FS VISITS ZIPPER FACTORY

\* \* \* \*

THE FINANCIAL SECRETARY, MR PIERS JACOBS, TODAY (WEDNESDAY) VISITED THE YKK ZIPPER COMPANY (HONG KONG) LTD. IN TUEN MUN TO SEE THE LATEST DEVELOPMENTS IN THE LOCAL SLIDE FASTENERS INDUSTRY.

HE WAS ACCOMPANIED BY THE ACTING SECRETARY FOR TRADE AND INDUSTRY, MR MICHAEL CARTLAND, AND THE ACTING DIRECTOR OF INDUSTRY, MR ANDREW LEUNG.

MR JACOBS WAS GIVEN A BRIEFING ON THE ZIPPER COMPANY BY ITS MANAGING DIRECTOR, MR HIDEO HYUGA, AND DIRECTOR, MR HISAO ISHIDA.

HE ALSO TOURED THE PLANT TO LOOK AT THE ZIPPERS (INCLUDING METAL, NYLON AND PLASTIC ZIPPERS), BUTTONS, BUCKLES AND ALUMINIUM WINDOW SASHES PRODUCED BY THE JAPANESE FACTORY WHICH WAS ESTABLISHED IN HONG KONG IN 1966.

THE SLIDE FASTENERS INDUSTRY IS AN IMPORTANT SUPPORTING INDUSTRY TO THE GARMENT, HANDBAGS AND TRAVELLING BAGS MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES.

THE BULK OF THE OUTPUT OF SLIDE FASTENERS MADE BY HONG KONG FACTORIES IS FOR LOCAL CONSUMPTION. DOMESTIC EXPORTS OF SLIDE FASTENERS AMOUNTED TO \$438.7 MILLION IN 1987, REPRESENTING AN INCREASE OF OVER 100 PER CENT SINCE 1985.

NEW FISH MARKET TO BEGIN OPERATION TOMORROW

HONG KONG'S NEWEST WHOLESALE FISH MARKET WILL START OPERATION IN KWUN TONG TOMORROW (THURSDAY) TO SERVE THE INCREASING POPULATION OF EAST KOWLOON.

THE MARKET, LOCATED AT 10 TUNG YUEN STREET, YAU TONG, IS THE LATEST IN THE FISH MARKETING ORGANISATION'S WHOLESALE MARKET NETWORK TO PROVIDE ORDERLY WHOLESALE MARKETING OF MARINE FISH FOR BOTH FISHERMEN AND FISH BUYERS.

CONSTRUCTED AT A COST OF \$25 MILLION, IT OCCUPIES AN AREA OF 4,150 SQUARE METRES AND PROVIDES A 91-METRE WATER FRONTAGE TO ENABLE THE BERTHING OF 10 DEEP-SEA FISHING VESSELS AT THE SAME TIME.

THE SENIOR FISHERIES MANAGEMENT OFFICER OF THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT, MR T.Y. YIM, SAID TODAY (WEDNESDAY) THAT THE NEW MARKET PROVIDED THE LATEST FACILITIES FOR THE MARKETING OF MARINE FISH AND ITS CENTRAL LOCATION WOULD PROVE TO BE CONVENIENT PARTICULARLY TO FISH BUYERS IN EAST KOWLOON.

"IT IS ALSO CLOSE TO THE HONG KONG INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT. MARINE FISH EXPORTERS WOULD FIND IT VERY CONVENIENT TO HANDLE THEIR BUYS FOR EXPORT BY AIR," HE SAID.

THE KWUN TONG MARKET COMPRISES A THREE-STOREY ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDING AND A BUSINESS FLOOR. THE ROOF OF THE LATTER WAS BUILT WITH A UNIQUE SPACE FRAME DESIGN WHICH REQUIRES FEW PILLAR SUPPORT.

"THIS ALLOWS A BETTER UTILISATION OF FLOOR SPACE AND ENHANCES MARKETING EFFICIENCY," MR YIM SAID.

