FREEDOM OF MOVEMENT ESSENTIAL ELEMENT OF LIFE: SASI

* * * * *

THERE IS ABSOLUTELY NO QUESTION OF THE GOVERNMENT TRYING TO PREVENT PEOPLE FROM EMIGRATING, THE SECRETARY FOR ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES AND INFORMATION, MR PETER TSAO, SAID TODAY (FRIDAY).

"FREEDOM OF MOVEMENT IS AN ESSENTIAL ELEMENT OF LIFE IN HONG KONG AND THE CONTINUATION OF THIS FREEDOM IS GUARANTEED IN THE JOINT DECLARATION AND THE DRAFT BASIC LAW," HE TOLD A GRADUATION CEREMONY AT HONG KONG SHUE YAN COLLEGE.

"THE GOVERNMENT THEREFORE RECOGNISES THAT THE ONLY WAY FORWARD IS TO DO WHAT WE CAN TO ENSURE THAT HONG KONG REMAINS AN ATTRACTIVE PLACE BOTH TO LIVE AND WORK IN, AND TO RETURN TO," HE SAID.

"OUR PRIMARY TASK MUST BE TO MAKE SURE THAT THOSE INCLINED TO STAY, THAT IN PRACTICE MEANS OVER 90 PER CENT OF THE POPULATION AND I HOPE INCLUDES MOST OF US HERE, REMAIN FIRM IN THEIR RESOLVE; AND THOSE WHO WANT TO COME BACK FEEL WELCOME."

MR TSAO SAID IT WAS TRUE AND ONLY NATURAL THAT AT THIS POINT IN TIME SOME PEOPLE WERE CONSIDERING EMIGRATION.

"THE PHENOMENON OF EMIGRATION IS NOT A NEW ONE AND HONG KONG HAS ALWAYS BEEN KNOWN FOR ITS HIGHLY MOBILE POPULATION," HE SAID.

MR TSAO POINTED OUT THAT EMIGRATION WAS NOT ITSELF A PROBLEM, BUT IT DID BRING PROBLEMS IN ITS WAKE AND THESE PROBLEMS MUST BE ADDRESSED.

"TO THIS END, WE ARE HAPPY THOUGH NOT COMPLACENT TO NOTE THAT THE NUMBER OF NEW FIRST DEGREE GRADUATES PRODUCED IN HONG KONG HAS INCREASED BY 25 PER CENT FROM 3,000 IN 1987 TO 3,750 IN 1988 AND BY A FURTHER 15 PER CENT TO 4,330 THIS YEAR," HE SAID.

"FURTHER SUBSTANTIAL INCREASES ARE ALREADY ASSURED AND BY 1999 THE NUMBER OF NEW GRADUATES EACH YEAR WILL EXCEED 15,000.

"IT IS NOT JUST A NUMBER GAME BUT A REAL SOLID PLAN FOR THE FUTURE."

IMMUNISATION PROGRAMME FOR VBP ON TAI A CHAU BEING PLANNED
* * * * *

TWO SENIOR DOCTORS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TODAY (FRIDAY) VISITED THE VIETNAMESE BOAT PEOPLE DETENTION CENTRE ON TAI A CHAU.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID THE TWO DOCTORS WERE THERE TO WORK OUT THE ARRANGEMENTS AND PREPARATIONS FOR A MASS IMMUNISATION PROGRAMME AS RECOMMENDED IN A REPORT THE DEPARTMENT SUBMITTED TO THE SECURITY BRANCH YESTERDAY.

THE REPORT WAS SUBMITTED FOLLOWING A STUDY ON AN EARLIER REPORT BY THE UNITED NATIONS HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR REFUGEES CONCERNING THE CONDITION OF BOAT PEOPLE IN DETENTION.

DR C.M. NGAN, COMMUNITY PHYSICIAN AND DR P.L. MA, CHIEF PORT HEALTH OFFICER, WHO ARE THE PRINCIPAL MEDICAL OFFICERS IN CHARGE OF THE MEDICAL AND HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE VBP ON TAI A CHAU, ARRIVED THERE AT ABOUT 10 AM TODAY.

