAT IMPORTANCE ON THIS PROGRAMME TO WHICH IT DEVOTED OVER 30 PER CENT OF ITS TOTAL FIELD STAFF RESOURCES.

SHE SAID FAMILY SERVICES WERE AIMED AT PRESERVING AND STRENGTHENING THE FAMILY AS A UNIT BY HELPING INDIVIDUALS WITH THEIR PERSONAL OR FAMILY PROBLEMS, AND WERE PROVIDED THROUGH A NETWORK OF 19 FAMILY SERVICES CENTRES LOCATED THROUGHOUT THE TERRITORY.

THE MAIN FEATURES INCLUDE PROFESSIONAL COUNSELLING FOR VARIOUS FAMILY PROBLEMS, REFERRALS FOR ASSISTANCE IN HOUSING, JOB, SCHOOLING, MEDICAL OR INSTITUTIONAL CARE, FAMILY LIFE EDUCATION, CARE AND PROTECTION FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTHS, HOME HELP, AND LEGAL ADOPTION SERVICE, SHE SAID.

IN THE PAST 10 MONTHS, THE CENTRES RECEIVED NEARLY 16 000 NEW CASES REQUIRING FAMILY SERVICES, OF WHICH SOME 9 500 OR ABOUT 60 PER CENT WERE BY DIRECT APPLICATION, WHILE SOME 5 200 WERE REFERRALS.

+THE DEPARTMENT ALSO REACHES OUT TO HELP NEEDY PEOPLE,+
MRS CHAN ADDED.

SHE SAID THE PROBLEMS HANDLED WERE WIDE-RANGING AND MAINLY CONCERNED DIFFICULTIES IN INTER-PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP, PROBLEMS CONNECTED WITH CHILDREN'S UPBRINGING AND DISCIPLINE WHICH MIGHT INVOLVE NEGLIGENCE, ABUSE AND ILL-TREATMENT OF CHILDREN, PROBLEMS ARISING FROM POOR HEALTH, DISABILITIES AND OLD AGE, AS WELL AS FINANCIAL HARDSHIPS.

AT PRESENT, SHE SAID, THE FAMILY SERVICES CENTRES HAVE AN ACTIVE CASELOAD OF OVER 18 000.

CANAL ROAD FLYOVER EXTENSION OPENS TO TRAFFIC

* * * * *

THE \$62 MILLION CANAL ROAD FLYOVER EXTENSION SCHEME WILL BE PARTIALLY OPENED TO TRAFFIC FROM SATURDAY (DECEMBER 13).

THE FLYOVER WILL PROVIDE A HIGH CAPACITY ROUTE FROM THE CROSS HARBOUR TUNNEL TO THE ABERDEEN TUNNEL WHICH IS EXPECTED TO BE OPENED IN PART BY THE END OF NEXT YEAR.

FROM SATURDAY, OTHER THAN ON HAPPY VALLEY RACE DAYS WHEN SPECIAL TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE MADE, THE NORTHBOUND UP-RAMP LEADING FROM MORRISON HILL ROAD, THE SOUTHBOUND DOWN-RAMP FOR MORRISON HILL ROAD AND QUEEN'S ROAD EAST, AND THE VIADUCTS OF THE FLYOVER EXTENSION WILL BE OPENED TO TRAFFIC.

AT THE SAME TIME,

- * THE UP-RAMP, DOWN-RAMP AND THE VIADUCTS OF THE FLYOVER EXTENSION WILL BE PROHIBITED TO ALL LEARNER DRIVERS, CYCLISTS AND PEDESTRIANS=
- * A SPEED LIMIT OF 40 MILES PER HOUR WILL BE IMPOSED ON THESE SECTIONS OF THE FLYOVER=
- * SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC FROM THE CROSS HARBOUR TUNNEL WILL BE ABLE TO GO TO QUEEN'S ROAD EAST VIA THE VIADUCT OVER MORRISON HILL ROAD AND THE DOWN-RAMP BEFORE TURNING RIGHT INTO QUEEN'S ROAD EAST=
- * SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC FROM THE CROSS HARBOUR TUNNEL FOR THE JOCKEY CLUB FOR RACE MEETINGS WILL BE REQUIRED TO OPERATE VIA THE EXISTING DOWN-RAMP OF CANAL ROAD EAST, TURN LEFT INTO LEIGHTON ROAD AND THEN TURN RIGHT INTO WONG NAI CHUNG ROAD NORTHBOUND=
- * TRAFFIC FROM QUEEN'S ROAD EAST FOR THE CROSS HARBOUR TUNNEL, CENTRAL AND NORTH POINT WILL USE THE UP-RAMP AND THE VIADUCT OF THE FLYOVER EXTENSION INSTEAD OF MORRISON HILL ROAD= AND
- * TRAFFIC FROM QUEEN'S ROAD EAST FOR WAN CHAI AND CAUSEWAY BAY WILL FILTER LEFT AT THE JUNCTION OF QUEEN'S ROAD EAST AND MORRISON HILL ROAD TO OPERATE VIA MORRISON HILL ROAD FOR WAN CHAI AND VIA MORRISON HILL ROAD AND LEIGHTON ROAD FOR CAUSEWAY BAY.

