FIGHT YOUTH CRIME ESSAY COMPETITION
* * * *

PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS ARE INVITED TO TAKE PART IN A +FIGHT YOUTH CRIME+ CHINESE ESSAY COMPETITION JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE COMMUNITY YOUTH CLUB SECTION OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT AND THE ROYAL HONG KONG POLICE FORCE.

THE COMPETITION IS AIMED AT PUTTING ACROSS TO PUPILS THE MESSAGE THAT CRIME DOES NOT PAY AND AT MAKING THEM AWARE OF THE CONSEQUENCES OF BECOMING INVOLVED IN CRIME.

IT IS DIVIDED INTO THE PRIMARY (PRIMARY SCHOOLS), SECONDARY (FORMS 1 TO 3), AND SENIOR (FORMS 4 TO 7) DIVISIONS.

THERE WILL BE ONE TOPIC FOR EACH DIVISION: +THE EVIL OF SHOPLIFTING+ FOR THE PRIMARY, +WHAT YOUNG PEOPLE SHOULD DO TO HELP CURB CRIME+ FOR THE SECONDARY, AND +THE EFFECT OF CRIME ON INDIVIDUALS, FAMILIES AND THE COMMUNITY+ FOR THE SENIOR DIVISION.

INFORMATION ON THESE TOPICS CAN BE OBTAINED FROM THE POLICE PUBLIC RELATIONS WING ON 5-284163, EXT. 276 OR 244.

ENTRIES SHOULD BE 400-500 WORDS FOR THE PRIMARY DIVISION, 500-800 WORDS FOR THE SECONDARY DIVISION, AND 800-1 000 WORDS FOR THE SENIOR DIVISION.

THE WINNER OF EACH DIVISION WILL BE AWARDED A PLAQUE AND A BOOK OR A STATIONERY TOKEN WORTH \$1 000.

THE FIRST AND SECOND RUNNERS-UP OF EACH DIVISION WILL RECEIVE A PLAQUE AND A BOOK OR A STATIONERY TOKEN WORTH \$500 AND \$300 RESPECTIVELY.

A PEN AND A CERTIFICATE WILL ALSO BE AWARDED TO WINNERS OF 10 MERIT PRIZES IN EACH DIVISION WHILE ALL PARTICIPANTS WILL EACH RECEIVE A SMALL SOUVENIR.

THE SCHOOLS OF THE THREE WINNING ENTRIES FOR EACH DIVISION WILL BE GIVEN A CERTIFICATE AND A SOUVENIR WORTH \$1 000.

EACH SCHOOL CAN SUBMIT A MAXIMUM OF FIVE ENTRIES FOR EACH DIVISION AND IS REQUESTED TO INFORM THE ORGANISER OF THE ACTUAL NUMBER OF PARTICIPATING PUPILS.

THE ESSAYS, WHICH MUST BE WRITTEN ON SINGLE-PAGED CHINESE SCRIPT PAPER, SHOULD REACH THE COMMUNITY YOUTH CLUB SECTION OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT AT LEE GARDENS, 4/F, HYSAN AVENUE, CAUSEWAY BAY, HONG KONG, NOT LATER THAN OCTOBER 30, 1982.

MODEL WORKER AWARDS

A COMPETITION FOR 10 MODEL WORKER AWARDS STARTS THIS WEEK WHEN FACTORY OPERATORS IN TSUEN WAN, KWAI CHUNG, TSING YI AND MA WAN WILL BE INVITED TO NOMINATE CANDIDATES.

TO WIN A MODEL WORKER AWARD, CANDIDATES MUST HAVE SHOWN INTEREST IN THEIR JOBS AND CONTRIBUTED TO THE INDUSTRY.

ANNOUNCING DETAILS OF THE SCHEME AT A PRESS CONFERENCE TODAY (SUNDAY), THE ORGANISING COMMITTEE'S PRESIDENT, MR LAM KIN-MING, SAID HE WAS CONFIDENT THAT RESPONSE TOWARDS THE COMPETITION, BEING HELD FOR THE THIRD SUCCESSIVE YEAR, WOULD BE AS ENCOURAGING AS IN THE PAST.

EACH FACTORY MAY NOMINATE NOT MORE THAN TWO EMPLOYEES WHO MUST HAVE WORKED THERE CONTINUOUSLY FOR FIVE YEARS.

