YOUNGER GENERATION NEEDS TO KNOW MORE ABOUT INT'L DEVELOPMENTS  
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THE ACTING GOVERNOR, SIR DAVID FORD, TODAY (SUNDAY) STRESSED THAT IT WAS ESSENTIAL FOR OUR YOUNGER GENERATION TO BE MADE MORE AWARE OF INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENTS.

SPEAKING AT THE OPENING OF THE INTERNATIONAL CULTURAL VILLAGE, SIR DAVID POINTED OUT THAT THE POLITICAL CHANGES WE HAD SEEN IN EASTERN EUROPE LAST YEAR AND THE CURRENT SITUATION IN THE MIDDLE EAST DEMONSTRATED CLEARLY HOW THE WHOLE WORLD COULD BE AFFECTED BY THE TURN OF EVENTS IN ONE AREA OF IT.

"FOR US IN HONG KONG WHO ARE SITUATED AT A CROSS-ROADS IN SOUTHEAST ASIA AND WITH OUR OPEN ECONOMY WHICH RELIES ON INTERNATIONAL TRADE FOR OUR VERY EXISTENCE, IT IS ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT THAT OUR YOUNG PEOPLE GAIN AN UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD AT AN EARLY STAGE.

"I HOPE THIS WILL BE THE FIRST IN A SERIES OF SIMILAR GATHERINGS OF YOUNG PEOPLE IN THE YEARS TO COME," SIR DAVID SAID.

HE SAID THAT THIS WEEK HAD BEEN A WONDERFUL ONE FOR HONG KONG AS OUR YOUNG PEOPLE HAD HAD THE OPPORTUNITY OF MEETING AND MIXING TOGETHER WITH OVER 50 DELEGATES FROM EUROPE, AMERICA AND SOUTHEAST ASIA.

SIR DAVID SAID THE THEME OF THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE, "GLOBAL UNDERSTANDING AND CO-OPERATION FOR A BETTER WORLD", WAS VERY TIMELY AT WHICH LIVELY DISCUSSIONS WERE HELD ON SUCH IMPORTANT ISSUES AS POVERTY AND INTERNATIONAL ASSISTANCE, ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, DRUG ABUSE AND COMMUNITY BUILDING.

"SUCH EXCHANGES OF EXPERIENCE IMPROVES UNDERSTANDING AND ENRICHES THE KNOWLEDGE OF ALL THOSE PARTICIPATING," HE ADDED.

SIR DAVID SAID THOUGH WE CAME FROM DIFFERENT PARTS OF THE WORLD, WE ALL FACED THE SAME CHALLENGES OF BRINGING UP THE NEXT GENERATION SO THAT ALL YOUNG PEOPLE COULD HAVE A STRONG SENSE OF PURPOSE AND WOULD BE ABLE TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE COMMUNITIES TO WHICH THEY BELONGED.

HE CONGRATULATED THE FEDERATION OF YOUTH GROUPS FOR ORGANISING THIS INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE, AND RADIO TELEVISION HONG KONG FOR CONTRIBUTING TO THIS MOST COLOURFUL EVENT.

"ALL OF YOU WHO HAVE WORKED SO HARD TO MAKE IT A SUCCESS CAN BE JUSTLY PROUD," HE SAID.

JOINT UK/HK GOVT FUNDING SCHEME

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NEW STUDENTS INTENDING TO PURSUE TERTIARY EDUCATION IN THE UNITED KINGDOM AS FROM THE 1990-91 ACADEMIC YEAR WERE TODAY (SUNDAY) REMINDED OF THE ARRANGEMENTS FOR APPLICATIONS FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THE UK/HK GOVERNMENTS JOINT FUNDING SCHEME.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AGENCY SAID THE SCHEME WAS JOINTLY FINANCED BY THE HONG KONG AND UNITED KINGDOM GOVERNMENTS TO HELP NEEDY HONG KONG STUDENTS MEET THE HIGHEST TUITION FEES CHARGED ON OVERSEAS STUDENTS IN THE UNITED KINGDOM.

"IT IS OPEN TO HONG KONG STUDENTS PURSUING FULL-TIME FIRST DEGREE OR HIGHER NATIONAL DIPLOMA COURSES AT UNIVERSITIES, POLYTECHNICS AND COLLEGES IN THE PUBLIC SECTOR IN THE UNITED KINGDOM, SUBJECT TO THEIR HAVING RESIDED CONTINUOUSLY OR BEEN DOMICILED IN HONG KONG FOR AT LEAST SEVEN YEARS IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO COURSE COMMENCEMENT," HE SAID.

"THE SCHEME IS MEANS-TESTED AND THE MAXIMUM LEVEL OF ASSISTANCE IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN TUITION FEES PAYABLE BY AN OVERSEAS STUDENT AND A BRITISH HOME STUDENT STUDYING THE SAME COURSE.

