FIGHT CRIME MESSAGES IN TV SPECIAL

\* \* \* \* \*

MORE THAN HALF THE REPORTED CASES OF BURGLARY IN 1985 OCCURRED IN RESIDENTIAL PREMISES AND BURGLARIES HAVE BEEN ON THE RISE IN RECENT YEARS WHILE MOST OTHER CRIMES HAVE FALLEN. THIS WAS REVEALED BY THE FIGHT CRIME COMMITTEE (FCC).

+ALTHOUGH BURGLARY IS A DIFFICULT CRIME TO DETECT, IT IS EASY TO PREVENT BY TAKING SOME STRAIGHTFORWARD AND EFFECTIVE MEASURES,+ A SPOKESMAN FOR THE FCC PUBLICITY SUB-COMMITTEE SAID.

TO HELP PROMOTE PUBLIC AWARENESS OF CRIME PREVENTION, THE FCC PUBLICITY SUB-COMMITTEE WILL JOIN HANDS WITH THE TELEVISION BROADCASTS LIMITED (TVB) TO PRODUCE A +FIGHT CRIME NIGHT+ SPECIAL ON THE +ENJOY YOURSELF TONIGHT PROGRAMME+ TOMORROW (MONDAY).

THE SPECIAL IS DEDICATED TO PUTTING ACROSS FIGHT CRIME MESSAGES TO THE PUBLIC, WITH EMPHASIS ON SAFETY PRECAUTIONS AGAINST RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY.

A DRAMA SEQUENCE IN THE PROGRAMME WILL FEATURE VARIOUS ASPECTS OF CRIME PREVENTION IN THE AVERAGE HOME.

+BY HIGHLIGHTING THE VARIOUS DARK AREAS IN RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY AND FEATURING THE EFFECTIVE MEANS TO PREVENT THEM, WE HOPE TO GIVE VIEWERS A BETTER INSIGHT INTO THE PREVENTION OF THE CRIME,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

ALSO FEATURED IN THE PROGRAMME WILL BE AN INTERVIEW WITH THE RECIPIENT OF THIS YEAR'S GOOD CITIZEN AWARD WHO WILL SHARE HIS EXPERIENCE IN FIGHTING CRIME WITH VIEWERS.

THE GOOD CITIZEN AWARD SCHEME WAS INTRODUCED IN 1973 AS PART OF THE FIGHT CRIME CAMPAIGN. THE SCHEME WAS CONCEIVED WITH A VIEW TO ENCOURAGING CITIZENS TO COOPERATE WITH THE POLICE. MONETARY AND CEREMONIAL AWARDS ARE GIVEN TO THOSE WHO RENDER POSITIVE ASSISTANCE IN THE PREVENTION OR DETECTION OF CRIME AND IN THE APPREHENSION OF CRIMINALS.

ON A MORE LIGHTHEARTED NOTE, AN +EYT GOOD CITIZEN AWARD+ WILL ALSO BE PRESENTED TO A CITIZEN WHO RIGHTEOUSLY PERFORMED HIS CIVIC RESPONSIBILITY BY REPORTING A +CANDID CAMERA+ SHOP THEFT INCIDENT TO THE POLICE.

THE POLICE RECENTLY CHANGED THE ORIGINAL TERM +SHOPLIFTING+ TO +SHOP THEFT+ TO UNDERLINE THE SERIOUSNESS OF THE CRIME TO POTENTIAL OFFENDERS - TEENAGERS AND HOUSEWIVES.

IN TOMORROW'S PROGRAMME, TELEVISION VIEWERS WILL HAVE THE CHANCE TO SEE A DOCUMENTARY DEMONSTRATING THE MOST UP-TO-DATE CRIME FIGHTING EQUIPMENT AVAILABLE IN HONG KONG.

OTHER SEGMENTS OF THE PROGRAMME WILL INCLUDE A PARADE BY THE ROYAL HONG KONG AUXILIARY POLICE BAND AND A MOTORCYCLE TEAM, A QUIZ AND A TELEMATCH GAME BY TVB ARTISTES AND A SOUVENIR PRESENTATION CEREMONY.

THE +FIGHT CRIME NIGHT+ WILL BE BROADCAST LIVE ON THE JADE CHANNEL'S +ENJOY YOURSELF TONIGHT+ PROGRAMME AT 9.35 PM TOMORROW.

CRIME PREVENTION ACTIVITIES IN FULL SWING

A SERIES OF ACTIVITIES TO DRIVE HOME THE MESSAGE OF CRIME PREVENTION AND HOME SAFETY WILL BE LAUNCHED IN NORTH DISTRICT STARTING TOMORROW (MONDAY).

