+GO TO VOTE+ PUBLICITY IN FULL SWING

PUBLICITY TO GET PEOPLE TO GO TO VOTE IN THE DISTRICT BOARD ELECTIONS ON MARCH 7, HAS GONE INTO FULL SWING.

THE MESSAGE +HONG KONG NEEDS YOUR VOTE+ IS BEING SPREAD BY RADIO, TELEVISION, CINEMAS, NEWSPAPERS AND VARIOUS PUBLIC AREAS.

POSTERS, SHORT FILMS, RADIO ANNOUNCEMENTS AND PRESS ADVERTISEMENTS FORM PART OF THE LARGE-SCALE MEDIA PUBLICITY CAMPAIGN LAUNCHED BY THE GOVERNMENT TO URGE REGISTERED ELECTORS TO VOTE IN THE FIRST TERRITORY-WIDE DISTRICT BOARD ELECTIONS.

AND SOME 30 000 POSTERS BEARING THE MESSAGE HAVE BEEN DISTRIBUTED TO DISTRICTS, AND ARE ON DISPLAY AT BUS-STOPS, FERRY PIERS, PUBLIC AND PRIVATE HOUSING ESTATES, POST OFFICES, PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS, AND GOVERNMENT OFFICES.

MORE THAN 300 LARGER ONES HAVE BEEN PUT UP AT VARIOUS MTR AND KCR STATIONS.

+ANNOUNCEMENTS OF PUBLIC INTEREST+ ARE BEING SCREENED ON TELEVISION AND IN CINEMAS, AND ARE BEING BROADCAST ON RADIO.

ON THE DAY OF THE ELECTIONS, HALF-PAGE ADVERTISEMENTS, GIVING MORE DETAILS ABOUT THE VOTING PROCEDURE, WILL BE PLACED IN LEADING NEWSPAPERS.

VANS WILL TOUR VARIOUS DISTRICTS, BROADCASTING THE THEME SONG SUNG BY MICHAEL KWAN AND ELECTION MESSAGES.

WELL-KNOWN TELEVISION STARLETS AND POPULAR RADIO DISC JOCKEYS, JOINED BY MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNITY YOUTH CLUB WILL DISTRIBUTE ELECTION HANDBILLS TO MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC AT MAJOR TRANSPORT TERMINI DURING LUNCH HOURS.

TO CREATE AN ELECTION ATMOSPHERE, VOTING POSTERS WILL ALSO BE PUT UP ON HUNDREDS OF GOVERNMENT VEHICLES, AND TWO HELIUM-INFLATED BALLOONS, CARRYING LARGE BANNERS WITH THE +VOTE TODAY+ MESSAGE, WILL BE HOISTED OVER STATUE SQUARE IN CENTRAL AND THE URBAN COUNCIL CENTENARY GARDENS IN TSIM SHA TSUI.

AT THE SAME TIME, PUBLICITY AT THE DISTRICT LEVEL CO-ORDINATED BY THE CITY AND NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION IS REACHING ITS HEIGHT.

DISTRICT ACTIVITIES IN THE FORM OF FORUMS, SEMINARS AND MEET-THE-PRESS SESSIONS HAVE BEEN CONDUCTED SINCE EARLY THIS MONTH.

THESE WILL BE SUPPLEMENTED BY MORE LIGHT-HEARTED AND ATTRACTIVE EVENTS SUCH AS CLASSIC CARS DISPLAY, ELECTION FAIRS AND DISTRICT FESTIVALS OVER THE LUNAR NEW YEAR PERIOD.

'AN IMPORTANT STEP AHEAD'

THE FIRST TERRITORY-WIDE DISTRICT BOARD ELECTIONS ON MARCH 7 WOULD BE AN IMPORTANT STEP TOWARD THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE POLITICAL SYSTEM OF HONG KONG, PRINCIPAL ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF THE CITY AND NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION, MR C.M. LEUNG SAID TODAY (SATURDAY).