UPON ARRIVAL, THEY VISITED THE TWO HEALTH DEPARTMENT DOCTORS WORKING AT THE MEDICAL CLINIC ON THE ISLAND AND DISCUSSED WITH THEM THEIR WORK AND ALSO THE PREPARATORY WORK FOR THE MASS IMMUNISATION PROGRAMME.

DR MA AND DR NGAN SAID AFTER THE VISIT THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH IS NOW WORKING OUT THE LOGISTICS OF THE MASS IMMUNISATION PROGRAMME AND IT IS HOPED THAT FIRM ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE MADE NEXT WEEK.

"THE IMMUNISATION PROGRAMME TO BE CARRIED OUT FOR THE BOAT PEOPLE ON TAI A CHAU WILL BE SIMILAR TO THAT FOR THE LOCAL COMMUNITY," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

"CHILDREN WILL BE IMMUNISED AGAINST MEASLES, TUBERCULOSIS, DIPHTHERIA, TETANUS, WHOOPING COUGH AND POLIOMYELITIS," HE SAID.

DIRECTORATE POSTS IN TRADE DEPT RETITLED

THE DIRECTORATE POSTS IN THE TRADE DEPARTMENT HAVE BEEN RETITLED TO ALIGN THEM MORE WITH INTERNATIONALLY ACCEPTED PRACTICE AND TO CONVEY THE CORRECT STATUS OF THEIR HOLDERS IN TRADE NEGOTIATIONS.

FROM TODAY (FRIDAY), THE DIRECTOR OF TRADE HAS BEEN RETITLED DIRECTOR-GENERAL OF TRADE. THE NEW TITLES FOR HIS DEPUTIES AND ASSISTANTS ARE DEPUTY DIRECTOR-GENERAL OF TRADE AND ASSISTANT DIRECTOR-GENERAL OF TRADE RESPECTIVELY.

HOWEVER, THE CORRESPONDING CHINESE TITLES AND THE TITLES OF ALL OTHER POSTS IN THE DEPARTMENT REMAIN UNCHANGED.

A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN SAID THE CHANGES, WHICH WERE ANNOUNCED IN THE GAZETTE TODAY, FOLLOWED A RECENT RECOMMENDATION BY THE STANDING COMMITTEE ON DIRECTORATE SALARIES AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE.

"THE CHANGES ARE BEING MADE BECAUSE WE WANT TO MATCH THE TRADE DEPARTMENT'S DIRECTORATE TITLES WITH THE TITLES OF THEIR COUNTERPARTS OVERSEAS AS FAR AS POSSIBLE," HE SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID BEFORE THE RETITLING THERE WAS THE POSSIBILITY OF SOME MISUNDERSTANDING OVER THE STATUS OF HONG KONG'S TOP TRADE NEGOTIATORS.

"THE PROBLEM IS THAT, WHEN OVERSEAS, THE DIRECTOR OF TRADE, HIS DEPUTIES AND ASSISTANTS ARE SOMETIMES ASSUMED TO BE MORE JUNIOR THAN THEY ACTUALLY ARE.

"SUCH CONFUSION NEEDS TO BE AVOIDED. THIS IS PARTICULARLY IMPORTANT WHEN HONG KONG IS DOING ITS BEST TO CEMENT ITS STATUS AS A KEY PLAYER IN THE GENERAL AGREEMENT ON TARIFFS AND TRADE AND TO PRACTISE TO THE FULL ITS AUTONOMY IN TRADE AND ECONOMIC MATTERS," HE SAID.

CSD RENOWNED FOR HIGH STANDARDS

THE CORRECTIONAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT IS RENOWNED FOR ITS HIGH STANDARD OF DISCIPLINE, INNOVATIVE PROGRAMMES OF TRAINING AND EDUCATION, AND HUMANE REGIMES FOR OFFENDERS IN CUSTODY, THE SENIOR MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL, MR ALLEN LEE, SAID TODAY (FRIDAY).

SPEAKING AT THE DEPARTMENT'S PASSING OUT PARADE AT ITS STAFF TRAINING INSTITUTE IN STANLEY, MR LEE SAID CORRECTIONAL WORK IN A MODERN SOCIETY WAS A PROFESSION IN ITS OWN RIGHT.