THE ACTIVITIES, ORGANISED BY THE NORTH DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME COMMITTEE, ARE IN SUPPORT OF THE CAMPAIGN INITIATED BY THE CENTRAL FIGHT CRIME COMMITTEE WHICH DESIGNATED SEPTEMBER AS THE +FIGHT CRIME MONTH+.

+THROUGH ACTIVE PARTICIPATION, RESIDENTS IN NORTH DISTRICT, YOUNG AND OLD, WILL BECOME MORE AWARE OF THE IMPORTANCE OF HOME SAFETY AND MORE WILLING TO CO-OPERATE WITH THE POLICE IN COMBATING CRIMES,+ CHAIRMAN OF THE NORTH DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME COMMITTEE, MR TAO MAN-KWONG, SAID.

A MOBILE EXHIBITION VAN WILL VISIT VARIOUS LOCATIONS INCLUDING CHEUNG WAH AND CHOI YUEN ESTATES, LUEN WO HUI, SHEK WU HUI, TIN SUM AND SHEUNG SHUI TEMPORARY HOUSING AREAS FROM TOMORROW TO WEDNESDAY (SEPTEMBER 10) TO SPREAD THE FIGHT CRIME MESSAGE.

BRIEFING ON CHEMICAL WASTE TREATMENT PLANT

MEMBERS OF THE KWAI CHUNG AND TSING YI DISTRICT BOARD WILL BE BRIEFED ON THE ENVIRONMENTAL AND SAFETY ASPECTS OF THE PROPOSED CHEMICAL WASTE TREATMENT PLANT AT A SPECIAL MEETING ON TUESDAY (SEPTEMBER 9) AT THE KWAI TSING DISTRICT OFFICE.

PRINCIPAL ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION OFFICER, MR MIKE STOKOE, AND SENIOR ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION OFFICER, MR PATRICK LEI, WILL EXPLAIN TO BOARD MEMBERS THE TRANSPORTATION OF WASTE, OPERATIONAL FEATURES OF THE PLANT AND ITS IMPACT ON SURROUNDING AREAS.

THE BRIEFING IS A FOLLOW-UP TO LAST MONTH'S DISTRICT OFFICE-ORGANISED SITE VISIT TO VARIOUS POLLUTION BLACKSPOTS IN TSUEN WAN AND KWAI CHUNG WHICH WERE CAUSED BY IMPROPER DISPOSAL OF CHEMICAL WASTE. DURING THE VISIT, BOARD MEMBERS HAD EXPRESSED INTEREST IN VARIOUS SAFETY ASPECTS OF THE PROPOSED PLANT.

CO-OPTED MEMBERS OF THE BOARD'S INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE COMMITTEE AND ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE WILL ALSO ATTEND THE MEETING.

SEWAGE SCREENING PLANT FOR NORTH POINT  
\*\*\*\*\*

TENDERS ARE INVITED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SEWAGE SCREENING PLANT AT HEALTHY STREET WEST IN NORTH POINT.

THE PLANT WILL FORM PART OF A COMPREHENSIVE SEWAGE COLLECTION, TREATMENT AND DISPOSAL SCHEME FOR THE NORTH POINT SEWERAGE DISTRICT, WHICH INCLUDES THE WESTERN PART OF QUARRY BAY, PART OF CAUSEWAY BAY AND TAI HANG.

AT PRESENT, SEWAGE FROM THE DISTRICT IS DISCHARGED UNTREATED INTO VICTORIA HARBOUR THROUGH A SINGLE-PORT SUBMARINE OUTFALL OFF TONG SHUI ROAD.

/THE NEW PLANT, .....

THE NEW PLANT, DESIGNED TO SERVE 370 000 PEOPLE, WILL PROVIDE SCREENING AND DEGRITTING FACILITIES BEFORE DISCHARGE INTO THE HARBOUR VIA A NEW MULTI-PORT SUBMARINE OUTFALL OFF HEALTHY STREET WEST.

IT IS EXPECTED THAT ON COMPLETION OF THE SCHEME THE QUALITY OF WATER OFF NORTH POINT AND NEIGHBOURING AREAS WILL BE SIGNIFICANTLY IMPROVED.

WORK ON THE PROJECT WILL INVOLVE BUILDING AN INLET PUMPING STATION, SCREENING CHAMBERS, GRIT TRAPS, PLANT HOUSES, A TRANSFORMER HOUSE, AN ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, ANCILLARY STRUCTURES, LANDSCAPING, AND ASSOCIATED PIPEWORKS AND ROADWORKS.