"THE BRITISH HOME STUDENT FEE WILL BE INCREASED TO 1,675 POUNDS STERLING IN 1990-91. HOWEVER, HAVING CONSIDERED THE NEED OF HONG KONG STUDENTS, IT IS DECIDED TO ADOPT A NOTIONAL 'HOME' FEE OF 637 POUNDS STERLING FOR THE PURPOSE OF CALCULATING STUDENTS' FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN 1990-91," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OFFERED TO SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS WILL BE IN THE FORM OF GRANTS, BUT IF THE TOTAL REQUIREMENT EXCEEDS THE JOINT CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE TWO GOVERNMENTS, THEN EACH SUCCESSFUL APPLICANT'S SHARE OF GRANT WOULD BE PROPORTIONATELY REDUCED, WITH THE BALANCE MADE UP BY A LOAN SOLELY FINANCED BY THE HONG KONG GOVERNMENT.

WITH EFFECT FROM THE 1990-91 ACADEMIC YEAR, AN INTEREST ON THE LOAN BORROWED BY APPLICANTS SHALL BE CHARGEABLE AT THE RATE OF 2.5 PER CENT PER ANNUM CALCULATED FROM THE COMMENCEMENT DATE OF THE LOAN REPAYMENT PERIOD.

APPLICATION FORMS ARE NOW AVAILABLE AT THE STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AGENCY AT QUEENSWAY GOVERNMENT OFFICES, LOW BLOCK, GROUND FLOOR, 66 QUEENSWAY, HONG KONG.

APPLICANTS SHOULD BRING WITH THEM DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE OF THEIR HAVING BEEN ACCEPTED BY AN INSTITUTION IN THE UNITED KINGDOM FOR ONE OF THE COURSES COVERED BY THE SCHEME (PROOF OF CONDITIONAL OFFER WILL BE ACCEPTABLE).

COMPLETED APPLICATION FORMS MUST BE RETURNED BY HAND TO THE STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AGENCY ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 1990.

APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AFTER THE DEADLINE BUT ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 1, 1990 MAY BE ACCEPTED BUT WILL BE PROCESSED FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOANS ONLY.

BEACH SHOW TO PROMOTE KEEP CLEAN MESSAGES  
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A VARIETY SHOW WAS HELD AT THE CLEAR WATER BAY SECOND BEACH TODAY (SUNDAY) TO DISSEMINATE KEEP CLEAN MESSAGES.

THE SHOW IS THE SECOND IN A SERIES OF BEACH EVENTS ORGANISED BY THE JOINT URBAN COUNCIL/REGIONAL COUNCIL KEEP HONG KONG CLEAN STEERING COMMITTEE FOR THIS YEAR'S KEEP HONG KONG CLEAN CAMPAIGN.

"TO ACHIEVE A CLEANER AND THUS, BETTER ENVIRONMENT, IT IS IMPORTANT TO ALSO KEEP OUR BEACHES CLEAN," A SPOKESMAN FOR THE COMMITTEE SAID.

"HOWEVER, MANY BEACH-GOERS STILL LITTER INSTEAD OF MAKING USE OF RUBBISH BINS," HE ADDED.

ACCORDING TO STATISTICS, THERE WERE 271 REPORTED CASES OF LITTERING ON THE BEACHES IN THE PAST 17 MONTHS ENDING THIS MAY.

THE SPOKESMAN STRESSED THAT THE GOVERNMENT AND THE PUBLIC SHOULD JOIN HANDS TO ALLEVIATE THE POLLUTION PROBLEM ON BEACHES.

DURING TODAY'S BEACH SHOW, SPECTATORS WERE REMINDED TO SHARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF KEEPING THE BEACHES CLEAN.

THE ONE-AND-A-HALF HOUR SHOW, COMPRISING A VARIETY OF PERFORMANCES BY SINGERS AND DISC JOCKEYS, WAS PRODUCED BY AND BROADCAST LIVE ON COMMERCIAL RADIO 2.

OFFICIATING AT THE SHOW'S OPENING WERE THE VICE-CHAIRMAN OF THE JOINT UC/RC KEEP HONG KONG CLEAN STEERING COMMITTEE, DR PANG HOK-TUEN; A COMMITTEE MEMBER, MR JOHN WU MAN-KEUNG; CHAIRMAN OF THE SAI KUNG DISTRICT BOARD'S ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE, MR HO KOON-SHUN; AND SAI KUNG DISTRICT OFFICER, MR FREDERICK TONG KIN-SANG.