FACILITIES PROVIDED ON THE BUSINESS FLOOR FOR THE HANDLING OF FISH INCLUDE HYDRAULIC CRANES, WEIGHING SCALES AND ELECTRIC CONVEYING BELTS. THERE ARE ALSO ICE STORE, AUTOMATIC SEAWATER PUMPS AND FRESHWATER SUPPLY POINTS FOR FISHING VESSELS.

THE NEW MARKET WILL INITIALLY PROVIDE SERVICES FOR BULK SALES AND BOXED FISH SALES WITH AN ESTIMATED THROUGHPUT OF 15 TO 20 TONNES A DAY.

BUSINESS HOURS OF THE NEW MARKET ARE FROM 1 AM TO 12.30 PM.

#### MORE FUNDS FOR SCHOOL FOR HANDICAPPED

THE FINANCE COMMITTEE HAS APPROVED ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO BUILD A SPECIAL SCHOOL IN TUEN MUN FOR MENTALLY HANDICAPPED CHILDREN.

TOGETHER WITH FUNDS APPROVED EARLIER, \$9 MILLION HAS BEEN ALLOCATED FOR THE SPECIAL SCHOOL PROJECT WHICH WILL PROVIDE 200 AND 100 PLACES RESPECTIVELY FOR MILDLY AND MODERATELY MENTALLY HANDICAPPED CHILDREN.

THE SPECIAL SCHOOL, TO BE BUILT AT AREA 31A, TUEN MUN, WILL HAVE 20 CLASSROOMS, FIVE SPECIAL ROOMS, A WORKSHOP, AN OPEN PLAYGROUND AND ANCILLARY FACILITIES.

AT PRESENT 40 AND 120 SPECIAL SCHOOL PLACES FOR MILDLY AND MODERATELY MENTALLY HANDICAPPED CHILDREN ARE PROVIDED IN TUEN MUN AND YUEN LONG.

THE EXTENSION OF THE TUEN MUN WU KING MORNINGHOPE SCHOOL, SCHEDULED TO BE COMPLETED NEXT MONTH, WILL PROVIDE AN ADDITIONAL 100 PLACES.

SITE INVESTIGATION WORK FOR THE PROPOSED SPECIAL SCHOOL HAS NOW BEEN CONDUCTED, AND THE PROJECT WILL BE COMPLETED IN 1992.

SEVEN SENIOR OFFICERS OF THE IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT WILL LEAVE THIS MONTH FOR TRAINING IN THE USA AND EUROPE.

AN ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL IMMIGRATION OFFICER, MR SIU CHUNG-KIT, WILL ATTEND AN 18-WEEK MID-CAREER DEVELOPMENT COURSE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF SYRACUSE, NEW YORK.

CHIEF IMMIGRATION OFFICERS, MR LEUNG PING-KWAN AND MR CHAN CHUN-TO, WILL SPEND NINE MONTHS IN THE STUDY OF SYSTEM ANALYSIS, PROJECT PLANNING AND MANAGEMENT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, BERKELEY, USA.

CHIEF IMMIGRATION OFFICERS - MR YING YICK-MAN, MR LI KAI-FUN AND MISS HUNG MAN-YAN - AND SENIOR IMMIGRATION OFFICER, MR HO KAM-PING, WILL LEAVE FOR THE UNITED KINGDOM, GERMANY AND NETHERRLANDS ON AN EIGHT-WEEK STUDY OF THE IMMIGRATION PROCEDURES IN THESE COUNTRIES.

#### HEADQUARTERS FOR AUXILIARY MEDICAL SERVICES

WORK WILL START IN OCTOBER ON THE CONSTRUCTION OF A HEADQUARTERS FOR THE AUXILIARY MEDICAL SERVICES.

THE ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT IS NOW INVITING TENDERS FOR SITE FORMATION AND CAISSON FOUNDATION WORK FOR THE AUXILIARY MEDICAL SERVICES TRAINING CENTRE IN HO MAN TIN, KOWLOON.