MR LEUNG SAID: +WHEN ELECTORS CAST THEIR VOTES ON MARCH 7, THEY WILL BE SELECTING THEIR REPRESENTATIVES WHO WILL SPEAK UP AND FIGHT FOR THEIR BENEFITS.

+THE ELECTIONS ARE ALL THE MORE IMPORTANT BECAUSE LATER THIS YEAR, ELECTED DISTRICT BOARD MEMBERS WILL HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY OF SERVING THE PEOPLE AT A HIGHER LEVEL.

+THEY MAY BE ELECTED TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL WHERE THEY CAN REFLECT PUBLIC OPINION AND ALSO TAKE PART IN GOVERNMENT POLICY MAKING.+

MR LEUNG WAS SPEAKING AT THE FINALS OF THE INTER-DISTRICT TELEMATCH GAMES ORGANISED BY RADIO TELEVISION HONG KONG AND THE 18 DISTRICT OFFICES TO PROMOTE DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION.

TEAMS FROM THE 18 DISTRICTS THROUGHOUT THE TERRITORY HAD BEEN COMPETING IN WEEKLY MATCHES FOR TOP HONOURS IN THE TOURNAMENT.

THREE TEAMS REACHED THE FINALS. AFTER TODAY'S CLOSE COMPETITION IN FOUR TELEMATCH GAMES, THE EASTERN DISTRICT TEAM EMERGED WINNER. SECOND CAME THE TSUEN WAN TEAM AND THIRD THE KWUN TONG TEAM.

SPEAKING ABOUT THE COMING ELECTIONS, MR LEUNG SAID THE AVERAGE AGE OF THE 501 CANDIDATES CONTESTING THE 237 SEATS IN THE ELECTIONS, WAS MUCH YOUNGER THAN THAT FOR THE 1982 ELECTIONS, AS 31 PER CENT OF THE CANDIDATES WERE AGED BETWEEN 31 AND 40.

+THIS SHOWS THAT MORE YOUNG PEOPLE ARE INTERESTED IN SERVING THE COMMUNITY,+ HE SAID.

CANDIDATES REPRESENTED A CROSS-SECTION OF THE COMMUNITY, INCLUDING MERCHANTS, EDUCATIONISTS, SOCIAL WORKERS, PROFESSIONALS, FACTORY WORKERS, DRIVERS, HOUSEWIVES AND WHITE COLLAR WORKERS.

THE GRAND FINAL OF THE GAMES WILL BE BROADCAST ON TVB JADE AT 12 NOON ON MARCH 3.

GOOD TECHNICAL TRAINING OFFERED  
\* \* \*

+MANY STUDENTS NOWADAYS PREFER TO DEVELOP THEIR CAREERS IN INDUSTRY AND THE TRAINING CENTRES UNDER THE VOCATIONAL TRAINING COUNCIL PROVIDE THEM WITH GOOD OPPORTUNITIES,+ THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE COUNCIL, MR MORRIS MORGAN , SAID THIS (SATURDAY) MORNING.

THE CENTRES IN THE KOWLOON BAY AND KWAI CHUNG TRAINING CENTRE COMPLEXES WILL ADMIT FORM 3 AND FORM 5 STUDENTS INTO FULL-TIME CRAFT AND TECHNICIAN COURSES IN SEPTEMBER, HE SAID.

SPEAKING TO SOME 200 CAREERS MASTERS AT A SEMINAR ON INDUSTRIAL TRAINING, MR MORGAN SAID THE AVAILABILITY OF APPROPRIATE TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES FOR WORKERS OR NEW ENTRANTS WAS VITAL TO THE CONTINUING EXPANSION OF LOCAL INDUSTRIES.

HE URGED CAREERS TEACHERS TO INFORM THEIR STUDENTS OF THE TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES AND FACILITIES OFFERED AT THE TRAINING CENTRES AND HELP TO MAKE THEM A SUCCESS.