CANDIDATES WILL BE ASSESSED ON THEIR JOB PERFORMANCE, WORKING RELATIONS WITH COLLEAGUES, SENSE OF RESPONSIBILITY, PARTICIPATION IN FUNCTIONS ORGANISED BY THEIR FACTORIES, AND KNOWLEDGE OF LABOUR LEGISLATIONS.

NOMINEES WILL ALSO BE INVITED TO GIVE THEIR VIEWS ON LOCAL INDUSTRY AND LABOUR LAWS BEFORE A PANEL OF JUDGES.

BESIDES THE COMPETITION, THERE WILL ALSO BE A SINGING CONTEST FOR WORKERS AND A TWO-HOUR VARIETY SHOW TO BE STAGED BY RADIO TELEVISION HONG KONG.

NOMINATION FORMS FOR THE COMPETITION AND ENTRY FORMS FOR THE SINGING CONTEST WILL BE SENT TO FACTORIES FROM TOMORROW (MONDAY). THESE FORMS WILL ALSO BE AVAILABLE AT THE DISTRICT'S PUBLIC ENQUIRIES SERVICE COUNTERS.

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRY FORMS FOR THE SINGING CONTEST IS OCTOBER 15 AND NOMINATION FORMS FOR THE COMPETITION IS OCTOBER 26. ALL FORMS MUST BE RETURNED TO THE TSUEN WAN DISTRICT OFFICE IN FOU WAH CENTRE.

EACH MODEL WORKER WILL RECEIVE A CASH PRIZE OF \$2 000 AND A TROPHY. WINNERS OF THE SINGING CONTEST WILL RECEIVE PRIZES OF \$2 000, \$1 500 AND \$1 000, AND THERE WILL BE THREE CONSOLATION PRIZES OF \$300 EACH.

RESULTS OF THE TWO COMPETITIONS WILL BE ANNOUNCED IN EARLY NOVEMBER AND A PRIZE PRESENTATION CEREMONY, TOGETHER WITH A VARIETY SHOW, WILL BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 16.

THE TSUEN WAN DISTRICT BOARD'S INDUSTRIAL SUB-COMMITTEE HAS ALLOCATED \$50 000 TO THE MODEL WORKERS AWARD SCHEME WHILE ANOTHER \$30 000 WILL BE OBTAINED FROM LOCAL DONATIONS.

OTHER ORGANISATIONS TAKING PART INCLUDE THE FEDERATION OF INDUSTRIES IN TSUEN WAN AND THE CHINESE MANUFACTURERS' ASSOCIATION.

RESPONSE TO NEW MAXICAB SERVICES ENCOURAGING

* * * *

MORE THAN 1 000 APPLICATION FORMS HAVE BEEN DISTRIBUTED FOR RUNNING 25 NEW MAXICAB ROUTES IN KOWLOON AND THE NEW TERRITORIES SINCE THE GAZETTE ANNOUNCEMENT ON SEPTEMBER 10, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

HE SAID THE RESPONSE TO THE CURRENT EXERCISE HAS BEEN VERY ENCOURAGING AND REMINDED PLB OWNERS THAT THE CLOSING DATE FOR APPLICATION IS OCTOBER 1.

+THE APPLICATIONS WILL THEN BE PROCESSED AND THE NEW ROUTES ARE EXPECTED TO BE INTRODUCED EARLY NEXT YEAR,+ HE SAID.

A SELECTION BOARD COMPRISING UNOFFICIAL MEMBERS OF THE TRANSPORT ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND OFFICIALS FROM THE TRANSPORT AND OTHER GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS WILL SELECT THE MOST SUITABLE APPLICANTS.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT IF THE APPLICANT IS IN PARTNERSHIP WITH ONE OR MORE PERSONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATING THE MAXICAB SERVICES, THE PARTNERSHIP SHOULD BE REGISTERED AS A BUSINESS AND THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED WITH A BUSINESS REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE.