THE EXISTING TEMPORARY BUS STOPS IN NORTHBOUND MORRISON HILL ROAD ABOUT 150 METRES FROM ITS JUNCTION WITH QUEEN'S ROAD EAST WILL BE CANCELLED.

NEW BUS STOPS LOCATED WITHIN THE BUS BAY ON QUEEN'S ROAD EAST OUTSIDE QUEEN ELIZABETH STADIUM FOR ROUTE NOS. 5, 10, 15B, 17, 19, 72 AND 170 AND NEW BUS STOPS AT THE CENTRAL TRAFFIC ISLAND ON MORRISON HILL ROAD FOR ROUTE NOS. 5, 10 AND 19 WILL BE PROVIDED.

PEDESTRIAN SUBWAYS FROM QUEEN'S ROAD EAST AND MORRISON HILL ROAD TO THE JOCKEY CLUB HAVE ALREADY BEEN OPENED. PEDESTRIANS ARE ADVISED TO USE THEM.

ALSO ON SATURDAY FROM 11 AM, THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS OF ROADS WILL BE DESIGNATED URBAN CLEARWAYS:

- * THE NORTHBOUND SECTION OF WONG NAI CHUNG ROAD 168 METRES SOUTH OF ITS JUNCTION WITH HAU TAK LANE BETWEEN 7 AM AND 12 MIDNIGHT DAILY=
- * THE NORTHBOUND SECTION OF WONG NAI CHUNG ROAD BETWEEN A POINT 194 METRES AND A POINT 300 METRES SOUTH OF ITS JUNCTION WITH HAU TAK LANE BETWEEN 7 AM AND 12 MIDNIGHT DAILY= AND
- * THE NORTHBOUND SECTION OF CANAL ROAD WEST BETWEEN LEIGHTON ROAD AND ITS JUNCTION WITH CHEUNG WOO LANE FROM 7 AM TO 10 AM AND FROM 4 PM TO 7 PM DAILY.

WITHIN THESE CLEARWAYS, ALL MOTOR VEHICLES EXCEPT FRANCHISED BUSES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO STOP FOR GOODS OR PASSENGERS.

AT THE SAME TIME, SUNG TAK STREET WILL BE DESIGNATED A PUBLIC LIGHT BUS PROHIBITED ZONE. ALL PLB'S EXCEPT THOSE AUTHORISED IN WRITING BY THE COMMISSIONER FOR TRANSPORT WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM ENTERING THE ZONE.

DETAILS OF EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT IN NT REVEALED

DETAILS OF EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENTS IN THE NEW TERRITORIES IN THE NEXT FIVE YEARS WERE OUTLINED TODAY BY DEPUTY SECRETARY FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES, MR AUGUSTINE CHUI.

MR CHUI, WHO WAS SPEAKING AT THE SPEECH DAY OF THE HEUNG YEE KUK SECONDARY SCHOOL, YUEN LONG, SAID 36 PRIMARY SCHOOLS WITH NEARLY 78 000 PLACES AND 66 SECONDARY SCHOOLS WITH 74 400 PLACES WOULD BE BUILT IN THE NEW TERRITORIES DURING THIS PERIOD.

ALSO, THE GOVERNMENT WILL CONTINUE TO SEEK THE CO-OPERATION OF VOLUNTARY ORGANISATIONS EXPERIENCED IN EDUCATION IN RUNNING THESE NEW SCHOOLS.

THE HEUNG YEE KUK, WHICH HAS ALL ALONG ADHERED TO ITS OBJECTIVE OF SERVING SOCIETY, WILL CO-OPERATE WITH THE GOVERNMENT TO BUILD A SECOND SECONDARY SCHOOL AT MUI WO, MR CHUI SAID.

THE KUK HAS AGREED TO PROVIDE MORE THAN \$1 MILLION TOWARDS CONSTRUCTION COSTS AND THE GOVERNMENT HAS ALSO APPROVED FUNDS FOR THE PROJECT.

WORK WILL BEGIN SOON AND IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED BEFORE THE START OF THE 1982/83 ACADEMIC YEAR, HE SAID.