"IT DEMANDS A GOOD DEAL OF UNDERSTANDING OF THE HUMAN SCIENCES AND MODERN MANAGEMENT IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE ITS HIGHER OBJECTIVES OF CORRECTION AND REHABILITATION.

"MORE RECENTLY, THE DEPARTMENT HAS ALSO EXCELLED ITSELF IN KEEPING AND CARING FOR HUGE NUMBERS OF VIETNAMESE REFUGEES AND BOAT PEOPLE, AN ARDUOUS AND SENSITIVE TASK WHICH DEMANDS INNOVATIONS AND FLEXIBILITY.

"THE ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR VIETNAMESE REFUGEES AND BOAT PEOPLE IS POSSIBLY BUT ONE REFLECTION OF MORE COMPLEX AND VARIED INTERNAL SECURITY RESPONSIBILITIES TO COME TO THE CORRECTIONAL SERVICES AND OTHER DISCIPLINED SERVICES AS WELL," MR LEE SAID.

"THIS ALSO BRINGS OUT THE IMPORTANCE OF THE DISCIPLINED SERVICES TO THE STABILITY AND PROSPERITY OF HONG KONG AS A WHOLE, ESPECIALLY IN THIS TIME OF TRANSITION," HE ADDED.

MR LEE TOLD THE RECRUITS ON PARADE THAT THEY COULD BE RIGHTLY PROUD OF THEMSELVES IN HAVING CHOSEN A WORTHWHILE CAREER WITH A FINE SERVICE.

AS FOR THE DEPARTMENT'S STAFF SHORTAGE PROBLEM, HE SAID THE OFFICERS COULD EXPECT SOME HARD TIMES TO COME.

"I AM SURE THAT IN YOUR WORKING LIFE, THERE WILL BE TIMES OF FRUSTRATIONS AND BOREDOM AMIDST ALL THE STRAINS AND STRESSES, MORE PARTICULARLY SO WHEN YOU ARE STARTING FRESH.

"MY ADVICE IS TO LET YOUR SENSE OF RESPONSIBILITY AND INTEGRITY PREVAIL AT ALL TIMES," MR LEE SAID.

MR LEE ALSO ANNOUNCED THAT 21 OFFICERS HAD BEEN APPOINTED TO ACT AS PRINCIPAL OFFICERS WITH EFFECT FROM AUGUST 1, AND 90 ASSISTANT OFFICERS II WILL ACT AS ASSISTANT OFFICERS I WITH EFFECT FROM TODAY.

TODAY'S PARADE MARKED THE PASSING OUT OF 40 OFFICERS AND 192 ASSISTANT OFFICERS WHO HAVE JUST COMPLETED 26 WEEKS' BASIC TRAINING AT THE STAFF TRAINING INSTITUTE.

MR LEE ALSO PRESENTED SILVER WHISTLES TO THE 10 BEST RECRUITS.

MEMBERS OF THE ROYAL HONG KONG AUXILIARY POLICE FORCE MUST EQUIP THEMSELVES WITH A HIGH DEGREE OF ADAPTABILITY TO COPE WITH THE RAPID PACE OF THE FAST CHANGING SOCIETY, A MEMBER OF THE SHEUNG WAN AREA COMMITTEE, MR BILLY LAM, SAID TODAY (FRIDAY).

ADDRESSING A PASSING OUT PARADE AT THE AUXILIARY POLICE HEADQUARTERS IN KOWLOON BAY, MR LAM POINTED OUT THAT AUXILIARY POLICE OFFICERS SHOULD ACT IN LINE WITH THE CURRENT SOCIAL AND POLITICAL CHANGES TO ENSURE THAT LAW AND ORDER WAS SUCCESSFULLY MAINTAINED.

MR LAM ALSO COMMENDED CENTRAL DISTRICT AUXILIARY POLICE OFFICERS FOR HELPING THEIR REGULAR COUNTERPARTS DURING THE RECENT MASSIVE PUBLIC PROCESSIONS IN THE DISTRICT.