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RESIDENTS URGED TO REGISTER AS ELECTORS

"IN THE NEXT FEW YEARS, THE MASSIVE PORT AND AIRPORT PROJECTS WILL BE CARRIED OUT IN THE ISLANDS DISTRICT AND MANY DECISIONS AFFECTING RESIDENTS AND THE ENVIRONMENT WILL HAVE TO BE MADE.

"THEREFORE, MAKE SURE THAT THE REPRESENTATIVES YOU WANTED ARE ELECTED BY REGISTERING AND VOTING," HE SAID.

ABOUT 1,000 ISLANDERS AND HOLIDAY-MAKERS ON CHEUNG CHAU ENJOYED THE VARIETY SHOW HELD AT THE PAK TAI PLAYGROUND.

MEANWHILE IN TAI PO, THE DISTRICT VOTER REGISTRATION LAUNCHING CEREMONY AND DISC JOCKEY SHOW HELD AT CINEMA SQUARE ATTRACTED ENTHUSIASTIC RESPONSE FROM RESIDENTS.

OVER 70 VOLUNTEERS LATER VISITED 13 CHINESE RESTAURANTS IN THE DISTRICT TO HELP RESIDENTS SIGN UP.

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APPLY NOW FOR DAY NURSERY FEE ASSISTANCE

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A SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT (SWD) SPOKESMAN TODAY (SUNDAY) REMINDED PARENTS WHO REQUIRE FEE ASSISTANCE FOR THEIR CHILDREN ATTENDING DAY NURSERY TO SUBMIT THEIR APPLICATIONS.

EXISTING RECIPIENTS OF SUCH ASSISTANCE ARE ALSO REQUIRED TO APPLY AGAIN.

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR FEE ASSISTANCE, THE CHILD IN A DAY NURSERY MUST BE AGED BETWEEN TWO AND SIX YEARS OLD.

"THE PARENTS OR GUARDIAN WHO WISH TO APPLY FOR ASSISTANCE MUST DEMONSTRATE THAT THEY ARE UNABLE TO AFFORD THE FULL COST OF THE FEES CHARGED BY THE NURSERY," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

"THEY MUST ALSO PROVE THAT THEY ARE UNABLE TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE CARE FOR THEIR CHILDREN AT HOME DURING THE DAY FOR REASONS SUCH AS BOTH PARENTS HAVING TO WORK TO EARN A LIVING, THE CHILD BELONGING TO A SINGLE-PARENT FAMILY, OR THE PRESENCE OF AN AGED OR DISABLED MEMBER IN THE FAMILY WHO REQUIRES SPECIAL CARE," HE ADDED.

THE AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE PAYABLE WOULD BE CALCULATED WITH REGARD TO THE FAMILY'S NET INCOME WHICH IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE FAMILY'S TOTAL INCOME AND THE RECOGNISED RENT.

THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE PAYABLE WOULD BE BASED ON THE AVERAGE FEES CHARGED IN NON-PROFIT MAKING DAY NURSERIES.

APPLICATION FORMS AND A PAMPHLET INTRODUCING THE FEE ASSISTANCE SCHEME ARE OBTAINABLE AT DAY NURSERIES AND THE SWD'S SOCIAL SECURITY FIELD UNITS.

SEMINAR ON SCHOOL LIAISON COMMITTEES AND CIVIC EDUCATION  
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A SEMINAR TO EXAMINE THE ROLE OF SCHOOL LIAISON COMMITTEES (SLC'S) IN THE PROMOTION OF CIVIC EDUCATION WILL BE HELD ON AUGUST 29 AT THE HALL OF HENRY G. LEONG YAUMATI COMMUNITY CENTRE, 60 PUBLIC SQUARE STREET.

ABOUT 200 MEMBERS OF THE 10 SLC'S IN THE URBAN DISTRICTS ARE EXPECTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SEMINAR ORGANISED BY THE CITY AND NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION. THE SEMINAR WILL BEGIN AT 2.30 PM.

THE SLC'S, INTRODUCED IN 1982, HAD BEEN PLAYING A SIGNIFICANT ROLE IN PROMOTING INTER-SCHOOL LIAISON AND COMMUNITY BUILDING, A SPOKESMAN FOR CNTA SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

"THROUGH ORGANISING A VARIETY OF INTER-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES IN SUPPORT OF GOVERNMENT CAMPAIGNS AND COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT FUNCTIONS, THE SLC'S HAVE ENCOURAGED A LARGE NUMBER OF STUDENTS, PARENTS AND TEACHERS TO PARTICIPATE IN COMMUNITY AFFAIRS," HE SAID.

"THEY ARE ALSO AN IMPORTANT MEANS OF PROMOTING CIVIC EDUCATION," HE ADDED.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT IN VIEW OF THE INCREASING IMPORTANCE OF CIVIC EDUCATION IN CULTIVATING A SENSE OF BELONGING AND CIVIC-MINDEDNESS IN THE COMMUNITY, THERE WAS A NEED FOR A SEMINAR BE HELD TO EXAMINE THE ROLE OF SLC'S IN PROMOTING CIVIC EDUCATION.