THE SCHOOL, WHICH WILL BE BUILT TO STANDARD PLANS, WILL HAVE 24 CLASSROOMS AND 12 OTHER ROOMS, INCLUDING LABORATORIES. IT WILL PROVIDE QUALITY EDUCATION TO CHILDREN LIVING IN ISLANDS DISTRICT.

THE PROJECT IS A GOOD EXAMPLE OF HOW VOLUNTARY ORGANISATIONS, WHICH HAVE EXPERIENCE AND HAVE ACHIEVED A REMARKABLE PERFORMANCE, HAVE CO-OPERATED WITH THE GOVERNMENT IN EXPANDING EDUCATION.

THE CONTRIBUTION OF VOLUNTARY ORGANISATIONS IN THIS AREA HAS PLAYED AN IMMENSELY IMPORTANT PART IN HONG KONG'S DEVELOPMENT, MR CHUI SAID.

HE ADDED THAT IN THE NEW TERRITORIES IN THE LAST DECADE, 54 PRIMARY SCHOOLS PROVIDING 102 000 PLACES AND 43 SECONDARY SCHOOLS PROVIDING 45 000 PLACES HAD BEEN CONSTRUCTED.

FURTHER WORK ON KCR MODERNISATION

WORK ON YET ANOTHER SECTION OF THE KOWLOON-CANTON RAILWAY WILL START SOON AS PART OF ITS MODERNISATION AND ELECTRIFICATION PROGRAMME.

THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TODAY AWARDED A \$96 MILLION CONTRACT TO KIN SHING CONSTRUCTION CO, FOR THE DOUBLE TRACKING OF A THREE KILOMETRE SECTION OF THE RAILWAY BETWEEN TAI PO KAU AND TAI PO MARKET STATIONS.

COMMENTING ON THE CONTRACT, MR K.K. CHAN, CHIEF ENGINEER OF THE RAILWAY DIVISION OF THE PWD'S CIVIL ENGINEERING OFFICE SAID THE WORK WOULD START IMMEDIATELY AND BE COMPLETED BY LATE 1982.

+WORK ON THE CONTRACT, WHICH FORMS AN IMPORTANT PART OF THE \$2 000 MILLION KCR MODERNISATION AND ELECTRIFICATION PROGRAMME, HAS BEEN DESIGNED AND CONSTRUCTION WILL BE SUPERVISED BY THE RAILWAY DIVISION ON BEHALF OF KCR,+ HE SAID.

SO FAR, CONTRACTS TOTALLING SOME \$86 MILLION HAVE ALREADY BEEN AWARDED AND WORK IS IN PROGRESS FOR DOUBLE TRACKING BETWEEN THREE OTHER SECTIONS -- CHINESE UNIVERSITY AND TAI PO KAU, TAI PO MARKET AND SHEUNG SHUI, AND SHEUNG SHUI AND LO WU STATIONS.

+TODAY'S CONTRACT IS FOR EMBANKMENT WIDENING AND LAYING OF A SECOND TRACK AS WELL AS THE RECONSTRUCTION OF TWO EXISTING RAILWAY BRIDGES TO PROVIDE A HIGHER LOAD CAPACITY TO MEET THE KCR REQUIREMENTS,+ MR CHAN EXPLAINED.

CONSTRUCTION OF TWO ROAD UNDERPASSES UNDER THE TRACKS, FENCING ALONG BOTH SIDES OF THE RAILWAY EMBANKMENT AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF FOUR PEDESTRIAN SUBWAYS TO PROVIDE GRADE SEPARATED CROSSINGS WILL ALSO BE UNDERTAKEN.

MR CHAN SAID THAT THE CONTRACT ALSO COVERED PART OF THE WORKS FOR THE NEW TAI PO MARKET STATION WHICH IS LOCATED SOME 700 METRES SOUTH OF THE EXISTING STATION.

THE REMAINING WORK FOR THE NEW STATION WILL BE CARRIED OUT UNDER A SEPARATE CONTRACT TO BE LET LATER.

THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT IS INVITING APPLICATIONS TO FILL A NUMBER OF VACANCIES FOR BEACH AND SWIMMING POOL ATTENDANT IN THE URBAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT AND ARTISAN I (VEHICLE REMOVAL) IN THE ROYAL HONG KONG POLICE FORCE.

BOTH POSTS CARRY A STARTING MONTHLY SALARY OF \$1 725, RISING TO \$2 030.

THE DUTIES OF THE ATTENDANTS ARE LIFE SAVING, MAINTAINING ORDER AND CLEANLINESS AT BEACHES AND SWIMMING POOLS, GIVING FIRST AID TO SWIMMERS AND SUPERVISING LABOURERS.