THE TEN TRAINING CENTRES OF THE COUNCIL WILL TRAIN 9 000 TECHNICAL PERSONNEL AT VARIOUS LEVELS ANNUALLY FOR THE AUTOMOBILE, ELECTRICAL, ELECTRONICS, HOTEL, MACHINE SHOP AND METAL-WORKING, PLASTICS, PRINTING AND TEXTILE INDUSTRIES.

+ALL THESE TRAINING CENTRES PROVIDE PRACTICAL TRAINING IN A SIMULATED INDUSTRIAL ENVIRONMENT AND FULL-TIME TRAINEES AT CRAFT AND TECHNICIAN LEVELS WILL BE SENT TO ATTEND RELATED TECHNICAL EDUCATION COURSES AT TECHNICAL INSTITUTES,+ MR MORGAN SAID.

COURSES OFFERED AT THE CENTRES ARE FREE AND WEEKLY ALLOWANCES ARE ALSO GIVEN TO TRAINEES.

IN ADDITION, THERE IS A PLACEMENT SERVICE TO HELP GRADUATING TRAINEES TO ENTER INDUSTRY OR BECOME APPRENTICES TO RECEIVE FURTHER ON-THE-JOB TRAINING, MR MORGAN ADDED.

DISTRICT BOARDS' VITAL ROLE STRESSED

THE IMPORTANT ROLE OF DISTRICT BOARDS IN THE FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OF REPRESENTATIVE GOVERNMENT IN HONG KONG WAS STRESSED TODAY BY YUEN LONG DISTRICT OFFICER, MR JAMES WILSON.

+THE SUCCESS OF REPRESENTATIVE GOVERNMENT WILL DEPEND LARGELY ON HOW WELL PEOPLE'S VIEWS ARE REPRESENTED, AND DISTRICT BOARDS HAVE PLAYED AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN REFLECTING PUBLIC VIEWS ON A WIDE RANGE OF ISSUES,+ HE SAID.

MR WILSON WAS SPEAKING AT A FORUM INTRODUCING 32 CANDIDATES STANDING FOR THE YUEN LONG DISTRICT BOARD ELECTIONS.

+1985 MARKS AN IMPORTANT YEAR IN HONG KONG'S POLITICAL HISTORY AS THE TERRITORY TAKES A MAJOR STEP TOWARD ESTABLISHING A REPRESENTATIVE GOVERNMENT THAT IS ROOTED IN HONG KONG AND REFLECTS THE OPINIONS OF ITS PEOPLE,+ HE SAID.

+DURING THE PAST THREE YEARS, THE YUEN LONG DISTRICT BOARD HAS HELPED TO PROMOTE DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION THROUGHOUT THE DISTRICT AND CONTRIBUTED MUCH TO THE COMMUNITY BY PUSHING FOR VARIOUS COMMUNITY PROJECTS,+ HE ADDED.

#### SUPERSTRUCTURE FOR TUEN MUN FERRY PIER

THE NEW TERRITORIES DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT IS INVITING TENDERS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE SUPERSTRUCTURE TO THE TUEN MUN FERRY PIER, AS PART OF THE CONTINUING DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME OF THE NEW TOWN.

THE CONTRACT INVOLVES THE CONSTRUCTION OF A REINFORCED CONCRETE SUPERSTRUCTURE TO THE PERMANENT FERRY PIER TO BE SITED ON THE SEA FRONT SOUTHWEST OF TUEN MUN, NEAR BUTTERFLY AND WU KING PUBLIC HOUSING ESTATES.

A FINGER PIER EXTENSION TO THE SEAWARD OF THE MAIN FERRY PIER WILL ALSO BE CONSTRUCTED TO PROVIDE BERTHING FOR HOVERFERRIES AND DOUBLE AND TRIPLE-DECK FERRIES.

ON COMPLETION, THE PIER WILL REPLACE THE EXISTING TEMPORARY FERRY PIER FACILITIES AT THE TYPHOON SHELTER.