IT WAS ALSO HOPED THAT THE SEMINAR WOULD FURTHER ENHANCE LIAISON AMONG THE SLC'S IN THE 10 URBAN DISTRICTS, HE SAID.

THE REGIONAL SECRETARY FOR HONG KONG AND KOWLOON, MR DAVID LAN, WILL SPEAK ON "THE ROLE OF SLC'S IN PROMOTING COMMUNITY BUILDING AND CIVIC EDUCATION".

THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE ON THE PROMOTION OF CIVIC EDUCATION, DR DANIEL TSE, WILL DELIVER A SPEECH ON "DIRECTION OF CIVIC EDUCATION IN HONG KONG IN THE 1990'S", WHILE THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR (SCHOOLS) OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT, MR LUCAS CHAN, WILL SPEAK ON "POLICY CONCERNING THE PROMOTION OF CIVIC EDUCATION IN SCHOOLS".

AT THE SEMINAR, REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SLC'S WILL REPORT ON THE THREE CIVIC EDUCATION TOPICS WHICH THEY HAD EARLIER DISCUSSED IN THEIR RESPECTIVE DISTRICTS.

THE TOPICS ARE: ROLE OF SLC IN COMMUNITY BUILDING AND CIVIC EDUCATION -- A REVIEW OF THE PAST AND A VISION OF THE FUTURE; THE WAYS TO ACHIEVE BETTER UTILISATION OF DISTRICT RESOURCES IN PROMOTING CIVIC EDUCATION; AND HOW TO INTEGRATE CIVIC EDUCATION EFFORTS INSIDE AND OUTSIDE SCHOOLS.

DB DELEGATION LEAVES FOR SINGAPORE AND MALAYSIA

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A WONG TAI SIN DISTRICT BOARD DELEGATION LEFT THIS (SUNDAY) MORNING FOR SINGAPORE AND MALAYSIA ON AN EIGHT-DAY STUDY VISIT.

LED BY THE DISTRICT BOARD CHAIRMAN, DR MICHAEL LEE, AND ACCOMPANIED BY THE DISTRICT OFFICER, MR BRIAN LAU, THE DELEGATION COMPRISES 11 DB MEMBERS AND AN AREA COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN.

DR LEE SAID THE PURPOSE OF THE VISIT WAS TO ENABLE MEMBERS TO HAVE A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF THE SOUTHEAST ASIAN COUNTRIES WHICH HAD A SOCIO-ECONOMIC BACKGROUND AND ACTIVITIES SIMILAR TO HONG KONG'S.

"THE DELEGATION WILL FOCUS ON HOUSING, SOCIAL WELFARE AND TRANSPORT MATTERS OF THE TWO COUNTRIES," HE SAID.

THE DELEGATION WILL FIRST VISIT SINGAPORE WHERE MEMBERS WILL LEARN ABOUT THE POLICIES AND MATTERS RELATING TO SOCIAL WELFARE, PUBLIC HOUSING, ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT AND EDUCATION.

THE PARTY WILL ALSO VISIT COMMUNITY FACILITIES AND ORGANISATIONS IN SINGAPORE'S CHINA TOWN AND THE HEADQUARTERS OF THE PEOPLE'S ACTION PARTY.

IN MALAYSIA, MEMBERS WILL LOOK AT THE GOVERNMENT STRUCTURE AND CONSULTATIVE MACHINERY OF ITS CAPITAL CITY, KUALA LUMPUR, AND WILL SEE THE DEVELOPMENT OF SATELLITE TOWNS ON THE CITY'S OUTSKIRTS.

THE DELEGATION IS EXPECTED TO RETURN TO HONG KONG NEXT SUNDAY (JULY 26).

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THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES THAT THE GASCOIGNE ROAD FLYOVER WILL BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC FROM 12.01 AM TO 6 AM ON TUESDAY (AUGUST 21) TO FACILITATE BRIDGE-EDGING CONSTRUCTION AT THE WYLIE ROAD JUNCTION.

MOTORISTS ON FERRY STREET SOUTHBOUND ARE ADVISED TO TRAVEL VIA JORDAN ROAD EASTBOUND ONTO GASCOIGNE ROAD EASTBOUND.

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THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES THAT FROM TUESDAY (AUGUST 21), A SECTION OF ABOUT 150 METRES OF THE FAST LANES OF BOTH TOLO HIGHWAY NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND NEAR ISLAND HOUSE INTERCHANGE WILL BE CLOSED FOR ABOUT SIX WEEKS.

THE ARRANGEMENT IS TO FACILITATE ROAD CONSTRUCTION WORKS.