CONSTRUCTION IS EXPECTED TO START IN DECEMBER AND BE COMPLETED IN 24 MONTHS.

THE WORKS HAVE BEEN DESIGNED AND CONSTRUCTION WILL BE SUPERVISED BY THE CIVIL ENGINEERING OFFICE OF THE CIVIL ENGINEERING SERVICES DEPARTMENT.

NEW TYPHOON SHELTER PLANNED AT SHAU KEI WAN

THE GOVERNMENT PROPOSES TO CONSTRUCT A NEW TYPHOON SHELTER AT SHAU KEI WAN TO PROVIDE ABOUT 17 HECTARES OF SHELTERED ANCHORAGE SPACE.

THE SHELTER WILL BE CONSTRUCTED WITHIN THE LIMITS OF APPROXIMATELY 21.24 HECTARES OF FORESHORE AND SEA-BED NORTH OF THE EXISTING ALDRICH BAY TYPHOON SHELTER.

THE WORK, WHICH INCLUDES CONSTRUCTING BREAKWATERS, DOLPHINS AND PHYSICAL BARRIERS, IS EXPECTED TO START IN MID-1987 AND BE COMPLETED IN ABOUT 21 MONTHS.

DURING THIS TIME, ADEQUATE MEASURES WILL BE TAKEN TO AVOID CAUSING DISTURBANCE TO SEA TRAFFIC IN THE VICINITY.

WHEN COMPLETED, THE NEW TYPHOON SHELTER WILL REPLACE THE EXISTING ONE WHICH WILL BE RECLAIMED FOR HOUSING DEVELOPMENT.

THE EXTENT OF THE AREA AFFECTED IS DESCRIBED IN A NOTICE IN THE LATEST GAZETTE.

THE NOTICE AND PLAN HAVE BEEN POSTED ON NOTICE BOARDS NEAR THE SITE. THEY CAN ALSO BE SEEN AT THE BUILDINGS AND LANDS DEPARTMENT SURVEY AND MAPPING OFFICE AND AT THE EASTERN DISTRICT OFFICE.

ANY OBJECTIONS SHOULD REACH THE DIRECTOR OF BUILDINGS AND LANDS BY NOVEMBER 4.

PREPARATION IS WELL UNDERWAY IN THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT FOR STAGING A LARGE-SCALE DISTRICT FESTIVAL LATER THIS YEAR, A SOUTHERN DISTRICT OFFICE SPOKESMAN SAID.

A CENTRAL ORGANISING COMMITTEE COMPRISING DISTRICT BOARD MEMBERS, URBAN COUNCILLORS AND AREA COMMITTEE CHAIRMEN, AS WELL AS LEADING LOCAL PERSONALITIES IN SOUTHERN DISTRICT HAD BEEN SET UP TO PLAN THE FESTIVAL, HE SAID.

+ REPRESENTATIVES FROM VARIOUS GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS ARE ALSO INVITED TO ADVISE ON A SERIES OF SPORTS, CULTURAL, RECREATIONAL AND ENTERTAINMENT PROGRAMMES TO BE HELD FROM NOVEMBER 22 TO DECEMBER 7, + THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

SIX WORKING COMMITTEES HAD BEEN FORMED UNDER THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT FESTIVAL CO-ORDINATING COMMITTEE, RESPONSIBLE FOR THE OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONIES, ENTERTAINMENT PROGRAMMES, CARNIVAL, MURAL PAINTING COMPETITION, PUBLICATION AND PUBLICITY MATTERS.

THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT BOARD HAD SET ASIDE \$230 000 TO SUPPORT THE FESTIVAL, WHILE SPONSORSHIP FROM BUSINESS FIRMS AND LOCAL ORGANISATIONS TO DEMONSTRATE THEIR SUPPORT FOR COMMUNITY AFFAIRS WAS ALSO WELCOME.

TENDERS SOUGHT FOR CONTROLLED TIPPING

TENDERS ARE BEING INVITED FOR THE CONTINUATION OF CONTROLLED TIPPING WORK AT SHUEN WAN, TAI PO.

THE TIP, NEXT TO THE INDUSTRIAL ESTATE, IS ENTERING ITS SEVENTH PHASE, DURING WHICH ONE MILLION TONNES OF REFUSE WILL BE DEPOSITED.

THE CIVIL ENGINEERING SERVICES DEPARTMENT IS SEEKING A CONTRACTOR TO CONTINUE TIPPING ON THE SITE, AND ALSO TO CONSTRUCT A 950-METRE-LONG SEA WALL.