+ONLY THE APPLICANT WILL BE RESPONSIBLE TO THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT FOR THE SATISFACTORY OPERATION OF ANY ROUTE GRANTED. THE REGISTRATION OF THE PARTNERSHIP IS TO ENABLE THE SELECTION BOARD TO CONSIDER ANY PROPOSED TRANSFER TO ANOTHER PARTNER IN FUTURE,+ THE SPOKESMAN STRESSED.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT PRIORITY MEASURE IN SHAM SHUI PO
* * * * *

YET ANOTHER PUBLIC TRANSPORT PRIORITY MEASURE TO EASE TRAFFIC CONGESTION IN CASTLE PEAK ROAD AND UN CHAU STREET IN SHAM SHUI PO WILL BE IMPLEMENTED AT THE BEGINNING OF OCTOBER.

BY CURTAILING KERBSIDE ACTIVITIES AND IMPROVING JUNCTION CAPACITIES, BUS JOURNEY TIME AS WELL AS GENERAL TRAFFIC FLOW ARE EXPECTED TO IMPROVE CONSIDERABLY, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

PEDESTRIAN SAFETY WILL ALSO BE ENHANCED WITH THE INSTALLATION OF SIGNALISED CROSSING FACILITIES, HE ADDED.

THE FOUR-PHASE SCHEME WILL PRIMARILY INVOLVE THE DESIGNATION OF URBAN CLEARWAYS ON CASTLE PEAK ROAD AND UN CHAU STREET.

IN ADDITION, SOME TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS SUCH AS THE BANNING OF TURNING MOVEMENTS AND THE CANCELLATION OF PARKING SPACES WILL BE INTRODUCED.

PHASE ONE OF THE SCHEME WILL BE IMPLEMENTED ON OCTOBER 1, AND WILL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

(A) RE-ROUTING OF PRATAS STREET

- * THE SECTION BETWEEN SHUN NING ROAD AND CASTLE PEAK ROAD WILL BE RE-ROUTED FROM TWO-WAY TO ONE-WAY SOUTHBOUND;
- * THE SECTION BETWEEN CASTLE PEAK ROAD AND UN CHAU STREET WILL BE RE-ROUTED FROM ONE-WAY SOUTHBOUND TO ONE-WAY NORTHBOUND;
- * THE SECTION BETWEEN UN CHAU STREET AND FUK WING STREET WILL BE RE-ROUTED FROM TWO-WAY TO ONE-WAY NORTHBOUND.

(B) PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIGHT BUS STAND

THE PARKING SPACES ON THE WESTERN SIDE OF PRATAS STREET NEAR ITS JUNCTION WITH UN CHAU STREET WILL BE CANCELLED TO PROVIDE SPACE FOR THE DESIGNATION OF A PLB STAND.

JING YING DANCERS OFF TO UK

THE HONG KONG JING YING DANCE TROUPE LEFT FOR LONDON LAST NIGHT (SATURDAY) TO GIVE A SERIES OF PERFORMANCES IN BRITAIN.

THE PERFORMANCES ARE ORGANISED BY THE HONG KONG GOVERNMENT OFFICE IN LONDON, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE RECREATION AND CULTURE DEPARTMENT.

THE TROUPE COMPRISES FIVE MEN AND EIGHT WOMEN, ALL OF THEM DANCERS OF THE DEPARTMENT'S RECREATION AND SPORT SERVICE. THEY ARE LED BY A RECREATION AND SPORT OFFICER, MISS CHENG KUK-LAN.

THE PERFORMANCES, DUBBED +ON-THE-ROAD+, WILL START ON SEPTEMBER 30 AT THE ROYAL NORTHERN COLLEGE OF MUSIC IN MANCHESTER, THEN MOVE TO THE MUSIC HALL AND ASSEMBLY ROOM IN EDINBURGH ON OCTOBER 5, AND TO THE ALBANY HOTEL IN BIRMINGHAM ON OCTOBER 7.

EACH EVENT WILL CONSIST OF A RECEPTION FOR ABOUT 600 GUESTS, DURING WHICH THERE WILL BE A STAGE PRESENTATION COMPRISING A 25-MINUTE AUDIO-VISUAL SHOW AND A LARGE VARIETY OF CHINESE DANCES BY THE JING YING TROUPE. MISS CHAN MAN-CHEONG OF THE DEPARTMENT'S MUSIC OFFICE WILL ALSO PRESENT A SOLO PIPA PERFORMANCE.