OVER HALF A MILLION YOUNG PEOPLE HAVE JOINED THE JUNIOR POLICE CALL (JPC) SINCE ITS INCEPTION IN 1974, ACCORDING TO THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE. MR RAYMON ANNING.

"THIS FACT HAS CLEARLY ESTABLISHED THE JPC AS ONE OF THE MOST WIDELY RECOGNISED AND SUCCESSFUL YOUTH ORGANISATIONS IN THE TERRITORY," HE SAID.

ISLANDERS AT MUI WO ON LANTAU ISLAND WILL BE TREATED TO A FREE VARIETY SHOW ORGANISED BY THE ISLANDS DISTRICT OFFICE TOMORROW (SATURDAY) AT THE NGAN WAN ESTATE PLAZA.

THE 90-MINUTE SHOW, WHICH WILL START AT 8 PM, IS ORGANISED AS PART OF THE CURRENT VOTER REGISTRATION DRIVE IN THE DISTRICT.

ISLANDS DISTRICT OFFICER, MR JONATHAN NG, WILL OFFICIATE AT THE OPENING CEREMONY OF THE VARIETY SHOW.

ON THE VOTER REGISTRATION DRIVE, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE ISLANDS DISTRICT OFFICE SAID DISTRICT OFFICE STAFF WILL VISIT SELECTED AREAS OVER THE NEXT FEW WEEKS TO HELP ISLANDERS TO REGISTER.

"ISLANDERS AGED 21 OR ABOVE BY THE END OF THIS YEAR, WHO ARE PERMANENT HONG KONG RESIDENTS OR HAVE RESIDED IN HONG KONG FOR SEVEN YEARS, ARE ELIGIBLE," HE SAID.

"THE VOTER REGISTRATION DRIVE WILL END ON SEPTEMBER 30 AND THOSE REGISTERED WILL HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE IN FUTURE DISTRICT BOARD AND REGIONAL COUNCIL ELECTIONS," HE ADDED.

DURING THE DRIVE, DISTRICT OFFICE STAFF WILL ALSO GO ON BOARD FERRIES ON THE OUTLYING ISLAND ROUTES TO HELP COMMUTERS TO REGISTER.

"ALTHOUGH THE ISLANDS DISTRICT ALREADY HAS THE HIGHEST REGISTRATION RATE AMONG ALL DISTRICT - OVER 60 PER CENT OF THE ESTIMATED ELECTORATE IN 1988 - DISTRICT OFFICE STAFF ARE STILL TRYING TO HELP THE REMAINING 14,000 ELIGIBLE ISLANDERS TO REGISTER," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

MONG KOK TO CLEAN UP REAR LANES

THE MONG KOK DISTRICT BOARD'S ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT CAMPAIGN THIS YEAR WILL FOCUS ON THE HYGIENIC CONDITIONS OF REAR LANES.

A WORKING GROUP COMPRISING LOCAL LEADERS AND GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS HAS IDENTIFIED A DOZEN OF SUCH BLACK SPOTS.

APART FROM CLEANING UP THE FILTHY REAR LANES, THE CO-ORDINATION COMMITTEE OF THE CAMPAIGN HAS ALSO PLANNED PUBLICITY ACTIVITIES TO HELP SPREAD THE CLEAN-UP MESSAGE.

/THESE INCLUDE

THESE INCLUDE AN EXHIBITION TO SHOW THE CONDITIONS OF THE REAR LANES BEFORE AND AFTER CLEANING OPERATIONS. THE EXHIBITION WILL BE HELD ON SEPTEMBER 23 TO COINCIDE WITH THE OFFICIAL OPENING OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT CAMPAIGN.

POSTERS AND BANNERS TO REMIND RESIDENTS TO KEEP REAR LANES CLEAN WILL BE PUT UP AT PROMINENT LOCATIONS IN THE DISTRICT.

THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT CAMPAIGN WILL ALSO INCLUDE A VARIETY OF OTHER ACTIVITIES TO STRESS THE IMPORTANCE OF A CLEAN ENVIRONMENT. THESE WILL LAST UNTIL JANUARY NEXT YEAR.