TENDERS FOR THE WORKS MUST BE SUBMITTED BY NOON ON AUGUST 26. THE TARGET DATE FOR COMPLETION IS JUNE NEXT YEAR.

LOCATED ON A 4,500 SQUARE METRE SITE, THE EIGHT-STOREY BUILDING WILL HAVE A FLOOR AREA OF 7,800 SQUARE METRES.

FACILITIES TO BE PROVIDED INCLUDE A MULTI-PURPOSE HALL, LECTURE ROOMS, DEMONSTRATION ROOMS, A NURSING WARD, CANTEEN/OFFICERS' MESS, OFFICE ACCOMMODATION, EMERGENCY STORES AND OPEN PARADE GROUND.

CLOSURE OF UNAUTHORISED BUILDING WORKS SOUGHT

THE BUILDING AUTHORITY IS TO SEEK THE CLOSURE OF ILLEGAL STRUCTURES AT A KOWLOON CITY BUILDING SO THAT THEY CAN BE DEMOLISHED WITHOUT DANGER TO THE OCCUPIERS OR TO THE PUBLIC.

THE ILLEGAL STRUCTURES ARE LOCATED AT FLAT D, THIRD FLOOR, 25 GRAMPAN ROAD.

THE CLOSURE IS PART OF AN EXERCISE TO ENFORCE AN ORDER ISSUED UNDER THE BUILDINGS ORDINANCE ON JULY 22 LAST YEAR REQUIRING THE DEMOLITION OF THE ILLEGAL STRUCTURES.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO APPLY FOR A CLOSURE ORDER FROM THE SHA TIN DISTRICT COURT ON NOVEMBER 2 WAS POSTED ON A CONSPICUOUS PART OF THE STRUCTURES TODAY (WEDNESDAY).

IT IS EXPECTED THAT DEMOLITION WILL START IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE CLOSURE ORDER IS MADE.

URBAN CLEARWAY RESTRICTIONS IN YUEN LONG

\* \* \* \* \*

AS PART OF THE YUEN LONG TOWN CENTRE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT SCHEME FOR THE OPERATIONS OF THE LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT SYSTEM, A NUMBER OF ROAD SECTIONS IN YUEN LONG WILL BE MADE URBAN CLEARWAYS FROM 10 AM ON FRIDAY (AUGUST 5), THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCED.

AT THE SAME TIME, SOME OF THE EXISTING URBAN CLEARWAY RESTRICTIONS WILL BE LIFTED.

THE EXTENT AND OPERATING HOURS OF THE NEW RESTRICTIONS WILL BE INDICATED BY APPROPRIATE TRAFFIC SIGNS AND ROAD MARKINGS. MOTORISTS ARE ADVISED TO WATCH OUT FOR SUCH DIRECTIONS AND NOT TO STOP FOR PASSENGERS OR GOODS WITHIN THE URBAN CLEARWAYS DURING THE RESTRICTED PERIODS.

UNDER THE NEW ARRANGEMENTS, CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE FOLLOWING ROADS WILL BE DESIGNATED URBAN CLEARWAYS OPERATING ROUND THE CLOCK:

- \* EASTBOUND AND WESTBOUND CASTLE PEAK ROAD (YUEN LONG SECTION)
- \* YUEN LONG ON LOK ROAD
- \* LONG YIP STREET
- \* WANG CHAU ROAD
- \* THE NEW FLYOVER CONNECTING YUEN LONG NORTHERN BY-PASS AND CASTLE PEAK ROAD (YUEN LONG SECTION)
- \* TIN HA ROAD
- \* EASTBOUND AND WESTBOUND CASTLE PEAK ROAD (PING SHAN SECTION)
- \* HUNG SHUI KIU MAIN STREET
- \* TAN KWEI TSUEN ROAD
- \* TIN SHUI WAI SOUTH WESTERN ACCESS ROAD
- \* SAN HEI TSUEN ROAD