THE TIP IS BEING FORMED BY THE SANITARY LANDFILL METHOD, UNDER WHICH REFUSE IS SPREAD AND COMPACTED IN LAYERS WHICH ARE COVERED WITH EARTH. ALL WORKING FACES OF THE TIP ARE SEALED OFF AT THE END OF EACH DAY'S WORK SO THAT HEALTH AND FIRE HAZARDS ARE ELIMINATED.

TIPPING AT SHUEN WAN BEGAN IN 1974.

WORK ON THE SEVENTH PHASE IS TO START IN NOVEMBER AND TAKE TWO-AND-A-HALF YEARS TO COMPLETE. AN ADDITIONAL SEVEN HECTARES OF OPEN SPACE WILL BE PROVIDED FOR RECREATIONAL AND AMENITY USE FROM THIS PHASE.

CONTRACTORS SHOULD SUBMIT THEIR TENDERS BY NOON ON SEPTEMBER 26.

# Royal Visit.

## A ROYAL OCCASION AT GOVERNMENT HOUSE

\* \* \* \* \*

GOVERNMENT HOUSE WILL WELCOME THE RETURN OF THE QUEEN AND THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH WHEN THEY LUNCH AT THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICIAL RESIDENCE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THEIR ROYAL VISIT TO HONG KONG.

ON THE LAST ROYAL VISIT IN 1975 THE QUEEN AND PRINCE PHILIP STAYED AT GOVERNMENT HOUSE. THIS TIME THEY WILL BE STAYING ON BOARD HER MAJESTY'S YACHT BRITANNIA, BUT THE QUEEN WILL BE ATTENDING TWO FUNCTIONS AT THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICIAL RESIDENCE -- THE LUNCHEON ON THE FIRST DAY AND A GARDEN PARTY ON THE AFTERNOON OF OCTOBER 22.

PRESENTED TO HER MAJESTY AND THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH WHEN THEY FIRST ARRIVE AT GOVERNMENT HOUSE WILL BE DEPUTY CHIEF SECRETARY AND CHAIRMAN OF THE ROYAL VISIT STEERING COMMITTEE, MR ALAN SCOTT AND DIRECTOR OF PROTOCOL AND DIRECTOR ROYAL VISIT, SIR MARK HEATH.

THERE WILL BE 140 GUESTS AT THE LUNCHEON WHICH WILL BE HELD IN THE GOVERNMENT HOUSE BALLROOM. AS THE QUEEN AND PRINCE PHILIP ENTER THE BALLROOM A FANFARE WILL BE SOUNDED FOLLOWED BY THE NATIONAL ANTHEM PLAYED BY THE BAND OF THE ROYAL HONG KONG POLICE.

THE SENIOR REPRESENTATIVE OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, SIR SZE-YUEN CHUNG, WILL MAKE A SPEECH AND WILL PRESENT THE QUEEN WITH A SET OF GOLD COINS. TWO OF THESE WERE STRUCK TO COMMEMORATE HER MAJESTY'S VISITS TO HONG KONG AND THE OTHERS FOR EACH YEAR OF THE 12-YEAR CYCLE OF THE CHINESE CALENDAR.

GOVERNMENT HOUSE HAS SEEN MANY ROYAL VISITORS IN ITS 130-YEAR HISTORY. THE FIRST WAS A FORMER DUKE OF EDINBURGH, PRINCE ALFRED, ONE OF QUEEN VICTORIA'S SONS, WHO VISITED HONG KONG IN 1869, THE FIRST MEMBER OF THE BRITISH ROYAL FAMILY TO DO SO.

THE QUEEN'S GRANDFATHER, THEN PRINCE OF WALES, LATER KING GEORGE V, VISITED GOVERNMENT HOUSE IN 1881 AS A MIDSHIPMAN ON BOARD HMS BACCHANTE. ANOTHER PRINCE OF WALES, LATER KING EDWARD VIII, THE QUEEN'S UNCLE, STAYED AT GOVERNMENT HOUSE IN APRIL 1922 ON WHICH OCCASION HE WAS TRANSPORTED FROM THE WATERFRONT TO THE RESIDENCE BY SEDAN CHAIR, THE USUAL MODE OF TRANSPORT IN THOSE DAYS. POLO PONIES FOR THE PRINCE'S USE WERE STABLED IN FRONT OF THE BALLROOM.

MEMBERS OF THE GERMAN AND IMPERIAL RUSSIAN ROYAL FAMILIES HAVE ALSO STAYED AT GOVERNMENT HOUSE AND IN 1881 KING KALAKAUA OF HAWAII WAS A GUEST THERE.