THE AUDIO-VISUAL SHOW WILL INTRODUCE A PANORAMA OF HONG KONG TO BRITISH GUESTS, WHO WILL BE TOP PEOPLE IN GOVERNMENT, THE PROFESSIONS, COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY, AS WELL AS THE MEDIA. IT WILL EMPHASISE THE IMPORTANCE TO BRITAIN OF ITS TRADE WITH HONG KONG.

THE JING YING TROUPE WILL RETURN TO HONG KONG ON OCTOBER 15.

WELL AND STREAM WATER HYGIENE CAMPAIGN LAUNCHED

THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT HAS LAUNCHED A WATER HYGIENE CAMPAIGN IN WHICH VILLAGERS AND PICNICKERS ARE ADVISED NOT TO DRINK UNBOILED OR UNCHLORINATED WELL AND STREAM WATER.

A DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN TODAY (SUNDAY) SAID THAT HEALTH INSPECTORS ARE NOW VISITING VILLAGES TO ADVISE RESIDENTS ON PRECAUTIONS SUCH AS DISINFECTING STORED WATER AND, IF NO POTABLE WATER IS AVAILABLE, TO BOIL OR DISINFECT WELL OR STREAM WATER.

HE SAID THAT INFORMATION LEAFLETS ON THESE PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES ARE BEING DISTRIBUTED TO THE VILLAGERS.

POSTERS ARE ALSO PUT UP NEAR STANDPIPES TO REMIND VILLAGERS NOT TO DRINK WELL WATER.

MEANWHILE, NTSD STAFF ARE CHLORINATING ABOUT 170 WELLS LIKELY TO BE USED BY VILLAGERS IN THE REMOTE AREAS.

ENTRIES INVITED FOR NT JUDO COMPETITION

JUDO ENTHUSIASTS WILL HAVE A CHANCE TO DEMONSTRATE THEIR SKILL AT A COMPETITION TO BE HELD IN THE NEW TERRITORIES NEXT MONTH.

THE NEW TERRITORIES JUDO TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP, JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE HONG KONG JUDO ASSOCIATION AND THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE OSMAN RAMJU SADICK MEMORIAL GAMES HALL IN KWAI CHUNG FROM 9 AM TO 5 PM ON OCTOBER 24.

THE TOURNAMENT IS AIMED AT PROMOTING THE SPORT IN THE NEW TOWN AS WELL AS RAISING THE STANDARD AND SKILL OF THE GAME, SAID A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NTSD.

HE SAID REGISTERED NEW TERRITORIES ORGANISATIONS AND JUDO CLUBS, WHICH ARE MEMBERS OF THE HONG KONG JUDO ASSOCIATION, ARE INVITED TO TAKE PART IN THE COMPETITION.

PARTICIPANTS SHOULD FORM INTO TEAMS OF FIVE MEMBERS AND ONE RESERVE EACH, HE ADDED.

THE TOTAL WEIGHT OF THE FIVE TEAM MEMBERS SHOULD NOT EXCEED 325 KILOGRAMMES WHILE THE RESERVE MUST WEIGH 65 KILOGRAMMES OR BELOW.

THE LATEST INTERNATIONAL JUDO REGULATIONS WILL BE APPLIED IN THE COMPETITION AND HONG KONG JUDO ASSOCIATION REFEREES WILL ACT AS JUDGES.

APPLICATION FORMS ARE NOW OBTAINABLE AT ALL DISTRICT URBAN SERVICES OFFICES, PUBLIC SPORTSGROUNDS AND SWIMMING POOL COMPLEXES THROUGHOUT THE NEW TERRITORIES.

FRESH WATER SUPPLY TO A NUMBER OF PREMISES IN KENNEDY TOWN WILL BE SUSPENDED FROM 11 PM ON WEDNESDAY (SEPTEMBER 29) TO 6 AM THE FOLLOWING DAY TO FACILITATE A LEAKAGE TEST.

THE AREA AFFECTED WILL BE BOUNDED BY BELCHER'S STREET, SMITHFIELD, THE SEA FRONT AND QUEEN'S ROAD WEST. PREMISES IN THE SECTION OF SMITHFIELD BETWEEN BELCHER'S STREET AND FORBES STREET WILL ALSO BE AFFECTED.
